St. Josephs Concede Victory to South Chicagoans in Seventh; St. Als Throw Scare Into Baragas, Outthit Milwaukeeans

The terrific heat wave experienced throughout the Midwest on Sunday, July 22, was not sufficient enough to forestall the winning proclivities of the St. Florian Boosters and the Milwaukee Baragites. Though the mercury stood at the 100 mark our sturdy Midwest teams elected to swelter and play for the sake of dear old KSKJ.

In South Chicago, the Florians and the Waukegan St. Joes sweltered through a contest which was won by the Boosters, 9 to 3. The game was terminated in the seventh inning because of the intense heat and the run advantage held by the winners.

The St. Florian victory was achieved by the dint of some consistent and heavy hitting. The game started peacefully enough with the St. Joes drawing first blood in the initial frame. In the second inning the Florians countered with a barrage of seven hits to score six runs.

In that stanza T. Franko opened with a single, which was immediately duplicated by Frank Strubel. Joe Kucic fled out to left field, but little Johnny Benkovich responded with a double to score two runs. Tony Lowery, next up to bat, singled, scoring Benkovich. Alex Hurysz was hit by a pitched ball. Ed Primoic fled out to left. Johnny Franko uncorked a herculean wallop good for three bases and came home when Eddie Kucic banged a single. Tony Franko got his second single of the inning, which was ended when Strubel fanned. During this onslaught Joe Pustaver, hurler for the Joes, was sent to the showers and was replaced by F. Petrovic, who finished the game.

In the third frame the Florians garnered three more runs when Alex Hurysz walloped a homer with Benkovich and Lowery perched on the bases. The Waukegan lads scored their remaining two runs in the fourth and sixth.

In the summaries we find that the South Chicago boys totaled 14 hits off the pitching of Pustaver and Petrovic. The Waukeganers collected only five scattered hits from the offerings of Eddie Kucic, who also turned in 10 strikeouts. Tersar led the North Shore boys by getting two hits, one a triple, which bore fruit in the fourth inning.

Milwaukee Wins Close Game
In Milwaukee, where the temperature was a few degrees cooler, the Baragas took a thriller from the Chicago St. Als by a 7 to 6 score. This game, however, is the first close contest turned in by league teams this year. Though Milwaukee won the game, all playing honors go to the Als, who put up a staunch fight.

The Baragas got away to a three-run lead in the first by virtue of two hits and two errors. St. Aloysius tried to match it in the second when Pitcher Louis Kovacic walloped a home run with J. Mladic on base to score two runs. St. Als went into a 4 to 3 lead in the third when the Baragas allowed two runs to score on one hit. Milwaukee tied the score in the sixth, and went ahead in the seventh with two runs, which the Als tied in the eighth frame. The Baragites put across their winning marker in the eighth when Freno Grahek drew a base on balls and

scored on timely hits of Kostanevic and Manager Sadkovich.

Summarizing the game, we find that the St. Aloysius team touched Grahek for 12 hits and succumbed to 9 strikeouts. J. Mladic, Kovacic and Kolenko were their batting mainstays. Meanwhile the Baragas could only get to Kovacic for 9 hits, who also set them down with 14 strikeouts. For Milwaukee Sadkovich and Banko were better with the budgeon.

Joliet Forfeits Game to St. Stephens
The third game of the day between the Joliet Boosters and the St. Stephen Sports- was forfeited to the Chicago team when the Jolieters failed to abide with the schedule. Joliet's effort to postpone the game was not allowed owing to the very short notice and also an unimportant reason.

Another forfeiture which is being written into the league records is the game which was to have been played between St. Aloysius and St. Florians at 26th and Damen in Chicago on July 15. The St. Aloysius team sought a postponement which was disallowed after an investigation showed that their reason was also unimportant and the league statistician was not officially notified of their action. It must be emphasized here that the league will not tolerate any abrogation of its official schedule except by bona fide methods set forth in its constitution. The Midwest League race is far too close and important to allow any dilatory practices to upset the schedule.

PROPOSED BY-LAWS of K. S. K. Jednota

to be submitted to the delegation of the XVIII. regular Convention in Indianapolis, Ind.

