MOSKVA, 29. septembra. —

Zadnja poteza, ki dela Nemčiji upravičene skrbi, pa je bila izvršena z ozirom na Estonijo. Estonija je postala predvčerajšnjim ruska vojaška zaveznička in Rusija je postala na Baltiku dominantna sila. Rusija je sklenila z Estonsko nenapadalni in vojaški pakt, čigar prvi člen določuje, da bo priskočila Rusija z armado na pomoč Estoniji, ako napade kaka velesila pomorsko obalo slednje na Baltiku ali ako jo napade s kopnegā skozi Letvo.

Te besede so vredne premisleka. Edina velika sila, ki bi utegnila napasti Estonijo, je Nemčija. Pomen teh besed mora biti predvsem jasen nemškemu ministru Ribbentropu, kateremu je jasno, da je Stalin s potezo peresa zgradil barikado pred izpostavljenim Ljeningradom.

This is the second consecutive year that the Strugglers have won a Class A title. Last year if you recall correctly the boys won the City-Wide Class A elimination championship. Pitcher Eddie Zaletal who again pitched a marvelous game allowed the opponents only three hits while striking out ten.

I would like to add that Eddie Zaletal compiled a season's average of allowing only three hits per game while fanning thirteen. Amongst his victories were a no hit game and four one hitters. Beautiful pitching in any league, I say.

When the Spartans annexed their first Inter-Lodge Softball title a little over a week ago by defeating the Loyalites in a best out of three series, there arose much controversy as to whether the SSPZ men were really the better team and deserved to win the crown or not.

This dispute arose in the heated blood battles staged in the I-L trophy race when the Spartans had a very difficult time in gaining the championship over the Collinwooders.
