Iraške čete so odšle včeraj iz Jordanije

Irak je na uradno zahtevo jordanijske vlade včeraj končal umik svojih čet iz Jordanije, kjer so bile od junija 1967.

AMAN, Jord. — Irak je imel v Jordaniji še od junajske vojne 1967 12,000 svojih vojakov, ki naj bi skupaj z jordanijskimi in sirijskimi četami tvorili vzhodno krilo na arabski fronti proti Izraelu. V boju se iraške čete niso obnesle, bile so Jordaniji bolj v nadlegu kot v korist, posebno še, ker so podpirale palestinske gverilce ali pa jim vsaj dajale potujo. Kralj Husein bi se jih bil rad že davno znebil. Zadnji ponedeljek je vlada v Amanu uradno predložila Bagdadu, da svoj "Saladinov zbor", kot so te čete uradno imenovali, umakne dcmov.

Irak je na to pristal in takoj začel umikati svoje oddelke preko meje. Jordaniske čete so ta umik nadzirale, ker je izgledalo, da so hoteli Iračani odpeljati s seboj tudi nekaj jordanjske opreme in orožja.


Ko je prišlo pretekli mesec do boja med palestinskimi gverilci in jordanijsko armado, so iraški oddelki stali mirno ob strani, četudi so preje glasno zatrjevali, da ne bodo dovolili Huseinovim četam klati palestinskih gverilcev. To zadržanje iraških čet v Jordaniji je bilo delno ostre kritike in je privelo do spora v sami vladajoči stranki Baath. V tem sporu in trenju za oblast je bil odstranjen podpredsednik gen. Hardan Takriti.

Tekom teh sporov je bil pozvan domov in Bagdad povelnik Saladinovega zobra gen. Hasan Naguib. V Amanu so trdili, da so vodniki v Bagdadu pošljeli v Saladinov zbor v glavnem častnike, ki jih doma niso marali. Iraški oddelki so bili utaborjeni okoli mesta Mafraq, kakih 55 milij severozhodno od Amana.

ZDA bodo povečale svojo trgovinsko mornarico

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik Nixon je podpisal zakon, v okviru katerega bodo tekem prihodnjih 10 let zgradili 300 novih trgovinskih ladij in obnovili na ta način ameriško trgovinsko mornarico, ki je v zadnjih letih očitno propadala. Predsednik Nixon je s podpisom novega zakona izpolnil obljubo, ki jo je dal v ladjedelnici Lockheed v Seattlu tekom volivne borbe leta 1968.

Na temelju novega programa bo gradnja trgovinskih ladij potrjena. Skupno bo stalo to v 10 letih ZDA 2.7 bilijona dollarjev, bo pa tudi pomagalo ZDA, da postanejo zopet pravvrstna pomorska sila tudi na polju prometa in trgovine. V zadnjih letih je vlada ZDA podpirala letno trgovinsko mornarico z 300 milijoni dolarjev, od tega je šlo za gradnjo ladij 100 milijonov, za njihovo obratovanje pa 200 milijonov.

Bela hiša zanikava govorice o premirju

Predsednikov tiskovni tajnik Ziegler je izjavil, da Bela hiša nima nobenega novoga načrta o Vietnamu.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Sredi tedna so se razširile govorice, da ZDA in Južni Vietnam mislita na proglasitev enostranskega premirja koncem tega meseca.

Gоворите naj bi se razširile v zvezi z objavo sklicanja sestanka glavnih vojaških in političnih svetovalcev in sodelavcev predsednika Van Thieuja v Vnutašnji na koncu 10. zvečer, pa ni mogla napraviti reda. Morala je klicati pomoč, pa še potem je minilo tri ure, predno je bilo ob enih zjutraj, 7. oktobra, demonstracij konec.

Predsednik Van Thieu naj bi bil vojaškim in političnim upraviteljem pokrajine, mestnim županom in drugim naročilnikom in stroge ukrepe kot pravno za proglasitev premirja.

R. Ziegler je dejal časnikarjem, ki so ga spraševali, koliko je na teh govoricah resnice: Minimo namena objaviti nižimo tega, kar je bilo o Vietnamu že objavljeno!" Pripomnil je, da je najhtreša pot h končanju vojskovanja v Indokinu potom poganj. Vlada ZDA še vedno ne smatra, da so rdeči zavrnili Nixonov predlog dokončno.

