Sovjetija ponuja ZDA normalizacijo odnosov

Glavni govornik na proslavi obletnice boljševiške revolucije v Moskvi K. T. Mazurov je poudaril važnost "normalizacije" odnosov z ZDA.

MOSKVA, ZSSR — Na predvečer obletnice boljševiške revolucije je v Kremlju govoril v imenu Politbiroja Komunistične partije prvi podpredsednik vlade ZSSR Kiril T. Mazurov o pripravljenosti Sovjetske zveze voditi z Združenimi državami razgovore o omejitvi atomskega in raketenega oboroževanja. Poudaril je važnost odnosov med Sovjetsko zvezo in Združenimi državami za tisti dve sili sami in za svetovni mir.

Ko je razlagal mednarodni položaj, je dejal Mazurov: Mi smo vedno poslagali veliko važnost na normalizacijo odnosov med Sovjetsko zvezo in Združenimi državami, kar ni važno le za obe ti deželi, ampak tudi za svetovni mir. Na drugem mestu svojega govora je rekel: Važno je v zvezi s tem spomniti, da smo izrazili svojo pripravljenost na razgovore z Združenimi državami o celotni vrsti teh vprašanj. Toda tajihova pozitivna rešitev ne zavisi samo od Sovjetske zveze.

Besede K. T. Mazurova, 54 let starega člana Politbiroja, so pozdrav novoizvoljenemu ameriškemu predsedniku in prikaz dobre volje ter pripravljenosti za sodelovanje pri reševanju perečih mednarodnih vprašanj. Moskva na splošno ni kazala tekom ameriške volivne borbe nobene posebne naklonjenosti nobenemu izmed kandidatov, vendar je znano, da bi imel Kremlj rajši za predsednika ZDA demokrata Humphreya. V srednjem prvem poročilu o zmagi Nixonove agencije Tass pripomnila, da je Nixonova zmaga bolj znak protesta proti sedanji Johnsonovi vladi kot pa izraz zaupanja volivcev v Nixonu.

Južna Koreja ne odobrava takrite saigon-skega režima

SEOUL, J. Kor. — Saigonski predsednik Van Thieu je predlagal v svojem govoru pred parlamentom, da naj saigonska vlada stopi kar naravnost v stik s severno-vietnamsko vlado in se tako ogne vezavi z Ameriko in vietnamsko OF. Saigonska vlada je hotela pridobiti za to idejo tudi vladu v Južni Koreji. Ta je to idejo gladko zavrnila in stoji na stališču, da ne sme biti nobenih pogajanj, kjer ne bi bila prisotna Amerika.

Južna Koreja zastopa to stališče že dolga leta. Dobiva namreč redno od Severne Koreje vabila, naj se direktno pogaja z njim brez sodelovanja ameriške diplomacije, pa vse te pravice dosledno odbija. Južna Koreja namreč ve, da bi z direktnimi razgovori s Severno Korejo ne prišla daleč brez podpore ZDA.

Rdeči bodo nadaljevali v Vietnamu z nasiljem

SAIGON, J. Viet. — Zajeti komunistični dokument vsebuje ukaze iz Hanoia za povečanje bojevanja, nasilja in sabotaž v Južnem Vietnamu klub ustaviti ameriški napadov na Severni Vietnam. Dokument so zasegle južnovietnamske čete in ga proučujejo ameriški strokovnjaki z ozirom na verodostojnost in zanesljivost. Boji se med tem manjšem obsegom nadaljujejo po vsem Južnem Vietnamu od Demilitarizirane cone pa na jug v Mekongovo delto.

Rdeči saboterji so uničili most na glavni cesti v Saigon, na mestu so v zadnjih dneh izstrelili par sto raketa, ki so ubile nekaj civilistov, več pa jih ranile. Ti napadi so vsaj v duhu nasprotne dogovoru o končanju ameriških napadov na Severni Vietnam.

Zajeti dokument naroča komunističnim okrajinom komisarjem, naj pospešijo in razširijo gverilsko vojskovanje in vse vojaške in politične aktivnosti. Naročeno jim je, naj pošljejo v mesta posebne teroristične skupine, ki bodo izvajale nasilja, umore in sabotaže s ciljem strahovanja prebivalstva.

