

Truman si prizadeva, da bi dosegel sporazum s premogarji

Včeraj je zopet poklical k sebi zastopnike unije in pa premogovnih družb, ki med seboj ne morejo priti do nobenih zaključkov.

Washington. — Predsednik Truman je včeraj spet poklical k sebi John L. Lewisa, predsednika unijskih premogarjev in zastopnike premogovnih družb. Predsednik si na vso moč prizadeva, da bi spravil pogajanja v tek, ki so ostala na mrtvi točki pri medsebojnih razpravah. Pogajanja so obstala takrat, ko je Lewis zahteval od premogovnih družb, da plačajo gotov denar v sklad za dobrobit premogarjev in katerega naj bi upravljal samo unija.

Premogovne družbe so rekle odločni ne in razšli so se, ne da bi prišli niti bližu zahtevi Mr. Trumana, naj mu predložijo do srede novo pogodbo z unijo.

Predsednik Truman je bil razočaran, ker so premogovne družbe enostavno zavrnile Lewisovo zahtevo za dobrodelni sklad, ne da bi se ponudilo kak kompromis, na katerem bi se moglo razpravljati naprej. Zdaj bo morda skušala vlada staviti kak posredovalni predlog, da bi se moglo vsaj nadaljevati s pogajanjem.

Videti je, da se premogovne družbe ne bodo dale premakniti, dokler Lewis ne bo nekaj odnehal.

Čemer se družbe najbolj ustavlajo je to, ker Lewis zahteva, da unija sama upravlja dotični dobrodelni sklad, ceprav bi dale denar zanj premogovne družbe. Družbe pravijo, da bomo dale me denar, hočemo imeti tudi besedo, kako se bo sklad upravljal.

Opis dogodkov med okupacijo v Rovtah nad Logatecem.

(Konec.)

Na podoben zahrbten način so partizani uničili Godovič kot so poskušali uničiti Rovte. Godovičane so silili v partizane, pa se niso hoteli odzvati. Partizani so se maščevali takole: Napadli so Nemcev prav za vasjo. Ranjenih je bilo par Nemcev. Neštejo je v teh sestkah prostorov za tak napad, toda oni so izbrali ravno prostor za vasjo, da so tako vasi ni hotela z njimi po Nemcih uničili. Vedeli so namreč iz drugih zgledov, da so Nemci v takih slučajih vse požgali, ljudi pa odgnali. Tako se je tudi zgodilo v Godoviču. Za par ranjenih Nemcev je bila požgana prav celo vasa, pobrana vse živila, kolikor jih zgorela. Več ljudi je bilo postreljenih, drugi so bili odgnani, le nekaj se jih je razbežalo in ušlo. Tudi župnik Dežela se je dalj časa skrival v Zavratich.



Reversing themselves after a sprightly early performance had given them their first home triumph of the season, the Indians Sunday divided a double-header with the St. Louis Browns before a turnout of 19,860 in the stadium.

Bob Feller, rendered fine aid by Lou Boudreau and George Case, lasted to win his fourth game in the 10-inning opener, 4-3, adding 12 strikeouts to make his total 71.

In the late clash, however, Allie Reynolds was driven out for his fourth successive beating. For the third straight time, the right-hander, who won 18 games last season, lasted only 4 and one-third innings.

A six-run outburst in the fifth when the tribe's defense collapsed brought the Brown's triumph to Tex Shirley, 9-3.

Fuller gave up nine hits, the Browns winning the game at 3-all in the ninth, while the Indians collected the same number off three tossers.

Four Cleveland pitchers — Reynolds, Ed Klemm, Don Black and Bob Lemon — sacrificed 12 blows in the second clash, while Shirley granted nine, including Mickey Rocco's initial no-hitter.

Despite such delightful features as a triple play, fancy base stealing and Ken Keltner's fourth home run sock, the Indians Monday again had to rest content by splitting a twin bill with the St. Louis Browns.

After arousing genuine enthusiasm from a goodly turnout of 4,500 fans in League Park with a 9-2 triumph, the tribesmen suffered the ignominy of being blanked by their former teammate, Al Milnar, 3-0. However, the even break for the series sufficed to lift them a notch into sixth place.

Red Embree's strong five-hit twirling earned him his third decision against one defeat in the opener, while Joe Krakauskas, entrusted with his first starting assignment, was beaten by the defeat.

Krakauskas, left-hander, who will have another try at starting soon, engineered the triple killing in the second inning of his game — first in Cleveland since Bill Wamby's unassisted gem in the 1920 world series against Brooklyn in League Park.

London, May 14 — Gus Lesnevich of Cliffside, N. J., retained his world light heavyweight championship tonight by scoring a technical knockout over Freddie Mills of England at 2:56 of the 10th of a scheduled 15-round battle at Harringay Arena.

The gate was estimated at \$200,000 — a new all-time British boxing record.

A capacity crowd of 10,700 saw Lesnevich, with blood streaming from a deep gash over his left eye and a cut on his nose, hammer gamely to victory, after it seemed in the middle going that he might lose because of his injuries.

Three Knockdowns in Second

Making his second defense of the title he won in 1941, Lesnevich floored the game former Royal Air Force man three times in the second round for six, eight and nine. Mills, light heavy champion of the British Empire, came back remarkably well.

The battle see-sawed until the 10th when Lesnevich floored the bullshuddered, black-haired Briton with hard rights to the jaw for counts of seven and nine. Then Referee Eugene Henderson, former amateur welterweight champion of the empire, stopped the bout to save Mills from further punishment.

Mills was on the verge of unconsciousness, draped over the ring ropes from a final hard right to the chin, when the referee stepped in.
