Dr. Eva Klemenčič je raziskovalka, vodja Centra za uporabno epistemologijo na Pedagoškem inštitutu. Je nacionalna raziskovalna koordinatorka dveh mednarodnih raziskav znanja IEA, in sicer ICILS in ICCS. Eva Klemenčič is also a representative of Slovenia in the General Assembly of the IEA and one of the founders of the international research network that conducts research on the use of international large-scale student assessments datasets to the national policy-making in the field of education. Her main research areas are international large-scale student assessments, citizenship education, textbook analyses, didactics of sociology, sociology of education, and theories of knowledge.