ZDA bodo povečale svojo trgovinsko mornarico

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik Nixon je podpisal zakon, v okviru katerega bodo tekem prihodnjih 10 let zgradili 300 novih trgovinskih ladij in obnovili na ta način ameriško trgovinsko mornarico, ki je v zadnjih letih očitno propadala. Predsednik Nixon je s podpisom novega zakona izpolnil obljubo, ki jo je dal v ladjedelnici Lockheed v Seattlu tekom volivne borbe leta 1968.

Na temelju novega programa bo gradnja trgovinskih ladij potrjena. Skupno bo stalo to v 10 letih ZDA 2.7 bilijona dollarjev, bo pa tudi pomagalo ZDA, da postanejo zopet pravvrstna pomorska sila tudi na polju prometa in trgovine. V zadnjih letih je vlada ZDA podpirala letno trgovinsko mornarico z 300 milijoni dolarjev, od tega je šlo za gradnjo ladij 100 milijonov, za njihovo obratovanje pa 200 milijonov.

Cleveland, O. — Švedska akademija znanosti je letos podelila Nobelovo nagrado za mir ameriškemu agronomu dr. Borlaugu za napredok, ki ga je dosegel pri pridelovanju pšenice. Na video je to nekaj izrednega in je res izredno. Napredek v pridelovanju ni bil namreč tako lahka stvar, kot na primer iznajde v tehniki in kemiji, kjer laboratorijski igrajo največjo vlogo in pospešujejo postopek, ki vodi do uspeha.

Pri zboljševanju deželnih pridelkov stvar ni tako enostavna. Pri tem postopku so laboratorijski samo v pomoč strokovnjakom, ki iščejo nova poto v poljedelstvu. Glavno delo mora biti opravljeno na njivah, vrtovih, travnikih, gozdovih, gredicah, skratka na prsti in zemljiščih in ne v zaprtih prostorih. Temu pravilu je moral podrediti svoje preiskovanje tudi dr. Borlaug. Ko je končal svoje študije, se je posvetil nalogi kako zboljšati pridelek pšenice.

Začelo se radi športa, končalo pa s politiko!

Odgločitev nogometne zveze v škodo "Hajduka" je povzročila v Splitu demonstracije, ki so se spremenile v izgred proti Beogradu.

CLEVELAND, O. — "Hrvatski glas" poroča v zadnjem številki po jugoslovanskem časopisu o hudo demonstracijah v Splitu 6. in 7. oktobra. Povod za demonstracije je dala odločitev sodniške komisije n o g o metne zveze o tekmi Hajduk-Beograd. Tekma je bila prekinjena pri stanju 2:2, komisija pa jo je prisodila Beogradu v korist 3:0.

Komaj je prišlo to v javnost, se je kolona preko 100 avtomobilov podala v mesto. Demonstracije proti odločitvi v škodo domačega nogometnega moštva Hajduka so kmalu doble popolnoma drug značaj. Na Rivi so prevrnili tri avtomobile z beograjskimi tablicami, dva pa vrgli v morje... Demonstranti so na Titovi obali uničili vse, kar so dosegli. Vsi avtomobili z beograjskimi tablicami in avtomobili domačih režimskih predstavnikov so bili uničeni ali močno poškodovani. Škoda je zelo velika... Milica je nastopila še okoli 10. zvečer, pa ni mogla napraviti reda. Morala je klicati pomoč, pa še potem je minilo tri ure, predno je bilo ob enih zjutraj, 7. oktobra, demonstracij konec.

Poročilo je "Hrvatski glas" povzel po zagrebškem "Vjesniku v srijedu" in po beograjski "Politiki". Sam dodaja, da je očitno, da "je česa polna" in da so Hrvatje v Dalmaciji siti "srbskega izrabljanja in zapostavljanja".

Grčija zaprla mejo proti Turčiji zaradi kolere

ATENE, Gr. — Vlada je zavrnili prila mejo proti Turčiji za veselje epidemije kolere, ki se je pojavila v zahodnem delu Turčije, zlasti v Carigradu, v Grčijo. Zapora meje je odrejena za nedoločen čas.

V čilu se pripravljajo na nastop dr. Allendeja

SANTIAGO, Čile. — Nasprotniki komunizma so se odločili za mirno opozicijo proti poskusom spremeniti republiko Čile v enostransko "ljudsko republiko" po vzoru Kube, ko bo prevzel oblast v deželi socialist dr. Allende 4. novembra. Njegova izvolitev je zagotovljena, ker nimata proti sebi nobenega kandidata. Desničarski kandidat dr. Alessandri je namreč kandidatu umaknil in se izjavil za Allendeja, ki je pri volitvah 4. septembra od treh kandidatov dobil največ glasov, četudi ne večine.

