Andraž Teršek, pravnik in doktor (ustavnega) prava, je doktoriral na Pravni fakulteti v Ljubljani, kjer je bil v letih 1998–2008 zaposlen kot asistent. V tem času se je uveljavil kot pravni teoretik in filozof, predvsem pa kot ustavni pravnik. Za njegovo ukvarjanje s pravom so značilni upiranje pravniškimi dogmam in klišejem, konstruktivna kritičnost do pravne realnosti, vztrajanje na trajnem upravičevanju prava z razumnostjo, logiko in moralo, opazovanje temeljnih pravnih vprašanj in problemov z nekoliko drugačnih zornih kotov, vnašanje novosti in novih študijskih pristopov v svetu pravne znanosti. Spisal je številna strokovna in znanstvena besedila s področja ustavnega prava, demokracije, človekovih pravic in drugih sorodnih tem. Bil je pomočnik urednika revije Dignitas. Je avtor dveh knjižnih del o svobodi izražanja. Je pobudnik, soustanovitelj in sourednik prve slovenske revije za ustavno pravo *REVUS*. Zaposlen je na Univerzi na Primorskem, kjer na Pedagoški fakulteti tudi predava.

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
