IN KDO JE MOJ BLIŽNJI?

Današnji evangelij je zelo pomemben, ker nam kaže, kako si moramo predstavljati ljubezen, kako moramo ljubiti bližnjega.

K Jezusu pride učitelj postave in ga hoče preizkusiti z zanimivim vprašanjem: »Učitelj, kaj naj storim, da dosežem večno življenje?« V nadaljevanju Jezus tega moža postavi na preizkušnjo, ko ga prisili, da spremeni svojo miselnost učitelja postave.

Učitelj postave mora vedeti, kaj piše v postavi, zato ga Jezus vpraša: »Kaj je pisano v postavi? Kako bereš?«

Učiteljev odgovor je odličen, čisto po Jezusovemu nauku: »Ljubi Gospoda, svojega Boga, iz vsega srca, z vso dušo, z vso močjo in z vsem mišljenjem, in svojega bližnjega kakor samega sebe.« Jezus ga pohvali, rekoč: »Prav si odgovoril, to delaj in boš živel.«

Učitelj postave pa želi vedeti, kako je treba razlagati zapoved ljubezni do bližnjega, zato Jezusa prosi, naj pojasni meje te ljubezni. Niso vsi ljudje sami po sebi že naši bližnji. Do kod moramo torej imeti ljudi za bližnje? Je dovolj ljubiti ljudi iz lastne družine, ali pa tudi tiste iz našega mesta, iz našega naroda? Po judovski miselnosti se onkraj te točke ni moglo iti.

Jezus pa ne odgovori neposredno na to vprašanje, ampak odgovori z življenjsko zgodbo. »Neki človek je šel iz Jeruzalema v Jeriho ...« Jezus preprosto govorí o »nekem človeku«; ne pove, ali je bil Jud ali Samarijan ali pogán. Gre iz Jeruzalema v Jeriho in naleti na razbojnike. Ti ga slečejo in pretepejo, pustijo napol mrtvega, potem in odidejo. Gre torej za človeka, ki se je znašel v skrajni stiski.

Po tej cesti gre duhovnik, in ko ga vidi, gre mimo po drugi strani, enako tudi levit. Jezus ne pojasni razlogov za njuno obnašanje. Fizični stik z ranjencem bi ju, po judovski postavi, lahko onesposobil - napravil za obredno nečiste - za opravljanje bogoslužnih obredov, zato se raje umakneta.

Pa pride mimo neki Samarijan, ki je na potovanju, vidi ranjenega

človeka, vidi njegovo trpljenje, vidi, da potrebuje pomoč, in se ga usmili. Obveže mu rane, ga naloži na svoje živinče - kar pomeni, da sedaj Samarijan hodi peš ob ranjenem, kot služabnik - potem ga pelje v gostišče in poskrbi zanj. Zaupa ga gostilničarju z obljubo, da se bo vrnil in poplačal morebitne stroške. Čudovita človeška solidarnost! S tem svojim dejanjem Samarijan postane bližnji nesrečniku v stiski.

Jezus na koncu vpraša učitelja postave: »Kateri izmed the treh, se ti zdi, je bližnji tistem, ki je padel med razbojnike?« Jezus začetno vprašanje učitelja postave obrne na glavo. Odgovor učitelja je jasen: »Tisti, ki mu je skazal usmiljenje.« Jezus mu je rekel: »Pojdi in tudi ti tako delaj!«

Tako je Jezus učitelja postave prisilil k spremembam. Predvsem potrebujemo spremembo miselnosti: ne imeti predsodkov, ne postavljati ločitev, ampak biti odprtih do vseh, ki so blizu nas in so v potrebi. Zanje moramo narediti vse, kar je v naših močeh.

Prvo berilo nas vabi, naj verujemo, da je to učenje zelo jasno; zato ni treba iti ne na nebo in ne onkraj morja, da bi poiskali pojasmilo. Gre za očitno resničnost, ki je v našem srcu in v naših ustih, da bi jo uresničili. Jezusov nauk je nauk brezmejne ljubezni. Podreti je treba pregrade in predsodke in postati bližnji vsem.

