Sovjetska pomoč Indiji Iz slov. naselbin morda nevarno darilo!

Sovjetsko ponudbo Indiji za napredok mejnega ozemlja proti Kitajski smatrajo za nevarno — Sovjetiji bo od-

krila večino vojaških tajn.
NEW DELHI, Ind. — Kitajski komunisti se trudijo, da bi zrahljali moralni odpor indijskega prebivalstva v obmejnih predelih. Pri tem ne izbirajo sredstev, vsa so jim dobrodošla. India je nevarnost spoznala in je ustanovila posebni urad, ki se posveča gospodarskemu napredku teh predelov in skrbi prav posebej za zgradbo cest in drugih prometnih sredstev.

Ta urad je sedaj na temelju dogovora med Indijo in ZSSR posiljal v Moskvo svoje zastopnike kупити съветски прометни напрave, med drugim tudi večje število helikopterjev. V okviru sporazuma bodo prišli v indijsko-kitajsko obmejno področje tudi sovjetski strokovnjaki, ki bodo pomagali graditi ceste in razne vojaške naprave. Da se bodo pri tem z njimi natančno seznanili, ni nobenega dvoma.

Nerazumljiva kratkovidnost
V zahodnih krogih, posebno v Vel. Britaniji so začeli resno razmisljati o ustanovitvi prodaje novejšega orožja in vojaški potrebski Indiji, da ne bi preko nje prišle angleške vojaške skrivnosti v sovjetske roke. Čudijo se, kako da Nehru in njegov obrambni minister ne razumeta, da sta Sovjeti in redče Kitajska vojaški zavezni, pa naj bosta trenutno tudi v "ideološkem sporu."

Sovjetska zveza je objavila pomagati Indiji z raznimi potrebsčinami v višini 31 milijonov dolarjev za razvoj in ureditev obmejnih predelov. S to pomočjo bo Sovjetom omogočeno novirano vohanje v vsem območju predelu Indije od Barme do Pakistana. Njegovi uspehi bodo v slučaju potrebe zelo verjetno na razpolago tudi — Kitajcem.

Indijski sprejem sovjetske pomoči ne bi bil še tako nerazumljiv, če bi ne bilo mogoče dobiti pomoči na Zahodu, pa izgleda, da se Indija v tem pogledu nanj ni niti obrnila. Krišna Menon je znani levičar, ki mu je Moskva še vedno veliko bližje kot London ali Washington!

Kennedy in Nixon bosta nočoj zopet na televiziji

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Predsedniška kandidata se bosta nočoj pogovarjala na televiziji o zunanjih politiki. Demokrat Kennedy je predložil ponovno še peti nastop na televiziji, ki naj bi bil bližje samim volivtivom, republikanski kandidat Nixon je predlog zavrnil, pa predložil, naj se namesto petega nastopa četrti podaljša od ene na dve ure. Kennedy je na podaljšanje pristal, toda v mreže so ga odklonile.

Nočojšnji zastop je določen od 10. do 11. ure. Vršil se bo pod istimi pogoji kot zadnja dve.

Mao ne pojde v Moskvo

HONG KONG. — Po vesteh, ki prihajajo iz rdeče Kitajske, Mao-Tsetung ne bo šel na sestank komunističnih vodnikov, ki ga je sklical v Moskvo Nikita Hruščev za obletnico boljševiške revolucije.

Na sestanek bosta odšla po tukajšnjih napovedih predsednik Kitajske ljudske republike Liu-Sao-čin in predsednik vlade Ču-Enlaj. V zahodnih diplomatskih krogih sodijo, da čas za srečanje komunističnih "velikih dveh" še ni prišel.

Mao je bil zadnjji v Moskvi jeseni 1957 ob 40-letnici boljševiške revolucije. Hruščev je bil d tedej že dvakrat v Peipingu, tako je torej sedaj Mao na vrsti, da poroma v Moskvo.

Moskva v Peipingu sta v ideološkem sporu o neobhodnosti vojne. Moskva trdi, da vojna ni nujna, Peiping pa je na stalnšču, da brez nje ni končne zmage nad capitalizmom. V Moskvi so tudi nejedvolutni zaradi kitajskoga spora z Indijo in so Peipingu prevarjali, naj se umakne z indijskega ozemlja v Ladaku. Peiping je te predloge odklonil.

