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
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Božje usmiljenje in naše spreobrnjenje se dopolnjujeta

Kakor poroča današnji evangelij, je želel cestninari Zahej Jezusa videti. Hotel se je na lastne oči prepričati, kdo je Jezus, kaj govori, kakšne čudežе dela, kaj ljudi vleče k njemu. Njegova začetna radovednost in tudi pričakovovanje sta bila bogato poplačana: Kristus se mu je sam najavil na obisk.

Evangelist Luka na več mestih govori o Bogu kot dobrem in usmiljenem Očetu. Spomnimo se na priliko o izgubljenem sinu, o povabilu cestninarju Leviju, o ženi grešnici, ki Jezusu umiva noge, o farizeju in cestninarju, ki sta prišla molit v tempelj, o izgubljeni ovci in drahmi pa tudi na priliko o usmiljenem Samarijanu, zapovedi, ljubiti celo sovražnike. Med te dogodke spada tudi srečanje Kristusa z Zahejem. Vsebina teh prilik in dogodkov je strnjena v Jezusovih besedah: »Nisem prišel klicat pravičnih, temveč grešnike, da se spreobrnejo.«

Ne vemo, kaj je gnalo Zaheja, da je hotel videti Jezusa, se mu čim bolj približati, ga sploh videti. Lahko je bila to radovednost, želja po nečem izrednem, da bi imel zadoščenje ali se mogel pred drugimi pohvaliti: »Videl



sem Jezusa!« Morda so ga k temu spodbujala plemenitejsa čustva. Zavedal se je svojih človeških in poklicnih ravnanj, zaradi katerih so bili tedaj cestninarji od ljudi osovraženi. Ljudje so bili prepričani, da so krivični in prevaranti, da zahtevajo več, kot bi smeli, da skrbijo le zase, ne vidijo pa reveža, ki je potreben pomoči. Ob srečanju z Jezusom Zahej odkrito priznava: »Gospod, ako sem koga v čem prevaril, povrnem četverno; polovico svojega imetja dam ubogim.«

V Zaheju se je prebudilo spoznanje, da bi moral biti drugačen, da mora svoje življenje spremeniti. Tega začet-

nega spoznanja in glasu svoje vesti ni preslišal. Naredil je prvi korak, pripravljen je bil narediti še naslednjega. Še več korakov je naredil Jezus naproti Zaheju. Tudi ni preslišal besed in spodbud, ki jih je slišal od svojih rojakov, ki jih je Jezus pritegnil s svojo besedo in čudeži. Njegova radovednost ali pa želja, da bi bil drugačen, se je obrestovala. Jezus mu je pokazal pot v drugačno, popolnejše življenje. Dosegel je veliko več, kot je v začetku pričakoval. Ko se je pozneje teh dogodkov spominjal, je v njih prepoznaval božji klic in milost, za kar je bil Jezusu gotovo hvaležen. Čeprav je bilo Zahejevo (prvo) srečanje z Jezusom nekaj izrednega, je postalo tudi nekaj vsakdanjega. Jezusov klic - biti drugačen, boljši - se je odslej vsak dan ponavljal v njegovi zavesti.

Ljudje ne ravnamo vedno tako, kot je ravnal Zahej. Pogosto mislimo: saj sem dober, pošten, pravičen, delaven. Ali pa se sklicujemo na to, da drugi ravnajo enako ali so še slabši kot mi. Zdi se, kakor bi bila misel, da moramo spremeniti svoje mišljenje in ravnanje, skušnjava! Ko vest utihne, ker je nismo poslušali ravnamo kot doslej. Nič se ni spremenilo in se tudi ne bo. To se nam ljudem, žal, pogosto dogaja. Ni zaman med blagri na prvem mestu »Blagor ubogim v duhu, zakaj njih je nebeško kraljestvo«.

