## Po navalu kiauxkih beguncev v Hong Kong

Izgleda, da je Peiping s tem, da je odprl začasno vrata v svobodo, dosegel, kar je hotel. — Pomanjanje hrane je ečitno, prav tako tudi nezadovoljstvo lačnih množic.

HONG KONG. — Sedaj, ko se je val beguncev iz rdeče Kitajske ustavil in vlada na prehodih v Hong Kong že nekaj dni "normalno" stanje, prihaja na dan, kaj je hotela rdeča Kitajska s tem, da je za tri tedne odprla vrata skozi bambusovo zaveso, dosegli. Vse kaže, da je vlada v Peipingu z nenavadnim korakom več pridobilna kot izgubila.

Na eni strani je svetu jasno pokazala, da trpe kitajske ljudske množice pomanjanje hrane, ki jo ima posebno svob. svet na pretek. Namesto da bi tega prosila naravnost za pomoč, je pokazala s prstom na potrebo češ, pomagajte, če ste res taki, kot trdite. Na drugi strani se ji je posrečilo prikazati Hong Kong, ki je v rdeči Kitajski na glasu kot Zahodni Berlin v Vzhodni Nemčiji, "okno svobodnega sveta," kitajskim množicam v slabici. Preko 50,000 vrnjenih beguncev priča proti njemu in njegovim angleškim gospodarjem, čeprav so jih najprej nasiliti, pa jih šele nato pokazali nazaj preko meje.

Množice beguncev niso vedele in ne vedo, da v Hong Kongu zanje ni "mogoče dobiti prostora," da je malo ozemlje prepričljeno. Vedo le, da so jih ob prihodu v svobodni svet prijeli in jih peljali nazaj v pomanjkanje.

Pomanjanje povzročilo pa-dec discipline

Begunci, ki jim je uspelo ostati v mestu pripovedujejo o splošnem pomanjanju hrane, o seliti prebivalstva iz mest na podeželje, ki naj pomaga poljedelstvu zopet na noge, o brezposelnosti v mestih zaradi ustanove cele vrste tovarn, ker jim manjka surovin.

Poročila se krijejo v glavnem s poročili kitajskih beguncev v portugalski Macao. Vsi povedo, kako težavne so razmere, govor o popuščanju discipline ne samo med množicami, ampak celo med particijami in uradništvtvom, pri tem pa ne upa nikje preročati možnosti širšega upora proti sedanjim oblastim.

Zanimivo je, da meja v Macao ni bila nikdar odprtta tako kot v Hong Kong. Tam straže še vedno streljajo na begunce.

Konferenca v Ženevi brez zaključkov

Konferenca za razorožitev je končala svoje prvo razdobje, dva in pol meseca, in pripravila poročilo za ZN. Rusk je k poročlu o delu razorožitve konference dejal, da so Zdržene države razočarane nad negativnim stališčem Sovjetske zveze do zahodnih predlogov. Omenil je posebej sovjetsko odločitev sodelovanja pri razpravi o dogovoru o končanju preskušanja atomskega oružja, o začetku razorožitve, o oboroženosti sili ZN, ki naj bi nadzirala svetovni mir in o končanju hujskanja k vojni.

Lauschetov predlog je bil najprej sprejet, nato pa spremenjen v toliko, da bo Indiji odščipnjena le desetina predložene pomoči. V predlog o poročju je skušal vključiti tudi dolžico, da morajo države, ki dobitjo ameriško pomoč, tudi v Ameriki kupovati potrebnice, ki jih nimajo doma.

SEATO je dejansko mrtva stvar, kajti Anglija in Francija zlorablja svojo veto pravico in preprečuje vsako skupno akcijo proti komunizmu. Zato delegacija predlaga, naj se veto pravica v SEATO ukine, če pa to ni mogoče, pa naj se likvidira SEATO in ustanovi nova organizacija, ki bo imela več smisla za boj proti kitajskemu komunizmu.

Da je bil ta dokument objavljen ravnino sedaj, je gotovo v zvezi z dogodki v Laosu, Tajske in Južnem Vietnamu. Sedaj bodo prizadete države morale reči svojo besedo na ameriške obtožbe.

## Amerika in Sovjetija pomagata v boju proti jatam kobilic v Iranu

TEHERAN, Iran. — Celi oblik kobilic, ki so tako veliki in gosti, da zatemne nebo, vdirajo iz Kuvača in Saudske Arabije v Iran že od začetka preteklega meseca.

Po štiri ameriška in ruska letala ter večje število domačih skušajo roje kobilic uničiti s pršenjem posebnih strupov. Boj proti kobilicam, ki ogrožajo zlasti dežele Srednjega vzhoda, južne Azije in severne Afrike, je v rokah posebne mednarodne ustanove, v kateri sodelujeta tudi Sovjetska zveza in Amerika.

