UMOR REPOR- TERJA BO OSTAL ZAGONETKA?

Tako pravijo tisti, ki poznavajo korupcijo politikov in njihovo zvezo s podzemskimi karakterji.

Chicago, Ill. — (F. P.) — Kar vedo tukajšnji časopisi o umoru "Jake" Lingla, poročevalca "Tribune", toda ne dajo v javnosti, je postal predmet raznih govoricam, ki se sirijo po Chicagu. Vsi časopisi grme o zvezi politikov in policije z gangeškimi skupinami, sprejemajo doneče resolucije, zahtevajo razkritje grafta in obljubujejo svojo pomoč pri čiščenju. Razpisana je velika denarna nagrada tistem, ki najde morilca. Toda včas temu umor poročevalca, ki je bil izvršen v obljudenem hodniku v glavnem delu mesta, ne bo nikoli pojasnjens, ako človek polaga kolikaj važnosti na govorice ljudi, ki poznavajo korupcijo policije in politikov.

Lingle je opravil le malo poročevalskega dela v prešlem letu za "Tribuno". Priateljstvo s policijskim komisarjem Russellom mu je nudilo važnejši in bolje plačan posel. Neki tukajšnji časopisi je poročal, da je Lingle nosil govorice vrste pas, kakršnega nosijo glavni pobočniki Caponije gange. Takih pasov ne nosijo člani gange, ki tekmuje s Caponijevim katero sume, da je odgovorna za umor "Tribuna". Še posej politiki, je s pomočjo Lingla dosegla, da je bil Russell imenovan za policijskega komisarja in to v času, ko je Frank Loesch prevzel vodstvo preiskave o korupciji v mestni upravi, ki je grozila, da bo vrgla mnogo vplivnih uradnikov s političnih tronov.

Spošno mnenje prevladuje, da ne bodo dejstva, ki so igrala veliko vlogo pri umoru, nikdar pojasnjega iz vzroka, ker bi to lahko dovedlo do razkritja zvez, ki jih imajo politiki s podzemskimi karakterji. Tudi čakački bankirji, ki so pravi diktatorji nad mesto upravo, nimajo čistih rok. Tudi oni delajo profite z denarjem, ki ga vlagajo butlejarji in gangeži v bančne institucije.

Umori, politični in drugačni, niso neznana stvar v Chicagu. V interesu korupcije morajo takoj umori ostati tajnost, posebno takrat, kadar bi razkritje lahko pokazala na zvezne butlejarjev z visokimi uradniki. Tisti, ki poznavajo oficijski graft, napovedujejo, da bo umor Lingleja ostal "misterij", kot so postali drugi, ki so bili izvršeni v sličnih okolicah.

147,192 BREZPOSEL-
NIH V CHICAGU
Stevilo so popravili, da je malo
večje

Chicago, — Ljudsko štetje v zadnjem aprili je zabeležilo 147,192 brezposelnih delavcev v Chicagu. To je oficijalno poročilo čakačkega cenzusnega odbora in izdano je bilo 16. junija.

Priješnje poročilo, ki je bilo objavljeno zadnji teden, je bilo revidirano, tako da zdaj izkazuje približno 12,000 več brezposelnih. Največ brezposelnih delavcev so našteli v stanovanjskih hotelih v glavnem delu mesta. Omenjeno stevilo brezposelnih je oficijno definirano tako: "Osebe, ki so bile občasno v števju zmožne za delo, ki so izkale dela, pa ga niso mogle dobiti".

Burna konvencija litvinske jednote

Komunisti razbili prvo sejo zborovanja v Chicagu

Chicago. — Litvinska narodna zveza v Ameriki, bratska podpora organizacija, je 16. junija otvorila svojo redno konvencijo v Chicagu, toda prvi dan je minil med neprestanimi kravali in rabukami, ki so jih uprizorili komunistični delegati. Med 521 delegati je okrog 200 komunistov, med katerimi je precej žensk in te so še najbolj hude. Ves dan so kričale, tako da je bilo vsako delo nemogoče. Predsednik je neprenehoma tolkel s kladivom, dosegel pa ni nič. Imenovan je bil poverilni odbor, a ko je hotel poročati, so komunisti zagnali tak vrišč, da se ni slišala niti ena beseda. Končno je predsednik zaključil sejo in zagrozil, da bo drugi dan poklicana policija v dvorjan, če ne bodo komunisti dari mihi.