Med volivci, ki so se dali na novo registrirati, je največ mladine.

Število novih registracij za posamezne države še ni dokončno ugotovljeno, obstajajo pa zanje precej zanesljive cenitve. Vseh ne moremo navesti. Najomenimo samo državo Ohio. Vseh registriranih volivcev je 3,582,000, dočim jih je bilo leta 1958 le 3,258,000. Največ jih odpade na Cleveland. Pred dvema letoma jih je bilo registriranih 768,000, letos pa 825,000.

Usoša Juž. Tirolske pred Združenimi narodi

ZDRAVENI NARODI, N. Y. — Pred posbenim političnim odborom ZN je prišla na vrsto ponova pritožba Avstrije, da Italija pregača nemško manjšino v južnem Tirolu.

Obtožba ne navaja nobenih novih podatkov, opisuje samo, kako so Laški "napredovali" v posameznih metodah pregačanja tirolskih Nemcev. Tudi laška obramba ne pove ničesar novega; trdi samo, da nemška naročna manjšina sploh ne obstoji in da dunajščina zahteva, naj dobijo Nemci tak položaj, kot ga ima Sicilija, ne pomeni ničesar drugačega kot pripravo za zahtevo, naj pride nemški del južne Tirolske zupet pod Avstrijo.

Kot se vidi sta ostala laški in nemški nacionalizem tako, kot sta bila: neposredljiva! In vendar imata samo nekaj kilometrov v Švici lep primer, kako se dajo urediti vprašanja narodnih manjšin.

TORONTO, Ont. — Ontarijska farmarska unija je mnenja, naj bi celotno prebivalstvo pokrajine nosilo odgovornost za morebitno škodo na letini. Zakonodajni skupščini je predložila, naj bi vlad vzela odgovornost za zavarovanje letine.

Unija trdi, da se morajo koristiti napredka v poljedelstvu in njegove večje učinkovitosti, zato je tudi prav, da nosijo vse tveganje, ki je zvezano z vsako letino.

Po predlogu, ki ga je stavila farmarska unija, naj bi zvezna pokrajinska vlada nosili vse administrativne stroške zavarovanja in plačevalne tudi polovicam županovnih premij.

Vladna skupina dognala ugled ZDA v - upadanju!

Posebna skupina strokovnjakov vladnih ustanov je po dolgi preiskavi na ukaz samega predsednika Eisenhowera dognala, da je ugled Združenih držav od jeseni 1957, ko je ZSSR poslala svoj prvi "sputnik" na pot okoli Zemlje, v stalnem upadanju. Objava ugotovitev bo odložena za čas po volitvah, vendar je že sedaj povzročila živahnou debato, ker je to eno izmed osnovnih vprašanja volivne borbe.

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Znana prestolniška lista The Washington Post in Times-Herald sta prinesla poročilo o tajni skupini osobja zvezne vlade, ki je po nalogu predsednika Eisenhowera od preteklega decembra pručevala razpoloženje v svetu do ZDA. Ta skupina je dognala, da je ugled ZDA od jeseni 1957, ko je ZSSR poslala prvega Sputnika okoli Zemlje, v upadanju. Po poročilu omenjenih listov je skupina dognala v devetih od desetih držav, kjer je skušala dognati razpoloženje v javnem mnenju, da je ugled ZDA brez dvoma v upadanju. Pri preiskavi so sodelovali člani U. S. Information Agency in člani Centralne obveščevalne službe. Zbrane podatke so nato izročili predsedniku imenovani tajni skupini, na katere čelu je baje Mansfield Sprague, podpredsednik American Machine & Foundry Co., bivši pomožni obrambni tajnik.

Quemoy in Matsu v volivni borbi

Ko so kitajski komunisti leta 1949 zavzeli kitajsko celino, so se ostanki nacionalističnih čet in nasprotniki komunizma umaknili na Formozo in otočja vzdolj kitajske obale. Ker komunisti niso imeli pomorskih sil, niso mogli naložiti zasesti teh otokov. Bilo je že resno vprašanje, ali se bo mogla obdržati sama Formoza. ZDA v onih dneh niso kaže posbenega zanimanja za njo. Šele korejska vojna je opozorila ZDA, kaj lahko pričakujejo od komunistične kitajske vlade Mao-Tsetunga, ki so ga preje proglašali za "agrarnega reformatorja."

