Steve Valencic Honored by Button Boxers

Eddie "Zeke" Vertovsnik thought it was time someone gave Steve Valencic a little respect. Zeke feels Steve is one of those volunteers behind the scenes whose good works should be acknowledged.

On Sunday, April 4, Zeke planned to present Steve with a plaque and proclamation at the Super Button Box Bash at the Slovenian Society Home in Euclid, Ohio. But Zeke is battling a serious illness, and it prevented him from personally making the presentation.

Zeke insisted the show go on without him, and it did. Steve received a clock with a hand-painted portrait of himself, and a proclamation from Zeke and Charlie and Friends.

Aside from the fact Steve is Zeke's good friend and button accordion player with "Zeke and Charlie," Steve helps out whenever called upon and on his own.

Tony Petkovsek knows first hand because Steve has been a member of the Cleveland Slovenian Radio Club for 35 years. "We call Steve our troubleshooter," said Tony. "He is ready to help anywhere."

That includes driving Bishop A. Edward Pevec to and from the Polka Mass in downtown Cleveland on Thanksgiving weekend. It also means being on call to drive visitors from Slovenia. Because Steve was born in Slovenia, he knows the language and he knows the city. Steve was a Cleveland firefighter for 39 years, and retired as secretary of the Department.

Friday afternoons finds Steve playing at the Slovene Home for the Aged. He is a member of the dedicated group of musicians who volunteer to entertain at the Home each week. For many years Steve was a chorus member and accompanist of Singing Society Zarja. In the recording studio, he was on Frankie Yankovic's last album. He also played accordion on "Smooth as Cilka," with Zeke and Charlie, and with Zarja.

Few people know that the Slovenian Country House benefits from Steve's contacts with the polka bands in the area. He has booked the bands that play at the popular dining spot ever since his friend Frank Sterle, the

original owner, asked him to help out.

Probably the most unusual contribution Steve has made to his Slovenian heritage - of which he is very proud - is delivering baseballs, bats, and gloves to baseball teams in Slovenia. Steve is considered the godfather of baseball in Slovenia. He solicited the Euclid baseball league for used equipment some 20 years ago, and brought them to amateur teams in Slovenia. Today, the Republic of Slovenia has several baseball teams and competes in the European Baseball League.

Steve served the United States in the Navy during World War II.

Steve and his wife, Shirley, live in Euclid, Ohio, with their daughter Nancy. His daughter Beverly Valencic also lives in Euclid. Son Dennis and his wife Cindy live in Willoughby Hills and have two sons, Michael and James. His brother Zarko and his wife Nancy also live in Euclid.

For all of the above and more, Zeke and Charlie and friends think Steve Valencic deserves this recognition.

What Happens to Countries When They Join EU?

From the gridlocked streets of booming Dublin to the relaxed affluence of Seville's old quarter, Europe's new member states have been trying to find out what went right - and wrong - when other countries joined the European Union.

Ireland and Spain have proved a magnet for politicians from the 10 new EU members who want to see how they transformed themselves from economic backwaters into self-confident, modern European states.

But the fact-finding teams set up by new member states were equally keen to see what went wrong in countries such as Greece and Portugal, for whom EU membership prompted an initial boom followed by a painful slump.

Or in Austria, which raised expectations of membership to such an extent that disillusionment with the EU quickly set in when the

promised benefits failed to materialize.

The enlargement on May 1 (when Slovenia joins the EU) is the biggest undertaking, but the shape and identity of Europe has been altered with four previous expansions.

Britain, Ireland and Denmark were the first to join the EU's six founding members in 1973. Next was Greece in 1981, followed by Portugal and Spain in 1986. Finally, the European Union swelled to 15 with the accession of the wealthy countries of Austria, Finland and Sweden in 1995.

Portugal and Spain are particularly fascinating for new member states from the former Soviet bloc, for whom EU membership is also an affirmation of a break from a dictatorial past.

"Spain is a very good example in a number of contexts," says Marek Grela, Poland's ambassador to the

EU. "It has been very good on regional policy and structural projects."

Spain's investment in big transport projects, largely funded by the EU, has been seen as vital in bringing new life to its regions, including the south.

Portugal, on the other hand, was recently identified by Michel Barnier, the former EU regional affairs commissioner and now French foreign minister, as a country that had not made the best use of its structural funds. For the new EU members, it is vital to make every euro(ϵ) count, because compared with other enlargements this one is being done on the cheap: a net ϵ 10.3bn (\$12.2bn) of EU funds will be transferred to the new states in the first three years of their membership, mainly in the form of regional aid and farm subsidies.

That means, for instance,

that Poland will receive ϵ 67 per capita annually and Hungary ϵ 49, compared with (in 2000) Greece receiving ϵ 437 per head and Ireland ϵ 418. Mr. Grela says the accession countries should draw lessons from many countries. "Finland has been very good with innovations, while Ireland made it a priority to invest in education."

Poland also noted what happened to popular support for the EU in Austria, which collapsed shortly after it joined in 1995 from previously high levels.

"It's better sometimes to have expectations that are not too high," he says. "I think the Poles are somewhat skeptical."

All countries want to avoid the economic nightmare suffered by Greece and Portugal, for whom EU membership heralded high spending, high inflation and then the inevitable crunch.

"Portugal made a big strategic mistake," says Daniel Gros, director of the Center for European Policy Studies. "They ate up all the money. They partied hard and then had a hangover."

"Greece was actually using EU funds to prevent economic reform, by supporting failing industries, rather than to promote it," says Heather Grabbe, of the Center for European Reform.

Ms. Grabbe argues that EU membership alone is not enough for a country to succeed: it has to be accompanied by fundamental reform.

Ireland's "Celtic tiger" performance, Finland - recently named as the world's most competitive economy - and Greece's recent revival were helped by EU membership and access to a vast single market, but all were underpinned by tough fiscal and monetary discipline and economic reform.

She also highlights the impact on national self-confidence which EU membership can bring, which feeds through into wider economic benefits.

"Ireland used membership to move out of the UK's shadow and to develop its own strong and modern identity as a distinctive European country," she said.

"A country like Slovakia, for example, will have noted that and will take the opportunity to move out of the

shadow of the Czech Republic and boost its self-confidence."

One other factor noted in previous enlargements is that - contrary to popular belief - new members tend to experience net *inward* migration.

After Spain and Portugal joined the EU in 1986 increased prosperity at home led to a net inflow of migrants so that by 1995 there were 100,000 fewer Spaniards living in other member states than before enlarge-

ments, and 110,000 fewer Portuguese.

The "outward flood of migrants" were heading in the opposite direction to the one dramatized by tabloid newspaper headline writers: Britons and Germans buying up homes in the stately Irish countryside or along Spain's Costa de Sol. That didn't happen.

Life in the Refugee Camps

1948

Tuesday, Aug. 24, 1948

Today I loaded lumber on one truck and cement on another, and unloaded sand from 2 others. I learned that I will have 3 days off and then we will begin working in a different location.

Back in our barracks, Karl helped me rearrange our room for the baby. We set up a new wood-heated cook-stove which Fric made for 50 shillings. For dinner, I cooked myself some polenta at 9 p.m.

