### Indija ne bo popustila pred vojaško silo Kine

Predsednik republike Radhakrishnan je dejal na skupni seji obeh domov parlamenta, da Indija ne bo sprejela kitajskih zahodov v mejnem sporu.

NEW DELHI, Ind. — Indijska vlada in javnost se zavedata, da nevarnost kitajskega vpada v deželo še ni mimo. Blizajoča se pomlad prinaša v obmejno področje novo negotovost. Dežela se pripravlja na vojaški in mednarodno-politični področju na novo razdobje v mejnem sporu z rdečo Kitajsko.

Kot že preje nekajkrati predsednik vlade Nehru, tako je sedaj predsednik zvezne republike Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan poudaril v parlamentu, da Indija ne bo popuščala pred kitajskim vojaškim pritiskom, ampak bo z vsemi sredstvi branila svoje ozemlje.

### Povečana sredstva za obrambo

Zvezna vlada se je odločila skoraj podvojiti sredstva za oborožene sile, pri tem pa je komaj kaj skrčila svoje gospodarske načrte. Zaveda se predobro, da mora s temi nadaljevati, če hoče odstraniti nevarnost notranjih nemirov in porasta nezadovoljnosti ljudskih množic, ki zahtevajo boljše življenje.

Posebna skupina ameriških, angleških in avstrijskih strokovnjakov preiskuje potrebe indijske oborožene sile in narodne obrambe. V kratkem bo predložila svoje poročilo.

### Amerika voljna pomagati šele po sporazumu s Pakistonom

Nedavno so prispevali v Indijo štiri ruska Mig-21 jet-letala in Indiji jih pričakujejo še nekaj in seveda postavitev tovarne, ki bo taka letala ob sodelovanju s Sovjetsko zvezo izdelovala doma. Pri tem se Nehru zaveda, da mora na glavno vojaško pomoč računati le iz Združenih držav. V Washingtonu so pokazali, da so voljni razpravljati o tem, pa povedali tudi jasno, da Indiji ne bodo dali nobene obsežnejše vojaške pomoči, dokler ne reši spora o Kašmirju s Pakistanom. To vprašanje se med tem kljub trem sestankom med zastopniki Indije in Pakistana ni premaknilo z mrtve točke.

### Bo Gana prekinila diplomatske odnose z Bolgarijo?

### Kongres nezadovoljen s sateliti za zvezde

Zaliteva pre očeno stališča zvezne vlade do privatne družbe, ki je prevzela odgovornost za organizacijo telekomunikacij preko satelitov.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Do sedaj je administracija sodelovala pri treh komunikacijskih satelitih: Telstar, Relay in Syncocom. Obnesel se je dejansko samo Telstar, kar mu je ustvarilo veliko smpatij na Kapitolu. Pod vtimom uspehov s Telstarom je Kongres tudi izglasoval zakon, ki regulira uporabo telekomunikacijskih satelitov.

Zakon je naletel na precejšen odpor v vrstah liberalnih kongresnikov in senatorjev, ki so trdili, da zakon ne daje federalizmu tistega vpliva na uporabo telekomunikacijskih satelitov, ki bi ga moralna imeti z ozirom na njene velike materialne žrtve.

Zdi se, da so nasprotniki zakona imeli prav. Satelit Relay je slabo obnesel, Syncocom pa sploh ušel v vesolje in ga ni mogoče najti. Vse to je napotilo nekaj senatorjev do zahteve, da administracija na novo oceni svoje stališče do komunikacijskih satelitov. Delegat je na federacije v Communication Satellite Corp. bodo radi tega dobili nova navodila, kako naj varujejo koristi javnosti v tem zasebnem podjetju.

## Ob rojstnem dnevu Georgea Washingtona

Prvi v vojni, prvi v miru, prvi v srečih svojih sodržavljanih! Tako je zapisal zgodovinar o G. Washingtonu, očetu Zdrženih držav in njihovemu prvemu predsedniku. Podatki o njegovem življenju so splošno znani, saj jih uče po vseh šolah dežele, pa tudi izven nje, vendar ne bo napak, če jih v glavnem znova navedemo.

George Washington se je rodil na današnji dan pred 231 leti Augustinu Washingtonu in njegovim drugim ženi Mary Ball. Izobraževal se je delno v domači šoli, delno pa ga je učil njegov polbrat Lawrence. Še kot mlad fant je bil leta 1748 potrenjen za javnega zemljemerca od kolonialne vlade v Virginiji, kjer je bil rojen in kjer je živel. Naslednjih tri leta je meril največ v Shenandoah Valleyu, pa prevzel po smrti svojega polbrata Lawrencea julija 1752 Mt. Vernon, rodbinsko posestvo ob reki Potomac.

