Konservativna večina rešila župana Yortya

Volivna udeležba in volivni
izidi kažejo, da večina volivcev v Los Angelesu ne
mara skrajnežev, ne belih
ne črnih.

LOS ANGELES, Calif. — Sam Yorty, ki so ga bili volivci tretjega največjega mesta dežele po dveh 4-letnih poslovnih dobah že siti kot župana, je bil v torek ponovno izvoljen, največ zato, ker je bil njegov tekmeč črnec in so ga podpirali črni in beli levičarji vseh vrst od "liberarju" do komunistov. Javno se je za njegovo izvolitev zavzel sam vodnik Komunistične partije ZDA znani Gus Hall in eden od glavnih Bradleyjevih pomočnikov je bivši komunist Dan Rotherenberg.

Sam Yorty je dobil preko 53% vseh glasov z okoli 55,000 glasovi večine nad Thomasonom Bradleyjem. Udeležba pri volitvah je bila sorazmerno velika, saj je volilo okoli 80% vseh volivnih upravičencev. Bradley je bil precej gotov zmage, ker je pri primarnih volitvah dobil 42% glasov, Yorty pa le 26% in so še tik pred volitvami zadnjo nedeljo napovedovali znago njemu.

Yorty je volivce svaril pred skrajneži vseh vrst, črni in beli, ter pri tem pokazal na mestu Gary in Cleveland, kjer imajo črna za župana. Bradley je kazal na brezpravje in korupcijo v mestni hiši in na Yortyjeva potovanja po tujini.

Chapman, sinove Jamesa A., Thomasa J. in Richarda A., tri vnuke in brata Emeryja. Pogreb bo v soboto ob 7.45 iz Grdinovega pogreb. zavoda na Lake Shore Blvd., v cerkev sv. Križa ob 8.30, nato na Kalvarijo.

SAIGON, J. Viet. — Predsednik vlade Severnega Vietnamca Pham Van Dong je dejal tujim obiskovalcem v Hanoiu, da bo Hanoi sprejel neutralizacijo Laos in Kambodže le tedaj, če bodo Združene države pristale tudi na neutralizacijo Tajske. Ta je kot znano članica SEATO in še posebej povezana z ZDA.

Hanoi zahtuje, da je za uveljavitev ženevskega dogovora o ureditvi Indokine. Ta je določil neutralnost za Laos in Kambodžo, za Laos jo je še ponovno dočila konferenca v Zenevi leta 1962. Pa vendar se Hanoi za to ne briga, kot kažejo te vesti.

Znano je, da hoče Ho-Ci-Minh razširiti svojo oblast nad vso Indokinom, to je nad Južnim Vietnamom, Kambodžom in Laos, da pa skuša svoj vpliv raztegniti tudi nad Tajske, na to ni doslej nihče resno mislil. Popuščanje v Juž. Vietnamu že rodi svoje posledice. V Hanoiu se zdijo, da so dajo, da so jim odprta pota k novim osvajanjem, čeprav se niso trdo usedli še niti v Južnem Vietnamu.

Da bo Tajska iskala v zunanjosti politiki nova pota, če bodo ZDA dovolile, da rdeči prevzamejo oblast v Južnem Vietnamu, je očitno. Storila bo to zaradi lastne varnosti, ker na ameriško pomoč tudi v skrajni sili ne bo mogla računati. Postala bo najmanj neutralna, pa naj že to Hanoi zahteva ali ne in naj v tem reče Washington, kar hoče.

Francija sita gaullizma

PARIZ, Fr. — Pri predsedniških volitvah v nedeljo, 1. junija, napovedujejo, da bosta od 7 kandidatov dobila največ glasov bivši predsednik vlade pod De Gaulleom G. Pompidou in začasni predsednik A. Poher, prvi 41%, drugi 30%. Pri glavnih volitvah, ko bosta sama, napovedujejo zmago Poherju v razmerju 55:45.

Naj že volitve izpadajo kakor koli, očitno je, da se je razpoloženje javnosti odmaknilo od De Gaullova načrtov in programov tako v domači kot v mednarodni politiki. Tej se je tekom volivnega boja moral odreči sam Pompidou, ko je videl, da gredo volivci za Poherjem, ki je De Gaullovo politiko odklonil.

