## Fordov dobiček za 49% večji v prvih 3 mesecih

Ford Motor Company je objavila, da je imela v prvih treh mesecih letosnjega leta 252 milijonov dobička 49% več kot lani.

DETROIT, Mich. — Letošnji trije meseci so bili za Forda izredno uspešni, uspešnejši kot kdajkoli preje, 49% bolj kot v istem razdobju lani. Družba je objavila, da je zaslužila v teh mesecih 252 milijonov. Zato se je odločila znižati cene vsem svojim avtomobilom, osebnim in tovornim, za povprečno \$13.

Dobiček je porastel na eni strani zaradi zelo povečanega obsega prodaje avtomobilov, na drugi strani pa tudi zaradi "povečane učinkovitosti" vodstva družbe, kot je dejal predsednik Lee A. Iacocca. Znižanje cen je bilo potrebno, da je družba spravila svoj dobiček v sklad z določili Komisije za cene.

Zanimivo je, da je družba objavila svoj povečan dobiček kmaj dva dni potem, ko je Komisija za cene odklonila prošnjo Ford Motor Company za povišanje cen nekaterih njenih izdelkov, ki naj bi po njeni misli prinesli 2 milijona dodatnega dohotka.

Načelnik Komisije na cene C. J. Grayson je objavil, da bodo izdana nova navodila z zvezni produktivnostjo, ki bodo zmanjšala dobičke podjetij. Stopila bodo v veljavu v ponedeljek, 1. maja.

Kenguruji v nevarnosti?

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Ko je prišla sem vest, da so kenguri v Avstraliji v nevarnosti, ker jih na veliko love in streljajo, so ZDA odločile položaj presoditi od bliže. Strokovnjak, ki je odpotoval v Avstralijo, se bo od tam vrnil s pripomočilom, ali je kenguru res ogrožen ali ne.

Ce bodo dognali, da je kenguru v nevarnosti, ga bodo dali na seznam takih živali in prepovedali uvoz v ZDA kengurjevih lačnih, mese in vsega ostalega. Lačni so uvozili 516,000 kož kengurjev v vrednosti 1,2 milijona. Porabili so jih za izdelavo parsov, atletskih copat, sedel, jahalnih škornjev in drugo.

Polet Apollo 16 je bil doslej največji uspeh odprav na Luno, četudi je bilo precej ovir in je prišlo pri pristanku na Luni do ur zakanitve. Na Luni so bile vse naloge uspešno opravljene, edina nesreča je bila, da je Young poškodoval kabel, ki naj bi pomagal ugotavljati toplost v notranjosti Lune.

## Zadnje vesti

SAIGON, J. Viet. — Rdeči prisiskajo od vseh strani na mestu Quang Tri in so dosegli žnjegova predmestja. Večina od kakih 30,000 prebivalcev je mesto že preje zapustila. Na ostalih bojiščih je pritisak nekaj popustil.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Senatni pravosodni odbor je včeraj potrdil znova R. Kleindiensta za pravosodnega tajnika z 11:4 glasov. Prihodnji teden bo razprava in glasovanje v senatni zboru.

KONAKRI, Gv. — Tu je včeraj umrl nekdanji predsednik Gane Kvame Nkrumah, ki so ga leta 1966 odstavili in je živel od tedaj v Gvineji.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — V marcu je znašal primanjkljaj v zunanjini trgovinski bilanci 584,3 milijone, le nekaj manj kot v februarju. V prvih treh mesecih letosnjega leta je znašal skupno že 1,5 milijona.

BONN, Z. Nem. — Vladna W. Brandta je včeraj srečno prezivila, ko je bila nezaupnica v parlamentu odklonjena z 249:247 glasovom, toda vladna kriza s tem še ni rešena. Vlada je v nevarnosti pri glasovanju za proračun, prav tako in se bolj pa pri glasovanju za odobritev nenapadnih podgovar Moskvo in Varšavovo, ki je določeno za prihodnji četrtek.

PARIZ, Fr. — Tu so bili včeraj obnovljeni razgovori o končanju vojne v Vietnamu v bistvu v starem duhu, polni propagande in očitkov. Napovedujejo začetek tajnih razgovorov v nekaj dneh, ko bo prispel v Pariz Le Duc Tho, glavni zastopnik Hanoia. Od tajnih razgovorov pričakujejo uspeh.

## Stvarna in možata odločitev predsednika Nixon-a

Predsednik je razlagal, kako so ZDA ponudile Hanoiu, velikodušno rešitev spora, v kateri so šle do skrajne možnosti. Rdeči bi imeli pravico sodelovanja pri volitvah, ki bodo pod mednarodnim nadzrom, predsednik Van Thieu in njegova vlada bosta en mesec pred volitvami stopila z oblasti...

