## POLICIJA RAZBILA "LAKOTNI POHOD" V ALBANY

Pet demonstrantov je bilo resno ranjenih, 60 pa arietiranih, ko so pohodniki prišli v mesto.

ALBANY, N. J., 30. okt. — Ko je nočno prikakalo sem 210 "lakotnih pohodnikov," da jih je pri Hudson River mestu napadel ter razgnal. V kratki in vrči bitki je bilo pet oseb takoj resno ranjenih, da se jih je moralo odpeljati v bolnišnico. 60 pohodnikov je bilo arietiranih.

Brezposelni ranjenici so obležali na mostu, med tem ko je policija ostale pogna v mračne ulice železniške naselbine Rensselaer, ki se nahaja na drugi strani mostu.

Straža državnih četnikov o krog državnega kapitola se je nočjo ojačila za 25 mož, akoravno se governer Lehman nahaja v New Yorku. Policija je ustavila in zapodila nazaj skupino pohodnikov, ki je prišla iz Buffalo. Od te skupine je bilo arietiranih 40 oseb. Policija pravi, da je podvzela te korake, da prepreči krvave izgredje, od katerih je prišlo v Albany pred tremi leti.

## VOJAŠKE PRIPRAVE ZA PLEBISCIT V SAARU

NANCY, Francija, 30. okt. — Vse francoske garnizije v Alzajsi in Loreni so doble navodile, da so pripravljene stopiti v akcijo za protektiono francoskih interesov, ako bi nemški nacijski poskušali s pučem v dolini Saar, kjer imajo prebivalci v januarju glasovati, če se pokrajina vrne pod Nemčijo ali ostane še nadalje pod upravo Lige narodov.

Prosim Vas za prostor v vašem cenjenem listu v svrhu prošnje na vaše cenjene čitatelje. Ker je Bruno Hauptman, ki je zapleten v Lindberghovo afero, inozemec, ki se nezakonito nahaja v Združenih državah, se je začela gonja, da se naši prisluženi zakoni poostrijajo in da se uvede registracija vseh inozemcev. Proti inozemcem, najbodo inozemci ali pa državljanji, treba seveda postopati z vso strogostjo zakona, da se javnost zaščiti pred njihovimi zlodjetvami.

Zgornje zahteve pa dajejo vrtis kot, da bi bila zaščita občinstva potrebna napram inozemcem nego državljanom. To je nezmišljeno in krivično. Narodni odbor o splošovanju in izvrševanju zakonov, ki ga je bil imenovan predsednik Hoover, je veliko pažljivo proučil vse to vprašanje in prišel do zaključka, da "razmerno s svojim številom, priseljeni počenjajo manj zločinov kot turisti Amerikanici". Ako je registracija zaželjiva, naj vključuje vse in ne samo inozemce. Pri tem pa treba tudi naglašati, da so ga na podlagi obstoječih zakonov mogli deportirati Hauptmann vsak čas, od kar je sem prišel. Ni torej mogoče pripisati njegovo bivanje v Ameriki pomanjkanju potrebnih zakonov.

CHICAGO, 31. okt. — Nocoj se zapro vrata "Century of Progress" svetovne razstave, ki je edina svetovna razstava, ki se je finančno dobro obnesla. Trajala je skozi dve leti in obiskalo jo je 38 milijonov ljudi iz vseh delov sveta, ki so samo na razvijeni prostorih in koncesijah potrošili \$60,000,000. Kar so obiskovalci zapravili v Chicagu v hotelih, zabavili in v trgovinah, v tej številki ni vključeno. Konservativno se računa, da so posetniki potrošili v Chicagu okrog \$100,000,000.

Razstava se je financiralo z bondno izdajo v znesku \$10,000,000. Od cele obveznosti se je 94 procentov že plačalo, in kot naznana uprava, ni nobenega strahu, da se ne bi moglo pokriti sleherni cent izdatkov, kadar bodo računi zaključeni.

"Kolumbijska razstava," ki se je vršila v Chicagu leta 1893, je pokrila samo 10 odstotkov svojih obveznosti, svetovna razstava v St. Louisu ni plačala nič, in z deficitom so se končale tudi vse podobne razstave v Evropi.

## ARMADA BREZPOSELNI NIH ZOPET RASTE

WASHINGTON, 30. okt. — Brezposelnost v Zed. državah zopet raste, kot razvidno iz poročila Ameriške delavske federacije, katero je objavil predsednik Green. Lani je bilo v septembru glasom podatkov federacije 10,108,000 brezposelnih, letos pa jih je bilo v istem mesecu 10,951,000. Samo zvezna vlada danes podpira 4,334,000 družin, oziroma okrog 17 milijonov oseb, pravi Green ter apelira na vlado, da pospeši uposelitev ljudi v privatnih industrijih.

V Pueblo, Colo., je umrl Mike Zigič, rojen v Liškem Osjeku na Hrvatskem. Bil je član SNPJ.

Louis Peyer, bivajoč v Herminie, Pa., je dobil iz starega kraja sporočilo, da je v vasi Breg pri Litiji umrla mati njegove pokojne žene Jera Zamejel v visoki starosti 90 let. V Ameriki zupušča zeta in vnukinja, v starem kraju pa eno hčer.

V Kranju je umrl vpokojeni gozdar Franc Terček, brat Janeza Terčka, urednika new-yorskega dnevnika "Glas Naroda". Bolezen si je nakopal na Galipolišu, kamor ga je v začetku svetovne vojne poslala nemška vlada kot strokovnjaka za pogodbovanje. Pokojni je bil star 50 let.

Ti ljudje so svojimi paradi in demonstracijami obsojajo ameriške institucije, oni širijo nauke uničenja in ustvarjajo sodobnost med ljudmi, ki jih zavajajo. Ti ljudje so javna sramota in njih početja se ne bo več toleriralo."

Kot znano, je bil Davis župan Clevelanda leta 1918, ko so socialisti v Clevelandu priredili največje prvomajsko demonstracijo v zgodovini mesta. Ko so mirni pohodniki prikakali iz raznih delov mesta na Public Square, jih je naskočila polica, kateri so pomagali člani Ameriške legije. Mirna demonstracija se je spremenila v krvavo bitko, v kateri sta bila dva demonstranta ubita, veliko pa je bilo ranjenih. Naslednjega meseca je na Davisovem domu eksplodirala bomba, toda ranjeni ni bil nikhe.



The acute colds are usually characterized by high infectivity and are most infectious during the early stages of the attack. The coughing and sneezing and the accompanying increase in the discharges from the nose and mouth facilitate the spread of the causative agents of other diseases: such as pneumonia, measles, mumps and meningitis.

There are no specific measures for the control of the respiratory diseases, but there are certain precautions which all of us should observe. Have the home temperature properly regulated, keep the hands away from the mouth and wash them frequently especially before eating, get plenty of sleep 8 to 10 hours daily, keep out of crowds, avoid chilling, drink plenty of water, form regular habits of body eliminations, dress warmly and keep the feet dry.