Vojanstvo in policija sta ukrotila nemirno Prago

Tisoči vojakov in policije so s solzivnim plinom in vodnimi brizgalnami krotili nemirne Pražane, ki so demonstrirali proti Sovjetski zvezi na dan obletnice boljševiške revolucije. Ta je bila v preteklih letih dan sovjetsko-českoslovaškega prijateljstva.

PRAGA, ČSR. — Skupine mladih ljudi, predvsem študentov, so demonstrirale po glavnem mestu republike proti Sovjetski zvezi, trgate z javnih in privatnih poslopij sovjetske zastave ter jih sežigale, pri tem pa kričale, naj gredo Rusi domov. Oblasti so poslale na ceste močne oddelke policije in vojaštva, ki so odločno nastopili proti demonstrantom in jih razgnali, kakor hitro se jih je več zbral. Demonstracije so trajale kljub vsemu šest ur. Večje število oseb je bilo prijetih, nekaj pa tudi ranjenih. Vlada je nastopila odločno proti demonstrantom, da bi zavarovala mesto pred novo zasedbo po sovjetskih četah.

Tekom demonstracij in manifestacij ob praznovanju 50-letnice ustanovitve českoslovaške republike v Pragi, Bratislavu in Brnu, pa tudi po drugih mestih republike je bila policija precej zadržana. Tokrat vlada ni upala tvegati takega nastopa, da ne bi vzbudila jezovij sovjetskih vojaških vodnikov, ki bi v takem slučaju lahko poslalo v Prago znowo svoje čete, saj tabore te končaj nekaj desetih kilometrov od mestnega središča.

Nastop pristašev Moskve na pokopališču včeraj ne obeta ni dobrega. Dubček in tovariši se trdo pripravljajo na zasedanje Centralnega komiteta Komunistične partije, ki je določeno za prihodnje sredo. Na njem bodo skušali konzervativci s sovjetsko podporo spodbopati tla Dubčeku in tovarišem ter postaviti na celo Komunistične partije ljudi, ki bodo boli naklonjeni Moskvi. Da se Rusi za kulisami trudijo z vsemi silami za tako rešitev, je več kot očitno, saj moskovsko časopisje sedanje vodstvo, posebno Dubčeka in Smrkovskega zopet javno napada.

Kolaboraterji postajajo pogumnejši
Skupina sovjetskih kolaboraterjev se je zbrala na Olsany pokopališču, kamor sta prišla na čelo uradne delegacije ČSR predsednik vlade O. Černik in glavni tajnik KP A. Dubček položil venec pred spomenik v zadnji vojni padlih sovjetskih vojakov in odkrit spomenik češkim in slovaškim vojakom, ki so padli v drugi svetovni vojni boreč se ob strani Rdečih armad.

Ko sta Černik in Dubček opravila svoj uradnik posel, sta se obrnili proti izhodu. Iz skupine navzočih so ju pozdravili klici "Mi smo s Sovjetsko zvezo!" Nekateri od kričačev so Dubčeka in Černika celo grabili za obete in ju hoteli zadržati. Oba vodnika sta brez težave odrinila kričice in odšla v čakajoči avtomobil.

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Po zadnjih podatkih je pri torkovih predsedniških volitvah dobil republikanec Nixon 30,456,559 ali 43.6% glasov, demokrat Humphrey 30,185,951 ali 43.2% neodvisni Wallace pa 9,186,016 ali 11.2%. Volivni izidi v Marylandu, Missouriju in na Aljaski še vedno niso znani, volivni može pripadeti še vedno lahko ali Nixonu ali Humphreju, vendar to je izvolitev ne more več vplivati.

KEY BISCAYNE, Fla. — R. M. Nixon je tu na kratkem odih. Izjavil je, da ne bo napravil nobenega potovanja ne v Južni Vietnam ne kam drugam pred 20. januarjem razen na željo predsednika L. B. Johnsona.

