## Bombardiranje naselij Biafri škodijo Lagosu

Nigerijska letala dnevno menejo bombe na naselja v Biafri. S tem večajo tam odporn, odvijajo pa tudi svetovno javno mnenje.

LAGOS, Nig. — Uradno taje, da bi nigerijska vojaška letala metala bombe in streljala na naselja v Biafri, privatno pa priznavajo, da se to dejansko dogaja iz dneva v dan. Tako je bilo v preteklih tednih izvedenih celo vrsto letalskih napadov na vasi in večja naselja v Biafri, pri katerih so bili ubiti in ranjeni izključno civilisti. Zadnji tak napad pretekel sredo v Ozu-Abam je končal življenje 120 civilistom. Vse podrobnosti napada so bile na razpolago tujim časnikarjem in predstavnikom.

Teh napadov ni mogoče skriti in ne zanikavati. Vse uradne izjave v Lagosu ne pomenijo in ne zadelejo v tem pogledu nič. Dejstva so na razpolago in vsakdo se lahko o njih prepriča. Poročila o teh napadih prepričujejo prebivalstvo Biafri, da ne more pričakovati od zveznih oblasti in nigerijskega vojaštva nobene milosti, zato krepe njihovo voljo do nadaljevanja odpora. Ta poročila vplivajo skrajno neugodno na javno mnenje in na vlade v Veliki Britaniji in v Združenih državah. Obsodba nigerijske vlade je vedno bližje, pritisik javnosti za pomoč Biafri, da se napravi konec klanjuju v pobiranju nedolžnih žrtv, vedno večji.

Škodljivost napadov na naselja v Biafri za Nigerijo so uvidnejši v Lagosu že davno spoznali. Predsednik gen. Gowon je ponovno izjavil, da je vse take napade najstrožje prepovedal. Tuji zastopniki verjamejo v Gowanovo iskrenost, ne dvomijo pa pri tem prav nič v resničnosti posročil o bombardiranjih biafranskih vasi.

Vzrok temu vidijo v slabih zvezih med glavnim poveljstvom v Lagosu in med letalskimi oporušči v bližini Biafri. Lagos nima nad vojnimi operacijami nobenega nadzora. Kakega pol dučata Iljušin 28 bombnikov nigerijskega letalstva vodijo Egipčani, ker Nigerija sama nima za ta posebne izvežbeni ljudi. Egiptovski piloti so znani po svoji zaniknosti in slabih izvežbanosti. Malo jih briga, kam odvržejo svoje bombe, da so le "naloži" opravili in se brez njih vrnili na poprišče.

Naj ima ta razlag ozadja letalskih napadov na biafranska naselja tudi svoj resničen temelj, to odgovornosti vlade v Lagosu prav nič ne zmanjša. Dokler zahteva za sebe mednarodno priznanje, se mora držati tudi mednarodnih predpisov. V vojskovjanju v Biafri jih očitno krši.

### Dayan za ustavitev izraelskih naselij na zasedenih arabskih tleh

JERUZALEM, Izrael. — Obrazbni minister gen. Moshe Dayan je v gorovu na zborovanju zdravnikov v Tel Avivu nastopil odločno za ustavitev izraelskih naselij vzdolž Jordana na zasedenih arabskih tleh, kot jih predvideva znani Allonov načrt. Dayan je šel še za korak dalje, zahteval je gospodarsko vključitev zasedenega ozemlja v Izrael in nadomestitev zakonov Sirije, Jordanije in Egipta z izraelskimi.

Ti predlogi bodo brez dvoma dignili nov vihar razburjanja in protestov v arabskih državah. Te bodo videle v njih upravičeno namero Izraela zasedeno ozemlje obdržati.

COLUMBUS, O. — Delo ohajske glavne skupščine bomozmeraj bolj čutili ne samo na svojih žepih, ampak tudi drugače v vsakdanjem življenju. Je namreč postala izredno živahnina v celo delavna, seveda ne na lastno pobudo, ampak na iniciativno ohajske državne uprave z guvernerjem J. Rhodesom na celu. O tem nam na primer priča njeno delo v tem tednu.

Ta teden je na primer poslanska zbornica obravnavala izredno zanimiv, pa tudi važen predlog. Imela je pred seboj osnutek zakona, ki pooblašča državno administracijo, da osnuje posebno policisko četo, ki bo vsak trenutek kjerkoli v državi na razpolago, kadar bo to potrebno. Policijski oddelek naj bi imel 100 mož, bil naj bi v stalni pripravljenosti, imel svoja transportna sredstva in v eni uri prišel kamorkoli na načinu načrta.

