"Voyage to the Moon"



Sparkling Offenbach Operetta at Music Hall
The brilliant new Boston Opera production of Jacques Offenbach's scintillating comic operetta, "Voyage to the Moon," will be presented at the Cleveland Music Hall on Saturday evening, March 19th at 8:30 p.m. under the auspices of the Cleveland Opera Association managed by G. Bernardi.

The company of fifty will include an orchestra, chorus and ballet and will present the timely, tune-filled Offenbach work in a superb new English adaptation directed by Sarah Caldwell, choreographed by Robert Jeffrey and designed and costumed by Robert Fletcher.

The story behind this gala "Voyage" goes back to the late 19th century. Then Jules Verne, the pioneer science-fiction writer who is perhaps best known to contemporary American audiences as the author of "Around the World in 80

Days" wrote a book called "Voyage to the Moon." Jacques Offenbach, composer of many popular musical works chose the story as the basis for his 87th operetta; in 1958 the Boston Opera's Sarah Caldwell unearthed two books in the Boston Public Library, which contained costume plates in color, scenic sketches of the original production of 1875 and a rare manuscript of the original libretto. In collaboration with Clyde Grigsby and Eugene Haun, a new adaptation was made. The American premiere in July 1958 was the high spot of the annual Boston Arts Festival.

A musical fantasy in four acts "Voyage to the Moon" although written years ago is timely today as is Cape Canaveral.

Foreign Literature Dept. in New Quarters at Main Library

Cleveland Public Library's Foreign Literature Department, with its book collection of over 130,000 volumes opens in new and enlarged quarters on the second floor of the Cleveland Public Library Main Building at 325 Superior Avenue, on Monday, March 14 at 9 A.M.

The Department, formerly housed on the first floor of the Main Library, will maintain its usual hours — 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Fridays, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturdays.

Thirty foreign language collections are represented — one of the most extensive and most complete of any library in the USA: Arabic, Armenian, Bulgarian, Chinese, Croatian, Czech, Danish, Dutch, Estonian, Finnish, French, German, Greek, Hebrew, Italian, Latvian, Lithuanian, Norwegian, Polish, Portuguese, Roumanian, Russian, Serbian, Slovak, Slovenian, Spanish, Swedish, Ukrainian and Yiddish. Primers and grammars in many other languages are also represented.

Their program of Russian church music, soldier and folk ditties of exaltation, whimsy, power and joy has thrilled and delighted audiences in virtually every country of the world except Red China and Soviet Russia. Just back from Europe, the group whose members, many of them new, are all naturalized American citizens have embarked on their 30th annual tour of the United States and Canada.

The additional space, and improved shelving arrangements for the book collections now allows the Foreign Literature Department to arrange and display books to greater advantage, and adds to the ease of browsing and book selection for the borrower. Attractive poster headings call attention to the various language collections and serve as guides for the borrower.

Resources of the Foreign Literature Department are designed to enlarge the knowledge and increase the skills of the foreign born, to the mutual benefit of both the new citizen and his new country. The Department also tries to introduce the best in the heritage of other peoples to the American-born.

The room now occupied by the Foreign Literature Department, formerly housed in the Technology Division, which moved to new quarters on the second floor of the Business and Science Building, in August, 1959.