Postavimo se v Zahejevo vlogo. Neštetokrat nas Bog kliče: po naši vesti, ki se oglaša v vsakem človeku; po besedah drugih ljudi, po dogodkih in znameñjih, naj postanemo drugačni, se spreobrnemo. Če ta glas preslišimo ali se nam zdi prezahteven, smo sami sebi zaprli pot v prihodnost. Nismo zaupali sebi, še manj drugemu, Bogu. Bog nas kliče na visoko goro. Ne bomo je dosegli v trenutku. Potrebno je narediti prvi pa drugi in tretji korak ter vztrajati na poti. Če kdo potem Bog upošteva »zakon postopnosti«, ker pozna naše zmožnosti.

Vendar nista dovolj samo naša odprtost in pripravljenost. Človek ni odrešenik samemu sebi. Z apostolom Pavlom mora priznati: »Ne delam namreč dobrega, ki ga hočem, marveč delam zlo, ki ga nočem«.



St Teresa of Calcutta, more commonly known as Mother Teresa, was once selecting children for a new orphanage of the Missionaries of Charity in East Africa. She could not take every orphaned child and a journalist spoke up, "What are you going to do for the rest?" Mother Teresa looked him straight in the eye and replied, "What are you going to do?" The journalist was so touched by these words that he returned home, gave up his job and started to raise funds for another orphanage in that part of Africa.

Many people are touched by the heroic stories of those who give up their lives in order to serve others. Some may not be religiously motivated, but they have a deep compassion for the suffering of their fellow human beings. The witness of such lives can be contagious. It touches something deep within us and we are motivated to act and do something more than simply dipping into our pocket for a bit of spare change. It may be life changing.



Gospel Teaching

Zacchaeus was a senior tax collector. Such people were despised in their own communities. First of all, they were collaborators with the occupying forces of Rome. They made their living by collecting taxes from the local people in order to support the oppressive structure of imperial Rome. But there was more; they made themselves rich by adding a premium to what they had to deliver to the Romans in order to cover their own expensive lifestyle. If they were going to be unpopular in any case, they might as well do it in comfort. Clearly, Zacchaeus was not happy with his way of life. He saw something in Jesus that was different. He wanted to know what it was, and so he climbed a sycamore tree that was along the way Jesus would pass, so that he could get a good view and maybe learn his secret.

He got more than he bargained for. Jesus not only saw him in the tree but called him down. Jesus did not join in the universal condemnation of tax collectors but on the contrary went so far as to invite himself to the home of Zacchaeus. The reaction of the crowd was predictable. They complained about Jesus associating with such a man. The reaction of Zacchaeus, however, was different. The way

Jesus accepted him, not condemning or criticising, helped Zacchaeus to see that he could change his life and do things differently. He was now ready to give back his ill-gotten gains and start afresh.

Application

Many of us are dissatisfied with our way of life. Perhaps we are disappointed with the way things have turned out. Maybe we have made bad or wrong choices. There are things that make us wish that we could start again and do things differently. We might be very successful in our career. We might have a wonderful relationship with our spouse and family. Or maybe not. For all of us there is a sense of incompleteness, something missing. We want something more. St Augustine summed it up in his Confessions, "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they find their rest in you." In fact, this desire for something more, something better, is built into our basic make-up as human beings.

The point of today's Gospel reading is to show us that the answer to our inner longings is not to acquire more things for ourselves but rather to build relationships of love and compassion with others who are on the same journey, with Jesus as our leader and guide. He brought salvation to Zacchaeus and his house. He did not condemn what he had been doing or even ask him to change. Simply by inviting himself into his home, Jesus helped Zacchaeus to make new and better choices for his life. And for those who considered that they were already doing the right thing by ostracising the tax collector, Jesus invited them to broaden their vision of who God wanted to save: all the family of Abraham, especially those who were lost.

What about us today? Jesus offers us choices. Like Mother Teresa, he asks us, "What are you going to do?" Will you try to find fulfilment in the enjoyment of what this world has to offer in power, pleasure and possessions? Or will you join Jesus on the way of love and compassion in the family of his faithful disciples?