## Podjeja in unije najomeje svoje zahteve

Predsednikov glavni gospodarski svetovalec je pozval podjetja in unije, naj se prilagode novim razmeram v urejanju cen in plač.

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Načelnik predsednikovega gospodarskega sveta Paul W. McCracken je v govoru pred Ekonomskim klubom New Yorka pozval tako podjetja kot delavske unije, naj svoje zahteve in načrte prilagode novim gospodarskim razmeram. Po njegovem bo povpraševanje po izdelkih in vsem blagom rastlo v letošnjem letu počasnejše kot je v preteklih, blago bo šlo zato težje in počasnejše v denar. Podjetja naj s tem računajo v lastno dobro in naj ne povišujejo cen.

Unije se morajo zavedati, da bo zmanjšanje naraščanja zahtev po blagu nujno zmanjšalo potrebo po njegovem izdelovanju in pridobivanju. Tako bo tudi delavski trg postal bolj sproščen, nevarnost za porast brezposelnosti pa se bo večala.

Pri takem razvoju v gospodarstvu je modro za podjetja kot za unije, da svoje načrte in zahteve omeje v skladu z novimi razmerami. McCracken je odklonil uradno postavljanje številki kot mejo za povišanje cen in delavskih plač. Razmere same bodo pokazale, kaj je možno in kaj ni, kaj je v danih razmerah sprejemljivo in kaj ne.

V času predsednikov J. F. Kennedyja in L. B. Johnsona je veljalo povišanje 3.2% kot nekaj sprejemljivega na dolgo roko. Vsekakor ne bi smelo to število biti večje od porasta produktivnosti, ker bi nujno zviševalo cene izdelkov.

### Bomba v Jeruzalemu ranila 25 študentov

JERUZALEM, Izrael. — Včeraj je eksplodirala v kafeteriji knjižnice Hebrew univerze bomba. Bila je sorazmerno preprosta in majhna, vendar je ranila 25 študentov ob kakih 250, ki so bili v času eksplozije v prostoru.

Izraelske oblasti so prijete skupino Arabcev in Arabk, ki so bili zapleteni v prejšnje bombe napade v Jeruzalemu.

## LODGE JE SVARIL, LAIRD ZAHTEVA KONEC NAPADOV

Pri razgovorih v Parizu je včeraj vodnik ameriške delegacije Henry Cabot Lodge resno svaril rdeče pred posledicami nadaljevanja njihovih napadov na mesta v Južnem Vietnamu. V Saigonu je obrambni tajnik Laird, ko je priletel včeraj tja, na tiskovni konferenci povedal jasno, da nadaljevanje rdečih napadov zahteva "primeren" odgovor.

CLEVELAND, O. — Vojskovanje v Vietnamu prehaja v novo razdobje. Rdeči preskušajo trdnost in odločnost nove vlade v Washingtonu in upanju, da bodo morda le našli kako pot za doseglo cilja: razširitev svoje oblasti nad Južnim Vietnamom. Predsednik Nixon je v torem dejal, da hoče to vojskovanje "končati čim preje je mogoče na temelju, ki ne bo puščal semena za novo vojno". Opozoril je rdeče, naj ne smatrajo ameriške umirjenosti in potrežljivosti za slabost. Svaril, da bo nadaljevanje sedanjih napadov na mesta v Južnem Vietnamu zahtevalo odgovor. Rdeči so z napadi nadaljevali, včeraj jih je vodnik ameriške delegacije v Parizu Henry Cabot Lodge opozoril, da bodo morali prevzeti posledice za nadaljevanje napadov, ki so v očitnem nasprotju s "sporazumom" ob 31. oktobra lani. Obrambni tajnik Melvin R. Laird je sinoči v Saigonu dejal, da so zadnji rdeči napadi na mesta v Južnem Vietnamu "grozilno" kršenje "sporazuma". Poudaril je, da bo njihovo nadaljevanje dobilo "primeren odgovor".

Včerajšnji sestanek v Parizu med zastopniki Hanoia in OFDA in zastopniki ZDA in Južnega Vietnamoma na drugi strani je končal po štirih urah, ko je zastopnik saigonske delegacije dejal, da ne obstoji "ozračje, ki bi dopuščalo uspešne razgovore" in predložil njihovo odločitev do prihodnjega četrtega. Razgovori so bili očitno v polni očitkov. H. C. Lodge je rdeče opozoril, da morajo prevzeti na sebe odgovornost za posledice sedanjih napadov v Južnem Vietnamu, ki so v očitnem nasprotju s "sporazumom", na temelju katerega so ZDA lani 1. novembra ustavile vse napade na Severni Vietnam, tudi na sam Hanoi.

