## Sukarno je omahoval

V boju za oblast v Indoneziji, ki so ga sprožili preteklci četrtek levičarji, se predsednik Sukarno v prvem trenutku ni odločil na nobeno stran.

KUALA LUMPUR, Malez. — Ko je pretekl četrtek, "30. septembra", začel polkovnik Untung predsednikove osebne straže s tremi bataljoni te straže poskus prevzeti oblast in deželi in pomesti s protikomunističnimi generali, predsednik Sukarno ni nastopil proti temu. Tudi se menda ni uprl, ko so Untungovi ljude na letalskem oporišču nedaleč od glavnega mesta prijeti protikomunistične generale neusmiljeno pomorili in zakopal.

Obrambnemu ministru gen. Nasuntionu in večini njegovih sodelavcev se je posrečilo rešiti pred Untungovimi ljudmi in priti do vojaških enot, ki so jim ostale zveste. Postavili so se na čelo teh enot in nastopili proti Untungu in njega podpirajočim oddelkom. Dva bataljona predsednikove straže sta predala brez ostrejšega boja, tretji, ki je bil pod osebnim poveljstvom polk. Untunga, pa se je boril odločno. Vladne čete pod poveljstvom gen. Suharta so kramali v petek bile že gospodar glavnega mesta Džakarte. Polk. Untung je z mestnega letališča pogbenil v notranjost otoka Jave, kjer je polk Suharman še vedno držal položaj trdno v rokah, da bi od tam začel nov pohod na glavno mesto.

Generali so "rešili" Sukarna iz rok polkovnika Untunga, nkar se je ta umaknil v svoje letno bivališče v Bagor, kakih 40 milj od Džakarte. Tam je v torek sklical vladno sejo, katere so se udeležili tudi vodniki oboroženih sil in poveljnik državne policije. Kaj je bilo na seji sklenjeno, ni bilo objavljeno, je pa očitno, da je hotel Sukarno dočeli pomiritev med obema sovražnima taboroma, med komunisti in njihovimi levičarskimi podporniki ter med protikomunističnimi generali, nacionalističnimi in verskimi skupinami, ki zavračajo komunizem.

Vladne čete pod poveljstvom generalov so strelje odpri v glavnem mestu, trdijo pa, da se jim še vedno uspešno upira del levičarskega vojaštva s podporo oboroženih mladih komunistov sredi otoka Jave. Tam naj bi bil del divizije Diponegoro pod poveljstvom polk. Suhermana, ki se je od začetka izjavil za polk. Untunga. Mesto Jogjakarta, kjer je bil glavni stan polk. Suhermana, naj bi bilo trikrat menjalo svojega gospodarja. Poveljni te divizije gen. Surjo se je izjavil za armadno vodstvo in obsojal polk. Untunga.

Polk Untung in njegovi so poleg prijetih protikomunističnih generalov pomorili še veliko število drugih protikomunistov in članov njihovih družin. Doselej naj bi bilo odkritih vsaj 72 razsekanih trupel teh žrtv.

## Francozi naklonjeneji Združenim narodom

Zunanji minister je po povratku z zasedanja v New Yorku poročal vladi, da se ZN resno trudijo, da bi spravili v red svoje finan-

ce. PARIZ, Fr. — Francija v zadnjih letih ni kazala nobenega spoštovanja do Združenih narodov, ponovno se je ob nje hudo obregnala in zavračala odločno plačilo prispevka, ki ga je glavna skupščina odredila za njo kot njen delež stroškov za poseg ZN na Srednji vzhod in v Kongo. Francozi so bili nejevoljni na Združene narode še iz časa alžirske vojne, ko so se ti ponovno obregnili ob Francijo, ki ni marala dati Alžiriji neodvisnosti.

Letos je že od začetka zasedanja izgledalo, da je francoska vlada svoj odnos do Združenih narodov spremeni. Na odprtje zasedanja glavne skupščine je prišel sam zunanj minister Maurice Couve de Murville, kar se nekaj let ni zgodilo. Njegov govor je bil dosti umirjen in na splošno ugodno sprejet, čeprav Francozi ni nič omenil o kakem francoškem prispevku v blagajno ZN in je zvrnil vsako vojaško akcijo ZN, pa tudi vseke posekancije.

Pretekli torek se je Murville vrnil domov in je naslednji dan na seji vlade pohvalil Združene narode, ki da so se odločili spraviti v red svoje finance in izdelati proračun s kritjem rednih izdatkov z rednimi prispevkami držav-članic.

## Papež Pavel VI. Združenim narodom

Govor sv. očeta Pavla VI. pred glavno skupščino ZN  
v ponedeljek, 4. oktobra 1965.