Naslednje leto je bil imenovan za poveljnika vojaške milice južne Virginije. Sodeloval je v indijski in francoski vojni ter se pokazal ne samo kot sposobnega, ampak tudi kot hrabrega vojaka in poveljnika. Tako je razumljivo, da ga je drugi kongres Zdrženih držav izbral junija 1775 za poveljnika kontinentalne armade v revolucionarni vojni z nalogo, da požene iz dežele Angleže in utrdi njeno svobodo. Vse od junija 1775 pa do končne zmage je Washington vodil svoje rojake v borbi za svobodo in neodvisnost in jo s pomočjo v podporo Francije tudi izvjeval.

Ko je bila zmaga dosegrena in podpisana mir jeseni 1783, je odložil poveljstvo nad armado in se umaknil v privatno življenje, dokler ni bil izvoljen za prvega predsednika Zdrženih držav in 30. aprila 1789 kot tak tudi zaprisežen. Modro in preudarno je vodil Unijo skozi težave prih let in jo srečno držal izven vojne, ki je nastala v Evropi med revolucionarno Francijo in njenimi nasprotniki.

Ob koncu druge predsedniške dobe je Washington odklonil ponovno izvolitev in se umaknil na svoje posestvo Mt. Vernon. Ko se je odnos do Francije zaostril, je Kongres imenoval Washingtona znova za poveljnika armade, te pa je 12. decembra 1799 umrl.

George Washington je pripadal plasti plantažnikov v Virginiji in bil kot veleposestnik tudi član kolonialne zakonodaje. V javnem življenju se je vedno vztrajno in odločno zavzemal za svobodo in obsojal vsako nasilje. Trdil je, da je narod vladarju dolžan pokorščino le, dokler ta vrši svoje dolžnosti v skladu z zakoni. Če vladar te prelomi, se mu narod lahko upre. To je bilo splošno naziranje one dobe v smislu Montesquieujevih in Rousseaujevih naukov. Na tej osnovi je zrastla tudi ustava Zdrženih držav.

S svojo modrostjo in preudarnostjo je znal Washington držati skupaj ljudi različnih nazorov in stremljenj. Preprečeval je preostra nasprotja, ki bi utegnila deželo razdeliti v dva tabora. Bil je nad strankami, zato mu je uspelo v težavnih trenutkih posredovati. Ko so nekateri iz navdušenja do Francije in iz čuta dolžnosti do "priatelja v stiski" zahtevali, da gredo Zdržene države Franciji na pomoč, je Washington ta ogenj znan modro omejeval in deželo ohraniti izven vojne, ki je nato dve desetletji uničevala Evropo.

Spošna blaginja in korist skupnosti sta mu bili dragoceno vodilo, svoboda vredna vsake žrtve. Washington je kazal razumevanje za svoje stanovske tovariše, za veleposestnike in finančnike, pa tudi za malega človeka, saj je poznal deželo in njene prebivalce. Bil je lastnik črnih sužnjev, ki so obdelovali njegovo plantažo. Z njimi je ravnal človeško in določil v svoji oporoki, da po ženini smrti postanejo svobodni.

Pri zasedovanju ciljev je bil Washington vztrajen. Ni obupaval, ko je doživeljjal v bojih poraze, ni omahoval, ko je s svojo vojsko vred stradal in prebehal. Cilj, za katerega se je boril, mu je dajal moči, da je vedno znova vlij svojim vojakom voljo do prenašanja naporov in do nadaljevanja vojne do zmage. Marsikdo bi postal na njegovem mestu malodušen in pusti vse skupaj, Washington je vztrajal sam in dajal poguma drugim, pozival in rotil k nadaljevanju boja.

Po končani vojni je odložil poveljstvo nad četami in se vrnil na svoje posestvo. Pokazal je očitno, da mu ni do oblasti, da je poveljstvo nad armado prevzel le, da doseže postavljeni cilj. Ko je bil ta dosežen, ga slava in čast nista zapeljali. Šele ko je spoznal, da Unija potrebuje vodnika, ki bo ustvaril začetni red in ustanovil potrebno zvezno upravo, je sprejet vodilno mesto in postal prvi predsednik Zdrženih držav. Pristal je na ponovno izvolitev še enkrat, drugič pa jo odklonil. S tem je dal zgled svojim naslednikom, ustvaril je tradicijo, ki je obstala veljavna s kratko izjemo dobe Franklina D. Rooseveltta.

