WASHINGTON, D.C. — V

govore s predstavniki vlade v
Saigonu. Ta je take razgovore
OF ponudila že pred 10 tedni.

OF hoče ustvariti spore med
Washingtonom in Saigonom in
vlado v Saigonu oslabiti tako
daleč, da se bo morala umakniti
"mirovni vladi". Na vsak na-
čin hoče biti OF zastopana v
vladi Južnega Vietnama takoj
pred volitvami kot po njih. Le-
ta na ta način smatra, da bodo nje-
ne koristi zavarovane in da ji bo
odprta pot do polne oblasti v
Južnem Vietnamu.

Washington in Saigon ni-
sta voljna sprejeti teh zahtev
OF, zato rdeči zavlačujejo raz-
govore v Parizu in pripravljajo
novi poletno ofenzivo, da bi še
bolj omajali ameriško voljo do
nadaljevanja vojskovjanja.

V Južnem Vietnamu zaseženi
rdeči dokumenti kažejo, da imajo
rdeči hude izgube v bojih, pa-
še vedno trdijo, da imajo njihove
sile "najugodnejši položaj".
Iz zaplenjenih dokumentov je
razvidno, da imajo rdeči v načrtu
male ofenzive, da bi tako
povečali ameriške žrtve v vojni,
pa zavrl napore za izgradnjo in
utrditev južnovenetnamskih obo-
roženih sil ter napredok pacifi-
kacije, ki ji postopno uspeva širi-
ti nadzor nad področja, ki so
bila doslej pod nadzorom rdečih.

Rdeči se zavedajo tudi mož-
nosti, da ostanejo ameriške vo-
jaške sile v Južnem Vietnamu
tako dolgo, da se bo položaj tam
tako ustalil in bodo domače vo-
jaške sile postale tako trdne, da
bodo lahko prevzele in uspešno
nosile odgovornost za varnost
meja in za notranji mir in red.
Rdeči dokumenti govore tudi o
povečani uspešnosti napadov
bombnikov B-52 na rdeče polo-
žaje.

Latinska Amerika išče nov način pomoći ZDA

Skupni predlog zunanjih mi-
nistrov bo izročil Nixonu
v torek čilski zunanjí mi-
nister.

CARACAS, Venez. — Zunanji
ministri držav Latinske Amerike
so se sporazumeli na novo
skupno stališče v vprašanjih
medameriškega gospodarskega
in socialnega sodelovanja. Ta
gre, preko obsega Zveze na-
predek, ki služi za temelj temu
sodelovanju od časa predsedni-
ka J. F. Kennedyja.

Predlog vlad držav Latinske Amerike bo izročil predsedniku Nixonu prihodnji torek zunanjí minister republike Čile Gabriel Valdez. Isti dan bo Nixon sprejel tudi prvega obiskovaleca iz Južne Amerike, predsednika Kolumbije Carlose Llerasa.

Zunanji ministri držav Latinske Amerike so se sestali pred dve dni v Vina del Mar v Čilu in sestavili okoli 6000 besedi obsegajoči dokument. V njem se zavzemajo države Latinske Amerike za odpravo omejitve izvoza iz teh držav v Združene države, trdijo, da sedanja pomoč ne zadošča in da zato ciljev, ki so bili določeni leta 1961 v Punta del Estu na mogoče doseči.

Združene države so v okviru Zvezne za napredek dajale letno državam Latinske Amerike en bilijon dolarjev pomoči v naporu za gospodarski in socialni na-
predek. Te so pomoč velikokrat porabile za namene, ki niso bili v soglasju z načrti, same pa so se zelo malo prizadavale za na-
predek. Jedro težav v državah Latinske Amerike je še vedno v trdovratnem odporu premožnih do izvedbe kakršnihkoli so-
cialnih in gospodarskih reform, ki bi bile zvezane s kakimi-
žrtvami za nje.

PARIZ, Fr. — General De Gaulle je na Irskem na počitnicih. Ni ga veselilo, da bi počitnice pretrgal radi volitev. Zato je naročil kar svoji služkinji, naj odda glasovnice zanj in za njegovo ženo, kar je po zakonu dovoljeno. Časnikarji so za to

stracija v svojih 8 točkah, in pogojev, ki jih je objavila vietnamska OF, odkriva možnosti, ki vodijo do kompromisov. Optimisti trdijo, da so bistvene razlike le še v dveh točkah, v vseh drugih bi se kompromis dal hitro doseči, ako bi na obeh straneh obstojala dobra volja.

