Za boljšo vrsto Atlasa

Obrambni tajnik je odobril komaj polovico skvadronov Atlasa, ker čaka na novo, izpopolnjeno vrsto.

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Spomladni smo slišali veliko o našem zaostanku v oborožitvi z meddelinskimi raketami. Kritiki naših oboroženih sil so trdili, da lahko tak položaj spravi našo deželo v resno nevarnost. Obrambni tajnik McElroy je takrat že trditev odločno zavračal in zagotavljal ameriško javnost, da so vojaške sile Združenih držav še vedno najmočnejša vojaška sila na svetu in da se nam še dolgo ne bo treba nikogar batiti.

Sedaj je prišla iz letalskih sil vest, da bo meddelinska raketa "Atlas" skoraj izročena vojaškim enotam. Obrambno tajništvo je za enkrat odobrilo 13 skvadronov Atlasa. Ker ima vsak skvadron 10 raket, jih bo torej skupno 130, v kolikor niso vstete rezerve.

Kongres je dejansko odobril že sredstva za 26 skvadronov, toda obrambni tajnik je mnenja, da je boljše malo počakati in naročiti za oborožene sile izpopolnjeno vrsto Atlasa. Pri orozju ni toliko važno število kot njegova učinkovitost in točnost zadetka. Atlas se je v obeh teh pogledih izkazal za dosti uspešno orozje.

Razgovori med bogoslovci katoliške in pravoslavne Cerkve

ROD, Grč. — Tod se je vršilo pretekli teden zborovanje World Council of Churches, v katerem so povezane krščanske verske skupine razen katoliške Cerkve. Zborovanja sta se od katoliške strani udeležila le dva duhovnika, sodelavca katoliških verskih časopisov.

Ta dva sta predložila zastopnikom pravoslavnih Cerkva razgovore s katoliškimi bogoslovci o vprašanjih, ki obe Cerkvi ločijo. Predlog je bil sprejet in razgovori so predvideni za prihodnje leto. V koliko bodo ti razgovori dobili uradni značaj, zavisi od vodstev obeh Cerkva.

Kongres je postal pretekl torek kompletan

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Pretekli torek so v Kongresu zaprišeli oba senatorja in kongresnička iz najmlajše, havajske države. Havajska država je poslala v senat enega republikanca in enega demokrata, v predstavniški dom pa je prišel demokrat. V senatu je sedaj 100 senatorjev, 65 demokratov in 35 republikancov, v predstavniškem domu je 437 kongresnikov, 283 demokratov in 153 republikancev, eno mesto je prazno.

V senatu so imeli republikanci število. Oba senatorja sta moralni žrebati, kdo bo pet in pol let v senatu. Žreb je odločil v korist republikanca.

BANGKOK, Taj. — Indonezija je v vseh letih svojega obstoja vodila neutralno politiko, ki pa je v preteklem letu enkrat zašla že močno na levo in se približala tako Moskvi kot Peipingu. Predsednik Sukarno se zavzema za sodelovanje s komunisti doma in v međunarodni politiki. Vojska pod vodstvom gen. Nasutiona je odločnejše protikomunistična in je ponovno uspelo zmagati s svojim stališčem.

Sedaj se je v krogu diplomatov SEATO (Jugovzhodna azijaka obrambna zveza), ki ima tod sedež, raznesla vest, da je zelo verjetno, da bo Indonezija skušala v bodočih mesecih najti pot za vstop v to protikomunistično zvezo.

Glavni vzrok za to naj bi bila želja Sukarna končati upor, ki uničuje sile države že dve leti in pol. Uporniki so znani kot hudi protikomunisti. V slučaju, da bi Sukarno pokazal v tem pogledu zbljanje, bi bil sporazum verjeten.

Vesti iz kitajskih krogov v Jakarta trdijo, da se uporniki dejansko že posredno dogovarjajo z vladom Sukarna za končanje upora. Njihova glavna zahteve je, da dobe zunanje pokrajine več sredstev za lasten gospodarski razvoj.