Wednesday, Aug. 25, 1948

This morning I rode in the Red Cross auto to Leoben, where we picked up Cilka and our baby, and then returned to the camp. We've decided to call him Janko (Johnny).

I bought an electric iron for 80 shillings. Cilka has wanted one for a long time.

I went to a number of government offices to report the birth of my son and arrange for the proper documentation.

Thursday, Aug. 26, 1948

Janko woke up at 2:30 a.m. and cried loudly until he was fed.

We received our first extra food ration for our baby. Levičar stopped by to see him.

Friday, Aug. 27, 1948

Mrs. Jesenko went to the Leoben hospital yesterday and had an 8-pound baby boy today. Mr. and Mrs. Jesenko already have about 10 daughters, but this is their first boy. Mr. Jesenko was so happy he put on his Sunday clothes.

Saturday, Aug. 28, 1948

Baby Janko's baptism was at 4 p.m. today. Rev. Klemencic baptized him, naming him after John the Baptist (but we will just call him Janko). Karel Erznoznik and Jelka Malavasic were the godparents. After the baptism, we celebrated with wine and cookies in our room.

Sunday, Aug. 29, 1948


We went to see a play put on by Slovenians from Celovec (Klagenfurt). The play is called "The Pastor from the Blooming Vineyard."

Monday, Aug. 30, 1948

Most of my co-workers on the construction crew have decided that the conditions at the new work location are impossible. They want us to arrive at 6 a.m. and work until 7 p.m. without lunch. Zupan and a couple of others decided they will stay with it, but I won't.

Tuesday, Aug. 31, 1948

The camp gave us extra food rations for Cilka and Janko - more than we can

eat. Cilka is still getting credit for working as a lace-maker, though she hasn't done that for three months and she hasn't been paying 64 shillings a month like the other lacemakers.

Wednesday, Sept. 1, 1948

Joza Zorc and Zalka Zupan both had baby daughters.

Thursday, Sept. 2, 1948

I worked on bobbin lace designs.

I renewed my request for logging work in the woods, but was turned down again.

Friday, Sept. 3, 1948

A two-year-old boy from the Arlič family died in Leoben - before he was baptized.

Monday, Sept. 6, 1948

I decided to go back to construction work after all. Two of us were allowed all day to tear down some steps near an old factory. I could have done the work myself in two hours. I was bored.

Tuesday, Sept. 7, 1948

I got up at 5:45, but missed my ride to the construction site. After a combination of walking and riding a train, I arrived there at 8 a.m. I loaded sand into a cement mixer all day. We got an hour for lunch, so I was able to go to a nearby inn, where I bought a good lunch for 5.5 shillings. A truck brought us back to the camp at 7:30 p.m. I'm very tired.

Wednesday, Sept. 8, 1948


Although I slept only four hours last night, I worked a full day in the construction job today.



4 Colin Powell Welcomes New NATO States

On Monday, March 29, seven new countries joined the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO). U.S. Secretary of State Colin Powell spoke at an accession luncheon in Washington, DC. Among the new entries is the Republic of Slovenia.

SECRETARY COLIN L. POWELL: Please join me in welcoming these distinguished guests (Prime Ministers of the new member states).

Ladies and gentlemen, it's a great pleasure to welcome you here today for this historic occasion, and I feel myself especially privileged to be hosting this event, especially because most of my life was spent as a soldier. And most of that as a soldier for NATO. Most of my adult life was spent as a soldier who looked over an Iron Curtain at what I used to call the "red side of the map," and we were on the blue side.

In 1989 after I ceased being National Security Advisor for President Reagan and went back into the Army, I saw what was happening in Europe and realized great forces were at work. And I remember saying to some of my Army colleagues, "Guys, things are changing. Things are changing in the Soviet Union. Don't be surprised if one day it comes apart and we are giving out membership applications to all the former members of the Warsaw Pact."

And here it is today. Nearly three years ago in Warsaw, President Bush called for a new round of NATO enlargement to extend Europe's zone of freedom and security from the Baltics to the Black Sea. Today, March 29th, 2004, is a historic day, a historic moment for today we mark a major step for the achievement of this vision.

The ceremony we now undertake marks the formal entry into the North Atlantic Treaty Organization of seven independent and democratic European nations: Bulgaria, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Romania, Slovakia, and Slovenia.

To the seven heads of state here assembled, I say to you and to all of your people, "Welcome to the greatest and most successful alliance in history."

We all know of NATO's achievements. For half a century, NATO defended a continent that was half free from tyranny and subversion, until the source of that tyranny collapsed without a shot being fired. You know this particularly well because all seven of your countries were held captive by that tyranny. But now you are free, and by joining NATO's bonds of collective security, Article 5 and all, you will remain free.

You are free for the pursuit of a better future, the future of liberty, of prosperity, a future of peace. All 19 NATO allies you joined with

today will help you achieve this future, but you seven will also help the 19. You bring a new vigor to the alliance. You bring a deep and abiding appreciation for what it means to be free. And so you will form the vanguard of NATO's determination to support the yearning of other people for freedom and for peace around the world.

Today heralds a great occasion. It's a great accomplishment. NATO's enlargement, together with that of the European Union on May 1st, brings us closer to that very, very vital vision of ours, a Europe whole, free and at peace.

This ceremony, however, does not mark an ending, it marks a new beginning. Our common future will be bright. It will be worthy of the sacrifices of those who have come before us and worthy of the dreams of those not yet born.

We have to make that future happen. The threats to freedom today are different from those of the 20th century, but they are no less ominous. We still live in a dangerous world where our enemies seek not only the death of multitudes but the death of liberty itself. They will not succeed, for we stand united in the global war against terrorism, a war that compels the resistance of all free peoples and must be won by free peoples together in alliance.

My friends, for most of its existence, NATO has been concerned mainly with the defense of common territory. NATO is now transformed, as only a league of democracies can be, into an alliance concerned mainly with the defense of common interest and common ideals.

NATO was determined, above all, to prevent aggression. Now it is determined, above all, to promote freedom, to extend the reach of liberty, and to deepen the peace. And I am confident that with the new energy that these seven nations bring to our alliance, our alliance will be as successful in the future as it has been in the past.

And now, ladies, and gentlemen, it is my honor and very, very distinct privilege, on behalf of President Bush and the American people, to invite the seven Prime Ministers to deposit their instruments of accession with me, making all seven nations full and equal partners to the North Atlantic Treaty Organizations.

(The Instruments of Accession are deposited.)

POWELL: Bravo.

Ladies and gentlemen,

may I ask you to stand and raise your glasses in a toast. A toast to seven new allies dedicated and true, who take our alliance from strength to still greater strength, to free-

dom, security, and peace to us all.

All About Padre Peter Opeka

an inspiring servant of the poorest of the poor, a humanitarian giant who walks in the footsteps of Mother Teresa

Who is Father Peter Opeka, also known as Padre Pedro, whose exceptionally successful work among the poorest of the poor has justly been compared to that of Mother Teresa? Several books and scores of articles have been written and television documentaries have repeatedly been aired in a number of European countries, as well as in South America and Africa, documenting his exceptionally successful and inspirational work in Madagascar. The State of Madagascar proclaimed him its "Chevalier (Knight) de l'ordre nationale" (1997). A year later, the President of France made him "Officier de l'ordre merites francaises." *Revue d'Ocean Indien* hailed him as the 1999 "Man of the Year for Humanitarian Work." In 2000, he was selected "Missionary of the Year" in Cuore Amico de Brescia, Italy. In 2001, ONG Habitat for Humanity International conferred upon him its Humanitarian Award and, during the same year, the Center of United Nations in Nairobi honored him with the award Habitat of Honor — to mention but some of the major forms of recognition.