Konvencija zboruje v dvorani poslopja št. 3139 So. Halsted st. Odborniki organizacije pravijo, da bi se komunisti radi polastili vodstva in blagajne, čeprav so v manjšini. Pred dvema letoma, ko je bila konvencija v Baltimoru, so se komunistični delegati poslužili enake taktike in razbijali seje.

Magnatje se organizirajo

Borili se bodo za "ekonomsko svobodo" in proti Sovjetski uniji

Atlanta, Ga. — (F. P.) — Bankirji, tovarnarji, plantažniki, železniški in elektrarski magnati devetih južnovzhodnih držav se že dni organizirajo Južnovzhodni svet, ki sicer Novoangelskemu svetu, ki je bil organiziran na vzhodu leta 1926. V izjavi pravijo, da je namen organizacije protektirati njihove interese v borbi za "ekonomsko svobodo". Za vsem tem se seveda skriva tajna grožnja proti organiziranemu delavstvu. Svet je imenoval dolgo vrsto komitejev, med katerimi je eden, ki bo vodil "prosvetno publicitetno".

Hugh MacRae iz Wilmingtona, N. C., je bil izvoljen predsednikom in C. V. Rahner, predsednikom Floridega trgovske zbornice, tajnikom. Uradniki so izrazili, da so pripravljeni na združitev s Trgovskim svetom, ki je bil pred kratkim organiziran po guberniju Gardnerju v Ashevillu, N. Carolina.

J. R. Reib, predsednik Kentucky-Tennessee Light & Power Co., je povedal zborovalcem, da sovjetska Rusija hitro koraka na polju industrijskega napredka in da bodo Združene države v njej v kratkem imeli nevarnega tekmeča. Dejal je, da se bodo moralni ameriški industrijalci hitro pobrigati za gotove revizije ekonomskega načrta, da se prizavijo na tako kompeticijo.

Profesor S. H. Hobbes iz državne univerze v Severni Karolini je pojasnil, da je glavni vzrok nezdrevemu ekonomskemu položaju na jugu najemniški sistem na plantažah. Nasproti so splošnemu mnenju, da so najemniki večinoma zamorci, je Hobbes pokazal, da sta dve tretini najemnikov belopoteči. Navedel je, da bo sejanje bombaža in tobaka vrglo južne države vše večje najemništvo na plantažah kot se nahajajo že sedaj.


Bebata: "Ali je Bog?"

Policjska korupcija na rešetu preiskave. Veleporota dobila nalog, da "gre do dna"

Chicago. — Vojna med butleškimi, raketirske vbori in borlakimi gangami v Chicagu je dobila ta teden novo lice. Ko je bil pred desetimi dnevi ustreljen pri belem dnevu v vprito množični Alfred J. Lingle, reporter največjega čakačkega dnevnika Tribune, in ko v desetih dneh ni bil videti najmanjšega sleda za morilcem, se je vsa jeza dnevnega časopisa obrnila proti policiji. Časopisna ofenziva je bila tako močna, da je policijski načelni Russell podal ostavko v pondeljek in z njim vred je odstropil tudi šef tajne policije John Stege. Russell je odstopil brez vsakega pojasmila ali opravila — kar izgleda je in si vzel en mesec dopusta.

John H. Alcock, ki je provizorično nasledil Russella, je začel najprvo s transferiranjem mnogih policijskih kapetanov in drugih uradnikov. Kaj prineseta izprenemba, se še ne more reči. Obenem pa je policijski odsek mestnega sveta odredil preiskavo o korupciji policijskega departmanta. Istočasno je vrnoviški sodnik kriminalskega sodišča Normoyle naložil okrajni veleporoti, da začne takoj s preiskavo o umoru reporterja Lingla, ki mora iti "do dna".

