

Dvolična klijajska zunanja politika

Mao hoče povsod le revolucijo — Ču-en-lai pa se otevra na osamljenosti.

HONG KONG. — Še lani je imela rdeča Kitajska 49 poslanstev po vsem svetu. Povsod je gospodaril v njih redni peipiški poslanik. Maova kulturna revolucija je to diplomatsko mrežo čisto raztrgala. Odpoklicala je nameč skoraj vse poslanike, le širje še sedijo v tujini na svojih službenih mestih. Nekaj poslanstev je sploh zaprtih, v drugih pa vodijo pisarniške posle nizji diplomati, ki pa nimajo z diplomatsko politiko nobenega posla. Maova struja pa še ni tem zadovoljna, skuša navzočnost tujih diplomatov v Pepingu izkoristiti kot priliko za divjaške napade na tuja poslanstva in njihove urade in uradnike. To je že navadna norija, ki je svet ne more razumeti, pa je ne obsoja preveč.

Zato skrbi ministrski predsednik Ču-en-lai, ki mu pri tem pomaga kolikor more zunanj minister Chen-ji. Oba se trudita, da določita zasebne stike s tujimi diplomatimi.

Kolikor dovoljujejo razmere, se pokaže celo javno v družbi tujcev. Zato se je Ču-en-lai posrečilo, da je zaprav že marsikatero luknjo, ki jo je napravila v diplomatskih odnosih zaletela politika Maove skupine.

Tako se je Čuenlaju posrečilo, da je njegova dežela ostala v zmosnih stikih s kambožanskim princem Sihanukom, s ceylonsko vlado, z japonsko diplomacijo. Ni pa imel sreče v Burmi in v Zunaju Mongoliji.

Največ preglavje dela Ču-en-laju Maovo stališče, da le socialna revolucija nekaj velja in da mirno sožitje ni nič vredno. Lahko služi samo za pretezo, ki naj pokriva podtalno agresivnost. Težave ima Ču-en-laj tudi z Maovo idejo, da morajo kitajske manjšine po svetu za vsako ceno širiti ideje kulturne revolucije, s čemur se naravno nobena, tudi komunistična, vlada ne more strinjati.

Tuji diplomatski svet ve za vse te težave peipiškega ministarskega predsednika in jih vpoštova. Zato je Čuenlai dosegel velikokrat s svojim molkom več kot Mao in njegova oklica s svojim razgrajanjem v besedah in dejanjih.

Predsednik republike Chile prodrl v parlamentu

SANTIAGO, Chile. — Parlament čilske republike je po živahnih debati izglasoval načrt zakona o prisilnem fonda za obnovno. Predsednikov predlog je moral pretrpeti več sprememb, a končno je bil vendarje odobren. S tem je odpadla trenutna nevarnost krize v krščansko-demokratičnem režimu sedanjega predsednika Edwarda Montalva Frei.

NATO išče svoj političen program

BRUXELLES, Belg. — Ko v NATO organizaciji uvideli, da se s Francijo ne bodo mogli sporazumeti v nobenem važnem vprašanju, se NATO zunanji ministri sklenili že lanskega decembra, da je treba premisljevati, kako bi NATO dobila tudi politični program kot dodatek k obrambnemu. Kot je znano, se Francija upira obema programoma, sabotira delo na njih in se izmika vsaki obvezni na tem področju.

Na podlagi ministrskega sklepa v lanskem decembру je administracija NATO naprosila strokovnjake, naj izdelajo 4 načrte, kakšno obliko najima NATO za politično delo. Pri tem sta sodelovala ameriški diplomat Kohler in bivši belgijski zunanji minister Spaak. Delegatje vseh NATO članic so se pa zbrali ta teden v glavnem stanu in skupaj prereščali vse nabranje gradivo. Dosegli so sporazum v presoji in naročili glavnemu tajniku NATO Brosiju, naj skupaj z administracijo izdelava na podlagi gradiva načrt za NATO politiko. Delegatje se bodo ponovno zbrali na sejo koncem novembra ali začetkom decembra, da odobrijo Brosijev načrt. Ta načrt bo pa služil za podlago debati, ki jo bodo imeli NATO zunanj ministerji 12. in 13. decembra na svoji redni seji.

Bistvo načrta bo obsegalo način, kako naj tudi NATO prispeva k mirnemu sožitju med komunističnim in svobodnim svetom. Francija bo temu najbrže načelno ugovarjala, ker general De Gaulle misli, da NATO ni ustvarjena za ta posej, ki se da veliko učinkovitejše obravnavati v bilateralnih pogajanjih med posameznimi velikimi silami.

Zato je malo upanja, da bi Francija pristala na NATO načrt. Morda ga bo celo poskušala torpedirati z zavlačevanjem.

