KONCEM TEDNA

GLAVNI pomočnik za nemške uspehe v Libiji in na Balkanu je bil čas. In čas je bil na koncu Nemčev, dasi ne po njih ukušenju. Kakor hitro je nemške Bolgarija kapitulirala pred Nemčijo, je Anglia sklepla pošlje armado na Grčijo. To se je potegnilo iz Afrike in Novo Zelandijo, da ne bodo malo prezgodaj, prije preobrat in Anglia je hitro v Grčijo, da se pridobi na času, diplomatski v Belgradu trudna vse načine, da bi regent zavlekel pogodbo z osemom. Toda Pavel je podpisal predno se je sploh pričakalo. Tako se je zgodilo, da Grčija ni bila pripravljena niti v severni Afriki, udaril Hitler.

MERIKANCI so si izmislišli nekaj popolnoma novega, bodo pomagali škodovati namizirja, ki posreduje med Amerikani in angleškimi tovarnami za izdelavo bomb. To dela na takle način. Amerikanec kipi z gotovo vsoto denarja te ali one vrste bombe, prepisana nanj. Potem nobi lastnik te bombe napoveda sporočilo, kje in kdaj je bomba vržena in kakšno je napravila pri Nemcih.

INGRESNIKI so zahtevali, da je ameriški armadni častno v uniformah. Temu pa ti upri. Pravijo, da bo dosti po uradih in ljudem v Washingtonu bi se začetnu spraševati, kaj dela občinjenje v kapitolu, medtem ko bili z armado.

Evropskih državicah, katerih so zasedli Nemci in v varstvo osebe nemškega, hoče biti zdaj skoraj Nemec, da bi užival ta ugodnost. Tako se je Jugoslavskim toliko ljudi prisluškalo za Nemce, ki nimajo niničkega imen, niti ne znajo nemškega, da je besedice nemškega, da je minister notranjih zagonil, da jih bo prijet za vse izgnal na Nemce. Toda ustavil ga je vodja manjšine in rekel, da vsekakor Nemec, kdo horjel. In slovaški minister je jeno požreti. Na Madžarsko, kjer so uradno našteli, da vsekakor Nemec, se jih je enkrat za Nemce že enkrat. Vlada jih je molče zasezlo, za Nemce, ker je prišel iz Berlina.

Jugoslavija je imela v načrtu, da bila zlasti slaba v dveh točkah: prvič, armada ni bila popolnoma prometnih zvez na deloval. Ko je nemška zračna sila razbijala zvode, telefon in radijske postaje v prvem navalu na Jugoslavijo, je bila rmada brez vsake komunikacijske zveze.

Jugoslovanska armada je pred umikom poškodovala železniške predore

Berlin pravi, da je s porazom Jugoslavije en korak bližje k zmagi. — Toda za Nemčijo ne bo imela okupirana Jugoslavija dosti veljave, ker ne bo mogla rabiti železnic radi razbitih predorov. — Hitler imenoval prvega poslanika za Hrvatsko.

Berlin, 18. aprila. — Vest o kapitulaciji jugoslovanske armade so pozdravili v Berlinu kot nov korak k pohodu do končne zmage. Za Nemčijo to pomeni, da bo zdaj lahko poslala več vojašta in več bojne opreme v Grčijo. Vojaški izvedenci opisujejo padec Jugoslavije po 12 dneh boja kot nemško zmago, ki je bila dobljena skoro brez vsakega prelivanja krvi. Kot trdi nemški poveljstvo je padlo v Jugoslaviji komaj nekaj sto nemških vojakov.

Nemci polagajo veliko važnost na to, da so strli zopet eno državo v prav istem času, ko so nemški bombniki s takim uspehom razbijali po Londonu. To, pravijo Nemci, dokazuje, da Nemčija lahko vodi boj na raznih oddaljenih krajinah in ima pri tem še dovolj rezerve pripravljene.

Nekateri komentirajo, da se je Jugoslavija vzdržala dlje, kot se je Nizozemska, toda je omahnila prej kot nekatere druge države, ki so se postavile proti Hitlerju. Tako je vzdržala Nizozemska samo pet dni, Poljska 18, Belgija 19 in Francija 45 dni.

Vesti iz Italije javljajo, da je italijanska vlada razglasila Slovenijo in Dalmacijo za laški provinci ter za vsako imenovala civilnega komisarja. V Sloveniji je bil imenovan za komisarja dosedanji fašistični tajnik v Trstu, Emilio Grazioli, v Dalmaciji pa fašistični tajnik v Zadru, A. Bartolucci.