Načela, ki jih je uveljavil George Washington, načela,

na katera so on in njegovi sodelavci postavili Združene države, so tem omogočale, da so rastle, se razvijale, se raztegnile od Atlantika do Pacifika in postale prva sila modernega sveta. Modrost, razumevanje in umirjenost, ki jih je Washington kazal in se po njih ravnal, so postale zdrovo vodilo njegovim naslednikom, on sam pa ni postal vzor samo predsednikom Združenih držav, ampak vsem državljanom.







## Cleveland Home and Flower Show

Seventy-six percent of the total attendance at last year's Cleveland Home and Flower Show own their own homes as compared with the last national figures which show that 51% of American families are home owners.

These facts were revealed in a survey made at the Show, which this year is scheduled for March 9 through March 17, at Cleveland Public Hall.

Other facts revealed by the survey show that more than a third of the Show's attendance comes from beyond Cleveland and its suburbs, many from as far as Columbus, Pittsburgh, Erie, Buffalo, Indianapolis, Detroit and Toronto. They travel to Cleveland to meet the Spring at the Home and Flower Show by chartered bus, by automobile and by railroad.

Twenty-three percent said they plan to buy or build a new home in the future. They indicated that these new homes would be in the range of \$10,000 to \$40,000. To meet their requirements these show visitors indicated that they would need three, four and two bedrooms, in that order by number voting. Just a little more than 50% indicated that they preferred a basement for their new homes.

What would be a surprise to a home owner of the past generation was the fact that 75% indicated that they preferred a home on one floor, 20% named a two-story house as their preference, and 5% stated that their choice would be a story and a half house.

He and his wife Janet, son David and daughters Deborah and Cheryl live at 2975 Tall Tree Trail in Willoughby Hills, Ohio.



## Reporting from Washington

**THE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE ON EDUCATION.** 182 pages of an Education Bill (so-called) have been submitted to the Congress. H.R. 3000 was introduced by the Chairman of the House Committee on Education and Labor—who then took off for two weeks in Puerto Rico. There is everything imaginable in that bill, something for each, all mixed up together in the greatest hodge-podge you ever saw. And just before he left, the Committee Chairman announced that two members would be a sufficient number to conduct any hearing.

The bill establishes no priorities, which means the Committee must sort out the categories and then work at them. Here at a time when we have become more acutely aware than heretofore that there is a very real need for classrooms, laboratories and so on, that teachers are all too few—oh, a thousand things that drag our standards down—the Administration sends an utterly unrealistic bill to the Hill. It would be laughable were it not so serious! And, although it comes to us without a price tag, members of the Committee have estimated that its total cost would be anywhere from \$7 to \$10 billion, with our National Debt already up to \$308 billion.

With costs climbing on every hand, higher education grows more and more difficult to come by. In order to ease the burden, I have introduced H.R. 983, which would permit a taxpayer to deduct tuition expense paid for the higher education of himself or any dependent. The Republicans of the House Committee on Education and Labor have introduced the College Academic Facilities Act—providing a 5-year program of grants and loans—to help meet the ever-increasing need for facilities in the colleges. The

Administration recommendation for college facilities proposed no grants, only loans, in spite of the fact that many States have Constitutional provisions which would prevent their State Universities contracting a debt through a Federal loan.

The proposed Republican Academic Facilities Act and my tax deduction bill are two practical, realistic efforts to give more young people the chance to prepare themselves to make a real contribution to the country they are eager to serve. Of course, these two bills do not cover the entire need but they point the way toward down-to-earth common sense answers to our education problems.

### MONEY-MAKING F.B.I.

Many persons are aware of the very fine job the Federal Bureau of Investigation does in apprehending criminals, recovering stolen property, and gathering evidence with which criminals are successfully prosecuted. Many persons appreciate the dedicated service of the gallant men of the FBI and the very fine leadership which has been afforded that organization by J. Edgar Hoover. But probably very few persons realize that, in these days of sky's-the-limit Government spending, the FBI more than pays its own way.

Of course, the FBI has revenue-making opportunities not found in every Government agency. But only if its efficiency was it able to produce more than \$200 million from fines, savings and recoveries. This amounted to some \$70 million more than its annual budget. So among all the other reasons for being appreciative of Mr. Hoover's Department and his operatives, let us not forget their spectacular solvency.

## From the Indian Teepee



TUCSON, Arizona.—For the 17th consecutive spring, the Cleveland Indians opened their baseball training base here this Thursday and even though the old Western town hasn't changed considerably, the Indians have.

On a roster of 43 men, three of whom are currently in military service, 19 of them have never been on the Arizona site and only 16 of the players were with the club as recently as 1961.