OBSOJENCEV V SAIGONU NE BODO USTRELILI

SAIGON, J. Vistnam — Trije komunistični teristi so bili od vojaškega sodišča obsojeni na smrt s strelnjanjem, ker so izvršili vrsto umorov in roparskih napadov. Predsednik vietnamske vlade je izvršitev sodbe ustavil.

U.S. obdrži otok Okinawa

Po zaključku razgovorov med predsednikom Johnsonom in predsednikom japonske vlade so izdali uradni komunikate, ki pravijo, da sta se državnika sporazumela o vseh vprašanjih, ki so bila v razpravi. Otok Okinawa z vsemi napravami ostane še dalje za nedoločen čas v upravi Ameriških Združenih Držav. Istotako ostanejo v ameriški upravi otoči Ryukyu med Okinawo in japonsko obalo, Japonska pa prevzame otoke Bonin in Iwo Jima. Japonski predsednik je tudi dodal, da bo Japonska brez pridržka podpirala ameriško obrambo svobode in neodvisnosti južnega Vietnam.

Vojska med vasmi na Cipru

NICOSIA, Ciper. — Med prebivalci vasi Kopinou, ki je čisto turško naselje, in vasi Ayios Theodhoros, ki je mešano turško-grška, je nastala prava vojska, 40 milij južno od glavnega mesta je 8 ur trajalo strelenje s puškami, ročnimi granatami, bazukami in celo z enim topom. Grki so po osmih urah bili v premoci in prodri v turško naselje. Zastopniki Združenih Narodov niso mogli preprečiti napada, pa posredujejo ustavitev bojevanja. Ambasadorji Turčije, Grčije in Cipra so o incidentu poročali generalnemu tajniku Združenih Narodov in skupno posredovali v priporočili upostavitev miru.

Turčija grozi, da bo njena vojska nastopila na Cipru

NICOSIA, Ciper. — Turčija je alarmirala svoje vojne sile in grozi, da jih bo poslala na Ciper, da zaščitijo tamkajšnje turško prebivalstvo pred grškimi napadalci. Ciperska vlada metropolita Macariosa pa trdi, da so napadli Turki grške vasi in začeli zadnje strelenje. Vlada na Cipru tudi trdi, da ni razloga za kakršnokoli posredovanje Turkov. ker so že zastopniki Združenih Narodov tam in so uspešno posredovali.

Ali Nemčiji res grozi obnovljeno nacistično gibanje?

BONN, Nemčija. — Nemška na rodno-demokratska stranka je mela svoj letni kongres, ki je bil za stranko usodnega pomena. V stranki so namreč že davno izbruhnili veliki prepriki, ki so vodili naravnost v razpad stranke. To ni samo po sebi za nemško politiko nič novega. Po vojni so konzervativne in nacionalistične struje osnovale že nekaj "demokratskih" strank, ki so pa vse kmalu zamrle, čeprav so nekajkrat ob rojstvu doble kar veliko prispevali v simpatizerjev. Nemška javnost je mislila, da bo ista usoda zadeila tudi narodno-demokratsko stranko. Do tega zaključka je prišla pod vtisom razpadanja stranke svobodnih demokratov, ki ima v parlamentu okoli 50 poslancev in je bila dolga leta v koaliciji s krščansko demokratsko stranko v vladi. Pa se je prevzela, zahtevala je od zadnje vlade dr. Erharda preveč koncesij in s tem pokopalne ne samo politiko dr. Erharda, ampak tudi sebe.

Kakor hitro je namreč moral v opozicijo, so se v njene vrstah začeli prepriki, ki so občutno zmanjšali njen že itak ne ravno velik političen vpliv. Zato večina političnih opozovalcev misli, da je stranka obsojena na propadanje. Kam bodo v tem slučaju šli njeni pristaši, s tem si belijo glave nemški politiki.

Tu pa je stopila pred javnost na rodno-demokratska stranka, ki je po svojem političnem programu zelo blizu Hitlerjevim idejam. Pri nekaterih deželnih volitvah je dosegla kar lepo število glasov in mandatov, zato so mnogi politiki videli v njej naslednico svobodnih demokratov. Med tem so pa nastali v strankinem vodstvu spori, ki so spravili v nevarnost sam obstoj tranke. Sedanji novi voditelj stranke von Thadden je pa na kongresu vse svoje tekme polemal iz stranke in ostal sam kot gospodar položaja.

To je tisto, kar je važno za nemško politiko. Sedaj bo namreč od von Thaddena odveljaviti in postati

odvisno, ali se bo stranka uveljavila kot voditeljica vseh nemških nacionalistov, levih in desnih, na prednih in konservativnih. Dve okoliščini govorita za to.

Nemški nacionalisti so strašno razbiti. To vedo in to jih boli. Zato se vodstvu von Thaddena ne bodo upirali, ako ne bo zahteval od njih prevelikih političnih žrtv.