Dr. Allende je obiskal dr. Alessandrija na njegovem domu, ko je postal precej očitno, da v koaliciji, ki je pomagal Allendeju do zmage, ni več prave edinstvenosti in se tri glavne skupine prerivajo med seboj za odločilno mesto v vladi. Vsaka od treh glavnih strank, komunistov, radikalov in socialistov bo dobila tri ministre v novi 15-članski vladi.

Krščanska demokracija bo ostala v opoziciji, čeprav bodo njeni člani jutri glasovali za predsednika Allendeja. Za to so se odločili, ko jim je zagotovil, da bo potrdil dopolnila ustav, ki jamčijo svobodo tiska, delo strank in politične svoboščine. Obljubil je dalje, da ne bo uvažal bistvenih sprememb v politici in vojski.

Devlin tiho pustila ječo

LONDONDERRY, S. Ir. — Bernadette Devlin, najmlajša članica britanskega parlamenta, je v sredo čisto tiho in na skrivaj zapustila ječo, kjer je prestala 4 mesece zapora od 6, na katere je bila obsojena zaradi čuvanja k izgredu tekom nemirov v Londonderryju lani. Izpustili so jo "zaradi dobrega vedenja".

V nedeljo se bo vrnila v London, kjer bo prisegla kot članica parlamenta, v katerega je bila ponovno izvoljena v preteklem juniju, pa se ni mogla udeleževati njegovega zasedanja, ker je bila v ječi.

NIXON IN GROMIKO NISTA MOGLA RAZREŠITI SPOROV

Predsednik ZDA in sovjetski zunanji minister sta se včeraj razgovarjala v Beli hiši dve uri in pol v "priateljskem ozračju", pa nista uspela razčistiti spornih vprašanj, ki ustvarjajo mednarodno napetost.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Sovjetski zunanji minister Andrej Gromiko je prišel včeraj v Washington in bil sprejet pri predsedniku ZDA R. M. Nixonu. Prnjem je bil na razgovoru nekako dve uri in pol. Glavnega dela razgovora sta se udeležila na ameriški strani še državni tajnik W. P. Rogers in dr. H. Kissinger, na sovjetski pa poslanik A. Dobrinin. Razgovor je potekal s pomočjo tolmačev in pomočnikov v sobi poleg predsedniškega urada v Beli hiši. Ob koncu sestanka je predsednik ZDA spremil sovjetskega zunanjega ministra do izpred Beli hiše.

Letno za 350 milijonov več uvoza iz Latinske Amerike

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Zastopnik ZDA je na posvetu gospodarskih strokovnjakov iz Latinske Amerike in Evrope napovedal povečanje uvoza iz držav Latinske Amerike za letno 350 milijonov, če bo seveda Kongres to odobril. To bi pomenilo 8-odstotno povečanje uvoza.

Lani so ZDA uvozile iz držav Latinske Amerike skupno raznega blaga za 4.2 bilijona, prodale pa so tja svojih izdelkov v skupni vrednosti 3.6 bilijonov dolarjev.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Sovjetska zveza je objavila, da bo njeni vesoljsko vozilo Zond 8, ki so ga pognali proti Luni v torek, doseglo Luno jutri in zakrožilo okoli nje, pa se po opravljeni nalogi vrnilo prihodnji terek na Zemljo.

Zond 8 naj bi tekom svoje poti okoli Lune beležilo podatke o Luninem ozračju in o Lunini površini. Luna dejansko ozračja nima, ker je njena težnost premajhna, da bi ga zadržala.

Jaz in moji tovariši se bomo od tega dne dalje borili do smrti ali svobode proti vsaki stvari in vsaki osebi, ki ne podpira naravnega življenja na tem planetu. Materializem mora umreti ali pa bo človeštvo."



VOINOVICH RAPS CRITICS OF KENT STATE GRAND JURY REPORT

"Those demagogues from the ranks of the 'loud minority' who criticize in strident tones the report by the Portage County Grand Jury on Kent State are, in actuality, playing political ping pong with the safeguards of the American system of government," George Voinovich, candidate for re-election for State Representative in the 53rd District, said recently.

Voinovich said he was distressed by the tirade put out against this report by the American Civil Liberties Union, ex-president Morse of Case-Western Reserve University, militant student radical groups at Kent State, and Congressman Louis Stokes.