Medtem pa mestna vlada molči kot grob na težke obdolžitve, ki so jih izklepali listi, da so zločinske gange v zvezi s političnimi bossi in mestnimi oblastniki.

Eina milijarda dollarjev na panju ūla po vodi

Pondeljek, 16. junija, je bil spet črn dan za špekulantov, ovčice in evangeliste ameriške kapitalistične prosperitete. Bil je nov polom delnic na borzah in vrednost delnic je padla najnižje v tem letu in v mnogih slučajih še nižje kakor zadnjo jesen. Obenem je padla vrednost bondov, žita, klavne živine in kovin.

Izguba na newyorskih borzah se ceni na eno milijardo dollarjev. Več kot 7,450,000 delnic je bilo vrnjenih na trg v divljih panik, ko je vrednost tečajev padla od \$2 do \$25.

Polom je prišel, ko je prišla vest iz Washingtona, da predsednik Hoover podpiše carinsko predlogo. V borznih krogih je takoj zavladal strah, da novi carinski zakon zapre evropske trge Ameriki. To je bilo vrok, da so špekulantje začeli prodajati na debelo in kmalu je sledila aplošna panika.

Prepir v delavskih unijah

Niagara Falls, N. Y. — Vojna, ki je obenem cesna in smrtna, se je pojavila med uradniki Centralne delavskih unij in Svetom stavbinstvu unije. Gre se za vprašanje, kdo je glavni izvršni uradnik v krajnjem unijkem gibaju. Spor je nastal radi razlike pri nabiranju prispevkov med članji unij, ki so pridružene Ameriški delavski federaciji, toda v nobenem slučaju ne povedo, da je denar namenjen za komunistično stranko. Pri nabiranju se skoraj v vseh slučajih poslužijo druge firme. Green je pokazal na slučaj, ko se je nabralo za Sacco-Vanzettijev obrambni sklad.

Green je nadalje izjavil, da je najuspešnejše sredstvo za

pobiranje komunistične in vse druge radikalne propagande, pošteno postopanje delodajalcev napram delavcem, da niso slednji izpostavljeni izkoriscenju in bedi.

Plohe pomagajo policiji razgrijati bojkotiste; 60 ranjenih v Bombaju

Bombaj, Indija, 17. jun. — Angliški režim v Indiji in njegova policija sta dobila dobrega zavrnika v "monsunu", to je v sezniškem deževju. Velike plohe, ki ponavljajo dan za dnevno, zelo ovirajo gandhijevce, da ne morejo izvajati bojkotne kampanje.

Včeraj je več tisoč nacionalistov uprizorilo velike demonstracije pred angleškimi prodajalnami v Bombaju. V besm konfliktu s policijo je bilo okrog 60 oseb ranjenih. Tedaj pa se je vila ploha in demonstranti, premočeni do kože, so zbežali na vse strani.

Aretacije bojkotistov se vrše na debelo. Več sto piketov, ki so stražili prodajalnice in pivnice, je pred konfliktu s policijo bilo arrestrirani in odvedeni v trukih v zapore samo v Bombaju. Aret

OFICIJELNA NAZNANILA S.N.P.J.

POJASNILO O SPREMENIBI ASESENTMA MLADINSKEGA ODDELKA

Mladinski oddelek pri naši organizaciji posebno dobro uspeva. Ker stanje mlađinskega sklada omogoča spremembo zavarovalnične oziroma asesmenta na način, da se da višja zavarovalnina za obstoječe prispevke, je gl. odbor že na več sejih razpravljal o spremembah v tem oziru.