SAIGON, J. Viet. — Rdeči so v zadnjih dneh streljali na 16 pokrajinskih in okrajinah glavnih mest. Gen. C. Abrams je rdeče zaradi tega ostro obsojal. Na večih krajih je prišlo do manjših spopadov. Ameriške čete so imele v bojih v preteklem tednu 150 mrtvih in 1214 ranjenih, Južni Vietnam 129 mrtvih in 684 ranjenih, rdečih pa naj bi bilo v boju mrtvih 1393.

ZDRAŽENI NARODI, N.Y. — Zunanja ministrica Egipta in Jordanijske sta odpotovala do določenega vzdolila, pa se bosta nemara kmalu vrnila, da nadaljujeta razgovore o pomiritvi z Izraelom. Kljub njunim nepopustljivim javnim izjavam obstoji nekaj upanja na uspeh predstovanja G. Jarringa.

ZDRAŽENI NARODI, N.Y. — Skupina 15 držav je včeraj predložila glavni skupščini resolucijo za izključevanje nacionalne Kitajske iz ZN in za prepustitev kitajskega zastopnika rdeči vladi v Pepingu. Združene države nasprotujejo kot v preteklosti tudi letos temu predlogu. Napovedujejo, da bo predlog zavrnjen.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Na včerajšnji proslavi obletnice boljševiške revolucije je bil glavni govornik vojni minister marsal Grečko. Bil je sicer zavrnjen in običajno napadel Združenih držav.

BERLIN, Nem. — Ko je kancler Kiesinger na koncu letnega zborovanja krščansko-demokratske stranke tu dajal avtograf, ga je 29 let stara Mrs. B. Klarsfeld sunila v oku, da bi, kot je dejala, opozorila svet na to, da je bil kancler član Hitlerjeve nacistične stranke. Policija jo je prijela in je bila 9 ur nato obojena na letno zaporo. Vložila je pričiv in bila pod varčino izpuščena na svobodo. Zborovanje krščansko-demokratske stranke v Berlinu je sicer potekalo v miru, čeprav so preje v Panckowu in v Moskvi protestirali in grozili, da ne bodo mirno gledali zahodnonemškega poseganja v Zahodni Berlin.

Nixon bo ubiral srednjo pot

Volitve so za nami, izvoljen je nov predsednik, ki bo 20. januarja 1969 prevzel vodstvo dežele. Richard M. Nixon je bil izvoljen z večino volivnih mož, toda z manjšino volivcev. Če bo ostalo pri sedanjem razmerju števila glasov, je dobil Nixon okoli 270,000 več glasov kot demokrat Humphrey, pa še vedno le 43.6% celotnega števila volivcev. Demokratski kandidat je dobil 43.2% vseh oddanih glasov.

S komaj 43.6% volivcev za seboj bodo naloge novega predsednika že teže, kot bi bile, če bi imel za seboj jasno večino dežele. Prav zato bo moral tudi ubirati umirjeno, srednjo pot, gledati, da dobi podporo tudi pri tistih, ki ga niso volili. Ta cilj je nakazoval ves čas volivne borbe in ga označil jasno v svojem kratkem govoru po dosegli volivne zmage. Dejal je:

Videl sem v tej kampanji mnogo napisov. Nekateri od njih niso bili prijazni, drugi pa so bili zelo prijateljski. Toda najbolj me je ganil tisti, ki sem ga videl v Deshlerju v Ohiju na koncu dolgega dneva kampanje iz vlaka. Ljudje so stali tam v pol temi, da jih je bilo komaj mogoče razločiti, toda neki mladostnik je držal jasno viden napis "Spravi nas skupaj!" To bo veliki cilj te administracije od vsega začetka, spraviti ameriško ljudstvo skupaj. To bo odprta administracija, odprta novih idejam, odprta možem in ženam obeh strank, odprta kritikom kot tudi tistim, ki nas podpirajo. Mi hočemo premostiti starostni prepad. Mi hočemo premostiti prepad med rasami. Mi hočemo Ameriko združiti. Mislim, da se te naloge lahko lotimo in da bomo v njej tudi uspeli!

