

## Peach Pie Always Popular



Win new friends for an old favorite—peach pie—with this recipe for luscious Peachy-Coconut Pie. Diced fresh peaches and coconut accent the rich creamy filling. Combined with a tender, flaky crust, made with convenient pie crust mix, it's an irresistible dessert.

**Peachy-Coconut Pie**  
Makes one 9-inch pie

<b>Crust:</b>	One-half pkg. (1 cup) Flako Pie Crust Mix	2 tablespoons cold water
<b>Filling:</b>	1 tablespoon gelatine	1/2 cup flaked or shredded coconut
	1/4 cup cold water	1 tablespoon lemon juice
	2 eggs, separated	

For crust, heat oven to hot (425°F.). Measure into bowl. Sprinkle cold water by tablespoons over mix; stir lightly with fork until just dampened. (If necessary, add an additional one-half tablespoon cold water to make dough hold together.) Form into ball.

Roll out on lightly floured board or canvas to form a 13-inch circle. Fit loosely into 9-inch pie plate. Trim; flute edges; prick bottom and sides. Bake in preheated oven (425°F.) 10 to 12 minutes. Cool.

For filling, soften gelatine in water. Combine egg yolks, milk, sugar and salt in saucepan. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly until mixture coats a metal spoon. Stir in softened gelatine. Chill until mixture starts to thicken and set. Fold in peaches, coconut and lemon juice. Beat egg whites until stiff peaks form; fold into gelatine mixture. Pour into baked crust. Chill until firm. Just before serving, garnish with sweetened whipped cream and toasted coconut.

"WOMAN POWER"

The first woman astronaut may not be far in the future — perhaps no further than the moonshot was thought to be 10 years ago.

News stories everyday show women making further progress in areas of achievement once considered exclusively the domain of males. The first woman jockey, the first woman to cross the Pacific Ocean on a small boat — daring and exciting challenges on the frontiers of human experience.

On a less glamorous but no less dramatic scale is the quiet but steady move by women toward the economic mainstream of the country. Since World War II when they had an opportunity to prove they could do jobs traditionally done by men, they have increasingly taken on the role of breadwinner in addition to their roles as mother and wife. Well over one third — some 29 million — of the nation's labor force are women. Some 48 percent of women 18 to 62 are either working or seeking work. And in over 5 million families, women are the breadwinners.

Social security takes account of the woman's greater participation in the work force and the part her earnings play in the support of the family. She is increasingly becoming entitled to social security benefits in her own right.

SOCIAL SECURITY writer and researcher, Ella J. Polinsky, pointed up the trend in an article in the July 1969 issue of the "Social Security Bulletin" or, "The Position of Women in the Social Security System." The phenomenal increase in the number and proportion of

## Slovenia Revisited

## CONTINUED

The innovating spirit is evident in people. Now that the excitement of socialism is a matter of bygone days, the blaming of foreign exploitation for the backwardness of some areas and slow advancement in others, not appropriate after 20 years of the new regime, the community spirit and effort to build new things just to satisfy the urge of construction resulted in many by now abandoned structures, and many more abandoned plans, now the reality of everyday life and struggle of their own making is taking over. The innovators are somehow tired of repeated mobilization, they prefer to sit down and enjoy the fruits of their efforts which, however, are slow to come. The lethargy and disillusionments are prevailing primarily among the young, their future hindered by the lack of opportunities and positions, which are being vigorously retained by the "old partisans", politically qualified but often professionally incompetent.

Myth and reality are intermingled to the extent that people have difficulty in separating them. The myth in which they believe and cannot verify, becomes a reality and motivates people's behavior. In Yugoslavia the verification process is rather difficult for an outstanding observer, and it is equally difficult for the resident. I am not referring here so much to the material constructions which can be observed, admired, photographed, and sketched, but the material verifications of production and productivity, quality control and efficiency, profitability and level of satisfaction. The western measures can be used only in part. The myth of grandiose constructions is stronger than the reality of accomplishments, particularly if they are compared with the accomplishments elsewhere in the world. To believe that the best, the most beautiful, the most functional objects and constructions are found in their own country, is not peculiar to the Yugoslavs alone. But for them it is more ingrained in their psyche. The myth and reality of socialization, the myth and reality of modernization, the myth and reality of co-ordination are strikingly intermingled. The same kind of inconsistency is evident in people's opinions and their stereotypes about other people in the country. Their concepts are based on casual acquaintances and occasional perusal of the local paper. The unexpected is the degree to which the stereotypes are accepted still today in spite of all the genuine efforts of the authorities to steer away from them into the new course.

An example is the iron and steel works in Capriag near Sisak, considered one of the most modern industrial plants, built after the war, linked to the supply of iron ore nearby and on the imported coking coal. The references provided in studies on Yugoslavia portray the establishment as the focus of an industrial region, more of a growth point than an already integrated system. But if you venture the plant, as I did, thru the open main gates, open only to get the workers out and not to allow unauthorized visitors in — you see that the plant is quite modern, quite efficient, but the industrial linkages with the surroundings are only at the beginnings. The growth point has not yet generated any growth in the region, unless the growth includes apartments in the immediate vicinity of the plant, physically separated from

the city of Sisak, for the benefit of which the construction was made.