## IZ SLOVENIJE

### Neprostovoljni beg

V ponedeljek, 14. maja, v zgodnjih jutranjih urah se je na Soči pri Solkanu prevrnil čoln, v katerem je bil električar Felker Rupnik. Posrečilo se mu je, da se je oprijel nekega hloda, ki je priplaval mimo. Soča je bila zelo narasla in deroča. Zanesla ga je čez mejo v Italijo. Njegove klice na pomoč so zaslili še na plevnem mostu. Goriški gasilci so ga končno rešili iz vode, ko je v njej prebil poldrugo uro in preplaval na hladu 8 kilometrov. Prepeljali so ga v bolnišnico, ker je bil zelo izčrpan.

Branilci so imeli 26 mrtvih in 18 ranjenih, vendar jim je uspelo komunistični napad zavrniti po hudih borbah, ko je prišla pomoč iz središča naselja Binh Hung.

## Prvi sporazum med Skupnim trgom in Anglijo dosezen

BRUXELLES, Belg. — Med zastopniki angleške vlade in ministri Evropske gospodarske skupnosti je bil dosezen prvi sporazum. Glasom sporazuma je Anglija pristala, da bo do 1. 1970 ukinila vse carinske olajšave za industrijsko blago, ki ga kupuje v Kanadi, Avstraliji in Nove Zelandiji.

Odprto ostane še zmeraj veliko, bolj važno vprašanje, kdaj bo Anglija ukinila carinske olajšave za uvoz deželnih pridelkov iz omenjenih držav. Razgovori o tem kočljivem vprašanju so se že začeli, toda trajali bodo zelo dolgo, morda več let.



The dryer, manufactured by Whirlpool Corp., can be set for either high or low air speed and temperature.

Whirlpool points out that each speed is designed to custom-dry fabrics with the exact degree of heat and air volume required.

With two-speed drying, delicate fabrics, washed at slow agitation speeds in warm water, are dried at slow speeds and low temperatures. Heavier fabrics washed vigorously in hot water can be dried at higher speeds and temperatures. Another improvement in the new

unit is a redesigned console. Controls are at opposite ends of dryers and matching washer units. When the two units are installed in pairs, controls can be placed side-by-side, making it convenient to operate both units from a central location.

The new dryer, now on the market in six models, also has an air setting which is useful for fluffing draperies, blankets, and pillows, and removing mothball and cedar odors from stored clothing.

Homemakers can choose from six drying settings, ranging from one for delicate fabrics to one for quilts and rugs. Depending upon the dryness desired, the dial may also be set between these six cycles to get exactly the right drying time.

A.—Only a few moments. A simple registration form will be delivered to your home, or can be found in your local newspaper or in various public places. Fill it out and bring it to your nearest polio prevention center; pick up your sugar cube with the 3 drops of Sabin vaccine on it, pop it into your mouth. That's all! Trained doctors, nurses and pharmacists will staff each location.

Q.—How much will it cost to get the vaccine?

A.—Contributions are voluntary. 25¢ or more is suggested. If you can't pay that amount, the vaccine will be provided free of charge.

President Kennedy, by late count, has made in his 1962 messages to Congress 62 demands for more spending and 25 demands for more Presidential power. This situation brought former President Eisenhower to Washington recently to warn against this trend in government. He cited as particularly dangerous President Kennedy's proposal that the President be given (a) authority to modify income taxes whenever he might choose without coming to Congress for approval, (b) authority to regiment all agriculture, a request for authority, according to the former President, "more sweeping and repressive than any authority ever before sought over any segment of the Nation's economy," and (c) authority to finance, wherever and whenever the President pleases, large-scale emergency public works by using funds dedicated to other purposes by the Congress.

In a statement issued to warn the people and their elected Representatives and Senators about the dangers inherent in the strenuous efforts of the Administration to increase the power of the Executive Branch of the government, former President Eisenhower said, "It has long been my judgment that the real threat to liberty in this Republic will come not from any sudden, calculated assault, rather the threat to our liberties will be primarily found in a steady erosion of self-reliant citizenship, and in excessive power concentration resulting from the lodging of more and more decisions in an ever-growing Federal bureaucracy." Abraham Lincoln also warned: "At what point then is the approach of danger to be expected? I answer, if it ever reach us, it must stand up amongst us. If destruction be our lot we must ourselves be its author and finisher."

**MEMORIAL DAY, 1962**

Memorial Day, May 20th, a distinctly American institution, born nearly 100 years ago, will again be marked with eulogies and appropriate ceremonies to honor those who sacrificed their lives to protect and preserve our liberties. It is a day to recall that man's struggle on earth.

**Special Stamp for Christmas Season**

Postmaster General J. Edward Day disclosed in a speech on May 25th in Chicago that a special stamp to be used during the Christmas season and a new 50-Star Flag stamp will be included in this year's issues, according to Acting Postmaster Nelson E. Sundheimer.

Addressing the Combined Philatelic Exhibition of Chicagoland, Inc. (COMPEX), Mr. Day promised the Christmas stamp would be available in time for use on greeting cards next Christmas. It will be the first time in United States postal history that such a stamp has been issued.