Rdeči na te ponudbe niso hoteli niti odgovoriti niti o njih razpravljati. Vztrajajo pri svojih zahtevah, da naj ZDA odstranijo vlogo v Saigonu in vzpostavijo v Južnem Vietnamu komunistični režim. Zahtevajo torej popolno predajo, zahtevajo, da jim ZA pomagajo do tega, kar se jim doslej ni posrečilo doseči na bojišču in ne med vietnamskim ljudstvom. Svetovni mir bo nenačadno v veliko

večji nevarnosti, kot je sedaj. Kdo naj upošteva ameriško besedo, kdo spoštuje ameriškega predsednika, če se bi zdaj ZDA pod pritiskom enostavno umaknile in klonile pred rdečim nasiljem? je vprašal predsednik Nixon. Nato je pozval ZDA k edinstvu in trdnosti, kajti rdeči upajajo edino še na zmago svoje stvari v Kongresu in v javnem mnenju ZDA, ko so svoj boj izgubili v Južnem Vietnamu samem.

Predsednik Nixon je govoril stvarno, četudi morda v pogledu uspeha vietnamizacije nekaj preoptimistično, govoril je prav tako tudi možato, kot se vodnik ZDA spodbidi, pa naj bi to tudi škodovalo njegovim načrtom za ponovno izvolitev.

## Woolworth moral s hrano na stare cene

Komisija za cene je začela odrejati zniževanje preveč povišanih cen.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Komisija za cene se je zganila in začela na eni strani odklanjati predloge za povišanje cen, kot se je to zgodilo Ford Motor Co., na drugi pa je odredila znižanje cen, ki so bile v zadnjih mesecih povisane preko določenih meja. Da so bile meje prekoračene, je Komisija dognala, ko je dobila v roke poročila podjetij o njihovih dobičkih v prveim četrtletju 1972.

Spošno načelo je bilo, da smejo podjetja povisiti cene produktov za toliko, za kolikor se je produkcija podražila. Dovoljeno je tudi povišanje, če je dobiček podjetij padel pod povprečje dveh najboljših od zadnjih treh let. V tem pogledu so bile kršitve največje in najčešč.

Komisija za cene je tako odredila Woolworth Company, da mora znižati cene malic v svojih prodajalnah na povprečje v času njihove zamrznitve lani. Podjetje je zahtevalo izpolnilo.

Komisija je odredila znižanje cen tudi Simpson Timber Co., pa ji ukazala tudi vrnitve previsok v teku 90 dni. Njene cene naj bi bile 8% previsoke.



### KEEP TAXES DOWN!


As I have pointed out before, all Real Estate taxpayers in Cuyahoga County will receive a 10% reduction in the tax bill they receive in June.

Most of this reduction will be wiped out in your December bill because of a Board of Tax Appeal's ruling that will increase property valuations in Cuyahoga County to 35% of market value.

I am, therefore, asking for support from all taxpayers for Substitute Senate Bill 455 which will guarantee that you will receive your full 10% reduction in December.

Substitute Senate Bill 455 delays the implementation of the Board of Tax Appeals 35% rule until the next county-wide reappraisal. It also provides that when the 35% rule goes into effect and property values increase, tax rates will be proportionately reduced.

Substitute Senate Bill 455 will be debated on the floor of the Senate when the General Assembly reconvenes in May. So that you do not have a Real Estate tax increase in December, I urge you to contact your state senator indicating your support of Senate Bill 455.

## NEWS from the home front

★ The Lakeside Avenue Courthouse and the County Administration Building now have separate telephone numbers. The new number for the courthouse is 621-5800. This number will reach Common Pleas and Probate Courts, the court administrator, clerk of courts, jury commission, law library, civil branch of the sheriff's department and the county building custodian's office. The direct number for the Court of Appeals will remain 621-3285. The Cuyahoga County Administration Building will retain the old courthouse number 241-2700. Until now, both buildings have been serviced by a telephone switchboard in the basement of the administration building, that was overburdened.

★ A Mayo Clinic study of the effectiveness of common pain relievers, including some on prescription only, found ordinary aspirin to be the best of the lot. The study also found at least two prescription pain relievers, including widely used Darvon, to be hardly better than an inert pill. The Mayo study found that aspirin, which has been around for three-quarters of a century is superior to eight other common drugs used for pain relief. It found that Eli Lilly & Co.'s Darvon and Wyeth Laboratories Zactane were both "significantly inferior" to aspirin.

★ Provo, Utah — An FBI agent, searching the Utah Lake area on foot for a hijacker with \$500,000 in ransom, stepped on a skunk. The agent was not injured but was removed from the search. A helicopter, also malfunctioned as it was taking off and was disabled. Parts were flown in and mechanics fixed the hydraulic mechanism just before the air search was called off.

★ San Diego, Calif.—Police here have ordered 40 suits of medieval-style Samurial swordsman armor to wear in training for potential riots. "With this gear, we can throw tomatoes and rocks and shove the men with sticks to add realism and try to aggravate them," said Lt. J. A. McQueeny. He said the Japanese fencing gear would be traded for more modern body armor should the real thing occur.