Hamburger Hill še v zavezniških rokah

Ameriško vojaško poveljstvo je objavilo, da so enote 101. divizije letalske pehoty še vedno na znanem Hamburger Hillu, za katerega so se z ročnimi in tankimi oružji borile, predno so ga zasedle. Boj za ta hrib je označil sen. E. M. Kennedy za "nesmiselen in nekoristen" in se sploh zaginal v sedanjo ameriško vojaško taktilno v vojskovjanju v Južnem Vietnamu. Po njegovem je vsako bojevanje nesmiseln, ko se v Parizu vrše razgovori o koncu vojskovjanja in mora priti tako ali tako do miru in ameriškega odhoda iz Vietnamom. Vojaki so senatorjev odgovorili, da je treba sovražnika preganjati in ga skušati uničiti, dokler vojna traja. Želja po končaju vojne še ni njen dejanski konec.

Van Thieu je izjavil, da njegova vlada ne bo pristala na nobene posebne volitve in ne na kako koaličnsko vlado.

Demokratije se pripravljajo na županske volitve - s prepriki

CLEVELAND, O. — Že zadnjič so v tednih županske kampagne nekateri vodilni demokratje, ki niso bili za Stokesovo kandidaturo, govorili med seboj, toda ne tako tisto, da jih ne bi slišala vsej clevelandške politične javnost, da naj Stokesova kandidatura kar zmaga. Ko bo Stokes postal župan, mu bodo že nastavili past, ki se bo vanjo ujel in tako bo spodelata njegova kandidatura pri prihodnjih volitvah l. 1970. Tako govorjenje in tako žuganje ni v političnem življenju nič kaj nenavadnega, zato se ranj nihče dosti menil. Stokesovi tekmeci in nasprotniki med demokratami na to niso pozabili. Sicer niso kršili grobe strankarske discipline, pa vendar niso marsikaterega Stokesovega koraka odobravali. Parkrat so to tudi kar naravnost povedali. Stokesovo županovanje ni torej ravno utrijevalo demokratske edinstvenosti in discipline. Razmere med clevelandskimi demokratimi so že dolga desetletja take, da jim je bil vsem le malokateri župan všeč. Zato Stokesovi odnosi do stranke niso nič izred-

nega, akoravno niso taki, kot bi morali biti.

To se nazorno vidi tudi v slučaju z a i d a v e mestnega predela Lee-Seville. Mestna uprava mora v ta namen dati stavbna dovoljenja. Ali naj jih sploh da, kakšna naj da, kdaj in komu naj jih da, to so vprašanja, ki cepijo vse zainteresirane mestne prebivalce.

Vprašanje je izredno kočljivo, ker ob njegu zadenejo socialni in rasni spori, ki jih ravno v našem mestu ne manjka, kadar je treba govoriti o tem, kdo naj kje stanuje. Na vprašanja stavbnih dovoljenj v Lee-Seville se je razbila tudi demokratska politika. Nekateri politiki zagovarjajo županovo stališče, da je treba najti način, kako dati stavbna dovoljenja, drugi so pa načelno proti. Tako se je Stokes znašel med dvema ognjem, ki sta postala posebno pereča, ko je enega razpalihal sam predsednik mestnega sveta Stanton. Postavljal se je na stališče, da bo Stokesemu načrtu odločno nasprotoval in izjavil županovemu pravnemu svetovalcu Spectoru, da bo proti Stokesovi

ideji nastopal tudi takrat, kadar bo postalo jasno, da bi tako nasprotovanje pomagalo pri prihodnjih županskih volitvah republikanskemu kandidatu Perku na županski stolček. Republikanci so to Stantonovo izjavo brz raztrabili in napravili iz nje gradivo za začetek naše mestne volivne kampanje.

Ali je začetek postavljen v pravi čas, je odprt vprašanje. Zdi se, da je prezgoden, čeprav začetek v oči vsega postopka samega ni več tako zelo odmaknjen. Toda o tem ima lahko vsakdo svoje mnenje.