Svarila so jasna in razumljiva, vprašanje je le, če jih bo Hanoi hotel razumeti ali pa bo gnal vso reč na novo ostrino. Nixon je izrazil upanje, da utegne Moskva posredovati k pospešenju pogajanj in končanju vojskovanja v Vietnamu. Istočasno je namignil, da bo uporabil tudi silo, če druge rešitve ne bo. Za tak slučaj je izrazil upanje, da ga bo ameriško javno mnenje podprt.

Položaj je težaven, vsak kjer je utegne biti usoden. Ni dvojma, da si ameriško javno mnenje želi končna vojskovanja v Vietnamu, toda to javno mnenje še vedno ni pripravljeno sprejeti "brezpogojnega umika" in prepustiti Južni Vietnam po tolifikih žrtvah enostavno rdečim napadalcem.

## Kristjanov dom - podaljšana cerkev

Za cerkvijo je kristjanu najsvetjeji in najdražji prostor njegov dom, kjer je bil morda rojen, kjer je užival ljubezen svojih staršev, ki so se zanj žrtvovali, kjer je prvkrat v mla- do dušo padalo seme božje besede in se je v njem vnela iskra vere v Boga in nadnaravn svet, kjer je užil toliko veselih, morda pa tudi žalostnih ur. Ko prvi kristjani še niso imeli svojih cerkva, so bili njihovi domovi tudi njihove cerkve: tam so opravljali obojno bogoslužje, bogoslužje božje besede ali krščanskega pouka in tudi daritveno bogoslužje. Slišali ste morda, kako gre ponekod po svetu težnja za tem, da bi vsaj včasih ob določenih priložnostih smeli imeti obojno bogoslužje v domačem družinskem krogu. Kristjanov dom naj bi bil res nekako podaljšana cerkev, podaljšan bogoslužni prostor, v katerem se na mnogočetne načine bogatimo z božjo-besedo in častimo Boga. V dnu človekove duše je vsajena težnja po lastnem domu, po kotičku, ki ga lahko oblikuješ po svoje in se v njem čutiš doma. Nič ni važno, ali je veličastna palajoča ali pa le skromna lesena bajtka, glavno je, da je v nej božji mir, urejenost in ljubezen.

Že na zunaj naj bo tudi vidno, da je vaš dom krščanski. Zato si na častno mesto v njem postavite znamenje križa našega Gospoda Jezusa Kristusa, ki naj vas vedno spominja, da ste tudi vi odrešeni z njegovo krvjo. Znamenje križa naj nam pomaga pogosto obudit vero v odrešenje, obudit upanje, da tudi nas čaka po smrti življenje, ki nam ga je Kristus s križem pridobil, in naj nas uči ljubezni, ki je pripravljena tudi na žrtve za Boga in bližnjega. Križ na častnem mestu našega stanovanja je tudi zunanjaz izpoved vere in naj nam vedno obuja veselo upanje, da "nas bo Kristus nekoc priznal pred svojim Očetom, ker smo ga tudi mi priznali pred ljudmi". Poleg križa bomo radi postavili v stanovanje tudi podobo božje in naše matere Marije. Mati Cerkev je, zato naj bo tudi mati naše "domača cerkev". Tudi družinski rožni venec naj bi visel na naših stenah. Vse te reči skušajmo namestiti z okusom, da nas ne bi morda neokusni in natrpani predmeti bolj odbijali od sveta božje lepot, kakor po k njemu vrgajali. Lepo je, če je v kristjanovi sobi tudi kropilček z blagoslovljeno vodo, kateri je "Cerkev vrla moč svojega blagoslova".

Kakor nam je cerkev tisti kraj, kjer si ob poslušanju božje besede polagoma prisvajamo razočete in se poglabljamo v svet vere, tako naj bi bili naši domovi tudi neprestane učilnice božjega razočetja za vse prebivalce. Zadnji konci o tem tako lepo govoriti: "V družini, tej takoreč dočači cerkvi, morajo starši biti svojim otrokom z besedo in zgledom prvi oznanjevalci vere" (C 11, 2). In dalje: "Kristus izvršuje svojo preroško (učiteljsko) službo tudi po laikih (neduhovnikih). Zato jih Kristus postavlja za svoje priče in jih usposablja z milostjo besede, da bi moč evangelijsa sijala v vsakdanjem družinskem in družabnem življenu (C 35, 1).