To support his exemplary apostolate of love and peace, Madame Mitterand (wife of then President of France), as well as Prince Albert of Monaco, visited Padre Pedro's mission in Madagascar. On June 29, 2003, the birthday of Padre Pedro, his mission served as the seat of International Conference of Carmelite Sisters who had come there from Europe, Asia, and Canada. As the good Father celebrated the Mass in the huge multipurpose building which he had built, at least six thousand former "trash people" joyfully sang and prayed for this beloved servant of the poorest of the poor who had saved them from the trash hills of Antananarivo, the capital of Madagascar. Repeatedly, movies and television crews film "the miracle of Madagascar" to inspire and entertain viewers in various countries. In December 2003 "Christmas in Madagascar" was filmed for European audiences. (I suspect that Americans, too, would appreciate such programs.)

Who, then, is this humble, immensely energetic and visionary humanitarian priest, Padre Pedro? He was born in Argentina in 1948 to Slovenian refugee parents. Irrepressibly energetic, young Peter Opeka at first worked alongside with his father, a bricklayer, thus learning a skill that has later proved enormously valuable to him in his humanitarian work. Attracted by the example of dedicated refugee priests, Peter then studied under Vincentian (Lasarist)

priests in Buenos Aires and completed his theology studies in Paris, France. He also excelled in sports and played on the French national football team where he was soon befriended by many French influentials, including the family of President Mitterand.

Then he visited Madagascar, one of ten poorest countries in the world. On the trash hills of Antananarivo, its capital city, he saw thousands of children who scavenged the garbage for food and any item which they could sell. Deprived of the most basic necessities of life, hungry, often sick and desperate, they made an immense impression on the young visitor. How can we allow innocent children or anyone else to live like this? How can we call ourselves human and Christian and do nothing to help these poorest children of God?

Deeply moved by the suffering of his fellow-human beings, Padre Pedro dedicated his life, talents, and hard work to make a difference in their lives. He established Akamasoa, a Community of Good Friends. He noticed that the soil was suitable for the manufacture of brick and that rocky terrain could provide much stone and gravel — a source of employment and modest income, and also a source of dignity for his beloved trash people. Brick by brick, the Good Friends have by now built 3200 houses for their families, as well as several schools for their children, a huge multipurpose building which serves for sports and meetings and also as a house of God where thousands of the faithful attend the Mass on Sundays and holidays. Other missionaries, such as Father Rok from Slovenia, came to assist him in his work, as did teachers and Physicians without Borders. Benefactors from many countries have been moved to help. Under the leadership of Fr. Joseph Kopeinig, rector of Sodality House in Austria, the Slovenians and Austrians of Carinthia started a campaign to build one hundred new brick houses and a hospital to be known as the Carinthian Village of Madagascar. Prince Albert of Monaco helped build schools, and the good people from Argentina, Austria, USA, Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Slovenia, Slovakia, Australia, and elsewhere have helped with various projects and contributions.

Currently, in Akamasoa, the Community of Good Friends, about 17,000 former trash people work and study and pray. Within five years a family usually pays back for its new home, each of which costs approximately four thousand U.S. dollars. While the Akamasoa Good Friends cultivate their own rice fields and gardens, many tons of rice still have to be bought to feed so many people. Since Padre Pedro's arrival, about 150,000 trash people have been helped in various ways: with food,

shelter, clothes, medical aid, counseling and guidance. About 7,000 Akamasoa youngsters now attend primary and secondary schools of Akamasoa and score better than their rich counterparts in wealthy sections of the capital. In 2003, the first seven junior college graduates were ready for university studies. Padre Pedro hopes that several thousand of diligent, determined Akamasoa youngsters of good moral character may, with God's help, someday transform Madagascar, an island of about sixteen million inhabitants, most of them extremely poor and 54% illiterate.

Meanwhile, Padre Pedro has to cope with sporadic economic setbacks, floods, typhoons, an avalanche of the poor and the sick, including abandoned women with small children, who daily knock at his door. "How can I turn them back to scavenge the trash deposits or to beg and prostitute themselves in the slums of the capital?" he asks. He cannot — and he does not! No wonder that many view him as a leading and particularly worthy contender for the Nobel Peace Prize. The honor would go to the former trash people and all others who helped build Akamasoa, the Community

of Good Friends. All the money would, of course, be used to help the remaining garbage people, the poorest of the poor, to achieve decent life and human dignity, the best guarantee for peace.

May God richly bless this marvelous "miracle worker" of Madagascar and the follower of the blessed Mother Teresa, as he so admirably and successfully serves the poorest of the poor. And who among us Slovenians would not be proud of this great and wonderful fellow-Slovenian?

Lipizzan Stallions Perform in South Euclid

Lipizzans, the rarest and most aristocratic breed of horses in the world, were first established in the 16th century in what is now Lipica, Slovenia.

Originally bred for the exclusive use of the Hapsburg Royal Family, the bloodline was barely saved from extinction by American forces during WWII. Only a few hundred have existed at any one time.

This June, through the partnership of the Friends of the South Euclid-Lyndhurst Branch of the Cuyahoga County Public Library and the City of South Euclid, the original Herrmann's Royal Lipizzan Stallions of Austria will give three performances at Bexley Park, 4149 Temple Road, South Euclid, Ohio.

In the show, the stallions execute the same battle maneuvers their descendants were trained for centuries ago. Known as the "ballet dancers of the horse world," the stallions perform classical dressage, exquisite "Pas De Trois" and "Airs Above the Ground."

Performance dates and times are: **Friday, June 4** at 7:00 p.m., **Saturday, June 5** at 2:30 p.m.; and **Sunday, June 6** at 2:30 p.m.

You may visit the horses at Bexley Park beginning June 1, and before and after each show. Advance ticket prices are \$12.00 for adults and \$10.00 for children 6-12 years. Children under 6 are admitted free.



– Vesti iz Slovenije –

S 1. majem bo Slovenija polноправna članica Evropske unije

Ta teden potekajo po Sloveniji razne prireditve in slovesnosti, povezane z vstopom države v Evropsko unijo kot polnopravno članico. To se bo formalno zgodilo v soboto, 1. maja. Glavna prizorišča prireditv so park Zvezda, Prešernov in Kongresni trg, Dvorni, Ribji in Vodnikov trg, atrij Mestne hiše in Cankarjevo ter Hribarjevo nabrežje. V parku Zvezda se je štiridnevni kulturno-zabavni program začel v torek.