Nevarnost Stantonove izjave ne tiči ravno v tem, da Stanton namigava, da bo del demokratov volil republikanskega kandidata. Na take zapisane v ameriški politiki smo navajeni. Nevarnost tiči v tem, da se lahko spor zasuče tako, da pri volitvah ne bomo imeli republikanskega in demokratskega kandidata, ampak črnega in belega. Čudovito hitro so na to misel prišli vsi, ki so slišali, kaj je Stanton rekel Spectoru. Mimo grede povedano, Stanton sam

sedaj trdi, da kaj takega ni rekel Spectoru. To je razumljivo, saj je Spector mogel povediti Stokesu le smisel Stantonove izjave, ni pa mogel navesti doslovno.

V take drobnarje se clevelandška ulica ne bo spuščala. Se bo rajše oprijela misli, da bo nekaj belih demokratov zaradi Stokesa prešlo pri županskih volivath na republikansko stran in volilo Perka. To je sicer najslabša alternativa v razlagi spora med Stokesom in Stantonom, toda ni izključena.

Če se uveljavlji, bodo verjetno po nej takoj zgrabili črni skrajneži in jo razgreli v pravo rasno strast. To je tista nevarnost, ki se jo preneka ter bojijo. Kdor namreč misli, da nam je letošnje poletje mir v našem mestu že zajamčen, se moti. Črni nestrpne, podpirani od nove levice, komaj čakajo na priliko, da zopet sprožijo nemire, kot smo jih imeli pred 3 leti. Doslej so se vsaj deloma bali županovega moralnega vpliva. Kdo ve, če se ga bodo tudi v bodoče.

**V VIETNAMU PREMIRJE V
ČAST BUDOVEGA ROJSTVA**

Danes zjutraj so rdeči začeli svoje objavljeno premirje za 48 ur v čast Budovega rojstva. Zavezniška stran je proglašila premirje le za en dan in sicer od 6. popoldne jutri. — Izgube ta teden manjše. Zavezniški so niso odšli s "Hamburger Hill". — Van Thieu v Južni Koreji išče podporo proti "lažnemu miru".

SAIGON, J. Viet. — Rdeči so začeli danes zjutraj ob sedmih po tukajšnjem času svoje 48-urno premirje v čast Budovega rojstva. Zavezniška stran je objavila že pred tedni, da bo od svoje strani ustavila vse sovražnosti za Budov rojstni dan, v kolikor ne bo napadena od rdečih. Premirje je omejila na samo 24 ur, začela ga bo izvajati južni šestih popoldne. Preteklo noč so rdeči pognali rakete in mine na 11 raznih postojank vladnih in ameriških sil v Južnem Vietnamu. V zadnjih dneh ni prišlo do nobenih večjih spopadov. Rdeči so napadli južnovietnamsko vladno postojanko 8 milj severozahodno od Ap Bia nad dolino A Shaw. Napad je bil zavrnjen, Južni Vietnamci so imeli v boju 13 mrtvih in 24 ranjenih, rdeči pa so pustili na bojišču 22 mrtvih.

V preteklem tednu je padlo v bojih v Južnem Vietnamu skupno 265 ameriških vojakov, 1863 pa je bilo ranjenih. V primeri s tednom preje je število precej manjše, pa še vedno večje kot je bilo povprečno v zadnjih mesecih, ko je rdeča pomladanska ofenziva splahnela.

Vlada ZDA je poučila, da zavezniška stran ni povečala vojaških operacij, zlasti ne ameriške vojaške sile. V kolikor je prišlo do novih večjih bojev, so začeli ali vsaj zakrivili rdeči.

Van Thieu v Južni Koreji

SEOUL, J. Kor. — Predsednik republike Južnega Vietnamca Nguyen Van Thieu je tu na uradnem obisku, ko se pripravlja na sestanek s predsednikom ZDA Nixonom na otoku Midway konec prihodnjega tedna. V razgovorih s predsednikom Parkom se je Van Thieu izrazil odločno proti vsakemu "lažnemu miru", ki bi začasno vojskovjanje v Vietnamu ustavil, pa nato dal možnost rdečim za nov splošni napad in vojaško zmago nad Južnim Vietnamom. Predsednik Južne Koreje je podprt to stališče predsednika Južnega Vietnamca. Južna Koreja ima v Južnem Vietnamu dve celni divizi, preko 50.000 mož, ki se zelo uspešno vojskujejo z rdečimi, pa tudi uspešno pridobivajo domače prebivalstvo na svojo vladno stran.

