Povest o ljubljanski in ižanski revolucijski leta 1848

Pač bi bili graščinski lovci ga dne zastonj pričakovali v radi planili v gozdove za svoji "divjimi" tovarši in se spoprijeli z njimi za zver, toda kaj, ko so imeli toliko opravka drugod, ko so morali stražiti grad na Turjaku ter biti prisotni, ko so birci in vojaki prevráčali po vseh kotih in shrambah na Ižanskem.

V gozdovih turjaške graščine je ukal divji lovec in besedo je imela njegova puška in past.

Grof se je vrnil na Turjak, ko so birci na Ižanskem dovršili svoje delo in so najprednejši Ižanski puntarji sedeli v ljubljanskih ječah za trdnimi zapahi.

Na Ižanskem je bil tedaj gluh mir. Gostilničarji so sami posedali pri mizah, ni bilo prešernega petja in govorjenja. O marijah so bila že vsa vrata zapahnjena in iz hiš se je slišala samo molitev. Goreča molitev se je dvigala proti nebesom, da bi se Bog usmili nesrečnih očetov in sinov.

Na Turjaku pa je poslušal grof poročila nadoskrbnika in pisarjev. Brez posebnega zanimanja je poslušal kaj so ukreplili na Ižanskem, kdo so zbirali razneseno imetje, kakšna škoda je po gozdovih. Toda, ker mu nihče ni omenil divjačine v gozdih, je nestren poskušil in vprašal:

"Kaj že z našo divjačno?"

Povedali so mu, da gospodari med njo divji lovec.

Tedaj pa je dostenjanstveni cesarjev komornik očet uslužence kakor zanikne hlapce, njevolja in togota se mu je poznala v vseh kretanjih in v vseh besedah in ukazal je:

"V gozdove! Za tatincl! Postrati ih!"

Tako se je glasilo grofovovo povelje, in lovci in logarji so poslili vse drugo delo, potisnili v stran druge skrbi in obšla jih je samo ena velika skrb: iztrebljenje divjih lovcov.

In logarji in loveci so se vratali s svojimi družinami v zapuščene loveske hiše in vsi graščinski uslužbeni, ki so znali rabiti puško in nož, in drugi graščini vdani ljudje so moraliti na pomoč lovecem in logarjem.

Samo logar s Preseke in pa lovec, ki je bival v loveski hiši sredi gozdov v dolini med Malinjakom in Mokrcem, nista imela strehe in so ju morali deti drugam. Tako je prišel logar Menat v lograsko hišo v Krvavi peči, ki je prostorna in bližu velikih lovišč, ki so bila nekdaj najizdatnejša in zato sedaj najbolj obiskovana od divjih lovcov.

Po teh pripravah se je začelo naskakovanje divjih lovcov. Graščinski lovci so napeli oči in ušeja in so z nabitimi risanicami in nabrušenimi noži udri v gozdove. Boj kajpada ni bil lahak. Vse ozemlje, ki meji na graščinsko, je bilo taborišče divjih lovev, kjer je bil sleherni človek sovražnik graščine in pomagač divjih lovcov. 