Ob začetku praznovanja sta županja Ljubljane Danica Simšič in veleposlanik EU Erwan Fouéré izročila evropsko in slovensko zastavo slovenskim plezalcem, ti pa ju bodo 1. maja ponesli na najvišji evropski vrh, Mont Blanc. Park Zvezda bo prevzel začasno podobo Caféja Evropa, kjer se bo na osmih stojnicah z informativnim gradivom in kulinaričnimi posebnostmi predstavilo 25 držav članic Evropske unije. Podobne prireditve bodo potekale v vseh državah, novih članicah EU.

Referendum o izbrisanih ne bo

Ustavno sodišče je razsodilo, da je referendumsko vprašanje SDS in NSi o sistemskem zakonu o izbrisanih v nasprotju z ustavo. Ustavni sodniki so tudi opozorili na protiustavne posledice, če bi bilo preprečeno sprejetje sistemskega zakona (pravna končna rešitev stalnega prebivališča oseb, izbrisanih leta 1992), saj gre za obveznost zakonodajalca. V LDS upajo, da bo zdaj več posluha za poziv predsednika države Janeza Drnovška, ki je politiko pozval, naj neha vznenimirjati slovenske državljanke in državljanje z vprašanjem o izbrisanih ter naj neha s sramotanjem Slovenije v mednarodni javnosti.

Vse pa kaže, da bo zadeva v zvezi z izbrisanimi ostala predmet parlamentarne vojne kampanje, ki je dejansko že začela.

Slovenska zastava na častnem mestu

Tudi po 1. maju bo ob izobešanju zastav slovenska zastava zmeraj na častnem mestu, zastava EU pa bo izobešena skupaj z njo na poslopjih, ki jih predpisuje uredba, in ob raznih priložnostih, tudi ob državnih praznikih. Himno EU bodo igrali v Sloveniji ob posebnih priložnostih, igrana bo (z redkimi izjemami) zmeraj za slovensko himno.

LDS pred SDS

Po Politbarometru (892 vprašanih, raziskava, ki jo plačuje vlada) bi 27 odstotkov volilcev podprlo LDS (marca 20%), SDS na drugem mestu je ostala pri 15 odstotkih. Vse druge stranke niso dosegle niti 5 odstotkov. Na evropskih volitvah bi anketirani najbolj podprli LDS+DeSUS (21 odstotkov), nato ZLSD (20), SDS+NSi (10), SLS (8), Zelene+SMS (5) in SNS (4).

Narasla je tudi podpora vladu Antona Ropu (s 43 na 45 odstotkov). Vprašani najbolj zaupajo Milanu Kučanu (ocena 3,7), Janezu Drnovšku (3,58) in Antonu Ropu (3,3). 44 odstotkov pa je podprlo Ropov predlog petih novih ministrov.

Poleti na Viču nov dom za azilante

Azilni dom v Ljubljani bi lahko pričel delovati do konca poletja, je ocenil minister za notranje zadeve Rado Bohinc po ogledu gradbišča na Viču. Po načrtu naj bi azilni dom sprejel 206 azilantov. Investicija je okoli 1,2 milijarde tolarjev (od teh vsote prihaja 364 milijonov iz mednarodnega programa Phare). Lani je bilo v Sloveniji vloženih 924 vlog za azil.

Inflacijska stopnja se je znižala

Medletna stopnja rasti inflacije je 3,5 odstotka, napovedi pa kažejo, da naj bi se zniževanje še nadaljevalo, tako da bi lahko konec leta dosegli načrtovano 3,2 odstotno inflacijo, ob koncu 2005 pa 2,8 odstotno.

Ljubljana – Ob pridružitvi Slovenije Evropski uniji so slovenski škofje napisali pastirsko pismo. Poudarili so, da združena Evropa želi biti območje miru, sodelovanju, spoštovanja razlik in solidarnosti, ter spomnili, da so temeljne vrednote držav in narodov združene Evrope krščanskega izvora.

"Z vključitvijo v združeno Evropo stopamo v skupnost držav in narodov, katerih temeljne vrednote so krščanskega izvora. Tudi naše temeljne vrednote, ki so nam pomagale, da smo se ohranili kot narod z lastno kulturo in samozavestjo,

izhajajo iz istih krščanskih korenin. Te vrednote nas bodo tudi v prihodnosti povezovale z drugimi evropskimi narodi. Skupaj z nami vstopajo v združeno Evropo še nekateri slovanski narodi. 

RAZBURKANA LJUBLJANA

PERRY, O. — Z nastopom letošnjih "marčevih id" so se tudi nad Slovenijo in posebej Ljubljano pričeli graditi viharni, skrb zbujoči oblaki. Sredi priprav za vstop v dve najvažnejši "zahodni" politični konstrukciji je prišlo do vrste presenetljivih, čeprav morda ne povsem nepričakovanih dogodkov.

Kot prva je planila med ljudi vest, da namerava nekdanji predsednik Milan Kučan ustanoviti nekakšno pol-politično ustanovo, s katero bo skušal po svoje vplivati na nadaljnji razvoj v državi, ki jo je nekoč s skoraj absolutno močjo, vodil.

Tako se je rodila misel o organizaciji, ki si je nadela karakteristično ime "Forum 21". Za javnost je Kučan objavil, da bo to skupina, ki bo združevala ljudi, katerim ni vseeno, kakšna bo bodoča "podoba" Slovenije, pa tudi ne, KDO bo to podobo oblikoval.

Drugače povedno, to je v resnici prizadevanje, da bi bila "podoba" bodoče Slovenije v skladu s pogledi bivšega predsednika in, ker je ta pač izšel iz samega jedra Komunistične partije, je torej jasno, da gre za podobo, ki bo odsevala filozofijo nekdajne slovenske politične elite. V bistvu pa to pomeni, da se je z nastopom Kučanovega "Foruma" pričela vsestranska ofenziva za obnovo preteklega komunističnega enouma v Sloveniji.

Ironično je dejstvo, da da to totalitaristično miselnost, ki so jo v slovenskem narodu nekdaj z ognjem in mečem visevali politični komisarji in poklicni morilci VOŠa, zdaj prinaša t. i. "elita", se pravi skupek ljudi, ki so v zadnjih letih s takimi ali drugačnimi mahnitijami obogateli do stopnje, kjer danes predstavljajo nič drugega, kot slovenski kapitalizem. Po drugi strani pa je Forum 21 tudi izraz strahu, ki brez dvoma pre-

veva slovensko politično levico spričo najnovejšega razvoja, spričo upadanja politične popularnosti t.i. "liberalnih demokratov", obenem z drugimi levicarskimi strankami in njihovimi priveski. Ta strah pa je narekoval tudi vrsto ukrepov in odločitev, ki naj bi preprečile, odnosno zmanjšale možnost, da bi se položaj še poslabšal.

V nekem oziru bi lahko rekli, da je položaj v Sloveniji zelo podoben položaju v Združenih državah, kjer se je spričo zapleta z Irakom v resnici pričela letosnja predsedniška volilna kampanja, v Sloveniji pa je isti razvoj sprožil strah levice pred zloveščimi napovedmi političnih opazovalcev.

Zato so bili zadnji tedni v Ljubljani po vsej verjetnosti med najbolj razgibanimi in so si dogodki kar podajala "vraata" pred očmi presenečene javnosti.

Začelo se je z referendumom o t. i. "izbrisanih". Na tem vprašanju, tako vse kaže, se je tudi začelo drsenje popularnosti politične levice, ki je postajalo vse bolj očitno tudi v tedenskih anketaх političnega mnenja.

