WASHINGTON, D.C. — Po uradnih podatkih je Social Security izplačalo letos preko 16 milijonov upokojencev in preživelim vdovam in sirotom skupno 18.3 bilijone dolarjev, 2.1 bilijona več kot lani.

Vzrok povečanju izplačil je med po glavnim strankim blagajnikom generalom Clayem uredil finančno vprašanje, kajti stranka se ne sme spustiti v vojni boj brez polnih blagajn.

### Priprave za premirje podobne podobi iz sanj?

CLEVELAND, O. — Ta mesec se množijo posredniki za premirje v Vietnamu kot gobe po dežju. Kdor ima kaj zvez s komunisti ali jih je imel, misli, da je njegova naloga, da posreduje med Ameriko in Severnim Vietnamom za premirje. Nihče se ne da oplašiti z nespremenjenim stališčem vietnamske vlade: Amerika mora kapitulirati! Ta teden je celo predsednik Johnson spustil svoje zaupnike v teme za posredovanje. Časopis je seveda začelo govoriti o "mirovni ofenzivi", pri tem pa spregledalo, da so vietnamski partizani začeli znova z lepim številom lokalnih ofenziv proti našim in sajgonskim četam. Nasu zanimajo samo koraki, ki jih je napravil predsednik Johnson.

Ze sredi decembra je prišla iz Bele hiše novica, da bo predsednik "poskusil prav kmalu še enkrat", da sproži pogajanja za premirje. Če ne bo iz te moke kruha, bo pa v januarju povedal Ameriki in vsemu svetu, kaj namerava napraviti v vietnamskem vojskovjanju. Novici ni nihče uradno oporekal, je torej nekaj resnice na njej.

Ta teden smo dočakali prve Johnsonove korake, ki naj bi bili uradnih posrednikov je pa malo, ker so le redki pri kitajskih in vietnamskih tovariših dobro

### AMERIKA DELA ZA MIR

Predsednikov tiskovni tajnik Moyers je včeraj priznal, da se ameriški diplomati v Rimu, Parizu, Belgradu, Moskvi in drugod prizadevajo, da bi se spor v Vietnamu reševal rajše za konferenčno mizo kot na bojišču. Med tem se boji v Vietnamu nadaljujejo, le letalski napadi na Severni Vietnam so še vedno ustavljeni.

AUSTIN, Tex. — Po več dneh popolnega molka je včeraj Bela hiša priznala, da se diplomati Združenih držav prizadevajo vsepo sod, da bi prišlo v Vietnamu do premirja in bi se spor reševal za konferenčno mizo, namesto na bojiščih. Predsednikov tiskovni tajnik Moyers je razkril poleg drugih že znanih stikov še obisk predsedničkega posebnega svetovalca za narodno varnost Bundyja pri predsedniku kanadske vlade L. Pearsonu. Včeraj se je s tem predsednik Johnson še osebno razgovarjal po telefonu. Kanada je skupaj z Indijo in Poljsko član nadzorne komisije za l. 1954. v Ženevi sklenjeno premirje v Indokini.

Predsednikov poseben poslanik A. Harriman je priatel včeraj v Belgrad in je danes odletel na Brione na osbenem razgovor s Titom. Napovedujejo, da bo iz Belgrada še se tudi v Budimpešto in nato v Indijo, ki je predsednik komisije za nadziranje premirja v Indokini, sklenejeno leta 1954 v Švicarski Ženevi. Ostala člana komisije sta Poljska in Kanada. V Varšavi se je Harriman razgovarjal z glavnim tajnikom partije Gomulko; kar naj bi bilo nekaj nenevadnega.

Poslanik A. Goldberg se je po razgovoru s papežem sestal še z vodniki italijanske vlade, nato pa je odletel v Pariz, kjer bo danes sprejet pri predsedniku De Gaulu in pri zunanjem ministru Malrauxu.

Ameriški poslanik Kohler se je v Moskvi razgovarjal poleg s predsednikom Sovjetske zveze N. Pokornym tudi z zunanjim ministrom Gromikom in z njegovim namestnikom Kuznetzovom.

Trdijo, da ima predsednik Johnson na sprednu še nove korake, ki naj bi priveldi do premirja, vendar ne upa na to veliko nihče ne tu ne v Washingtonu. Peiping je v vseh svojih izjavah in javnih korakih za nadaljevanje vojne do "končne zmage", Moskva bi sicer nemara

zapisani. So to v glavnem tisti, ki so sprti z Moskvo ali se ji vsaj ne pokorijo. To so Poljska, Madžarska in Romunija. Diplomatom teh dežel so vsaj tupačatam odprtva v diplomatskih dvoranah v vzhodni Aziji. Rapacky ima torej dosti interesa, da posreduje, saj Amerika lahko veliko pomaga njegovim domovinam. Tudi Madžarska in Romunija se ne bosta branili tega posla prav iz podobnih razlogov. Seveda pa njihovo posredovanje še ne pomeni nobene mirovne ofenzive; je kvečjemu tipanje, ki naj svetuje, s katere strani zadejni na pravo komunistično žlico.