Nehru bo branil meje Sikkima in Butana proti Kitajcem

NEW DELHI, Ind. — Predsednik vlade Nehru je povedel v parlamentu, da je dobil indijski generalni konzul v Lazi v Tibetu od Kitajcev opozorilo, da prihaja indijski romarji v Tibet na lastno odgovornost, ker vodijo Kitajci ta čas "kazenško ekspedicijo" proti tibetanskim upornikom.

Nehrueva izjava je sledila izjavi Dalaj lame, da se upor v Tibetu nadaljuje, da so rdeči nasilniki pobili že okoli 80,000 tibetanski domačinov in da se zaradi komunističnih nasilij priključujejo upornim Kambom vedno nove skupine.

Dejal je, da ni izključeno, da so Kitajci prijeli tudi Pančen lamo, ki so ga po begu Dalaj lame iz dežele postavili za načelnika uprave Tibeta.

Nemci gradijo francosko A-bombo!

Britansko zunanje ministrstvo je zanikalo da NATO preiskuje poročila o pomoči zahodnonemških atomskih znanstvenikov Franciji pri graditvi njene atomskih bombe. Poročilo je objavil londonski Daily Herald.

Na tiskovni konferenci govoril britanskega zunanjega ministra ni hotel dajati podrobnoosti v zvezni s poročilom v zgoraj omenjenem dnevniku, Herald je poročal, da zahodnonemški atomski strokovnjaki pomagajo Franciji pri graditvi njene prve atomske bombe, ki jo bo razstrelila v zrinski puščavi Sahari. Ko je to poročilo prišlo v tajništvo NAO-a, piše Herald, je ta organizacija takoj začela s preiskavo.

Zahodni Nemčiji je namreč po pogojem zgraditi svoje atomske bombe ali kakršnega koli atomskega orožja. Zato da je Zahodna Nemčija našla izhod in poslala v Francijo svoje atomske strokovnjake, da se tam izvležajo za to delo, če in kadar bo Nemčija zopet svobodna.

Rickey Heads

Third Major League:

Branch Rickey, 77-year old "father" of baseball's farm system, was named president of the Continental League, baseball's proposed third major league, at a salary of \$50,000 per year. Rickey has spent 57 years in the game and said he is confident that the league will start operating in 1961 and possibly in 1960 but not probable. Rickey broke baseball's color line when he signed Jackie Robinson, the first Negro major leaguer, to a Brooklyn Dodger farm contract in 1945. Among other stars he either discovered or developed were Dizzy and Paul Dean, Stan Musial, Pepper Martin, Roger Hornsby, Marty Marion, Pee Wee Reese, Roy Campanella and Mort Cooper.

Dempsey Joins Rosensohn, Inc.

Rosensohn Enterprises, Inc., took an unexpected step last week toward clearing the path to the Ingemar Johansson-Floyd Patterson rematch for the world heavyweight championship September 22 by naming Jack Dempsey promotional director and adviser. Dempsey's role corresponds to that of Harry Markson in relation to Madison Square Garden boxing promotions.

Dempsey said he would fly to any part of the world if necessary with his new duties because he is "deeply interested in boxing and anxious to see the sport demand the respect and support of the public."

American Hockey League

Admits Quebec:

Quebec City, with the influential backing of baseball magnate Lou Perini, owner of the Milwaukee Braves, has been granted a franchise in the American Hockey League for the 1959-60 season. The directors of the six AHL teams unanimously voted the Canadian city into the league after it had met the league demands for a \$50,000 entry fee and a \$750 minimum guarantee for visiting clubs.

Police Suggest Ways To Foil Burglars

The war against burglary is "two-fold" . . . the prevention of burglaries by the homeowner before they occur and the apprehension of burglars who commit the crime. Apprehension, of course, is the continuing job of the police department, but the primary responsibility for prevention must rest squarely upon the shoulders of the homeowner. Only with his full cooperation can this war against the ever-increasing burglary rate be successful.