Za kaj gre? "Izbrisani" predstavljajo skupino prebivalcev Slovenije, nekateri med njimi so celo ilegalni prebivalci, ki se v času osamosvojitve Slovenije niso potrudili, da bi si pridobili njeni državljanstvo.

Razlogi za to so različni, po večini pa se zdi, da ti ljudje, v glavnem Bosanci in Srbi, niso verjeli v neko permanentno

Slovenijo in so ostali zvesti stari Jugoslaviji, v upanju, da bo nekako prebrodila to najnovejšo "slovensko-hrvaško" avanturom in spet vzpostavila oblast nad vsemi pokrajjinami.

Zdaj, ko so uvideli, da je Slovenija ne le obstala, temveč da daleč prehiteva tako Srbijo kot tudi Hrvaško, bi se jim slovensko državljanstvo prileglo.

Ko jim je potem nekdo še sugeriral, da so pravzaprav upravičeni do določene odškodnine, ker da so bili prikrajšani za polne ugodnosti slovenskega življenja, je bila odločitev zanje lahka: zahtevajo ne le vpis v državljanški register, temveč tudi odškodnino. Eden njihovih predstavnikov je javno govoril o desetih, če ne celo štiridesetih milijonih tolarjev.

S tem je ljudem prekipelo. Zahtevali so referendum, ki ga je bila vlada prisiljena izvesti, in pri 31-odstotni udeležbi (kar je normalno za aktivnosti te vrste v Sloveniji), je 95% volilcev zavrnilo zahteve "izbrisanih" (ki jih ljudska modrost posrečeno označuje za "prebrisane").

Levica je s tem utrpeла обčuten poraz, ki ga je skušala omiliti s prisiljenim obžalovanjem, da se je velika večina Slovencev odločila za nedemokratično kratenje človekovih pravic ljudi, ki jim gre pravica do državljanstva. Pesnik Boris Novak je celo napovedal, da v taki državi ne bo več živel. Kam je odšel še ni znano; morda v Severno Korejo. V resnici seveda gre za 18 tisoč glasov, ki jih bo levična potrebovala na jesenskih volitvah.

Po tem porazu je moral levica vgrizniti v še eno kislo jabolko: NATO. Kljub nezaslišani kampanji proti NATU in sramotilnim izpadom proti zunanjemu ministru Dimitriju Ruplu, arhitektu te akcije, se je NATO Slovencem vendorle zgodil in v edino tolažbo njegovim nasprotnikom je bilo nerodno ukrepanje poveljstva NATA, ki je hitelo simbolično potrditi članstvo Slovenije v svojem krogu in izpolniti prvo obveznost do nje z zavarovanjem slovenskega neba.

Škof Andrej Glavan bo začasno vodil nadškofijo

Ljubljana (Delo fax, 28. aprila) — Andrej Glavan, ljubljanski pomožni škof, bo do imenovanja novega nadškofa začasno vodil ljubljansko nadškofijo. V pondeljek ga je za nadškofijskega upravitelja izvolil zbor svetovalcev (deset duhovnikov, ki kot škofov se-nat pomaga pri vodstvu škofije).

Andrej Glavan je bil rojen leta 1943 v župniji So-teška pri Dolenjskih Toplicah, v škofa pa je bil posvečen junija 2000 v ljubljanski stolnici. Njegovo škofovsko geslo je "Karkoli vam reče, storite". Dokler je nadškofijski sedež izpraznjen — izpraznjen pa je od 21. aprila letos, ko je dosedanji nadškof Franc Rode, v Vatikanu prevzel službo prefekta Kongregacije za ustanove posvečenega življenja in apostolskega delovanja —, upravitelj nadškofije ne sme uvesti nič novega in prepovedano mu je storiti karkoli, kar bi moglo škodovati nadškofiji ali škofovskim pravicam. Služba nadškofijskega upravitelja preneha, ko novi nadškof vzame škofijo v posest.

Postopek za imenovanje novega ljubljanskega nadškofa vodi Santos Abril y Castello, apostolski nuncij v Sloveniji. Ta je že začel s poizvedbo o morebitnih kandidatih za novega nadškofa. Po pričakovanjih bo vprašal približno petdeset do sto ljudi v Sloveniji, duhovnikov in laikov, vsak od vprašanih pa se mora pisno obvezati, da o tem ne bo govoril javno. Po poizvedbi bo nuncij pripravil listo treh možnih kandidatov ter jo z osebnim mnenjem in mnenjem škofov o kandidatih poslal Svetemu sedežu.

Postopek izbire nadaljuje Kongregacija za škofe, končno pa novega nadškofa imenuje papež.

Pred nedavnim so v Cerkvi na Slovenskem ocenili, da ni mogoče predvideti, koliko časa bo trajalo do imenovanja novega nadškofa, da pa je v interesu krajevne Cerkve, da do imenovanja pride čim prej.



Pismo ob 50-letnici odhoda v Avstralijo

Dragi stric Stane!

V teh dneh sem veliko mislil na Vas in na teto Vido ter na Jožico, Borisca, Brankota in Tanjo, se pravi moja bratranca in sestrični v daljni Avstraliji. Predvsem pa sem skušal obujati spomine zlasti na Vas, ki ste umrli 1. oktobra 2002 v Perthu.

Zavedel sem se, da pravzaprav zelo malo ali premalo vem o Vaši usodi oziroma, da hranim v spominu le nekaj posameznih utrinkov in slik, ki pa so vezani na Vaše obiske. Tako imam še živo v spominu, kako sem Vas prvič videl. Bilo je oktobra 1963, ko ste se vrnili, da bi Vas v Trstu operirali zaradi težav z medvretenčnimi diskusi, ker takih posegov za "hernio disci" v tistih letih v vsej Avstraliji še niso opravljali.

Petleten otrok lahko hrani v spominu le nekaj slik ali občutkov bolj kot samih besed ali dogodkov. Tako še vem, kako se mi je zdelo čudno, da smo se iz južne sobe vsi preselili v severno in kako je tata prinesel v soko deske. Pripraviti Vam je bilo namreč treba posebno posteljo z deskami pod "štramacem", kot smo rekli, ker ste morali spati na ravnem in trdem. Temu sem se strašno čudil.

Spominjam se tudi, da se je tata odpravil v Genovo, kamor je priplula ladja, da bi Vas pospremil domov.

Prav tako se še spominim jutra, ko ste prvič vstopili v hišo in ste se mi zdeli mnogo starejši od mojega očeta, čeprav ste bili dejansko deset let mlajši od njega. V Avstraliji ste očitno strašno garali.

Sprva ste delali vse, nato ste se zaposlili kot zidar in nato polagalec

ploščic ter si pokvarili hrbel. Tudi dolga, menda dobra dva tedna trajajoča plovba, predvsem pa bolečine v hrbtnu, so vas silno zdelale in postarele.

Vem, da sem se čudil, da ste bili pred operacijo sklučeni in strašno suhi, prav izmozgani, po njej, ko ste si opomogli, pa spet visok in raven ter čudežno mlajšega videza.