IZVIDNIŠKO LETALO JE IZGINILO PRI ALEUTIH

Sinoč so objavili, da je kmalu po vzletu izginilo strateško izvidniško letalo RC135 v bližini zahodnih Aleutov. Obrambno tajništvo v Washingtonu je izjavilo, da letalo ni bilo sestreljeno, čeprav je izginilo nedaleč od meje Sovjetske zveze.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Izvidniško letalo strateškega po-
veljstva letalstva je včeraj ne-
nadno izginilo kmalu potem, ko
se je dvignilo z oporišča Shemya
na Aljaski. Stirnimotorno turbo-
propelersko letalo RC135 je

imelo 19 mož posadke in elek-
tronike naprave za preskušanje
radarja, prisluškanje radio-
komunikacij in za zbiranje dru-
gih na narodno obrambo po-
membnih podatkov.

Na letalskem oporišču Elmen-
dorf pri Anchorage na Aljaski
so prestregli klice na pomoč.
Zadnji znan položaj letala je bil

250 milj vzhodno od Shemye, ob koder naj bi letalo bilo na-
menjeno na letalsko oporišče Eielson severno od Fairbanksa.
To oporišče je domača baza za skupino letal RC135, ki pripada-
jo strateškim letalskim silam.

Obrambno tajništvo je izjavilo,
da letalo ni bilo sestreljeno.

Pogrešano izvidniško letalo je
bilo na običajnem letu vzdolž
meje Sovjetske zveze od Kam-
čatke do Beringovih vrat. Izgi-
nilo je v bližini zahodnega konca
Aleutovskih otokov. Ameriška
letala in ladje pregledujejo ce-
lotno področje, kjer je letalo iz-
ginilo, vendar se došle še ni po-
srečilo odkriti za njim nobene sledi.

Dva Djilasa

Milovana Djilasa je pustila jugoslovanska vlada, da potuje v inozemstvo "predvsem kot književnik, niso pa mislili, da bo dajal razne intervjuje in nastopal kot nekakšen predstavnik Jugoslavije", je pisala beografska Borba. Nastopal je res kot književnik, toda svet ga je sprejemal predvsem kot političnega borca proti "tiraniji dogmatičnega komunizma". Počaščen je bil z zlato kolajno v Domu svobode v New Yorku, kar je posebna vrsta odlike, ki so jo bili deležni dozdaj samo predsedniki ZDA: Eisenhower, Truman in Johnson, general Marshall, Churchill, Spaak, Brandt, čelista Casals in madžarski borci za svobodo. Tem je sedaj sledil Milovan Djilas. Predvsem zarađi knjig Novi razred in Pogovori s Stalinom, zaradi katerih je svoj čas dobil deset let zapora, ki ga je odsedel v Mitrovici. Iz ječe je prišel kot svetovni heroj, "junak svobode", za kar je dobil nagrado in diplomo z naslovom: "Herojski vodja in upornik, katerega sta razum in vest — pognala v boj proti tiraniji".

Med drugim je dal Djilas nekaj intervjuje v svetovne liste. Tako je njujorškemu Timesu (27. nov. 1968) izjavil, da je bil "on prvi, ki se je uprl Stalinu"; da Tita postavlja visoko, da ga je ta imel zaprtega deset let; da ga smatra celo za četrto osebnost v komunističnem gibanju... velik mu je zlasti v odporu proti stalinizmu... in v zadržanju sedaj ob češkoslovaški invaziji... Dobesedno pravi: "Tito ni Stalin, vi ga ne morete primerjati z njim, ker ni tako morbidna in kruta osebnost kot Stalin."