Volitve so pokazale, da teži dežela k umirjenosti, k večji ustaljenosti, k trdnosti, ki jo je v zadnjih letih pogrešala tako doma kot v svetu. Porast nemirov, izgredov in demonstracij, vsakdanje kršenje zakonov, ki je ostalo nekaznovano, premala odločnost v boju proti naraščajočemu zločinu, so vznemirili množice, ki so doslej za javna, zlasti še za politična vprašanja niso posebno zanimale. Te množice so volile v znameno protesta v manjši meri Wallacea, v večji pa so dale svoj glas Nixonu v upanju, da bo ta vrnili deželi "nekdanje", "mirne" čase, pa še dvignil ameriški vpliv in ugled tudi v svetu, ki je v zadnjem času postal nekam negotov in nevaren.

Kongres je v glavnem ostal tak, kot je bil, morda bo celo za spoznanje konservativnejši. Novi predsednik se tega zaveda in bo temu primereno usmerjal svoje korake v domači in v mednarodni politiki.

Najprej bo moral posvetiti svojo pozornost vojni v Vietnamu. V bistvu se bo držal poti predsednika L. B. Johnsona, iskal bo konec vojne v razgovorih v Parizu, toda ne za vsako ceno. Tekom volivne borbe je ponovno poddaril, da Amerika v jugovzhodni Aziji ne sme popuščati preko določene meje, če noče imeti novih, podobnih težav, kot jih ima sedaj v Vietnamu, drugod.

Predsednik De Gaulle je v častitki Nixonu k volivni zmagi izrazil upanje, da bosta obe državi tudi v bodoče gojili tradicionalne prijateljske odnose. Dejstvo je, da so bili odnosi v času L. B. Johnsona precej hladni. Obstoji upanje, da se bodo pod Nixonovo vladu izboljšali v korist Evrope in vsega svobodnega sveta. De Gaulle je namreč v preteklih letih ubiral v zunanjji politiki pota, ki niso bila vedno v skladu s potrebami in koristmi svobodnega sveta.

V Moskvi so tekom proslave obletnice boljševiške revolucije preteklo sredo ponovili željo po "normalizaciji" odnosov z Washingtonom v korist Združenih držav in Sovjetske zveze, pa tudi v korist "svečavnega miru", kot se je izrazil podpredsednik vlade ZSSR Kiril T. Mazurov. Ali bodo v Moskvi skušali doseči "normalizacijo" takoj ali bodo najprej preskusili Nixonovo odpornost in odločnost, kot so to v preteklosti redno storili z vsakim novim predsednikom od Trumana, Eisenhowerja in Kennedyja pa do Johnsona, bo pokazala bližnja bodočnost.

Nixon je v volivnem boju dejal, da morajo Združene države najprej okrepliti svoje oborožene sile in se nato razgovarjati z Moskvo s "polozaja moči". Pokazal je pri tem vendar dovolj jasno, da ne misli sveta gnati v novo mrzlo vojno, če bo Moskva pokazala le nekaj razumevanja in dobre volje. Ta je v obojestransko korist in nujno potrebna za hraničite sveta.

V zunanjji politiki je poleg Vietnamca posebno pereče vprašanje Srednjega vzhoda, kjer grozi nevarnost novega spopada med Izraelci in Arabci, v Afriki, kjer se beli v Rodeziji nočejo podati in priznati črni večini političnih pravic, v Nigeriji, kjer se pleme Ibo bori za svojo neodvisnost, v Evropi, kjer je treba obnoviti NATO, da se bo lahko uspešno uprl pritisku z vzhoda na kopnem in v Sredozemskem morju, kjer so Rusi začeli nevarno hitro krepiti svoje

pomorske sile. Pozornost bo seveda treba stalno imeti tudi na razvoju v Latinski Ameriki, ki išče ponekod pot iz zastalosti in revščine z revolucionarnimi sredstvi.