Truman je tedaj poslal sedmo floto v formozanske vode braniti Formozo in sosednja otočja pred napadi s kitajsko kopno in kopno pred morebitnimi napadi s Formoze. Vprašanje obalnih otočij, posebno Quemoy in Matsu, je ostalo odprto. Quemoy obsega skupno 60 kv. milj. Njen živi okoli 40,000 civilistov, imajo pa 70,000 mož vojske posadke. Otoče se na enem kraju približa kitajski celini, ki je pod oblastjo komunistov, na drugem pa je pod oblastjo komunistov, na dve milji. Zapira vhod v pristanišče Amoy. Matsu otoče je manjše, meri samo 12 kv. milj in ima kakih 12,000 civilnega prebivalstva ter okoli 22,000 mož vojske posadke. Leži pred pristaniščem Fučov in lahko nadzira njegovo plovbo. Quemoy je oddaljen od Formoze okoli 140 milj, Matsu pa okoli 125 milj.

Z ozirom na lego otočij je razumljivo, da sta ti dve za obrambo Formoze in Peskadorov kaj malo pomembni in vredni, služili pa bi odlično kot oporišči za pohod na kitajsko celino. Dokler sta ti dve otočji v oblasti Čangkajška, ta še vedno lahko govorijo o vrtnitvi na celino, o zrušitvi komunistične oblasti na Kitajskem. Kakor hitro bi se z njih umaknil, je jasno, da na povratak na celino ne more več veliko upati.

Ko so kitajski komunisti septembra 1954 začeli ostro obstreljevati Quemoy, so ZDA 2. decembra tega leta podpisale z vlado nacionalne Kitajske na Formozi vojaško pogodbo, v kateri so se obvezale pomagati braniti Formozo in Peskader in "taka druga področja, ki bi jih določil skupni sporazum." V začetku prihodnjega leta je Kongres izglasoval posebno resolucijo, v kateri je pooblastil predsednika ZDA, da lahko uporabi oborožene sile ZDA "kot se njemu zdi potrebno za obrambo Formoze in Peskaderov . . . pripadajočih položajev in ozemlj sedaj v prijateljskih rokah."

V aprilu so se začeli na predlog rdeče Kitajske razgovori med ZDA in Kitajsko ljudsko republiko za "odstranitev napetosti" na področju Formoze. Razgovori so se vlekli do 1. 1958, ko so v avgustu začeli komunisti nenadno težko obstreljevati otočji Quemoy in Matsu. Napovedovali so poskus izkrcanja in osvojitve otočij. Tedaj je Eisenhower dejal na tiskovni konferenci, da je "osnovno vprašanje izogniti se umiku pred silo, ne pa uporabiti silo za reševanje teh vprašanj." Dodal je: "Kot vojak sem prepričan, da ni bilo dobro spraviti tja (na Quemoy in Matsu) vse te čete. Osnovno more vsakdo videti, da ti dve otočji sami za se, kot dva kosa ozemlja, nista velikega življenjskega pomena za Formozo!"

Otoče je ostalo v Čangkajških rokah, čeprav so nekateri neutralci predlagali, da bi bilo za pomiritev položaja na Daljnem vzhodu in za ustalitev razmer na področju Formoze nujno, da se Čangkajške čete umaknijo z omenjenih dveh otočij, kot so se umaknile s Tačen in Nanči otokov februarja 1955. To stališče je dobilo močno oporo v Veliki Britaniji in tudi v naši severni sosedji Kanadi.