Article 5, New Section

18. Amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws relative to the payment of benefits, the granting of additional benefits or options, the increase, or decrease of mortuary assessments, etc., shall not be proposed by an individual delegate, or delegates, on the floor of the Convention unless a copy of such proposed amendments had been filed with the Supreme Committee of the Union at least ninety days prior to the convening of the Convention. This shall not apply to such amendments as may be proposed by the Supreme Committee.

Article 7, New Sections

18. The Supreme Committee shall have full power and authority to conduct the business of the Union in such manner as is not inconsistent with the Constitution and By-Laws. The Supreme Committee shall have full power and authority to determine and have prepared the forms of adult and juvenile benefit certificates to be issued by the Union. Certificates may be issued to provide for death, endowment, old age and other benefits not in violation of the statutes of the State of Illinois. The mortality and interest assumptions to be employed as the basis for the computation of the mortuary assessment rates, reserves, withdrawal values or non-forfeiture options, etc., shall be determined by the Supreme Committee and approved by the Actuary of the Union. The Supreme Committee also shall determine the expense loadings to be included in each schedule of mortuary assessment rates and all other details relative thereto. Should it become possible and desirable to grant additional benefits or options under any certificate forms heretofore or hereafter issued by the Union the Supreme Committee shall have full power to effect such changes or additions as may be approved by the Actuary of the Union. The Supreme Committee also shall have full power to discontinue the issuance of any form of benefit certificate at any time, but

such action, if taken, shall not affect outstanding certificates.

19. Should the State laws regulating fraternal beneficiary societies be amended so as to provide for a more liberal designation of beneficiaries, or otherwise, the Supreme Committee shall have full power to take advantage of such changes.

20. Acting under the advice of the Actuary of the Union, the Supreme Committee shall have full power and authority to establish all necessary rules and regulations relative to the transfer of members from one form of benefit certificate to another and for the exchange of such certificates.

21. The Supreme Committee shall have full power and authority to establish rules and regulations for the conduct and operation of the Juvenile Department and shall have complete supervision in all affairs pertaining to said Department.

22. Should the State laws regulating fraternal beneficiary societies be amended so as to provide for more liberal schedules of benefits under juvenile certificates, or for the insurance of children of non-members, or otherwise, the Supreme Committee shall have full power and authority to take advantage of such changes.

ARTICLE 18

The first section already printed shall be untouched, the remaining sections are to be killed and substituted with the following new sections 2-7:

2. During the first days of each month the Supreme Secretary shall forward to each Subordinate Society a correct statement showing the amount each such Society shall pay into the various Funds of the Union. In the event a deficit exists in any of the Funds of the Union the Supreme Committee shall have full power and authority to call special assessments until said deficit is eliminated.

3. Every member of the Union shall pay his assessments to the Secretary of his Subordinate Society on or before the 25th day of each month. Any member who shall fail to pay his assessments as herein provided automatically shall be suspended from the Union and shall not be entitled to any benefits in the Union until and after he is reinstated as provided by these By-Laws; provided, however, that this provision shall not apply to certificates in Classes C, D and E which have been maintained in full force and effect for three years or longer from date of issuance.

4. Members carrying certificates in Classes C, D and E, after maintaining said certificates in full force

Final Report From All Societies Not Due to Reach Headquarters Until Saturday, Aug. 11; Winners of Gigantic Drive Still in Doubt

Joliet, Ill., July 31—The K. S. K. J. National Recovery Program, after five months of intensive work on the part of all workers of the Grand Carniolian Slovenian Catholic Union, comes to a close at midnight today.

The Recovery was the most auspicious membership drive sponsored by the Union in recent years and gives every indication of being one of the most successful and fruitful campaigns ever conducted by a Slovenian fraternal organization.

Hope to Double Quota

With the final reports from the majority of societies still to be received, it is apparent the contest will go well above quota. In this regard, Joseph Zalar, supreme secretary and K. S. K. J. National Recovery administrator, reported that he had hopes the late reports would carry the drive 100 percent over its quota of a million dollars of new insurance.

Incomplete reports at this time further make it impossible to name the winning section, states and individual societies of each state. The race for honors in these divisions has been extremely close throughout the five-month period and the ultimate winners will depend entirely upon this final report. At the present writing not one of the seventeen trophies being awarded as prizes in this campaign can be claimed by any society, state or section.