Zadnji intervju je dal švicarskemu listu Die Zeit (16. maja 1969), iz katerega povzemamo te-je misli: da noče pretrgati povsem s komunistično partijo v Jugoslaviji, kajti demokratični procesi v njej se razvijajo v njegov smer. Trdi, da je komunizem, predvsem dogmatični, v razpadaju, toda — dasi ni antimarksist —, tudi marksizem v celotni pravih bodočnosti. Je drugačen v Nemčiji, kjer se oplaja tudi s katoliškimi elementi in ni več marksizem, druženec v Avstriji. Marksizem bo moral dobiti nekaj novega; bolj kot z razrednim vprašanjem se bo moral ukvarjati s problemom človečanstva v tehnični civilizaciji. On da ima mnogo skupnega z marksizmom, mnogo pa je tam tudi zastarelega. Vzhodnoevropske dežele bodo prevzele nekak mešan gospodarski sistem ("če spregledamo sovjetski imperializem kot faktor!"), ki bo naprej razvijal tudi individualne svobočine, prevzel bo pa v nekem smislu socialdemokratsko smer... Z rastjo nacionalizma bo odmirala internacionalna ideologija komunizma... "Če bi imel oblast," pravi, "bi za začetek nikakor ne mogel ustvariti take demokratične vlade, kakor je v Avstriji ali Švici — to je nemogoče! — potrebna bi bila krajska ali daljša prehodna doba, kajti računati bi bilo treba s policijo, vojaštvom, birokracijo, zastrellostjo".

Nato se je pa zasmehjal: "Sicer pa nimam nobene funkcije in govorim le teoretično... kot politik bi seveda moral delati kompromise..."

To je en Djilas, ki danes dela s svojim demokratizmom furore po Ameriki in budi upanje, da bi bil lahko človek bodočnosti v Jugoslaviji, ko se bo komunistična partija — v kateri še vedno vztraja — toliko zdemokratizirala, da bo enaka ali še boljša z zapadnimi socialisti. Oznana torej evolucijo jugoslovanskega komunizma in se skuša zopet prikupiti Titu.

Včasih Djilas ni bil tak. In to je tisti prvi, mladi ognjiviti, kruti, o katerem je sam rekel: "Bil sem besen komunist in opravljal sem svoj posel dobro" (intervju v The New Leader). To je Djilas, ki je bil med revolucijo Titov propagandni minister, njegov "Goebbels", ki je ščuvale parizane na "plemenito sovraštvo do nasprotnikov", proti četnikom in drugim nasprotnikom komunizma, katerim daje ime "psi! Zverine v človeški podobi!" To je bil Djilas, ki je s Pijadom vodil "osvobodilni boj" v Črni gori z vso krutostjo in bratomorno ihto. Ni osebno moril, kot pravil sam, razen v enem primeru, pa se opravičuje s tem, da je bil "previsoko v hierarhiji", da bi opravljal tak posel, kar mi verjamemo, ker so ga opravljali podrejeni po njegovih navodilih. In pobijati je ščuvati v imenu Stalina, katerega najzvestejši častivec je med vojno bil. Njegovi slavospevi iz l. 1942 ali 1944 so prekosili vsakega carskega dvornega pesnika!

Lahko, da se človek z leti spreobrne v tak ekstrem, kakor ga do Stalina kaže sedaj Djilas, toda kljub temu, da je L. Fisher rekel, "da on priznava svoje napake, tudi največje, dokler je imel moč," v to obtožbo ne verjamemo, ker — doslej je še nismo brali! Ni se obtožil svojega dela kot propagandist sovraštva, ne kot državnik po vojni, ko so v masah streljali neoborožene "pse". Nasprotno: potrjuje, da noče prekiniti s komunistično partijo, ki je vso to tiračijo vodila. Ne obtožuje jo zločinov, le prepeljati jo hoče — na drugi breg demokracije. Kako se bo to zgodilo, je nje-

gova utopistična misel, za katero je res herojsko pripravljen prenašati tudi ječe, in jo je deset let.

Hočemo reči samo to: ko beremo triumf Djilasovega upora proti tiraniji v svetu in njegove napore za humaniziranje komunizma v idealni socializem, nas moti samo — prvi Djilas, ta kruti oboževatelj nasilja in Stalinove tiranije; o njem je tedaj pisal, da je "najplemenitejši človek... in bi sonce potemnilo brez njega!"

Zdaj pojde himne drugačnemu soncu — na svobodi, dočim je Mihajlov, borec za isti ideal, še vedno v ječah istega Tita, katerega Djilas sedaj postavlja na četrto mesto komunističnih veličin v svetu! Tukaj nekaj ni v redu... Ko so ga vprašali, kaj misli o Titu, je rekel med drugim: "To je zelo kontrastno vprašanje: Jaz enega dne mislim tako, drugega drugače." (The New York Times.)