Ko se danes vedno bolj širi verska nevednost med nami, moramo vsi kristjani odgovorno iskati vse možne načine za poučevanje v veri. V krščanski družini vse članji nosijo odgovornost, da si med seboj posredujejo dobrine vere. "Bratje moji," govoril sv. apostol Jakob, "če kdo izmed vas zajde od resnice in ga kdo spreobrene, naj ve, da... reši njevo dušo..." (Jak 5, 19, 20). Judovski narod, ki je na takoj čuden način razklopil med druge narode, je kljub temu obdržal svoja sveta izročila in svojo vero prav zato, ker je pri njih družinsko ognjišče bilo že od stare zavezne sem in je še danes najvažnejša zakladnica verskih izročil in tudi kraj bogoslužnih slovesnosti. In dolga stoletja je bila tudi med kristjani družina nositeljica verskega oblikovanja otrok, ko niso še imeli načrtne urejenega verouka.

Vedno bo še veljala resnica, da mora biti krščanska družina otroku pot k Bogu. Psihologi so v zadnjih letih delali poskuse z mladimi ljudmi, da bi ugotovili, kateri izmed njih so najbolj sprejemljivi za svet vere. Ugotovili so, da so zares lahko verovali predvsem tisti otroci, ki so zrasti v toplem, plemenitem, z ljubeznijo in dobroto obdanem družinskem krogu — tam, kjer sta se oče in mati med seboj spoštovala in ljubila, se drug drugemu razdajala in oba skupaj nesrečno ljubila vse svoje otroke brez razlike ter se zanje iz ljubezni žrtvovala.

Tako naj bi krščanski starši, ki bi radi imeli verne otroke, nikdar ne prezrili tega prvega pogoja, kako morajo sami ustvarjati to toplo, z ljubezni in žrtvijo napolnjeno družinsko ozračje. V konciškem dokumentu je lepo povedano: "Družina je šola za bogatitev človečnosti. Za dosego polnosti njenega življenja in poslanstva pa je med zakonoma potrebno ljubezen občestvo duš in izmenjava misli, pa tudi skrbno sodelovanje obeh roditeljev pri vzgoji otrok. Očetova dejavnost navzočnosti je pri vzgoji otrok velikega pomena, toda tudi materina skrb za dom, skrb, ki jo tako zelo potrebujejo predvsem mlajši otroci..." (CS 52).

V krščanski družini mora biti dovolj poskrbljeno za ne, če bi slučajno pozabili.

svojevrstno "bogoslužje božje besede". Vemo, da se je danes družina skoro povsod zelo spremenila. Nekoč je bila družina 24 ur na dan skupaj. Zato so imeli dovolj priložnosti, da so si med seboj posredovali tudi versko znanje. Danes pride družina navadno skupaj le še ob prostem času. Zato je treba temu prostemu času dati važno mesto in članji družine bi morali stremeti za tem, da bi vsaj takrat radi bili skupaj in se duhovno med seboj bogatili. Cerkveni prazniki so nekaj nudili in ponekod še nudijo toliko različnih priložnosti za uvajanje družine v svet vere. Ker so zaradi dela mnogokrat tudi prazniki razbiti, naj bi družina porabila v skupno korist tudi državne praznike in "konc tednov". Naj se takrat starši svojim otrokom bolj posvetijo. Tudi družinski izleti so lepa priložnost za uvajanje v verske skrivnosti. 



Combine mix and cheese. Add egg and milk. Blend only until dry ingredients are thoroughly moistened. Fill greased miniature muffin cups half full.

On each muffin overlap three olive rings to form a shamrock design. Use pieces of end slices for stems. Bake in preheated oven (400° F.) 10 to 12 minutes or until golden brown. Serve piping hot.

## BASIC FACTS ABOUT THE NATIONALITIES SERVICES CENTER

The Nationalities Services Center, an autonomous agency member of the Welfare Federation and the American Council for Nationalities Services, is the result of a merger of the International Institute of the YWCA and the Citizens Bureau founded in Cleveland in 1916 and 1926 respectively.

The Women's Committee was formed for the purpose of helping the Board of Trustees and the staff of the Nationalities Services Center conduct special annual events; such as, the All Nations Fair, the Citizenship Ball, and the Golden Door Award.

The Center deals with personal needs of families of immigrants and visitors coming to settle in the Greater Cleveland Area: housing, jobs, health, adjustment to new environment and way of life. It also assists in the technical problems of immigration and naturalization around which 75% of its work revolves, and is engaged in casework with students and other temporary visitors. More than 15 languages are spoken by the staff and 50 volunteer professional translators and interpreters.

Independently and in cooperation with the Board of Education, the Nationalities Services Center provides English and citizenship classes and acquaints newcomers with every facet of Cleveland's civic and cultural life.