V afriških republikah se zmeraj nekaj kuha

CLEVELAND, O. — Odkar se Amerika ne briga več za notranje zmešljave v afriških republikah, se tam zmeraj dogajajo revolucije. V Sudanu se na primer vrstijo kar vsakih 5-6 let. Tam imajo torej prave politične petekete. Sudan je postal samostojen 1. 1956. Prvi dve leti je vladala civilna vlada, potem jo je pregnala zarota generalov v l. 1958. L. 1964 je sledila diktaturi civilna vlada, ki so jo pa ravno sedaj prekucnili vojaki v zvezi s civilisti in z Naserjevim blagoslovom. Podrobnosti o poteku revolucije še manjkajo, o-pazovalci so jo pa že dolgo časa napovedovali.

V republiki Dahomey niso na boljšem. Tudi tam vlada med predsednikom republike in vladajo tako napeto razmerje, da pričakujejo upor.

V sosedni republiki Togo na videz trdno sedi na predsedniškem mestu 32-letni general Eyadema, ki je l. 1963 lastnorocno ustrelil civilnega predsednika Olympia in uvedel diktaturo. Sestavil je vlado iz civilistov, ker med oficirji ni dobil sposobnih upravnikov, saj tudi sam nimam več kot 6 razredov ljudske šole. 





NEW GUIDES FOR MODERN BRIDES MAKES HER NEW HOMEMAKING JOB EASIER

Organizing a new household today is actually a study in logistics. Today's bride must know the answers to a score of modern homemaking questions that her mother was never really aware of. What colors or design should I choose in towels, shower curtains, bedspreads and blankets? How many pillowcases will I need? How should the pattern of my sheets coordinate with the rest of my linens?

The "linen trousseau" questions most often asked by brides-to-be were recently researched by the makers of the Fieldcrest bed and bath linens, and here are some of the answers, pointers that are important to every new homemaker.

Sheriff's Mounted Patrol Now Being Formed

Horse enthusiasts all over the country have long felt the need for a highly-trained, organized troop of riders and horses to be available for activities within the county, such as civic events, parades, aid in searching in wooded areas, traffic control in the smaller communities, etc.

Now that the Cleveland Police Department's mounted units are apparently being phased out, it is felt that the need for a volunteer group is greater than ever. The Cleveland Mounted Units have always been the high spot of parades in downtown Cleveland.

Herman P. Goldsmith, a businessman and horseman, has long been keenly aware of this need, and has started a campaign to enlist volunteers to form a Mounted Patrol, under the guidance and control of the County Sheriff. He has conferred with Sheriff Ralph E. Kreiger, and his staff, and has become familiar with the requirements and regulations. He has further visited other counties in Ohio and inspected their mounted organizations.

The requirements locally would basically be that each man be over 21 years of age, own his horse and western tack, and be able to transport by van to anywhere in the county, and be a registered voter in the county.

Mr. Goldsmith is asking that all riders who are interested, mail a card to him with their name, address and phone number to: Mounted Patrol, 2150 St. Clair Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44114. An organizational meeting will then be held and the program fully discussed.

"UNDER THE NEW Ohio laws, members of Mounted Patrols must be deputized by the Sheriff, and further, must take a prescribed schooling in all the laws relative to being a deputy sheriff," advises Mr. Goldsmith. "This is all being worked out, so that volunteers will have a year to absorb the required training. Meanwhile they will be able to wear the official deputy sheriff's uniform when on duty."

Mr. Goldsmith also explains, "I am anxious to develop groups of

skilled riders to visit residential areas in the inner city and put on small shows for the children. From time immemorial horses have held a fascination for the youngsters. We want to nurture this feeling and encourage them to participate."

Sheriff Ralph E. Kreiger's comments are, "We are very enthused over having such a volunteer organization of approximately 100 men and horses to assist us anywhere in the county, where the local community is unable to handle situations with their small police forces. We particularly like the fact that this whole enterprise will not cost the sheriff's department nor the county itself a cent."