Doma je na prvem mestu vprašanje pomirivte, odstranite razdrojenosti, ki jo je na eni strani povzročila vietnamska vojna, na drugi pa rasni spori. Naloga je težavna in jo ne bo mogoče rešiti preko noči in brez večjih žrtev. Treba je vrniti mir in varnost na ceste in ulice velemest, treba ustaviti naraščanje draginje, ki jo je sprožilo nepredurarno razmetavanje zveznih finančnih sredstev v času, ko vojna v Vietnamu že tako nalaga deželi hudo breme.

Novi predsednik ima pred seboj veliko in težkih nalog. Z vso skušnjo in priznano spremnostjo ne bo mogel rešiti vseh zadovoljivo in v skladu z željami in pričakovanji prebivalstva dežele. Vsekakor se bo trudil dosegči kar največ in v kar najhitrejšem času, da si pridobi zaupanje in podporo dežele; hodil bo pazljivo, da ju bo ohranil, ker le v takem slučaju more računati na uspeh in na ponovno — izvolitev!

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Politiki filozofi zopet kličejo, na pomoč usodo in njen podsmeh, da bi razumeli nekatere volivne rezultate.

Novi predsednik Nixon se je leta 1960 strašno jezil, da ga je Kennedy premagal s tako majhno večino. Zdaj je sam premagal Humphreya s še manjšo. V čim manjši zmagi je torej posekal Kennedyja! To razmerje zmaga še ni dokončno, treba je počakati definitivne številke o volitvah.

Zupan smatra to za političen malež, ki bo škodoval ne samo Clevelandu, ampak vsej naši državi. Kadar bo potreba politično ali podobno posredovanje pri republikanski administraciji v Washingtonu, zmeraj bodo letete opanake, da je Wallace dobil toliko glasov prav pri nas.

Stokes se upravičeno boji, da bo mesto dobilo sedaj veliko manj podpor iz Washingtona, kot je bilo predvideno v njegovih načrtih in upih. Nixonova administracija mu gotovo ne bo preveč naklonjena. To bo seveda imelo občuten vpliv na njegovo mestno finančno politiko, ki se je zmeraj bolj opiralna na dobrote iz Washingtona. Šest mumij pod žarki X

MUENCHEN. — Ali sta se ustroj in oblika človeških kosti spremenila v zadnjih dveh tisočletjih? Nemški znanstveniki upajo, da jim bo s šestih rentgenih posnetkov človeškega telea v naravnih velikosti uspelo razbrati odgovor na to vprašanje.

Posnetke, na katerih so okostja šestih staroegipovskih mumij, so napravili v nekem muenchenskem laboratoriju za tehnično fotografijo. Podobne raziskave so izvedeli dosegli samo enkrat in sicer pred leti v Veliki Britaniji.

Rentgensko snemanje mumificiranih trupel je povezano s prejšnjimi težavami. Potrebni so filmi dovolj velikih razsežnosti, da lahko v celoti zajamejo človeško okostje. Platnena obloga in asfalt motita odsev kosti na rentgenskem filmu.

Po več poskusih so v muenchenskem laboratoriju uspeli rentgenski posnetki, ki so dovolj jasni za antropološke raziskave. Znanstveniki bodo med drugim skušali ugotoviti tudi vzrok smrti šestih Egiptanov pred 2000 leti. Za zdaj poročajo o prvem zanimivem odkritju: rentgenski posnetki omogočajo brezhibno in zanesljivo identifikacijo mumij.



Thanksgiving Week

The Very Rev. Msgr. Casimir S. Ciolek, Diocesan Director of Catholic Charities, has been re-named Director of the 20th Annual Thanksgiving Clothing Collection by the Most Rev. Clarence G. Issenmann, Bishop of Cleveland.

Msgr. Ciolek said the drive for usable clothing will be held during Thanksgiving week November 25th through December 1st, in the eight-counties (Ashland, Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, Medina, Summit and Wayne) of the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland.

Msgr. Ciolek said "serviceable men's clothing and shoes, children's and infant's wear, blankets and bedding are the most urgent items needed." Women's clothing of a practical and serviceable nature are also much in demand."

More than 240 parishes will participate in the effort to collect and send usable clothing to the needy overseas.