Drugo berilo nam pokaže na temelj Jezusove ljubezni: »Vse je bilo ustvarjeno po njem in zanj.« Beseda v stvarstvo ne polaga ločitev, ampak vsem stvarem in vsem ljudem daje bivanje, življenje in srečo.

Potem, ko se je človeštvo zaradi greha razdelilo, se je Božja Beseda učlovečila, da bi ves svet spravila z Bogom, »da je po njem spravil s sabo vse stvarstvo, saj je s krvjo njegovega križa pomiril, kar je na zemlji in kar je v nebesih.« Gre za vesoljno spravo. Razsežnosti Kristusovega dela presegajo vsako mejo.

Zato Jezus tudi od nas zahteva, da imamo odprto srce za vse. On, ki je povsod kot Božji Sin in je odrešil vse, nas prosi, naj mu z velikodušnostjo, združeni z njim in gnani po njegovi ljubezni pomagamo, da bo njegova milost dosegla vse ljudi.

When Jesus was asked what the most important commandment is, he told the story of the Good Samaritan.

In 2018, marine archaeologists announced that, in the Black Sea, they had found an intact sunken Greek merchant ship dating from approximately 400 BC. The world's oldest-known intact shipwreck lies on its side, 1.5 miles deep and far beyond the reach of modern divers. Its cargo of wine, olive oil and other trading goods is untouched and undamaged. Experts think that the ship sank in bad weather, perhaps swamped by a massive freak wave. Even today, despite advanced on-board technology, such an unpredictable monster wave can swamp and sink a vessel, giving the crew no time to respond to the danger. Perhaps, when the wave struck, it simply sank like a stone. Perhaps this also explains why the ancient shipwreck appears undamaged.



In 2004, an extreme wave struck Alderney, in the Channel Islands, with such force and pressure that it would have destroyed almost any merchant vessel sailing the high seas today. The Greek wooden trading ship and its crew didn't stand a chance.

Coincidentally, today's Gospel story of the Good Samaritan reminds us of the Good Samaritans who serve through the Coast Guard, lifeboat crews, helicopter rescue service and first responders who sometimes risk their own lives to save others.

Gospel teaching

Jesus was a fantastic storyteller. It's why even non-Christians and atheists will quite happily describe someone as "a Good Samaritan", knowing the meaning of the expression even if they don't know the story.

In Jesus' day, any traveller risked meeting bandits. Traditionally, we associate highwaymen threatening their potential victims with the words "your money or your life". Did this happen to the traveller in Jesus' story or did the bandits just attack him anyway? Perhaps he put up a fight to

defend himself and his property rather than just handing it over: we don't know and Jesus doesn't tell us. What he does say is that two people who should have been prepared to help the injured man ignored him. Perhaps they had good excuses for hurrying on towards Jerusalem. We don't know. Jesus, however, draws attention to a Samaritan, someone who was despised in Israel but who didn't think twice about responding to someone in need even if his support cost him time and money.

Those who listened to Jesus were unimpressed: the priest and the Levite deserved greater respect than Jesus gave them. Instead, he showed them someone to whom public opinion and social status meant nothing when somebody needed help. Did the injured man call out the equivalent of an SOS? We don't know.

The Good Samaritan was the first responder and that was all that mattered. He'd saved a life and continued his journey without looking for thanks.

Application

We take it for granted that any ship in distress will send an SOS or a Mayday signal and that other vessels and the emergency services, hearing the cry for help, will respond. We remember 25-year-old Jack Phillips, the Titanic wireless operator. Only four years after SOS became the official, internationally recognised call for help, Phillips sent urgent signals from the Titanic, hoping for a rescue that could save lives, knowing that his would not be one of them. His heroism on 15 April 1912 enabled 712 of the 2,208 people aboard to survive the ship's sinking. Through his persistence, the Carpathia and other ships travelled out of their way on their rescue mission to the Titanic. There were many Good Samaritans that day, most of whom are known only to God.