THE MYTH of industrialization is predominant in many places, the reality of accomplished industrialization evident only at selected points. In other, more developed countries, the locating of an industry in a specific place usually generates an agglomeration of associated industries and services. However, this is not generally the case in Yugoslavia yet. The response is slow to materialize. In fact, among large scale industrial complexes, built primarily by the postwar efforts, are those Zenica in Bosnia, to a lesser extent the Litostroj in Ljubljana, and new establishments in Beograd and Zagreb. But Zenica, on the other hand, has very little of a Yugoslav character, either in the physical layout of the industry of the town, or the character and behavior of the population. Just another industrial complex, this time at a point of limited accessibility as well as far from the area of great demand. The belief in strategic location in the middle of the country, and the belief in the innovating role of the industry for the vast hinterland, have not materialized. The complex is an island in an exotic territory.

Similar impressions are conveyed by the vigorously pursued plans to construct modern rail and road connections. The "civilizing rail" in Yugoslavia is having an impact upon the terminals and intermediate stopping points, but the more advanced is the line, the less impact it has on the surrounding area, the faster does the flow move thru and not to the area. The modern coastal road along the Adriatic has a tremendous impact upon the coastal resort activity, but this influence is only a few miles deep toward the interior. Any venture perpendicularly from the coast would convince the occasional visitor that he is facing the contact of two civilizations, one contemporary, with Central European overtones, and the other historical, with Balkan ingredients.

The geography of any country is shaped by people, their constructions, their organizations and the dynamic linkages, as it is conditioned by the physical environment. The degree of the physical impact can be minimized in a technologically advanced region, but it cannot be overlooked in a developing area. The Yugoslav performance cannot escape the limitations of the physical environment, and all the efforts of the organizational fervor have been frustrated by the inertia of some people by the restrictions of nature.

The organization of the country based on conscious efforts of political bodies cannot create overnight the linkages which are necessary for an efficient operation of any structure. In Yugoslavia, the assumption that the pronunciation of a system and a linkage is enough to initiate a flow, an interaction, have led to the belief that the resistance is a result of bourgeois tradition and anti-social attitudes. In fact, the regionalized and localized systems, self-contained for the basic necessities of the population, do not generate interchange with outside areas, since there is little demand for them and there is little incentive (or profitability) to get them. The announced plans of close inter-linkages remained in many instances dead words, written in public documents, for the action didn't even start. The society, the community, the carriers of social goals and accomplishments, are territorially restructured into a mosaic-type system, static in nature, and stable by character. The innovation is slow to come, and when it arrives, it affects only a limited number of people and only selected facets of them. The transistor radio is not unusual, but it can be found in houses without running water, with outdoor privy, with sheep sharing the room with the family, and while it is ideally connecting the household with the outside world, this outside world is almost unreal to them, its character impossible to understand, its peculiarities beyond the grasp of an average person.

A social geographer, interested in the relationship between social organization and the spatial impact is often forced to revise his reasoning after he explored the field, to verify the adequacy of his theoretical postulates and to suggest some recommendations. The humanized landscape of Yugoslavia is an enjoyable scene to investigate, on one condition: the respect for the people and their work, a sympathetic understanding of their life and accomplishments, without which the country remains, as it has been for many in the past, "a land of confusion, unrest, violence and backwardness."

## IMMEDIATE TREATMENT OF BURNS MAY SAVE THE LIFE OF VICTIM

The domiciliary treatment of burns applies mainly to minor burns (first and second degree), although it is equally useful in extensive burns with certain technical and therapeutic modifications.

## TECHNIQUE:

1) Apply alcohol on the burnt surface.

This could be done by means of cotton-wool or gauze or simply pouring out the alcohol on the burnt surface without previous cleaning of the skin, taking good care not to injure or burst the vesicles already formed. To avoid this the atomizer should be sprayed with the atomizer. If the skin has already peeled off a sensation of burning will be felt.

2) Fanning of the burn. This will hasten evaporation of alcohol and cooling of the skin.

3) Apply alcohol again after the skin has dried, or whenever the patient complains of a burning sensation again.

4) This treatment should be applied for approximately two hours this being the time elapsed between application of alcohol and reappearance of the burning sensation which gets longer as treatment progresses.

5) Once the signs of inflammation and the sensation of burning have subsided medicated talcum should be applied on the healed suture.

If the burn is localized on a finger, hand, foot or arm, immersion of the burnt area in a recipient containing alcohol should be preferred each time the burning sensation appears.

The results of this treatment are really amazing.

FIRST DEGREE burns heal completely in two hours time.

SECOND DEGREE burns can be divided in three subgroups depending on the depth of lesion, the time elapsed since the accident and the moment treatment has commenced.

The first subgroup type of burns heals completely leaving only empty vesicles adhered to their bases.

The second subgroup heals leaving minimal and superficial scabs otherwise perfectly symptomless.

The third subgroup heals leaving scabs requiring routine treatment.

Since this method has been outlined for the benefit of lay people solely, the description of other forms of treatment has been discarded on purpose.