Last year Catholics in the Diocese of Cleveland contributed over 214 tons (429,487 lbs.) of the more than 10,000 tons (20 million lbs.) collected throughout the United States.

Clothing collected in the Diocese is shipped to New York City for world-wide distribution by the Catholic Relief Services — USCC which operates relief and self-help programs in 80 countries throughout the world.

A major share of the clothing contributed by generous Americans is distributed to the people in war devastated South Vietnam where the dislocation of families and individuals has caused an acute shortage of clothing and other bare necessities of life.

Catholic Relief Services has also played a leading part in meeting the needs of the starving people of Biafra/Nigeria by distributing food clothing and medicine valued at over \$3,000,000 (\$3,331,702) since May of 1967.

Central and South America, the Near and Far East and Africa are also benefited through the efforts of Catholic Relief Services.

In addition to meeting needs of clothing on a long-term basis, Catholic Relief Services "stock piles" a certain percentage of the clothing for disaster relief.

All clothing is distributed to needy families and individuals without regard for race, color or religion.

PRIORITIES SHOULD BE ESTABLISHED. Time will be the best judge of the legislative work of the 90th Congress, during the past two years. One of my major complaints of the Administration's spending programs was the absolute lack of setting priorities. It was a "something for everybody" approach which created massive fiscal problems for our country and diluted and truly weakened vital programs. In the 91st Congress, I would hope that tax reform, including a new approach on revenue sharing with the states, would top the legislative agenda. Other urgent legislative needs to be considered should be Electoral College Reform, Draft Law Reform, a new approach to foreign aid, tax credits for educational expense, tax credits for manpower training to benefit the hardcore unemployed, and creation of a new Hoover-type Commission to combat waste and duplication in a bulging administrative bureaucracy. These are just a few of the items. We must set priorities based on need and our ability to finance programs.

Drivers Penalty Point System Explained

Ohio's Automobile law point system is not clearly understood by many of us. A table of PENALTY POINTS for various kinds of violations of the Motor Vehicle Laws, are as follows:

- 1—Driving while drunk or drugged 6 points
- 2—Manslaughter resulting from operating a motor vehicle 6 points
- 3—Failure to stop and identify yourself after an accident 6 points
- 4—Driving a vehicle without the owner's permission 6 points
- 5—Using a motor vehicle while committing a felony 6 points
- 6—Drag racing 6 points
- 7—Driving while your license is revoked or suspended 6 points
- 8—Reckless driving 4 points
- 9—Speeding 2 points
- 10—Driving in violation of a restriction imposed by the registrar 2 points
- 11—Any other moving violation in operating a motor vehicle 2 points

Of course it should be understood that other PENALTIES may apply to motor vehicle driving besides the point system stated above. For example: reckless driving may be punished by fine or imprisonment or both, as well as by charging points on the violator's driving license.

All in all, it is clear that the public wants reckless drivers to be thoroughly punished for endangering lives and property.

An accumulation of penalty points on your driver's license, and soon you are not permitted in the driver's seat.

Solution: Strive for—NO POINTS SHOWING.

Cancer Society Report

The American Cancer Society's Cuyahoga County Unit, highlighting a year of public education activity in a report released here, noted that some 232,427 county residents viewed ACS life-saving films urging annual health checkups as the best insurance against cancer.

Harvey E. Kapnick, Jr., President of the local Unit of the American Cancer Society, said that some 9,289 women saw "Time and Two Women", featuring the importance of the "PAP" test for the early diagnosis of uterine cancer and when detected early and promptly treated virtually 100% curable.

Another 12,079 women, according to Mr. Kapnick, saw "Breast Self-Examination" which teaches women this technique for discovering abnormal growths as an aid for the early detection of breast cancer. "Life Story", another American Cancer Society life-saving film, urges a proctoscopic examination for the early detection of rectal and colon cancer and was seen by some 2,332 men and women here.

Some 223,394 teenagers, he said, saw many of the Society's films and filmstrips produced specifically for high school students to point up the relationship between cigarette smoking and lung cancer.