Tako imamo dva Djilasa. Prvi je kralj nacionaliste, drugi jih kliče v življenje. Podoba prvega Djilasa je jasna. Bil je iskren stalinist, besen komunist, ki je "dobro opravljal svoj posel". Podoba drugega Djilasa kljub govorom in izjavam ni jasna. Tudi dejstvo, da je dobil v ZDA tako odlikovanje, zadeve nič ne spremeni. Ni jasno ali zasleduje kot drugi Djilas kakšen cilj sam ali pa je le orodje drugih. Zato bo bodočnost drugega Djilasa tveganja. T. D.



½ cup chopped onion	2 tablespoons Worcester sauce
½ pound ground beef	1 tablespoon sugar
½ pound lean sausage	¼ teaspoon salt
1½ teaspoons monosodium glutamate	1 (8-ounce) package medium cut noodles
1 (10 ½ -ounce) can condensed cream of tomato soup	½ cup corn flake crumbs
	½ tablespoon margarine

Heat corn oil in heavy skillet over medium heat. Add onion and cook until soft. Add beef, sausage and monosodium glutamate, stirring until well browned. Add tomato soup, cheese, Worcester sauce, sugar and salt. Simmer 15 minutes. Meanwhile, cook noodles according to package directions. Add cooked noodles to meat mixture and place in greased 1½ quart casserole. Sprinkle cornflake crumbs over top and dot with margarine. Bake in 350 degree F. (moderate) oven 20 minutes. 
This month Mrs. Novak observes the 50th anniversary of her first national convention when she attended as a state president of the Woodmen of the World.



Sure To Be Top Banana



All the party-comers will think the hostess has a heavenly gift with desserts when she presents these bananas. They're sauced in the splendor and softness of nutty-sweet Neufchatel cheese and sweetened condensed milk, tufted with whipped heavy cream. Add another touch of the tropics—there's toasted coconut throughout—with a guava jelly accompaniment.

Heavenly Bananas

(Makes about 6 servings)

6 medium-size firm, ripe bananas	1 1/3 cups (15-oz. can) Eagle Brand sweetened condensed milk
1 tablespoon reconstituted lemon juice	1 cup toasted coconut
1 teaspoon cinnamon	1 cup (1/2 pint) heavy cream, whipped
3 tablespoons butter, melted	4 oz. (one-half of 8-oz. pkg.) Neufchatel or cream cheese, softened

Peel 5 bananas; slice diagonally. Arrange banana slices in a buttered 1 1/2 quart shallow (10 x 6 1/2 x 2 inch) baking dish. Sprinkle with lemon juice. Combine cinnamon and melted butter; pour over bananas. Place in broiler about 4 inches from source of heat. Broil until butter bubbles, about 5 minutes. In a small electric mixer bowl, beat cheese at medium speed of electric mixer until smooth. Gradually beat in sweetened condensed milk on low speed of electric mixer. Reserve 2 tablespoons toasted coconut for garnish. Add remaining coconut to condensed milk mixture; blend well. Pour over bananas. Bake in a moderate (350°F.) oven about 15 minutes, or until milk mixture is set and lightly browned. Remove from oven. Cool. Chill in refrigerator until ready to serve. Garnish with whipped cream and remaining banana slices and coated with reserved coconut. If desired, serve with guava jelly.

Be Sure To Take Camera Along On Vacation Trip

The traveler who returns from an interesting trip without a photographic record of places and people, often finds that he misses these lasting reminders. Details may fade from the mind, but a snapshot remains the same.

To get a satisfactory photographic record, start planning ahead of time.

KNOW YOUR CAMERA. If it's a new one, take several rolls of shots under different circumstances to be familiar with the several types of color and black and white film. Learn which film gives the qualities for which you are looking, those which react best in your camera in the situations in which you will be shooting. When problems arise, there will be time to solve them.

Before starting your trip, check the camera thoroughly; shutter, film winder, range finder, light meter, take along lens tissue and a lens brush. Wrap the camera in thin layers of foam rubber to avoid vibrations, particularly if you travel by air.

KEEP GADGETS to a minimum. Take a haze filter and a graduated yellow filter for black and white film. For color film, take a skylight filter to eliminate haze.

Although film can be bought almost anywhere, it is often quite expensive outside the country. Unless your trip is of long duration, take whatever you plan to use. Processing service is widely available.
