Amerika gleda v Evropo

Seveda ne v kakem namenu, da bi iskala v Evropi kakih osebnih dobičkov, da bi imela kake namene s tem ali narodom ali da bi hotela diktirati temu ali onemu narodu glede njegove vlade, ampak Amerika je začela pozornost gledati v Evropo, kjer se vrši zadnje čase silovita borba med demokracijo in fašizmom.

Dočim se vlada Zedinjenih držav prej ni mnogo ozirala na Evropo, pa je po takozvani "pogodbi v Monakovem" postala zelo pozorna na tekoče dogodke v Evropi. Predsednik Wilson je pred kratkim poklical dva ameriška poslanika, iz Berlina in iz Rima, da se vrnejo v Ameriko in poročata o resničnem položaju v Nemčiji kot v Italiji.

Da se vlada Zedinjenih držav toliko zanima za položaj v Evropi so jo privedli k temu bridki spomini iz leta 1917, ko je šla Amerika s svojo armado preko oceana in se borila za — demokracijo!

Brez dvoma je, da bo Evropa, prej ali slej ponovno klicala Ameriko na pomoč, bodisi za oboroženo silo ali pa za denarno pomoč. Toda ravno pogodba v Monakovem je povzročila, da si bo Amerika stokrat premislila, predno bo zrtvovala stotisoče mladit življenj in milijarde narodnega premoženja.

Vsi so enako sodelovali pri tej sramotni pogodbi, ministri predsednik Anglije in Francije, ki bi morali predstavljati demokracijo, kot voditelji Italije in Nemčije, ki so izrazili diktatorji. Anglija in Francija sta se pokorili Nemčiji brez vsake borbe, in to je nekaj nečudenega, nekaj česar Amerika pod nobenim pogojem ne more razumeti, kako se more namreč močna demokracija podati umetnemu diktatorstvu.

Nemčija je zasedla velik del Čehoslovaške. Anglija in Francija sta sklonili glave in ponižno potrdili. In vendar je bil obstanek in vsa bodočnost Čehoslovaške odvisna od Anglije in Francije. Kako je prišlo do te izjave od strani demokratskih držav, to je vprašanje, o katerem danes Amerika premišljuje? Pomisliti je treba, da je bila Čehoslovaška istinita demokratska država v Evropi, ki je imela največje naklonjenosti in prijateljstvo od strani Zedinjenih držav.

Amerika danes premišljuje, da če sta demokraciji Anglija in Francija pustili Čehoslovaško na cedilu, ali ni mogoče, da enako pustijo tudi Zedinjene države, če bi se naše Amerike še kdaj prišla slabost, da bi šla in se vmešavala v evropske intrige in zahrbtnosti? Poroča se, da je bil sam predsednik Roosevelt, ki je vendar bolje informiran kot sleherni ameriški državljani, tako začuden radi monakovske pogodbe, da sploh ni verjel prvotnim poročilom, da se je kaj enakega moglo zgoditi.

Taki igri, kot se je zgodila v Monakovem, Amerika nikdar ne more slediti, kar šče odobravati. Kaj bi rekla danes n. pr. Kanada, ako bi Zedinjene države zahtevale kos Kanade za sebe, rekoč, da je tam angleško prebivalstvo, torej spada ta kos Kanade Zedinjenim državam? To je rop, zasujenjenje človeških pravice.

Danes je na svetu mnogo takozvane "demokracije," katero izkoriščajo v vse mogoče svrhe, samo v demokratske ne. Tudi v Ameriki imamo precej "demokratskih organizacij," ki so v resnici slepo orodje raznih tujezemskih diktatorjev. Sledimo naši vladi v Washingtonu in počutili se bomo bolj varne kot sledeči hinavskim vabilom laži-demokratov.