Not only do these men absorb all the costs, they even earn money through horseshows, and in many other counties, have purchased vital equipment for the Sheriff that could not be obtained through their county. We urge all men riders to consider joining up with the Mounted Patrol. It will be fun, it will be instructive, and will be a great asset to Cuyahoga County.

Heart Association Lists

Four Goals In Heart - Helping Diet

(EDITORS' NOTE: Moderate changes in the typical American diet can reduce the risk of heart attack, says the Heart Association of Northeastern Ohio. Medical and nutrition authorities of the Association recommend a change to fat-controlled, low cholesterol meals. This article, discusses the four goals a homemaker should keep in mind in planning meals.)

The meal plan in the Heart Association leaflet, "The Way to a Man's Heart," calls for moderate, not drastic, changes in eating habits to achieve a heart-helping diet.

It is not advisable, or even possible, to completely eliminate saturated fats and cholesterol, because

they appear to some extent in many essential foods. But, their use can be controlled.

There are four goals to keep in mind in following the meal plan provided in detail in the leaflet:

To meet your daily need for protein, vitamins, minerals, and other nutrients.

To control calories and maintain a desirable weight.

To avoid eating excessive amounts of food containing saturated fat and cholesterol, by lowering your total intake of such foods.

To see that more of the fat you eat is polyunsaturated, and less of it is saturated.

New Citizenship Opportunity For Those Unable To Write English

Representative Michael A. Feighan, (D), Cleveland, announced on May 7 that the House Committee on the Judiciary has approved his legislation to make citizenship available to aliens who have been unable to learn to read and write English.

This exemption from the English language requirement of the naturalization laws will be available to persons over fifty years of age who have resided in the United States for at least twenty years at the time the application for naturalization is filed.

"Thousands of persons who have long resided in the United States and who will make excellent citizens hesitate to apply for citizenship because they fear they cannot pass the English language test," Feighan said.

Existing law waives the English language requirement only for those persons who were over fifty years of age and had resided in the United States twenty years on Dec. 24, 1952.

"There is every reason," Feighan continued, "to extend this waiver provision to persons who cannot take advantage of the 1952 cutoff date."

The Feighan bill also makes derivative citizenship available to children up to age eighteen upon the naturalization of a parent or parents. Existing law makes citizenship available only to children under sixteen years of age.

"MANY UNFORTUNATE cases have come to my attention as Chairman of the Subcommittee on Immigration and Nationality where a whole family is eligible for naturalization but one child over sixteen has to wait until the parents are naturalized and a separate petition filed. This legislation will eliminate this unintended situation since a child over eighteen can file his own application for naturalization," Feighan stated.

Numerous Varieties Of Cancer Found

Although medical science still has a great deal to learn about how cells become cancerous, a considerable amount of knowledge does exist about the variety of cancers and where and how they occur in different parts of the world, Dr. Clarence L. Huggins, Jr., member of the Medical Advisory Committee of the Cuyahoga Unit of the American Cancer Society, stated.

"For example, skin and lip cancers," Dr. Huggins explained, "are many times more common among white people in the southern half of the United States than among white people in the northern part. Breast cancer is more common among women in Israel than among women in Japan," he added.

"While lung cancer is the most common cause of cancer deaths among men in England and Wales, in Iceland, only 1,000 miles distant, lung cancer is a much less common cause of death," he continued. He added that while cancer of the liver causes half of all cancer deaths among the Bantu in Africa, in Europe and North America it accounts for less than 4% of cancer deaths.

DR. HUGGINS noted that uterine cancer mortality remains high in Chile, while in the United States where the famed "PAP" test is resulting in earlier treatment for women, the mortality rate has fallen sharply.

Breast cancer, too, also varies greatly in different parts of the world, Dr. Huggins stated. "With some 65,000 new cases each year, death from this type leads all other cancer deaths among U.S. women. It is high in Australia and Finland and is increasing in Europe, North America and in Israel. However, it is extremely low in Japan where only 4% of the female cancer deaths are from this form of the disease. Similarly, breast tumors are more common in older women than in younger ones, and in women who do not breast-feed their babies," he said.

"It is also true," Dr. Huggins stated, "that people living in Japan have higher rates of stomach cancer than those living in the U.S.A. Why this is so is not clear," he said.