The Postmaster General advised the COMPEX audience that a 50-Star Flag stamp, as part of a regular series, has been awaiting the outcome of legislation now pending in Congress, which would increase postage rates.

Denominations of both new stamps will hinge on whether the first-class rate is increased to five cents, he noted, adding that he was "confident" that new postal rates will be enacted.

**Placement Tests**

A new round of Peace Corps Placement Tests will be given at 3:30 a.m. Saturday, June 9, in Civil Service Commission testing centers throughout the country.

Persons taking the tests will be considered for many new Peace Corps projects in Africa, Asia and Latin America.

Peace Corps opportunities abroad cover many fields—teaching, nursing, engineering, plumbing, carpentry, agriculture, medicine, home economics, architecture, city planning, geology, physical education.

Applicants must be American citizens and at least 18 years of age. There is NO upper age limit. Married couples without dependent children may apply, providing both qualify.

"There is an almost irresistible tendency for stamp issues to fall into a pattern," he said. "As our Christmas stamp will illustrate, our efforts in the stamp field are to avoid this kind of stereotype... we are deliberately seeking opportunities to widen the horizon of stamp art and design. We have tried new color combinations, new approaches to design and, as in our bleed stamps (Arizona Statehood and Century 21) of this year, new production techniques."


In the bleed process, printing extends beyond the conventional borders and in the instance of the Arizona Statehood stamp, it artistically symbolized the vastness of the desert.

Noting that the Post Office Department annually receives nearly 1,000 letters requesting a stamp appropriate to the Christmas season, Mr. Day said the two new issues will be made "in response to heavy public demand."

When the 4-cent Battle of Shiloh "Civil War Centennial" commemorative stamp was first placed on sale at Shiloh, Tennessee, on April 7, 1962, a total of 526,062 first day covers was canceled at Washington, D.C., on April 11, 1962. In all, 820,677 stamps were sold that day.

margarine	2 eggs, beaten slightly
1 teaspoon salt	2 cups shredded Parmesan cheese

Combine first 3 ingredients in saucepan. Scald—do not boil! Add farina in a fine stream, stirring constantly during addition. Cook, stirring, until thickened. Beat in eggs and 1/2 of cheese. Press into greased square pan, 9 x 9 x 2 inches. Chill until firm. Cut when firm into slices 1/2 inch thick. Overlap slices in greasy shallow baking dish, 11 1/4 x 7 1/2 x 1 1/4 inches. Dot with remaining butter or margarine and sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake in hot oven (425°F.) until hot and brown, about 25 minutes. Serve with Spanish sauce. Yield: 6 servings.

**Spanish Sauce**

3 tablespoons fat	1 1-pound 13-ounce can (3 1/4 cups)
1/4 cup chopped onion	or (3 1/4 cups) tomatoes, undrained
1/4 cup chopped green	1/2 to 1 teaspoon salt
pepper	Pepper as desired
1/2 cup diced celery	

Melt fat, add onion, green pepper, and celery. Cook slowly until onion browns. Add remaining ingredients and cook slowly until thickened. Yield: About 2 cups.

**Secretary Amends Rulings for Youth Retail Jobs**

Washington, D.C.—Secretary of Labor Arthur J. Goldberg has amended Child Labor Regulation No. 3, governing the employment of minors of 14 and 15 outside of school hours.

The amendments, effective June 1, result from a hearing held last September after changes in the Fair Labor Standards Act brought an increased number of retail stores within the scope of the act's child labor provisions.

Jobs that youths of 14 and 15 will be permitted to do in retail establishments outside of school hours include office and clerical work, selling, price marking, packing, bagging, and errand, delivery, and clean-up work.

In food service, they will be permitted to prepare and serve foods and beverages at soda fountains, lunch counters, snack bars, or cafeteria serving counters. They will also be allowed to operate such machines as dishwashers, toasters, dumb-waiters, milkshake blenders, and coffee grinders.

In gasoline service stations, the youths will be permitted to dispense gas and oil, perform courtesy service, and do car washing (by hand), but not to do work involving the use of pits, racks, or lifting apparatus.

Other occupations which will not be permitted are jobs performed in boiler or engine rooms, maintenance or repair of the establishment or equipment, outside window washing, cooking and baking, operating power-driven food slicers or choppers and bakery-type mixers, work in freezers and meat coolers, loading and unloading trucks, and all occupations in warehouses except office and clerical work.

Hazardous occupations orders issued by the Secretary of Labor, which require an 18-year age minimum for certain jobs, continue to apply to employment in retail trade. The amended regulation also retains the hours standards, which prohibit employment after 7 p.m. and limit the number of hours minors 14 and 15 years of age may be employed.

Text of the amendments was published in the May 2 Federal Register. Copies may be obtained soon from the U.S. Department of Labor's Wage and Hour and Public Contracts Divisions.