"These people are having nothing more than a 'temper tantrum' because the report does not seem to fit with their preconceived idea of what the Portage County Grand Jury should do."

"Yet, this Grand Jury investigated over 200 witnesses and to criticize them in such violent manner raises the question as to whether or not they are trying to indicate that the people on this grand jury lacked integrity and honesty in so making the report."

If this small minority of students is not in college to study, but only to participate in riots, then they ought to be kicked off the campus and kicked off immediately."

Voinovich said he was unhappy with the result of the President's Commission's report on the Kent State incident because it did not fit in with what they thought actually occurred, but they believe in the system and respected the integrity of the members of the commission.

"The basic issue goes much deeper than the Portage County

Is Daylight Savings Time worth the trouble?

"War Time." After the wars some cities kept the fast time in summer months to give their citizens more sun hours after work. The rural communities found it to be to their disadvantage.

How does the changing of the time from standard to savings and back make individuals irritable? For approximately one week following the last Sundays in April and October we lose one hour of sleep a night. To illustrate: In the spring the mechanical clocks say we have to arise one hour earlier than normal, but our brain tells us to go back to sleep, it isn't time to get up yet. So we must rise one hour before our accustomed time. In the fall, after the clocks are turned back, we awaken one hour before we must. This goes on day after day until we readjust. The loss of one hour's sleep each night accumulates to make us bleary-eyed with circles under our eyes with an appearance of post-nocturnal droop and a marked grouchy disposition.

Sleep is essential to life. The brain needs rest. The physical muscular parts of the body do not need the sleep but the brain does. Falling asleep is a complicated process that does not occur in one quick motion. First a person becomes less and less aware of his surroundings. Then his sensations leave: first sight, then taste, smell, hearing, and touch. Then he goes into a succession of five to six cycles that go from light sleep to deep sleep. Generally speaking, a person can tell if he has had a

good rest if he wakes up in the morning without being called, and if he is not drowsy during waking hours, especially in the afternoon.

Rapid Eye Movement (REM) occurs when a person is dreaming. Scientists have found that REM sleep is important. They have discovered that when a person is deprived of his REM sleep by being awakened early he may develop symptoms of emotional and mental disturbances. When a man dreams, he acts out all his frustrations and emotions repressed during the day. If he doesn't get his normal amount of sleep he will carry these frustrations with him into the next day.

To combat the potential danger, prevention has been used. A major oil company has instructed its employees to do NOTHING for 24 hours after they have crossed a time zone. They believe a one-day loss of work is cheaper than an accounting error or loss of sale.

For the rest of us who cannot take a work stoppage or drop out of social contact with our families the best weapon we can employ to combat lurking irritability is awareness.

If we realize we will be sleepy and not up-to-par we have won half the battle. The other half is not let irritability overcome good intelligence. Good friends and family are irreplaceable. Some people favor savings time, others like standard time. Which is better is not debated here. The point being made is everyone should be wary of the changing of the time. It can be irritating.

Denver, Colo. — On October 4, 1970, Denver-area lovers of Slovenian folk music had the rare privilege to hear one of the world's great masters of the diatonic "button" accordion, Lojze Slak, with his trio and the male vocal quintet "Fantje s Proptno."

The Slovenian Home was jam-packed with happy people, who thoroughly enjoyed a presentation of old and new, instrumental and vocal, spiced by the delightful humor of the gifted actress Jana Osojnik.

Mr. Slak and his group skillfully presented a combination of his own compositions, among them "Po dekle," "Ej prijatelj," "Deželica sonca in grozdja," "Svatje že vriskajo," and the latest "Visoko nad oblaki"; and the traditional songs "Sem šel čez gmajnico," "Kje je moj mili dom," and "Pri farni cerkvici,"

sung unaccompanied so beautifully that they drew the audience to a reverent silence. Following the concert, Mr. Slak and his ensemble played for dancing for more than two hours. This was a day that we all enjoyed thoroughly, and hope that it won't be long before there can be another like it.

A frequently-asked question was: "Why did he keep changing accordions?" As I wrote in a previous article, the "button" accordion does not have a chromatic scale, but is built so that each row plays in a certain key, e.g. C Major or G major, etc., with the rows arranged according to the musical "circle of fifths." Thus, a three-row instrument can be built in C, F and Bb, A, D and G, Eb, Ab and Db, or any similar combination of keys. It becomes necessary to change instruments in order