Na svoji zadnji seji je gl. odbor zaključil, da bi se zavarovalnina mlađinskega oddelka zvišala s \$600 na \$1000 za one, kateri so zavarovani za \$600 ter proporcionalno tako tudi tistim, ki so zavarovani le za \$250. Zadeva je bila prepričena upravnemu odboru v potrebnu ureitev. Ali vsed zaprek, katere so nastale pri tem načrtu in na katere se takrat ni računalno, je bil gl. upravni odbor primoran načrt spremeniti in sicer iz razloga, ker postopek zakoni v raznih državah, ki določajo maksimalno vsto, za katere se more član mlađinskega oddelka zavarovati v določni državi. Nekatere države, v katerih naša jednota posluje, ne dovoljujejo zavarovalnine preko vsto \$600, in da se tako izognemo različnim zavarovalnim v mlađinskem oddelku, je bilo zaključeno, da se bistveno obdrži sedanji sistem, zniža pa se asesment iz 11 na 10c in iz 22 na 20c mesečno, kar stopi v veljavo s 1. julijem 1930.

Društveni tajnikom in članom naj bo pojasnjeno, da se to znižanje razume takole:

Po prejšnjih pravilih je bil za člane mlađinskega oddelka asesment po 11 in 22c. Od te vsto se je na gl. urad pošiljalo po 10 in 21c; Ie od vsakega člana pa je prejemal društveni tajnik za svoje delo. Po 1. juliju 1930 je asesment za člane mlađinskega oddelka 10 in 20c in ta vsto mora biti mesečno dostavljena na gl. urad, delo tajnika za mlađinski oddelok po navedenem času pa morajo društva plačati sama.

Posebno se se priporoča tajnikom, da bodoče vedno pošiljajo asesment mlađinskega oddelka SEPARATNO kakor tudi vse druge račune, ki ne spadajo med društvene asesmente kakor se to sedaj pogosto dogaja. Our Junior Movement

AT PRESENT there are approximately twenty thousand Juvenile (Junior) members enrolled in the subordinate lodges of the Slovene National Benefit Society. Their membership is scattered throughout the jurisdiction of the Society where there are our local lodges. The number of Juveniles in our organization is encouraging, but it could be increased if our local lodge officers would undertake a more productive plan in bringing into their respective lodges more and more new juvenile members. This could be accomplished successfully by explaining to parents the benefits that our organization is offering to its juvenile members.

There is every promise that the total enrollment of juveniles in the fraternal societies will exceed one million on January 1 next. And the Slovene National Benefit Society certainly can increase its Juvenile membership this year to twenty-five thousand.

Juvenile insurance was first accepted by the National Fraternal Congress of America in 1915. A few of the societies began to write this form of insurance in 1919. But the Slovene National Benefit Society instituted its Juvenile department before 1915. Its Juvenile department started back in 1912. The Slovene National Benefit Society is therefore the FIRST fraternal organization in America which initiated the Juvenile class. Now practically every fraternal organization in America has adopted this system.

Ever since the inauguration of the Juvenile class in the Slovene National Benefit Society it has each year shown steady advancement. With some new impetus given our Juvenile Movement in the next six months can grow to a substantial increase. The new Junior Membership Campaign will be launched, and all local lodges will be given the opportunity to increase their folds in the Juvenile class.

The steady, healthy growth of the Junior Movement within our organization has been nothing short of remarkable, but even more can be accomplished when we realize the far-reaching importance the Junior membership will play in our Society in the next few years. In seventeen years it has attained the wholesome total of approximately 20,000, and this without any nation-wide campaign or propaganda in its interests. Its growth has been due solely to the individual efforts of the local lodges.

The Slovene National Benefit Society early realized the importance of initiating the Juvenile class, and a few years later, in 1919, the Society decided to issue for that purpose for its Juvenile members and for young Slovenes in America a monthly magazine—the Madinski List. Truly, this has been a noble enterprise, as can be exemplified by the many responses from our Juvenile members in these columns.

The Slovene National Benefit Society with its Free Thought principles has undertaken many a progressive step showing the rest of the fraternal societies the way how to attract new members. This has been largely through its publications, together with the stimulation of thousands of adult volunteers who have given their services in this worthy cause.

Our Junior Movement presents to our parents and our race in general the greatest opportunity for the organization and the betterment of our Youth in the history of our existence. And the possibilities of our Juvenile Movement are still great.—(Madinski List.)