To do your part in this battle of wits against the burglar, Chief H. S. Weaver, executive secretary and treasurer of OACP, has recommended these simple precautions be taken by everyone when leaving their home or apartment:

1. Close and lock all windows and doors, including basement, porch and garage. Use pin tumbler cylinder locks on all outside doors.

2. Leave a lamp or two connected to an automatic timer to turn lights on and off regularly each evening. This makes the home look "lived-in" and is a good protective measure.

3. If you are going away for a week-end or for a vacation, notify local police officials as to the date you are leaving, and the date on which you will return.

4. Have the post office stop mail deliveries to your home while you are away and make certain that no store deliveries will arrive during your absence.

5. Cancel milk and newspaper deliveries. An accumulation of milk bottles and newspapers is a sure sign that you're not home.

6. If you are on vacation, have your lawn mowed and your sidewalk swept by a neighbor at least once a week.

7. Have your phone disconnected, if you're going away. Burglars will sometimes call to see if someone is home.

8. Tell one neighbor when you are leaving. Have him notify the police if he sees anyone prowling around.

9. Do not close shade or blinds completely. Leave them as you normally would when you are home.

10. Never advertise your departure with an item in the paper, or broadcast the news to your neighborhood at large. Burglars have big ears.

11. Never leave ladders and tools where outsiders can get at them. To do so is equivalent to giving a thief a key to your front door.

12. Close your garage doors. An empty garage with the door open is a good sign that no one's home.

13. Do not tell friends, neighbors or work associates of the valuable possessions you have around the house.

Lemon-Lime Float

KEEP YOUR EYES OPEN

The House Ways and Means Committee recently held hearings on a bill which would provide hospital, surgical and nursing home treatment to people drawing Social Security pensions. And it is highly significant that one of the most forthright statements in opposition to his scheme came from Arthur S. Flemming, Secretary of Health, Education and Welfare — the federal department which is vitally concerned with the well-being of older people as well as the rest of us.

Mr. Flemming said that the bill would commit the government to a course of action that would ultimately destroy voluntary health insurance plans. He pointed out that these plans, at the rate they are expanding, should provide insurance to about 70% of Social Security pensioners by 1965. He estimated the cost of the proposed bill for next year alone at \$1.12 billion. And he urged that Congress wait for the results of a study which is now being made in an effort to determine the role government should play in developing old age health plans that are practicable and desirable.

Mr. Flemming was a compelling witness, and he was far from being alone. Medical experts testified that the bill, if passed, would result in poorer, not better, medical care for the people of this country. And it takes no seer to see that the bill is little more than an opening wedge for socialized medicine. For, if certain people are to become wards of the government so far as medical care is concerned, other groups will demand the same kind of benefits.

The bill in question will not, in all probability, be voted on this session. But it will be up again next year. And it's something for the American people to keep a sharp eye on.

FROM BEHIND THE IRON CURTAIN. By the time this reaches you I shall have been to Russia! Congressman Wayne Hayes, Chairman of my Subcommittee on State Department Organization and Foreign Operations suggested I go with him to Moscow to see the U. S. National Exhibition and look into a number of matters there. Thanks to the miracle of jet-age transportation we were able to leave Washington after the passage of the labor-management reform bill and see much behind the iron curtain in a relatively short time. If we can, we shall stop off in Warsaw to see what facilities are provided our Embassy and Consular officials for working and living there. We may also look into the situation in Berlin. In my forthcoming letters I shall hope to include a more detailed report of the trip, together with my impressions of the Moscow Exhibit.