Operacija je lepo uspeila. Bila je zima in nosili ste baskovko, ki ste jo radi, v veliko zabavo moje najmlajše sestre Olge, ki je tedaj bila še v košku, sukali za vrhnji konček. Spominjam se pa tudi, kako ste se naslednjo pomlad, po daljem okrevanju, spet z ladjo iz Genove vrnili v Perth.

Dragi stric Stane! Na Vas sem se spomnil in mislil, ker je bila v teh dneh v Trstu cela vrsta pobud, s katerimi so želeli zaznamovati 50. obletnico odhoda prve potniške ladje z izseljenci iz naših krajev v daljno Avstralijo! Bil je 15. marec 1954, ladja pa se je imenovala Castel verde.

Na posvetu, ki so ga priredili na Pomorski postaji v Trstu, se pravi na tistem pomolu, s katerega so se mlađi ljudje vkrcali na ladje in zapuščali domovino, je bil širi javnosti sporočen podatek, da je med letoma 1954 in 1961 tržaško pokrajino zapustilo 18.647 ljudi, Goriško pa 3.246 ljudi.

Kar 90% od deset tisoč oseb, ki so bili doma na Tržaškem in so bili deležne posebnih podpor in spodbud za izselitev, je bilo mlajših od 35 let (!), največ teh mlađih izseljencev, kar 45%, je šlo v Avstralijo, 27% v ZDA ali v Kanado, 17% v druge evropske države in 7%

v Argentino.

Do tu statistika, a ti podatki so me samo še bolj vznemirjali, da ne morem pozabiti, da ste bili med temi izseljeni tudi Vi in teta Vida, sicer mamina sošolka doma iz Kobarida, da je bil med temi tudi drugi očetov brat, prav tako že pokojni stric Zoran in mamina sestrična Zlatka, ki sta odšla v Kanado, a sta se po nekaj letih tujine vrnili.

Naštrel sem le najblžje, a že v krogu bližnjih maminih in očetovih sorednikov, sošolcev in delovnih kolegov iz tistih let je še cela vrsta ljudi, ki jih je usoda vodila po svetu.

Kakšna rana! Narod, ki je preživel prvo svetovno vojno, ki je doživel prvi val begunstva v dvajsetih letih, ki je nato pretrpel fašistično preganjanje in krutosti druge svetovne vojne, ki je doživel strahote prvih vojnih let, kominform in ideološko Sovraštvo med brati, je ob koncu Slobodnega tržaškega ozemlja doživel še en odtok svojih - verjetno najbolj podjetnih in pogumnih - mlađih sil!

Da, dragi stric Stane, ta žalostna misel mi ne da miru. Zakaj ste se odločili, da odidete? Kje so bili tisti vzgibi, ki so Vas in vse ostale prepricali, da je edino pametno oditi in si drugje, v tujini, poiskati miru in sreče?

Ko ste bili zadnjič pri nas, mislim, da je to bilo poleti 1990, sem Vas obiskal v Kobaridu. Le malo sva se ustavila doma pri Vaši svakinji, nato ste predlagali, da bi šla na sončno stran, kot ste rekli. In sem Vas peljal v Drežnico.

Prvič sem bil v tej gorški vasi in vtis mogočne cerkve pod stenami Krna je bil silen. Pogovarjala sva o vsem mogočem, tudi o življenju v Avstraliji, a čeprav me je ves čas mučilo, da bi Vas vprašal, mi ni uspelo napeljati pogovora na leto 1954, da bi razumel vzdusje, v katerem je padla odločitev za odhod.

Kako so vaju s tetou Vido, s katero ste tisto pomlad poročili menda v cerkvi na Montuci, sprejemali v kontingenčni za Avstralijo?

Zakaj so Vas poslali v Hamburg in kako ste šele od tam na ladji, ki je

Ni bilo stanovanj. Dela ni bilo več. Odpadle so namreč številne službe, ki so rezale kruh v okviru zavezniške uprave.

Nove oblasti so že dale vedeti, da bodo predvsem poskrbele za druge begunce, ki so se iz Istre in Kvarnerja zgrinjali v Trst.

Ideologija prvih povojskih let je med tedanjim mladino tudi preglušila vse druge občutke in razočaranje, ki so ga doživljali ob vrnitvi Italije, je boleče poživilo slabo izkušnjo italijanskega predvojnega in medvojnega preganjanja Slovencev.

Mnogi so bili trudni in naveličani vsega tega. Tudi splošno protislovensko vzdušje je pomagalo, da so se mnogi naši ljudje lažje odločali za umik.

Tudi Vi ste odšli in si v Avstraliji ustvarili družino, garali, šolali štiri otroke in videli, kako odraščajo tudi že vnuki.

RAZBURKANA LJUBLJANA

Prej zaradi slabega premisleka kot zaradi preračunane taktike sta namreč kot prvi NATO letali preleteli Slovenijo dve italijanski lovci, kar je sprožilo – do neke mere upravično – nejevno borbenih Slovencev, predvsem iz vrst nekdanjih partizanov.

Da je bila vsa zadeva še toliko bolj neposrečena, so prišla poročila, da sta letali vključeni v eskadriljo italijanskega letalstva, ki nosi ime nekega poznanega fašističnega "asa" iz druge svetovne vojne. Če je podatek točen (kje so ga dobili?), bi bila vsekakor na mestu diskretna diplomatska nota, ki bi NATOve predstavnike opozorila na občutljivost Slovencev v tem vprašaju. Toda, NATO je zdaj dejstvo, tako kot je na pragu dejstvo o slovenskem članstvu v Evropski zvezi.

Druga nerodnost, ki se je pripetila v zadnjih tednih, je bila interpelacija proti dvema ministrom, zdravstvenemu ministru dr. Kebru in notranjemu ministru Bohincu. Opozicija je prvega obdolžila nekompetentnosti, drugemu pa očitala, da je protipravno pričel podeljevati t. i. "izbrisanim" dovoljenja za stalno bivanje v Sloveniji.

Ko je pritožbo proti Bohincu podprla tudi koaličnska Ljudska stranka, je premier Anton Rop, da bi začutil svoj osebni ugled, nemudoma posegel po sankcijah. Podobnikova stranka je bila izključena iz koalicije, kar je vodilo do odstopa treh ministrov in razcvetela se je resnična vladna kriza.

Rop je moral na hitro roko pripraviti pet kandidatov za ministrske položaje in tu je nastopila naslednja težava: za pravosodno ministrico, ki bi nadomestila odstopivšega SLSovca Ivana Bizjaka, je predlagal državno tožilko Zdenko Cerarjevo.

Temu je sledilo osebno pismo zunanjega ministra Rupla vsem poslancem, naj ne glasujejo zanjo, ker je nekompetentna in suženjsko izpolnjuje vse diktate kontinuitete.

Rupel se je s tem sam izpostavil morebitnim sankcijam s strani Ropa, toda je bila Cerarjeva za pravosodno ministrico potrjena. Rop je namreč ponudil vseh pet kandidatov kot enotno listo in tako so morali poslanci glasovati za vseh pet odnosno proti njim in ne za vsakega posebej.

