
Medved stated, "It is the feeling of the members that Councilman Trenton has been an outstanding representative for the people of our area."

When Euclid's first municipal judge, William F. Burns, retired in 1968, Smith was appointed by Burns to serve as interim judge. Prior to Burns' retirement, Smith had been asked by the distinguished jurist to serve as interim judge on many occasions.

Smith and his wife, Edna, live at 25751 Lake Shore Blvd. They have five children, all of whom have gone through the Euclid School system.

"I think we have a fine system," Smith said, "and I most certainly will put all the skill and dedication at my command to help maintain the high level of education for which the Euclid school system is noted."