## II.

Potem ko je omenil papež besede pokojnega Kennedyja "Cloveštvo mora napraviti konec vojni ali pa bo vojna končala cloveštvo", je dejal, da ni potreba veliko besedi v podporo temu pozivu, cilj Združenih narodov naj bi bila združitev v cilju in s pristavo "Ne več vojne, nikdar več vojne! Mir, mir mora voditi usodo ljudstev in vsega cloveštva!" Zahvalil se je ZN za vse, kar so skozi 20 let storili za mir, dal jih priznanje za preprečevanje sporov ali njih končanje, posebno za zadevne napore v zadnjem času, čeprav se ti še niso izkazali za odločilne.

Sv. oče je dejal, da so Združeni narodi šola cloveštva k miru. Vsakdo v njih je istočasno učenec in učitelj v umetnosti graditve miru. Mir po besedah papeža ne sloni samo na političnih sredstvih, na ravnotežju sil in koristi, zgrajen je v mišljenju, z idejami, ki delajo za mir. Združeni narodi so v svojih naporih za mir šele na začetku in vprašanje je, če bo cloveštvo kdaj uspelo spremeniti svoje sebično in bojevito mišljenje, s katerim je prepletene cloveške zgodovina, in našlo pot v mirno, res clovečansko bodočnost, ki jo je Bog obljubil ljudem dobre volje. Mi moramo na to pot, je dejal papež, ta je dobro zaznamovana in prvo znamenje na tej je razorožitev.

"Ce želite biti bratje, izpustite orožje iz svojih rok. Nihče ne more ljubiti z napadnim orožjem v rokah," je dejal sv. oče in nato opozoril na strah pred strašnim orožjem, ki ga je ustvarila moderna znanost. Obrambno orožje je po njegovem potrebno, dokler je človek tako slab, spremnljiv in celo hudoben, toda ZN proučujejo pota za jamstvo v mednarodnem življenju brez uporabe orožja. To je najpomenitejši cilj, to ljudstva od njih pričakujejo, to mora biti doseženo!

"Naj soglasno zaupanje v to ustanovo raste, naj se njegova oblast poveča in ta cilj, mi verjamemo, bo zagotovljen," je dejal sv. oče.

Vsa ljudstvo bodo hvaležna, kadar bo to doseženo, rešena bodo velikanski stroški, pa tudi strahu pred vojno. Papež je izrazil upanje, da bo del denarja, ki bi bil na ta način prihranjen, dan v pomoč razvoju in napredku z ostalih držav.

Združeni narodi ne delajo samo za preprečevanje spopadov med državami, ampak jih tudi navajajo k sodelovanju, delajo za bratstvo med narodi. Sv. oče je ZN pohvalil za proglasitev osnovnih clovečanskih pravic, dolžnosti človeka, časti in svobode cloveške osebnosti, predvsem pa verske svobode.

Združeni narodi imajo opravka predvsem s cloveškim življenjem, življenje je sveto in nihče se mu ne sme drzniti škodovati. Spoštovanje življenja, tudi z ozirom na velik problem rojstev, mora najti tu, v vaši zbornici, svojo najvišjo potrditev in najmočnejšo obrambo," je izjavil papež Pavel VI. in nato poučil, da morajo ZN stremeti k pomnožitvi kruha in ne gledati, da bodo z umetnim nadzrom nad rojstvi zmanjšali število gostov "na banketu življenja".

Dodal je, da ni dovolj nasiliti lačne, treba je tudi vsakemu človeku zagotoviti njegovi časti primerno življenje. Priznal je, da Združeni narodi in njihove ustanove v tem pogledu že nekaj delajo, omenil je njihov boj proti nepisemnost, proti boleznim, za razširitev znanosti in tehničnega napredka, povedal, da namerava tudi sam razsiriti delo katoliških dobrodelnih ustanov v boju proti laktoti in v zavdovljevanju svetovnih potreb. To je edini način graditve miru.

Sv. oče je nato prešel na duhovno stran češ, da stava ZN ne stoji samo na materialnem, na zemeljskem temelju, ker v tem slučaju bi bila hiša zgrajena na pesku, — predvsem je zgrajena na naših lastnih vesteh. Prišla je ura našega "spreobrnjenja", našega prerojenja, naše notranje obnove. Naučiti se moramo misliti na nov način, gledati tudi na clovekovo življenje na nov način, udarila je ura, ko moramo za trenutek obstati in premisliti znova o našem izvoru, o naši preteklosti, o naši skupni usodi.