The agency, through annual events it sponsors, stresses friendship and cooperation among all ethnic groups, encouraging them to contribute to the common good while retaining their heritage of customs and culture.

Services of the Center are offered free of charge to indigent people. As a Red Feather agency, it receives about 75% of its budget from the United Appeal. The Women's Committee has, as its main purpose, the raising of the remaining 25% through donations and membership so that the vital contributions of the Center to the well-being of the people of Cleveland may be perpetuated.





#### BACK TEACHING AUTHORITY

#### FAMOUS FRENCHMEN WRITE TO POPE PAUL

This article is a translation from the February 7, 1969, issue of the Cleveland Slovenian Daily "The American Home". — Since the extremists are getting most of the attention these days, it is urgent that the middle-of-the-road position be made known. — Gabriel J. Rus, SM, University of Dayton.

Under the above title the "Voice of Slovenian Cultural Action", published in Buenos Aires, Argentina, carries the following article in its January 28, 1969, issue which is interesting, important and instructive for every Catholic.

Sixteen leading French Catholics gave the impetus for an expression of thanks to Pope Paul VI. To set the example the first ones to sign for the dispatch were Edmond Michelet, Charles Flory, Etienne Gilson, Olivier Lacombe, Henri Guittot, Francois Mauriac, Henri Rolet, Stanislas Fumet, Jacques de Bourbon-Busset, Henry Boissard, Gabriel Maurice Vaussard, Jacques Nantet, Andre Latreille, Pierre Messnard and Andre Piettre.

This significant declaration takes its place among the expressions of a desire for serenity and order which are increasingly appearing in Europe by way of reaction to the confusion and chaos existing among Catholics. It reads as follows:

"Holy Father,

"At the close of this year 1968 we want very much to express to you our gratitude for the profession of faith as well as for the instructions in which you have reaffirmed the principles of Catholic doctrine and discipline.

"We must tell you that we are saddened and humiliated by the scandalous attacks on your Person and on your teachings, as well as by the attacks on the Catholic Hierarchy which is accused of being an aristocracy of dignitaries of the Spirit rising above the membership in order to lord it over them. (Statement borrowed from one of the recent books of Hans Kueng, the well-known German-Swiss professor of Theology.)

"In view of the increase and spread of error concerning the worship of God, the historicity of the Gospels, the Real Presence, and the teaching authority of the Church we want the leaders of the Church to fulfill their duties fully, in other words, preserve the deposit of faith intact.

"We demand that priests, who are far too few in number to take care of the ordinary needs of the Christian community and of the needs of the missions among non-Christians, continue, except in the case of special assignments, to dedicate themselves to their sacred trust which consists in teaching us the Word of God and administering the Sacraments to us.

"We protest against the accusations of riches and triumphalism which are being made against the Church. These might have been valid in the period of the Renaissance but its current needs as well as the restrictions which these needs impose on it, both in regard to the training of its priests and to its presence in society, are well known to us.

"We place our trust in your an guished concern for the Christian people being expressed through an admirable zeal for the renewal of the Church. This renewal begun by the Council you have courageously continued since then. However, it is being jeopardized by a small minority of lay and clerical agitators who are arrogating to themselves the governance of the Church and are everywhere spreading trouble and doubts.

"We assure your Holiness of our complete trust as you continue your mission into the New Year and we profess our submission as well as our filial devotedness."

#### Wm. Kennick Opposes New Drunk Driver Rule

Some weeks ago, Mr. George Voinovich, State Representative from District 53, proposed to reduce the alcoholic content in the blood stream from 15/100 to 10/100 of 1% as a criterion for drunken driving convictions. I am against this proposal for the following reasons:

1. It would lead to further regimentation and persecution of the public by the traffic court bureaucracy; there would be wholesale arrests by the thousands of people who are not under the influence of alcohol when they drink to the extent of 10/100 of 1%. Proof of his statement is that there are thousands of arrests made of people who fail to make a complete stop at a stop sign, even if this occurs at two o'clock in the morning where there is no other traffic.

2. Statistics, in my opinion, are inadequate to show any necessary close correlation between what might be described as light intoxication and accidents.

3. The mild drinker (to the extent of 10/100 of 1%, etc.) would be persecuted and treated more severely than the felon accused of armed robbery, or murder, because the felon is protected by the U.S. Constitution, and can plead the fifth amendment which provides that no person shall be compelled in any criminal case to be a witness against himself; strange as it may seem, the law has been twisted around so that this constitution provision does not apply to a person charged with drunken driving, inasmuch as he is compelled to take the alcoholic test, or have his license suspended for many months.