Cisto drugo ozadje ima pot nasega delegata pri ZN Goldberga v Rim k papežu. Te dni so časopisi prinesli malo opaženo novico, da je apostolski delegat v Washingtonu poslal neko zaupno poročilo v državno tajništvo, kjer so ga tam nekam zamečkali. Delegat je baje moral na svoje poročilo ponovno opozoriti prizadete ameriške diplomacije ne more priti. Pri tem se na vatikansko diplomacijo in njeno molčečnost lahko vsakdo zaneše. Tam ne more priti do slučaja "Fanfani". Vsega tega pa ameriška zunanjna politika ne more izrabiti, ker je dežela brez uradnih diplomatskih stikov z Vatikanom. Ko se Johnson enkrat osvobodi vietnamske krize, bo napravil deželi veliko uslugo, ako bi to anomalijo čim preje zbrisal iz ameriške politike.

Seveda ne moremo pričakovati kaj prida od sedanja Goldbergev poti. Bo samo popravila, kar je bilo že zagrešeno. Pa tudi brez ozira na trenuten neuspeh to je dobro delo.

### Nova ameriška brigada je prilepela v Vietnam

PLEIKU, J. Viet. — V sredo in včeraj je bila sem z letali prepeljana ena od treh brigad 25. armadne divizije s Havajev. Ta divizija je posebej izvezbana za boj v džungli. Nova brigada bo zavzela položaje na O-srednjem višavju v neposrednem sosedstvu 1. konjeniške divizije, ki je bila v preteklem in v začetku tega meseca zapletena v krvave boje z rdečimi v dolini Ia Drang in v podnožju tamkajšnjih gora.

Preko omenjega ozemlja prehajajo iz Laos in Kambodže v Južni Vietnam enote redne armade Severnega Vietnamu po takozvanih Ho-Ci-Minhovih cestah. Te so bile še do pred nekaj tednov "steze", sedaj so že kar ob vsakem vremenu uporabne ceste.

Nova brigada bo pomagala 1. konjeniški diviziji zapreti te prehode in nadzirati osrednje višavje, kjer so upali rdeči v preteklih mesecih prevladati in tam vzpostaviti glavno mesto za rdečo vlado Južnega Vietnam. Porazi, ki so jih jim zadale enote 1. ameriške konjeniške divizije, so te načrte preprečili.

### Jugoslovanski proračun za l. 1966: 867.7 bilijonov dinarjev

BELGRAD, SFRJ. — Zvezna skupščina je potrdila proračun za leto 1966 v višini 867.7 bilijonov dinarjev, kar znaša po uradnem tečaju 694.1 milijon dolarjev. Polovico vseh dohodkov je določenih za oborožene sile.

Ce pomiclamo, da ima Jugoslavija okoli 20 milijonov prebivalcev, torej dobro desetino prebivalstva Združenih držav, in primerjamamo njen z 10 pomnoženi proračun z onim zvezne vlade ZDA, potem dobimo približno sliko o gospodarskih razmerah Titove Jugoslavije do Amerike.

Ce bi vladale v ZDA razmere, kot so v Jugoslaviji, bi njen zvezni proračun znašal le 6.9 bilijonov dolarjev, dejansko pa bo v letošnjem letu presegel 100 bilijonov. Edino, kar je enako v obrežnih proračunih, je izdatek za oborožene sile, ki obsegajo v obrežek polovico vseh izdatkov,



Tebbetts Says He'll  
Shelve Juggler Role

Birdie Tebbetts, who used 93 different batting orders in leading the Indians to a fifth-place finish in 1965, promises better things (at least where the official scorer is concerned) next season.

During a recent visit to the Wigwam (primarily to help the Heart Association promote its annual fund-raising program), the Tribe manager indicated he wouldn't do as much juggling in 1966, all the while painting an optimistic picture of the Cleveland varsity.

"I think we are going into next season with fewer unanswered questions than in any of the previous years," Birdie commented. 

## Peace Corps To Test On January 8

Cleveland area residents interested in putting their skills to use in developing nations around the world are invited to take the Peace Corps placement test at 9 a.m. on Saturday, January 8 at 4240 Main Post Office Bidg., W. 3rd and Prospect Avenue.

The Peace Corps uses the placement test to determine how an applicant can best be utilized overseas. The test measures general aptitude and the ability to learn a language, not education or achievement. (If test scores indicated a limited language-learning ability, for example, the Peace Corps tries to place the applicant in an English-speaking country.) The placement test requires no preparation and is non-competitive — an applicant can neither pass nor fail.

The application form, not the placement test, is the most important factor in the selection of volunteers. Persons interested in serving in the Peace Corps must fill out an application, if they have not already done so, and present it to the tester before taking the test. Applications may be obtained from local post offices or from the Peace Corps, Washington, D.C. 20252.

The placement test takes about an hour and a half. An optional achievement test for applicants who have studied French or Spanish requires another hour.



