Neko notranje doživetje, ko se nam je v globini duše Bog razodel, da smo padli predenj in prznali s Tomažem: Moj Gospod in moj Bog! Bilo je verjeno manj slovesno kot pri Tomažu, vendar, če ne bi bilo tega, tudi naše vere ne bi bilo.

Zato moramo biti zelo obzirni pri presojanju nevere sodobnih Tomažev. Morda se jim Jezus še ni prikazal. Mogoče je bilo tudi naše pričevanje premalo prepričevalno.

Najbrž pa je še neki razloček. Ta je v odprtosti in sprejemljivosti srca. Jezus se ni prikazal ne Pilatu ne Herodu ne nikomur od tistih, ki so mu žeeli in povzročili smrt. Tudi če bi se jim prikazal, bi ga skušali ponovno križati. Zakaj? Ker ga niso imeli radi. Ker niso hoteli, da bi bil živ.

Jezus se je prikazal tistim, ki so ga ljubili. Ljubili celo takrat, ko je bil že mrtev. Da se ti Jezus prikaže, ga moraš imeti rad. /Franc Cerar/

Sunday's Readings

2nd Sunday of Easter - Divine Mercy

Response: **"Give thanks to the Lord for he is good; his steadfast love endures forever."**

First Reading Acts 5:12-16

A vignette of life in the early Church.

Second Reading Rivelation 1:9-13. 17-19

John, who shares the distress and the hopes of his readers, is to record visions received from Christ, the crucified and risen one.

Gospel John 20:19-31

Jesus reveals his divine mercy to his disciples, and empowers them to reveal it to us who believe.

"Jesus came and stood among them."

Aida was chatting to her parish priest after Mass. "It was in 1945," she explained, "in the wee small hours that the front-door bell rang. I was on my own. Six months earlier a telegram from the War Office reported that my husband – we'd been married only a matter of weeks before he was sent abroad – was missing, presumed dead; a later message said he might have been captured, but after that – silence. So, being alone in the house, my first reaction was to snuggle under the bedclothes. But the bell rang again – and again. Finally, I tiptoed downstairs, slipped the guard chain into place and opened the door a fraction.



"The figure on the doorstep turned towards me and spoke, called me by name. It was my husband. And for a moment my heart stood still." After a pause, Aida continued: "Perhaps you can understand why today's Mass, and especially today's Gospel, means so much to me. I feel I've had a taste first hand of the joy and unbelievable excitement the apostles must have experienced on the first Easter Sunday."

Gospel Teaching

But of course on that first Easter Sunday evening it wasn't simply someone missing, presumed dead, who appeared in the midst of the disciples. It was someone who had been put to a horrific death, who had lain lifeless in a tomb for the best part of three days, and who now stood in their midst, alive and radiant. He hadn't even needed to knock at the barred door.

Yes, of course there was excitement in the hearts of the disciples, and joy, even an element of disbelief; but was there perhaps something else?

The last time Jesus saw them, they were taking to their heels like a bunch of cowards; later their spokesman, Simon Peter, swore that he didn't even know Jesus. What would happen now? They didn't have long to wait; and it wasn't at all what they had feared. No word of reproach – instead, the incredible message, twice repeated, "Peace be with you." They were words not just of greeting but of absolution. Peace, God-given peace, came welling up in their hearts.

Wordlessly, Jesus showed them the wounds in his hands and side. The wound in his side led straight to his sacred heart, the source of limitless love and mercy and compassion. Then he breathed out upon the apostles the mighty power of the Holy Spirit and sent them, just as the Father had sent him, to bring God's forgiveness and peace to the world.

The apostle Thomas was absent on that occasion and was reluctant to accept the word of others. He wanted to see the risen Lord for himself, wanted to feel the marks of his wounds. One week later he got his wish. His reaction was a glorious cry of faith, "My Lord and my God!", which in turn earned the wonderful response from Jesus: "Happy" – truly blessed – "are those who have not seen and yet believe."

Application

Of course, we have not seen; and that means that we are truly blessed – at least, we are if we truly believe. But do we believe? Do we believe that Jesus' divine heart is ablaze with love and mercy for us at this very moment? That there is no weakness of ours that he does not understand, no sin of ours that he will not forgive, no time of day or night when he is not totally interested in us? Remembering our Lord's own words, "Happy the merciful: they shall have mercy shown them", do

we try to mirror his compassion in our dealings with others? Do we believe that just as Jesus is present in the Eucharist as food for our souls, so he is present in the sacrament of reconciliation as forgiveness for our sins, as the physician who can cure every ill? And do we act on that belief by making regular use of the confessional, or has the sacrament of God's compassion been airbrushed out of our Catholic lives?

In the year 2000 Blessed John Paul II announced that this Sunday, the first after Easter, would be celebrated as Divine Mercy Sunday. "The Divine Mercy", he explained, "is the Easter gift that the Church receives from the risen Christ and offers to humanity." To accept that gift, to open our hearts to the Lord's boundless mercy, is already to experience something of the unbelievable joy and peace that the apostles experienced on the first Easter Sunday