Po teh besedah je papež poučil, da je današnji čas, ki ga označuje izreden cloveški napredok, prav posebno potreben poziva na cloveško moralno zavest, kajti resnična nevarnost ne prihaja od napredka in znanosti, ta sta dejansko sposobna rešiti veliko težkih problemov, ki nadležujejo cloveštvo, če sta le prav uporabljeni.

"Ne, stvarna nevarnost prihaja od človeka samega, ki razpolaga z vedno močnejšim orožjem. Tega lahko uporabi enako dobro za uničenje ali za vzvišena osvajanja. V eni besedi torej, zgradba moderne civilizacije mora biti postavljena na duhovna načela, ki jo ne bodo le vzdrževala, ampak jo tudi osvetljevala in ji dala dušo. Mi verujemo, ko veste, da morajo ta načela višje modrosti izhajati iz

vere v Boga, onega neznanega Boga, o katerem je sv. Pavel govoril Atenjanom v Areopagu; neznanega njim, ki pa ga iskali, ne da bi se zavedali, da ga iščejo, in on je bil blizu njih, kot se dogaja to tudi mnogim ljudem na naših časih. Nam v vsakem slučaju in vsem, ki so sprejeli neizrečeno razočeritev, ki ga je Kristus dal nam o Njem, je On živi Bog, oče vseh ljudi.

## Prošnja za cerkev sv. Antona v Brezovici

CLEVELAND, O. — Iz mesta Ljubljane proti Notranjskemu pelje še iz starih časov znamenita cesta, že tisti čas imenovana "rimská cesta". Ob tej cesti približno 9 km iz mesta je raztegnjena vas po imenu Brezovica. V tej vasi nekoliko vstran od ceste stoji velika cerkev, posvečena sv. Antonu. To cerkev obiskujejo še ljudje iz vasi: Vnanje Gorice, Log in Dragomer.

Prek nekaj dnevi je prispeala prošnja župljanih z željo, da bi bivši župljeni omogočili kupiti zvočne naprave za to cerkev.

Prav posebno bi prišel v poštev te naprave sedaj, ko so vsi liturgični obredi v slovenskem jeziku. Mnogi v Združenih državah Amerike in Kanade se dobro spominjate, kako je velika ta cerkev in da brez takih zvočnih naprav ni možno slišati komentatorja in lektorja pri liturgičnem opravlju.

**MEMORIAL HONORING THE LATE MARY MCLEOD BETHUNE**  
Last week the President signed a Joint Resolution which I co-sponsored with Senator Anderson of New Mexico to extend for two years the existing authority for the erection of a memorial in the District of Columbia to the late Mary McLeod Bethune. The National Council of Negro Women is the sponsoring organization and the memorial is to be built at no expense to the Federal Government. It is to be located in Lincoln Park — on East Capitol Street in Washington. The original authorizing legislation was signed by President Eisenhower in 1960 and called for the statue to be built within five years, but the project fell behind schedule mainly due to the uncertainty of highway locations in the Lincoln Park area. Now, however, the statue is nearly completed and all plans have been approved by the National Park Service except those for an architectural base which will be submitted in the near future. The statue by Robert Berks, a New York sculptor, will stand 12 feet high. Mrs. Bethune will be depicted handing a copy of her legacy to a Negro boy and a Negro girl. Around the stone base of the monument will be seven sentences from the legacy which Mrs. Bethune dictated to a magazine writer shortly before her death in May, 1955.

Often called the "First Lady" of her race, Mrs. Bethune rose from childhood in a cotton picker's shack in South Carolina to become one of the world's foremost educators. She gained national prominence

also as an advisor to Presidents and as the founder and first President of the National Council of Negro Women.

**CONSUMERS ALL, 1965 YEARBOOK OF AGRICULTURE.** How the U.S. Department of Agriculture's services are woven into the fabric of American life is reflected in *Consumers All*, the 1965 Yearbook of Agriculture which has just been published. Although a primary objective of the Department is service to farmers and ranchers this book points out that the consumer has a vital stake in agricultural productivity and abundance.

*Consumers All* is a one-volume how-to-do-it reference work for American households, covering almost everything that we buy, eat, wear, and do in our everyday lives. Its 496 pages include many illustrations, charts, and tables. Prepared in the Department of Agriculture, the Yearbook is published by the Government Printing Office as a Congressional document.

The Yearbook of Agriculture stems from the 1840's, when Federal agriculture work was under the Commissioner of Patents (the Department of Agriculture was founded in 1862). The Commissioner's annual report was issued in two parts, and *Part II Agriculture* was the forerunner of the present Yearbook. In 1895 Congress formally designated the Yearbook of Agriculture.