Vzporedno z vprašanjem "izbrisanih" poteka tudi zadeva muslimanske mošeje, ki jo nameravajo zgraditi ob Cesti dveh cesarjev na Viču. V veliki meri gre seveda za iste ljudi, zato je tudi uradna politika precej podobna: nekdanji histerični nasprotniki kakršenkoli vere se zdaj zagreto zavzemajo za pravice muslimanov ter jim skušajo ustreči v vseh zahtevah in željah.

Pri tem hinavsko vijejo roke nad nepopustljivostjo opozicije, ki pa v tem primeru ne ostaja omejena samo na določene politične stranke, temveč ima prav tako močno zaledje kot v vprašanju "izbrisanih".

Mošja enostavno ni zašljena, tudi zato, ker ljudje niso prepričani, da je potrebna. V tedniku MAG se je oglasil nek

"francoski" Slovenec, ki svari rojake, naj nikar ne pristanejo na mošejo, češ da je tista, ki jo on pozna v Lyonu "eno samo zlo". Njegove navedbe bodo morda še bolj utrdile stališča opozicije.

Tudi v tem vprašanju bo, kot kaže, odločal referendum, čeprav si kontinuiteta slej ko prej krčitvo prizadeva, da bi ga preprečila. Razumljivo – rezultat bo skoraj gotovo podoben onemu o izbrisanih.

Spričo teh razburljivih dogodkov je skoraj neopazno minil odhod ljubljanskega nadškofa Rode na novo službeno mesto v Vatikanu. Bil je seveda na sprejemu pri ministrskem predsedniku (predsednik Drnovšek ga menda ni posebej vabil), opravljen je bila zahvalna služba božja, sicer pa je Rode odšel brez večje pompa in tudi sicer strupeno proticerkevno nastrojeni komentatorji so ga v glavnem pustili oditi brez pretiranega kričanja.

Na obzoru te dni je nov dogodek: sprejem Slovenije v Evropsko unijo. Poleg razumljivega vzbujanja ob številnih uradnih in poluradnih dogodkih ter proslavah, ki se pripravljam, je to po svoje najvažnejši dogodek v dosedanji slovenski zgodovini. Njegove posledice za naš narod še niso povsem jasne, saj nihče ne more zanesljivo predvidevati vseh prihajajočih zapletov, težav, pa tudi uspehov.

Dejstvo, da si levica krčitvo prizadeva utrditi položaje v slovenski družbi vsekakor dokazuje, da ni preveč optimistična o lastni prihodnosti. Ta se je pričela majati tudi spričo vse glasnejših otočb na račun komunističnega divjanja med in po zadnji vojni in revoluciji, in spričo naraščajočega prepričanja javnosti, da uradna razlagava medvojnih in povojskih dogodkov ni povsem zanesljiva. Mozinov dokumentarec, preprost in neposreden kot je, je baje odkril tisto magično formulo, ki se je zgodbina vinarjem in drugim razlagalcem doslej izmikala: kako razložiti slovenskemu človeku medvojno in povojsko dogajanje.

Res je: slovensko zemljo spet zalezuje "pošast" marxovega komunizma,

Na Trgu Pija XII., le lučaj od Trga svetega Petra, je dolžnosti prefekta enega izmed "ministrstev" v vodstvu Rimskokatoliške cerkve Francu Rode predal njegov predhodnik 77-letni španski kardinal Eduardo Martínez Somalo, ki je kongregacijo vodil 16 let, upokojen pa je bil zaradi starosti.

Kardinal po položaju bo na prvem naslednjem konzistoriju, verjetno čez leto ali dve, postal tudi novi prefekt in tako bo nadškof Rode tudi prvi kurijski kardinal slovenskega rodu. O tem, kdaj bo svojega prvega kardinala dobila Slovenija, za vatkanskimi zidovi še nič slišati.

Novega šefa so na hniku palače nasproti bazilike svetega Petra pričakali vsi njegovi novi sodelavci, med njimi tudi nekateri zelo izkušeni poznavalci redovniškega življenja in organiziranja. Rode je v Vatikanu sicer delal dolgih 16 let, vendar se je ukvarjal z drugačnimi zadevami, predvsem z nevernimi in kulturo.

Storil bom vse, da bo ste zadovoljni in srečni, je svojim sodelavcem obljubil novi prefekt, saj zadovoljni ljudje bolje delajo. Vseh zaposlenih na kongregaciji je 35, prišli so z vsega sveta, upravlja pa življenje in delovanje celega milijona ljudi, skoraj 800.000 redovnic in 200.000 redovnikov.

"Vsakogar od sodelavcev bom obiskal v njegovi pisarni, se pogovoril z njim in si vzel ves čas, ki bo potreben, da vidi svoje delo. Osebnost je pomemben, da se ljudje dobro počutijo. To zame ni zgolj formalnost," je pojasnil Rode.

"Svet redovnikov in redovnic ni tako zelo umiljen, kakor je videti navezen," je v pogovoru z novinarji po prevzemu dolžnosti povedal novi prefekt. "Dostikrat se povajijo notranja trenja in zamere. Nekateri predstavniki so preveč avtoritarni, pa tudi redovniki včasih

Notranjski regijski park ...

Domača zaščita za Cerkniško jezero

Ustanovitev državnega regijskega parka Snežnik stoji, občinski park pa se postavlja na noge – Pospešeno odkupovanje zemljišč

Cerknica – Javni zavod Notranjski regijski park je bil uradno registriran v začetku lanskega septembra, v resnici pa je začel delati konec leta. Trenutno odkupuje zemljišča na območju Cerkniškega jezera. "Prizadevamo si delati tako, da ljudje sploh ne občutijo, da za park veljajo omejitve. Zavedati se moramo, da so bili prav oni tisti, ki so naravo ohranili takšno, kakšno je danes," je povedal idejni oče parka Valentin Schein.

Javni zavod Notranjskega regijskega parka (NRP) skupaj z Društvo za opazovanje ptic Slovenije in občino Cerknica okviru projekta LIFE Natura vodi program odkupovanja zemljišč na poplavljene območje Cerkniškega jezera. V štirih mesecih so tako kupili 80 hektarov zemljišč, do konca leta jih nameravajo še 20 hektarov (kar bi predstavljalo dva odstotka območja Cerkniškega jezera), prihodnje leto pa še 50 hektarov. Z občino se dogovarjajo, da jim bo dala v upravljanje še 100 hektarov zemljišč.

"Težko prenašajo kakršno koli avtoriteto. Vsi ti konflikti pridejo tudi do Rima, do naše kongregacije, tedaj moramo ljudi pozivati k modrosti in potrpežljivosti," pravi Rode.

Napoveduje veliko potovanje, saj redovni predstojniki radi vidijo, da prefekt obišče in poskrbi, da je njegova uimeritev. Tudi slovenske redovnice in redovnike bo še kdaj obiskal, njihovi predstojniki so ga pozdraviti v Ljubljani, sam pa je obiskal karmeličanke v Sori in klarise v Nazarju.

Koga bo papež Janez Pavel II. imenova za Rodevega naslednika, še znano. Novi prefekt pravi, da se je postopek prav začel. Poleg treh kandidatov, ki jih predlagal apostolski predstojnik, je občina Cerknica ustavila svoj park.