Vprašanje je bilo skoro mrtvo, dokler ni na drugem skupnem televizijskem nastopu eden izmed izraševalcev stavljal Kennedyu vprašanje, kaj misli o obrambi Quemoya in Matsu. Kennedy je odgovoril, da smatra, da teh dveh otočij ne smemo v slučaju vojne vključiti v svojo trdno obrambo, ker da jih vojaško ni mogoče braniti. Poudaril je, da so ZDA vezane v smislu pogodbe braniti le Formozo in Peskader. Z izjavo je napravil vtis, kot da ZDA v slučaju napada otočij Quemoy in Matsu ne bodo pomagale braniti. Podpredsednik Nixon, ki so ga strankarski pristaši prijemali, da na prvem televizijskem nastopu s Kennedym ni bil dosti udaren, je takoj označil Kennedyjevo stališče za "napačno" in izjavil, da je otočji treba braniti "načelno," ker da ne smemo odstopiti komunistom niti ene inče svobodnega sveta.

Debata se je začela in je bila v polnem teku na tretjem nastopu na televiziji. Kennedy je prijeman Nixonom, da hoče raztegniti ameriško varstvo nad obalni otočji, ki ju ni mogoče braniti. Nixon pa je napadal Kennedyja, da se je pravljil umakniti pred komunističnim pritiskom.

Kennedy je v nedeljo na televizijskem sporedu v razgovoru s časnikarji, dejal, da se on v pogledu obrambe otočij popolnoma strinja s stališčem sedanja vlade in je pripravljen debato zaključiti, ker je Nixon izjavil, da je naistem stališču. V torek se mu je zdelo potrebo podariti pred veterani v Miami znova, da bo on v slučaju, če bo izvoljen, izpol-

nil vse obveznosti ZDA in da se pred silo ne bo nikjer umikal.

Cela debata je bila brez dvoma popolnoma nepotrebna. Do nje je prišlo v ihti volivne borbe, v naglici nastopa na televiziji. Kandidata sta z njo svoji deželi in prav posebno njeni vladci napravila težkoče, ki so popolnoma nepotrebne. Naj bo izvoljen katerikoli, mu bodo izjave iz te debate nemara hodile narobe.

Toda že v nedeljo pred tem, to je 9. sept., so imeli v Clevelandu slovenski mladinski koncert, ki ga je pripravil in izpeljal Tone Šubelj. Sporeda obeh koncertov sta ohranjena še danes in delata čast obema povodnjema. O prvem koncertu je napisal Ivan Jontez v Cankarjevem glasniku, 1941, str. 155, od koder so povzeti ti podatki takole:

"Na odru je stala v vzornem redu velika skupina slovenskih otrok, fantov in deklic v starosti od 5 do 15 let, verno upirajočih oči v svojega pevovodja Antona Sublja . . . V dvorani je bilo vse točno, in mirno; ljudje so zadrževali dih, kakor da bi se bali, da bi s preglašnim dihanjem ne motili ubranega petja. Ko sem pogledal po obražih okrog sebe, sem opazil v mnogih očeh sumljivo bleščanje. Moja sosedka pa je komaj slišno zašepatala, kakor bi molila: "Kdo bi si mislil! Naši otroci pojo slovensko pesem; pa še tako lepo! Ko so pevci odpeli prvo točko, je za trenutek nastala v dvorani smrtna tihota, potem pa se je tisočglava množica nenadoma razgibalna in v dvorani je zabobnel vihar nepopisnega navdušenja."

Navdušenje, ki sta ga vzbušila prva mladinska koncerta v Clevelandu, se ni poleglo, kakor se to rado zgodi po prvem ognju. Ljudje so se zavedli, da se materinski jezik na tujem zlašti med mladino najlaže ohrani z domačo pesmijo. Pod pokroviteljstvom Delavskega doma v Collinwoodu, in v oskrbi staršev, je bil ustanovljen nadaljnji mladinski pevski zbor, ki še danes deluje; v Euclidu so ustanovili "Škrjančke", v Newburghu "Kanarčke", v West Parku na zapadni strani mesta pa "Zvončke". Vsi ti zbori so bili sprva pod vodstvom L. Šemeta; Tone Šubelj se je bil namreč kmalu po omenjenem svojem koncertu vrnil v New York, kjer je kmalu organiziral poseben slovenski mladinski zbor. Njega bi imenoval drugega pionirja slovenskih mladinskih pevskih zborov; saj je temu stal zvest vse do danes, ko še vedno vodi mladinski pevski zbor pri enem izmed tukajšnjih društev SNPJ. Poleg že omenjenih mladinskih pevskih zborov so nastali v tistem času v Clevelandu še "Črički" in "Kraljčki", dva druga naša mladinska pevska zbara, ki ju je počeval rajnki pesnik Ivan Zorman, ki tako zasluži naslov tretjega pionirja slovenskega mladinskega pevskega udejstvovanja v našem mestu. Po Jontezovi sodbi so imeli vsi ti zbori 1. 1941 okrog 330 pevcev in so vsi poslovali pod vodstvom obočnih staršev. Skupno so podali do tega leta okrog 30 koncertov. Nastopili so nekajkrat tudi združeno. Tudi na radiju so nastopali.