Vsaka svobodna demokracija rabi vedno ne samo vladno večino, ki vodi narod in državo, ampak tudi edgovorno opozicijo, ki pomenu alternativo pri spremembni režimi. Nemčija je pa danes brez prave parlamentarne opozicije. Obe glavni stranki, krščansko-demokratična in socijalistična, sta v koaliciji vlad, stranka svobodnih demokratov je pa v primeri z njima neznanata in ji nihče ne prorusuje bodočnosti. Zato ni čisto izključeno, da se von Thaddena stranka ne bi mogla uveljaviti in postati

naslednica stranke svobodnih demokratov. Nekateri politiki se bojijo, da bi morebitna nemška gospodarska kriza mogla magnati nemškega volivca, da obesi svoje politično pričakovanje na von Thaddena stranko. Mislijo, da bo enajstih določenih se bosta poročila v cerkvih. 



The President's All America Team

Washington, D.C. — Probably every child at one time or another dreams of "making the team." Unfortunately, fewer do with each passing year. In a typical modern high school with an enrollment of 2,000, approximately 300 students—all of them boys — will be represented on 10 or 12 varsity athletic teams.

The rest — the girls, the boys who are too small, or those who have to work after school and can't practice — miss out on this experience.

A little over a year ago President Johnson took steps to correct this situation by establishing the Presidential Physical Fitness Awards program. The boys and girls who earn the award are referred to as members of "The President's All America Team," and 50,000 of them already have made it.

The wonderful thing about this team is that it's open to all students, ages 10-17. It presently has more girls than boys and more 13-year-olds than high school juniors or seniors. One little girl who made it has only one arm.

All a student has to do to make The President's All America Team is demonstrate that he's more physically fit than most members of what has been called "the Marshmallow Gene-

ration." He competes against the scores others his own age have made on the Youth Fitness Test, which measures strength, speed, agility and flexibility. No special skills are required.

The colorful emblem the winners receive certainly packs as much prestige as any varsity letter, and the Certificate of Achievement, which bears the Presidential seal and signature, is something any youngster would treasure.

Some schools haven't given their students an opportunity to make The President's All America Team because they feel the testing takes too much time. The 50,000 winners to date represent only five percent of the nation's schools, and more than one-third of them are from three States — California, Florida and Texas.

Actually, testing should be a part of every school physical education program, even if there were no awards program. It's the only way the teacher can determine the needs of the physically underdeveloped, assess program strengths and weaknesses or measure and motivate pupil progress.

Let's make sure every area is represented on The President's All America Team this year. This is one team that's a sure winner.

HOW TO CHOOSE THE RIGHT CASTLE

New York, N.Y. (ED) — If your home home is to be your castle, know how to choose the right one. Anyone can make a mistake when buying a house but the trick is to be sure the error is small. Careful studies have been made on determining the most common pitfalls into which the average American home buyer falls. So whether you're buying or building, the following tips will help you make the right move.

Can you afford it? You'll probably have to keep up monthly mortgage payments but these should not be excessive. Here's an easy way to figure out approximately what amount you can afford without straining your finances. From your annual salary subtract \$600 for yourself and for each of your dependents. Then, calculate 20% of the remainder. This is your approximate Federal income tax. Subtract this tax from your annual salary and divide what's left by 51. This figure is your approximate net weekly income. Your monthly payment — including principal and interest on the mortgage, taxes and fire and hazard insurance — should not exceed this net weekly income.

Pick the proper location: Once you've gotten your finances straightened, choosing the proper location is the next important step. Ask yourself these questions about the area: Is it near shops and schools, churches, fire and police departments, and health services? Is it close to your friends and near your job? Are there good roads nearby and is your location close to various forms of public transportation? Yet, don't forget that heavy traffic close at hand can be a liability for undisturbed sleep at night or if you have children. One of the best ways to find out about your potential neighborhood is to talk to some of the neighbors and find out what they think of the area — whether it's safe, well-kept and quiet.

Is the space adequate and well-planned? Your checklist for current functional needs should include space for eating, cooking, bathing, sleeping, cleaning, recreation, storing and garaging. Be especially sure to check the closets because a home without enough storage space for the whole family is no bargain at any price. If there's not enough space in the house for your probable future needs, don't buy it.

Get the best heating/cooling system. Your careful pre-buying inspection will be all for naught if, after you move into your house you are shivering in the winter and broiling in the summer. Insist on getting the best heating and cooling system for comfortable living. You should know all the facts before you choose which one is best for you. If your choice is between gas and electric heat, for example, gas is much less expensive than electric heat in most parts of the country. Electric heat will also require expensive additional insulation, unlike gas systems. Gas heating is one heating system that takes to cooling adaptation quite easily because the ducts used to conduct the heat can also be used for air conditioning purposes. Electric heating, however, which uses baseboard or ceiling coils as its means of conductivity cannot be switched over to an air conditioning system.