"Videli smo, da državi ne bo uspelo vzpostaviti snežniškega parka in se odločili, da Cerknica svojemu ozemlju prizna zaščito; očitke o tem, da je nima, smo namreč poslušali več kot 30 let."

Tone Hočevar

je povedal Schein in podaril, da z ustanovitvijo svojega parka ne spodkopavajo sistema in zamisli snežniškega parka.

"Ozemlje je zdaj pravno in formalno zaščiteno, ljudje sploh ne občutijo prepovedi. V parku namreč veljajo le omejitve, ki so navedene v že sprejetih zakonih, novih pa nismo vnašali. Ozemlje ima tako zdaj svojega odvetnika v obliki javnega zavoda. Tega ob pritisnih kapitala in tistih, ki nekaj manj dajo na varstvo narave, gotovo potrebuje," je dejal Schein.

Notranjski regijski park obsega območje 200 kvadratnih kilometrov, kar je skoraj celotna površina cerkniške občine, regijski park Snežnik pa bi predvidoma vključeval osem občin in obsegal tisoč kvadratnih metrov; slednji zaradi odpora nekaterih predstavnikov sodelujočih občin in prednostnih projektov Evropske unije – Natura 2000 – začasno stoji.

"Hkrati smo vodili tudi ustanavljanje Krajinskega parka Goričko, kjer takih odporov ni bilo. Zaradi svojih zelo omejenih kadrovskih potencialov in zato, da bi doseglo večjo učinkovitost, se je ministrstvo odločilo, da prednostno izpelje ustanovitev Krajinskega parka Goričko," so pojasnili na ministrstvu za okolje, prostor in energijo, kjer vsaj v kratkoročno ne pričakujejo nadaljnega ustanavljanja snežniškega parka.

In kako uskladiti občinske in državne projekte? Na ministrstvu menijo, da ne gre za podvajanje:

"Pričakujemo, da bo Notranjski regijski park učinkovito prispeval k ohranjanju narave in v sedanjem položaju ne gre za podvajanje. Zlasti na območju Rakovega Škocjana in na Cerkniškem polju so na navorstvenem področju dobrodoše številne dejavnosti, zato je sodelovanje Zavoda Notranjski regijski park dobrodošlo."

Na ministrstvu bodo, ko se bo nadaljevalo us-

tanavljanje Regijskega parka Snežnik, k sodelovanju povabili tudi občino Cerknica in njen zavod Notranjski regijski park.

Schein pa je glede takšnih povezav odločen: "Naš pogoj je, da se za začetek začnejo pogovarjati z nami in da se dogovorimo, katere projekte bomo vodili skupaj, katere pa posamezno. Od svojih načel ne bomo odstopali."

K Mariji kraljici... Zopet se bomo z novim zaupanjem obračali k Njej v vseh naših vsakdanjih potrebah. Ona nas ne zna razočarati. Majniška kraljica, zatekamo se k Tebi od srca do srca iz misijonskega sveta. Z velikonočnimi pozdravi vsem MZA sodelajočim je naš zvesti misijonar iz Tokia g. Vladimir Kos poslal sledeči zanimiv in zgodovinsko utemeljen članek:

"Naj nas maj spet spomni na našo Kraljico.

Pomladansko lep je občutek, da nas druži ista vera z nebeškimi svetniki. Naj misli nekaterih izmed njih omenim. Odkrili bomo, da tudi mi tako mislimo, čeprav tega nismo še nikjer zapisali. "Mislimo" je nepopolna beseda; treba je v tej zadavi reči "mislimo in čutimo". Tako piše sv. Atanazij: "Če je Marijin Sin Kralj, potem je resnično po vsej pravici Njegova mati vzvišena Kraljica." (Atanazij je odšel v nebesa v 4. stoletju.) Sv. Peter Damian jasno priznava, kljub tkm. temnemu 11. stoletju, v katerem je moral izvesti: "Marijin Sin tako zelo ceni Marijine molitve, in tako zelo ji hoče ugoditi, da se njene molitve zdijo bolj zapovedi kot prošnje, in Ona bolj kraljica kot pa dekle Gospodova." Sv. Tomaž Akvinski, v 13. stoletju z njem krasnim uvidom ugotavlja: "Ko je blažena Devica v svojem telesu spočela Večno Besedo in Jo rodila, je polovica božjega kraljestva postala njena last in ona kraljica usmiljenja, tako kot je Jezus Kristus Kralj pravičnosti."

In če nam stoletja, bližja našemu, še več pomenijo, moram navesti v 18. stoletju sv. Alfonza Liguorija: "Kjer je Jezus po svoji naravi vsemogočen, Marija vse premore samo po milosti... To spoznamo ob tem, kar se je zgodilo pri svatbi v Kani Galilejski... Sv. Janez Krizostom (+407) in sv. Tomaž Akvinski (+1274) umevata Jezusove besede: "Moja ura še ni tu" v tem smislu, da bi Jezus prošnji ne ugodil, če bi jo izrekel kdorkoli drug. Ker pa Ga je prosila Njegova Mati, prošnje ni mogel zavrniti. Tudi sv. Ciril (+444) in sv. Hieronim (+420) sta istega mnenja."

Besede svetnikov so važne. Ne le da so v skladu z vero, ampak jo osvetljujejo s svetnikom dano milostjo. Če bi se sv. Alfonz Liguori motil, ko imenuje Marijo takorekoč "vsemogočno" v Njenih prošnjah, kr Ji je to milost podaril Njen Božji Sin, bi bilo to njegovo mnenje ovira pri beatifikaciji, za katero vse, kar je kdaj kandidat za beatifikacijo napisal, najstrožje pregledajo in ocenijo.

Vem, da dosti ljudi ne ve kaj početi s pojmom "kralja" – toliko modernih kraljev s težavo uveljavlja svojo avtoritet. Toda pri Jezusu se ni nič spremenilo. Matej je zapisal Jezusove poslovilne besede: "Dana mi je vsa oblast v nebesih in na zemlji..." (28:18) Kako čudovito žari Njegova dobrota v dejstvu, da hoče imeti pri Sebi Mater, ki Ji noče ničesar odreči!

Ali se ne bomo z novim zaupanjem obrnili k Njej, ki Ji je tako zelo pri srcu Sinov načrt za širjenje Božjega kraljestva: "Pojdite torej in naredite vse narode za moje učence." (Mat 28:19). Pojdimo k Njej po pomoč za delo MZA. Pa tudi za tolažbo: delo MZA ni lahko, posebno takrat ne, ko imamo prekrasne načrte in premalo sodelovalcev. Pri Mariji Kraljici je zmeraj majsko lepo in kakor maj z rožami in ptički nas bo razveselil Njen odkritosčen, ljubeznivi smehljaj. Marija nas ne zna razočarati."

Dar, ki ste mi ga poslali ob božiču, sva s sr. prednico izbrala najbolj potrebne otroke in mlade, ki imajo resne težave: tako kot: starši zelo ubogi npr. – oče je invalid, družina brez očeta, ali v ječi, dalje matere samohranilke; mati in otrok resno bolna itd. Vsakemu smo pomagale tam, kjer je bila res največja potreba, in tako osrečile po

vaši dobroti mnoge. Bogu hvala vsem dobrotnikom.