Pogoji za napredok slovenskih mladinskih pevskih zborov so bili in so še danes dobrni. Naša mladina je imela in ima tudi še danes rada slovensko pesem; dovezeta je zanjo. Hvala Bogu, imeli smo ter jih imamo še danes tudi dobre pevske učitelje. Starši so se vedno ter se tudi danes zanimali za usodo teh zborov. Ne dvomim, da bo tudi nedeljski koncert Mladinskega pevskega društva Slavček v dvorani pri Sv. Vidu vse to polni meri potrdil.

Roy Face Gives Tip on Fork Ball:

Here is the story on how Roy Face's fork ball works:



NATIONAL DEFENSE STUDENT LOAN PROGRAM. Lawrence G. Dertchick, U. S. Commissioner of Education, has announced the allocation of \$57.7 million to colleges and universities participating in the National Defense Student Loan Program for the 1960-61 academic year. Schools in the Cleveland area receiving funds are: Baldwin-Wallace College, Case Institute of Technology, Cleveland Institute of Art, Cleveland Institute of Music, Cleveland-Marshall Law School, Dyke College, Fenn College, Notre Dame College, St. John's College, West Reserve University, and Ursuline College.

The Student Loan Program, authorized under Title II of the National Defense Education Act, is designed to encourage and assistable students to continue their higher education, who might otherwise have financial difficulty in doing so. Approximately 135,000 students have obtained loans since the program began eighteen months ago. At present a total of 1,407 colleges and universities are participating.

U. S. COAST GUARD ACADEMY

The U. S. Coast Guard has announced that the annual competitive examination for appointment to the U. S. Coast Guard Academy at New London, Connecticut will be held nationwide on February 20 and 21, 1961. These examinations will be given in 123 cities (including Cleveland). There are no Congressional appointments or geographical quotas for entrance to the Coast Guard Academy. All qualified young men who are interested should write for details and applications as soon as possible to U. S. Coast Guard Headquarters, Washington 25, D. C. Applications must be postmarked on or before January 10th.

A candidate for the next examination for the Coast Guard Academy must be single, must have reached his seventeenth but not his twenty-second birthday by July 1, 1961, and must be in excellent physical condition. A high school diploma is the minimum educational requirement, although high school seniors assured of being graduated by June 30 are eligible to take the examination if they will have at least 15 credits by that time. All applicants must have three units of English, two of Algebra, and one in Plane Geometry by graduation. There is a great opportunity offered young men who choose this four-year course. Successful completion leads to a commission as a career officer in America's oldest sea-going service and a Bachelor of Science degree.

Branko Krsmanovich Chorus of Yugoslavia Coming to Cleveland

One of Europe's oldest, most distinguished musical organizations, the Branko Krsmanovich Chorus of Yugoslavia, will make its long awaited appearance in Cleveland, O. on Saturday evening, November 12 at the Cleveland Music Hall under the sponsorship of the Cleveland Opera Association, Inc.

Making its debut in the United States and Canada, the company of eighty young men and women is the largest choral organization, domestic or foreign ever to tour so extensively on these shores.

Playing a most important part in the renaissance and recognition of Yugoslavian choral music since the war is Bogdan Babich who is the inspiring conductor of the Chorus.

Mr. Babich's devotion to Yugoslavian music inspired him to turn to composing and arranging, and many of his special arrangements have been sung by the chorus to critical plaudits throughout Europe. Of these, three will be sung on the American tour: "Hoska Svita" (a choral suite in Serbo-Croat); "Cucul" ("The Forest Devil," sung in Macedonian) and a special arrangement of a passage from Peter Jonjovic's opera "Kostana."