Kot vojaški činitelj je Jugoslavija popolnoma iz vojne terbo kot tako malo koristila Nemčija. Njena armada bo razorenja in Nemci bodo pobrali nekaj vojaške opreme. Toda vidi se, da je jugoslovanska armada, predno se je podala, opravila temeljito delo s tem, da je pohabila večino svojih železnic. Mnogo železniških predorov, katerih je na stotine po Jugoslaviju, so Jugoslovani uničili. Zato se Nemčija ne bo mogla posluževati jugoslovanskimi železnicami do Grčije.

Nemci pravijo, da se je videlo že takoj v začetku vojne, da jugoslovanska armada 1,250,000 mož ne bo kos Hitlerjevih mehaniziranih divizijs, kljub vsemu pogumu, s katerim so Jugoslovani postavili proti nacijem.

Jugoslovanska obramba je bila zlasti slaba v dveh točkah: prvič, armada ni bila popolnoma razbijana, in drugič, sistem prometnih zvez na deloval. Ko je nemška zračna sila razbijala zvode, telefon in radijske postaje v prvem navalu na Jugoslavijo, je bila rmada brez vsake komunikacijske zveze.

Pohod nemške armade proti Egiptu je bil ustavljen, trdijo Angleži

Kairo, 18. aprila. — Angleške puščavske čete, zračna sila in mornarica so ustavili pohod nemške in italijanske mehanizirane armade proti Egiptu. Zadnjih 48 ur so čete osišča splošno na defenzivni pri Tobruku in Salumu. Angleži so včeraj zajeli pet nemških častnikov in 72 vojakov.

Največ je pri tem pomagala bojna mornarica ob obrežju, ki je pošiljala na tone težkih izstrelkov v nemške pozicije pri Salumu. To obsipavanje z mornarico je razbilo dolge kolone motornih transportov in mornarica ima največ zasluga, da se je zarvrlo pohod osišča proti Sueškemu prekopu.

Pisano nekje v Črni gori. — Masni napad nemških bombnikov, ki so jih prizadevali Nemcem. V enem samem dnevu so razbili Nemcem 200 tankov.

Klub vsemu strahovitemu odporu, pa so rinili Nemci vedno globlje v deželo in boj je postal brezupen.

Reči moram, da se je srbska armada sama borila, ker pri svojem obhodu sem videl mnogo hrvatskih deserterjev in v kritični uri boja je prišlo uradno naznanilo, da so se Hrvati na severu uprili.

London, 18. aprila. — Angleški avijatičarji so brez odlašanja odgovorili na nemški napad na London zadnjio sredo, ki je bil eden najstrenješih v tej vojni. Angleži so sinoči poleteli nad Berlin in vrnili milo za draugo. Tudi Berlin je doživel bombardiranje, kot ga še ni to vojno.

Angleži so metali bombe na sredisce Berlina, kamor so ponesli bombe novi štirimotorni bombniki, ki lahko nosijo več totonov bomb na velike daljave. Angleži so pri tem izgubili osem letal.

Grčija ne bo več dolgo vzdržala

Grške in angleške čete so se umaknile na krajšo fronto. — Hitler je baje pri armadi na Balkanu. — Grški premier nenadno umrl.

London, 18. aprila. — Tujezski diplomiati so mnenja, da odpor Grčije ne bo trajal dlje kot kvečjem par tednov. Čast in ponos je edino, kar zadržuje Anglijo, da ne potegne armade iz Grčije. Kot sodijo diplomatski krog, je pričakovati prihodnje bitke za Egipt in Suez. Večinoma jiš je mnenja, da Hitler ne bo udaril preko Turčije v Egipt, ampak bo poslal svojo armado v Tripolitanijo in ob tam proti Egiptu. Mnenje prevladuje tudi, da bo Rusija ostala neutralna, tudi če udari Hitler preko Dardanel v Turčijo.

Nova obrambena linija preko Tesalije še vedno zadržuje nasoke nemške armade. Grške in angleške čete so se v polnem redu umaknile iz Albanije v krajšo obrambeno linijo.

Nemci naskakujejo z najmanj 10 divizijami in nad 1000 letali zavezniške pozicije. Toda branitelji Grčije odbijajo napad za napadom. Kupi padil nemških vojakov se dvigajo. Nekateri sodijo, da je padlo dozdaj v Grčiji že 50,000 nemških vojakov.

Atene, 18. aprila. — Danes je menadoma umrl grški premier Korizis, star 56 let. Samo 80 dni je bil na vladu, katero je prevzel za premierjem Metaxasom. Vladna ne poroča vroča nagle smrti. Kralj je imenoval governerja Aten, Kotziasa, za premierja z naročilom, naj nadaljuje z bojem proti nacijem.

Berlin, 18. aprila. — Adolf Hitler bo obhajal svoj 52. rojstni dan v nedeljo v glavnem stanu svoje armade na Balkanu. Ravnno kje se "firer" nahaja, poročila ne povedo. Propagandni minister Goebbels je ukazal, da bodo po vsej Nemčiji v nedeljo razobesene zastave.