MEMORIAL HONORING THE LATE MARY McLEOD BETHUNE

In commemoration of the 100th anniversary of the Emancipation Proclamation in 1963, the National Council of Negro Women has undertaken a project of memorializing their founder, the late Mary McLeod Bethune. I have introduced a joint resolution authorizing the Secretary of Interior to grant authority to this organization to erect a statue of Mrs. Bethune on public land in the District of Columbia at no expense to the government. Among the Negro people who have truly shared the American dream of freedom none stand higher than the late Mary McLeod Bethune, educator, civic worker, and advisor to Presidents. Rightly called the "First Woman of Her Race," her life work stands as a testimonial to selfless dedication in behalf of her people. The National Council of Negro Women hopes to be able to erect a statue of Mrs. Bethune in Lincoln Park on East Capitol Street in the District of Columbia. This is the location of a dramatic figure of President Lincoln and the Negro slave, known as the Emancipation Group. The Lincoln statue was dedicated on April 14, 1876, and was

1960 CENSUS—APPORTIONMENT OF REPRESENTATIVES

Did you know that when the 1960 Census is taken next April it will mean a redistribution of House seats among the 50 States for the 1962 elections? By Federal law, apportionment of representatives in Congress is determined on the basis of population. The 13 original states were allotted a total of 65 representatives. This figure grew as population and the number of states increased. Finally, after the 1910 Census, membership in the House was fixed by statute to 435. This 86th Congress is temporarily 437 due to the admission of Alaska and Hawaii to the Union. Under the current law, the size of the House will revert to 435 seats after the new population figures for the states are determined by the 1960 Census. Pre-census projection by the Census Bureau indicates that Ohio will retain its status quo of 23 Congressmen, and even may gain one seat.

New White Fleet

A little more than half a century ago President Theodore Roosevelt dispatched "The Great White Fleet"

of 16 U. S. battleships on a world cruise.

The purpose of this dramatic mission, as Life succinctly describes it, was "to impress the world with U. S. naval power and the nation's coming of age." That was exactly what happened.

Now Life tells, in a full-dress feature story, of a proposal for a "New White Fleet." It would, in certain essentials, be very different from its predecessor. For instance, none of the naval ships would be armed.

Instead, they would be devoted to helping underprivileged peoples to improve their own lot. The purpose, in a phrase, would be to serve people in trouble.

The idea for this striking proposal first came from Commander

John F. Stopinsek, U. S. Navy, and he contributes an article to Life ex-

plaining it. After the last world war, he writes, he saw diseased and destitute peoples in far-flung parts of the world. He actually saw people die on the streets of starvation and disease, and the grim and powerful impression this made stayed with him. Then, years after, a specific plan germinated in his mind. In his words, "In addition to inefficient food production methods, one of the major problems of underdeveloped nations is the vicious circle of deprivation. Because of malnutrition the farmers grow too weak to work with maximum efficiency and are thereby unable to produce the full potential of their land — and this in turn keeps them undernourished. Something from outside is needed to break the circle . . . I suddenly thought: why not have an entire fleet of mercy ships — grain ships, hospital ships, education ships, power ships — a fleet designed to make the benefits of the free enterprise system available to the entire human race?"

There will never be a lack of emergencies with which the New White Fleet could deal, Commander Manson goes on, citing as an example that malaria is now rampant in Indonesia and dysentery is a merciless killer in India. Moreover, he adds, the cost would not be great. The ships could be drawn from our huge mothball fleet. The project would not be financed by government, but by popular subscription.

Life describes the possible makeup of the fleet. The hospital ship and aircraft carrier would be the backbone. But with them would be two navy transports. One would be stocked with staple foods to feed the hungry. The other would be a "floating educational center." Native students would be brought aboard and given courses in agriculture and public health. In sum, a New White Fleet would carry good deeds, vital goods and fresh ideas to remote areas of the world which need them most.

Response to the idea has been all that its sponsors could wish. It is known that President Eisenhower is keenly interested. A Life poll of Congress shows that Senate and Representatives are overwhelmingly in favor of it. Spokesman for foreign nations praise it. Much planning, obviously, is needed. But there seems to be an excellent possibility that the world will see a New White Fleet whose mission is to serve mankind, not to destroy it.