The first two sections of the program to be sung here by the Chorus will run the gamut of choral works from such masters of the 16th century as Monteverdi and Gallus-Petelin through the romantics of the 19th century, to the contemporary works of such men as Oroff and Skalovski.

Among the instruments to be heard here are the *zurla*, an ancient type of oboe favored in Macedonia and Bosnia; the *toupan*, a national drum played with large and small sticks in contrasting rhythms; the *frula* a pastoral ancestor of the flute; and the *Dvojnitze*, a wind instrument consisting of two pipes for principal and counter melodies. The exciting music of the chorus was recorded recently in Jugoton, Yugoslavia and has just been released for American collectors.

Reviews by European critics have been unanimous in praising the chorus. Very few of the world's great choruses can claim enjoyment of such fabulous reviews from such widely different parts of the world. The appearance in Cleveland of the Branko Krsmanovich Chorus promises to be one of the most exciting, colorful and musically satisfying events in a number of concert seasons.



Centralized Information Service



Map indicates how Ohio is divided into four code areas for direct dialing of long distance calls. Centralized information center for obtaining telephone numbers in the northeast portion (216 code area) will be in operation at Canton beginning October 16. Similar centers in the other three areas will be inaugurated later.

Centralized information service to assist telephone users dialing long distance calls to most points throughout northeastern Ohio was inaugurated Sunday, Oct. 16.

The new information center is located in Ohio Bell's exchange building in downtown Canton. Information operators there will be equipped to provide telephone numbers for any dialable community in the "216" Direct Distance Dialing area within a matter of seconds.

Increased speed in obtaining "Information" will be aided by the fact that telephone users will be able to dial directly into the Canton center without charge from anywhere in the country where Direct Distance Dialing is in operation.

Callers from within the northeastern Ohio "216" code area will be able to reach the information center by following exactly the same dialing procedure they use for dialing the actual long distance calls. The telephone number of the information center will be 555-1212.

Persons wishing to reach the information center from points outside the northeastern Ohio "216" code area naturally must dial the 216 code ahead of the center's telephone number.



Monuments to Pres. (Maj. Gen.) Garfield and Maj. Gen. M. D. Leggett

Rarely indeed has any place in the South been named for a Union general of the Civil War.

Ohio's General William Tecumseh Sherman in his book stated: "Along Peach Tree Creek was an eminence then called Bald Hill, but since known as Leggett's Hill, from which Atlanta could be shelled". This hill was named for Major General Mortimer D. Leggett, commander of the Third Division of the 17th Army Corp, whose troops captured the location from General Hood's troops in the battle of Atlanta.

General Leggett, from Montville in northeastern Ohio, entered the Union army as Colonel of the 78th Ohio Volunteer Infantry which was organized at Zanesville, January 11, 1861. This regiment was at the battle of Shiloh as well as in the Atlanta campaign, for which Ohio supplied 76 regiments of infantry, seven regiments of cavalry and fifteen batteries of artillery.

National Youth Conference on the Atom

Thirty-one more top high school science students have been nominated in area competition to send six Northeast Ohio delegates to the second national Youth Conference on the Atom.

New names were listed by The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Co., sponsor of the program in this area. Among them was Patricia Opaskar of Regina High School.

All told, 54 science "whiz kids" have now been named by their principals as candidates to attend the unique annual assembly. The nominating period ended Wednesday, October 5.

From the record number of candidates — 11 more than last year — the best six will be determined this week. The Illuminating Company said. Judges, representing the cream of faculty science experts at Cleveland's five major colleges, will pick the delegates on the basis of interest, science ability and all-round leadership.

In store for the six prize winners, plus two of their teachers, is a 3-day look at the peaceful atom, October 20, 21 and 22, at Chicago's famed Museum of Science and Industry.

The agenda will include reports from both business and government in all fields, and information experts on the status of atomic tours of two of the country's leading atomic facilities near Chicago.

Teachers who will accompany the local student delegation will be the two named for the No. 1 and 2 ranking students of the top six.

All trip and meeting expenses for the Northeast Ohio group will be paid by The Illuminating Co.