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## Home Is Where The Heart Is




THE CURIOUS CHILD — Youngsters of all ages have a streak of curiosity that leads them into accident situations. If you're a crawler or clamberer in the house, see that knives and sharp pointed objects are kept in a locked drawer or an out-of-reach spot.

New York, N.Y. (ED) — How often have you greeted a member of the family with the words, "I'm so glad you're home safe and sound!"? What a shock it is to discover, then, that home isn't the cozy little haven we sometimes think it is. Of the 45,000,000 injuries estimated to occur annually in America, about 20,000,000 happen in or around the home.

Accident hazards lurk in every area — a child's toy left on the staircase... forgotten objects blocking a dark hallway... overtaxed wiring in the kitchen... unlabeled bottles in the medicine cabinet... cluttered storage closets... oily cleaning cloths strewn about the garage. At every turn there are potential dangers which can easily be corrected to make the safe and secure place it should be.

Jean Kinkead, Women's Consultant for The Travelers Insurance Companies, points out at least two psychological factors which contribute to hazard-filled homes: one is simply that people often tend to "let down" in their own homes, to forget some of their responsibilities while another is that people become so accustomed to the way things are in their homes that they tend not to notice half-hidden dangers.



NOT FOR CHILDREN — The medicine cabinet is a fascinating area for the growing child. Children should not be deceived by having medicines called "candy." When left alone, they may locate the bottle and drink its contents. And since children are imitative, avoid taking medicine in their presence.

It is no wonder, therefore, that housewives and children are the victims of about three-fourths of all home accidents — they spend most of their time at home. Whether you live in an apartment or a private house, it is your responsibility to eliminate as many hazards as possible, for the safety of your families, your guests and yourselves. A periodic room-by-room check will help you decrease accidents in your home.

Miss Kinkead recommends the following safety tips to help eliminate accidents of the home variety.



THE MATCH GAME — To the child, the little pick-up-sticks are fun to play with. Remember, the youngster doesn't comprehend the difference between a match and an ordinary stick. It's your responsibility to keep matches in a safe place.

In the living room, resist the temptation to run long extension cords around the room or overload the circuits just to suit that new furniture re-arrangement. Temporary extension cords are a dangerous substitute for permanent wiring and the proper number of outlets. Dim lights, a shrunken TV picture, blown fuses are indications that an electrician is needed. Another point to remember is that you can damage the insulation in electrical cords and risk a serious fire if you string them over radiators, under rugs, or through doors, tack them to walls, or hang them over nails or pipes. Check for and replace all cords that have become worn or frayed.

Because the kitchen is an area where people handle hot or heavy or sharp materials, often in a hurry, Jean reminds the culinary "expert" to mop up spills as soon as they occur, to lessen the chance of a fall. It is equally important to make certain that all flammable materials — curtains, towels, cookbooks, cooking oils, apron corners, etc. — are kept well away from open burners. Keep plenty of potholders handy, so you won't be tempted to substitute something else not suited to their purpose. Also, in the kitchen and elsewhere, cleaning fluids, bleaches, lye and other poisonous substances should definitely be kept out of the reach of children. The same is true of sharp knives, matches and other dangerous objects.

Travelers recommends another wise safety practice for those who use gas burners — light the match before you turn on the gas, and check the burners after use to be sure they are all off. Make it a practice to see that all burners are off when not in use, whether you use gas or electrical appliances for cooking.

An overloaded medicine cabinet is a major hazard in the bathroom. Throw out what you don't need, be sure the medicines you keep are labeled correctly. Another potential danger area is the tub or shower. Suction type bath mats, non-skid strips, wall mounted grab bars or hand rails can help reduce the chance of a serious fall. Don't rely on grabbing the shower curtain if you should slip — instead, take effective safety precautions in advance. Along this line, Jean recalls The Travelers Insurance Companies' case history of a young man who was taking a bath while his mother was entertaining friends at a garden party in their yard. The unfortunate fellow slipped in the tub, fell through the window, and landed — wouldn't you know it — right in the middle of the party!

Another important safety precaution is to keep electrical appliances where they cannot be reached from the sink, bathtub or shower. So if you enjoy the combination of a relaxing bath and soft music, please keep the radio in a room other than the bathroom, and turn up the volume. Electricity and water mix too well!

How well is your bedroom arranged for safety? Can you reach a light switch without getting out of bed? Do you make certain that all upper story windows are well secured or screened so that small children cannot open them? Do insist that no member of your family smokes in bed — smoking in bed is one of the chief causes of fires in the home.

In the basement, all electrical equipment — and especially power tools — should be properly grounded. Highly volatile liquids should be stored outdoors and oily rags discarded. Sharp tools, nails, screws etc. should have a place of their own on shelves or in a tool box or cabinet. Cellar stairs and work areas should be well lighted and free of clutter; and any loose steps or railings should be repaired immediately.

Making home a safer place for your children, your visitors and yourselves need not be a difficult task if only each member of the family will take the time and make the effort to be a little more safety-conscious. Safety is the responsibility of every homeowner — and it begins with you.
