Zapravljanje časa

Kongres je zadnje čase zapravljal čas z nepotrebnim razpravljanjem, nامesto da bi vršil resno in koristno delo.

CLEVELAND, O. — Človek bi mislil, da bo Kongres vsaj tik pred volitvami vpošteval željo volivev, da se zakonodajno delo ozira tudi na njihove potrebe. Pa se te dni pred koncem zasedanja godi ravno narobe.

Senat je na primer zabiral cele tedne z debatami o tem, ali je treba pristati na imenovanje A. Fortasa za vrhovnega zveznega sodnika ali ne. Debata je bila polna pravnega govorjenja, ki od nje navaden volivec ni imel prav ničesar, saj ga končno to tudi ne zanima. Saj je vendar predsednik Johnson odgovoren, da predlaga sposobnega kandidata. Konservativna senatna opozicija je hotela doseči svoje obracene z Belo hišo in zadevo zavlačevala, dokler Johnson ni predloga umaknil. Konservativni senatorji sedaj upajo, da bo Nixon izvoljen in imenoval konservativnega kandidata, ki bo delo najvišjega sodišča usmeril bolj na desno. Kaj pa, če Nixon ne bo izvoljen?

V predstavnikiškem domu so zadnje dni pokazali še manj interesa za potrebe volivcev. Zgubljali so čas z obravnavanjem predloga sprememb zakona, ki urejuje načelo ravnopravnosti pri nastopanjih predsedniških kandidatov na televiziji. Debata je dejansko nepotrebna, ker je Nixon na podlagi slabih skušenj, ki jih je napravil pred 8 leti s svojim temkemom Kennedyjem, odbil idejo, da nastopa na televiziji skupaj z alabamskim guvernerjem in Humphreyjem. Republikanci so zato bili proti spremembam zakona, demokratje pa za. Ker debate ni hotelo biti konec, je domov predsednik McCormack za par zaprl vse izhode iz doma, da obvaruje kvorum. Kaj takega se je zadnjič zgodilo 1. 1917.

Dvomimo, da je bila ta burja predstavnikiškemu domu res potrebna. Naj bi rajši glasovali o par drugih predlogih, ki bi od njih volivci imeli kaj koristi. Sedaj so bležali in čakajo na svojo usodo pred prihodnjim Kongresom.

5. novembra bodo volivci šli na volišča, ne da bi pomisli, kako Kongres velikokrat bolj politizira, kot opravila zakonodajno delo. Ali je tudi to potrebno?

Zaščilna carina za jeklo? Sovjetska "doktrina" povzroča skrbi ZDA

Sovjetsko stališče do satelitskih držav "socialističnega bloka", kot ga je določila Pravda 26. septembra in ga ponovil Gromiko v ZN, vzbua skrbi v državnem tajništvu.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Sovjetska "doktrina", kot jo je postavila Pravda 26. septembra, je začela povzročati skrbi tudi v državnem tajništvu, kjer vidijo v njej hudo oviro za "gradnjo mostov" proti Vzhodu, ki je bila moderna v zadnjih letih. V okviru sovjetske doktrine ima Sovjetska zveza pravico varovati komunistični red pred nevarnostmi v vseh državah "socialistične skupnosti". Ona sama odloča tudi, kdaj je ta red "v nevarnosti".

Nova sovjetska doktrina je trenutno najbolj nevarna Romuniji in Jugoslaviji, ki obe spadata med "socialistične države", Romunija je pri tem članica Varšavske zveze, Jugoslavija pa ne. Tako je verjetno, da v Moskvi svojo novo doktrino smatrajo za veljavno za Romunijo, ne pa za Jugoslavijo. Ce bi zadnjo raztegnili na SFRJ, bi jo brez dvoma tudi na Albanijo, ki je še v zvezi s sovjetskim vdom na Češkoslovaško uradno odgovadal s svoje članstvo v Varšavski vojaški zvezi. Vse omenjene tri države se pripravljajo na odpor proti vsakemu sovjetskemu poskušu uvejaviti novo doktrino proti njim.

V skrbih so tudi v Washingtonu. D. Rusk je naročil podjenim, da izdelajo načrte postopka za slučaj sovjetskega nastopa proti Romuniji in Jugoslaviji. Novo sovjetsko doktrino je v svojem govoru pred glavnim skupščino ZN pretekli teden tudi odločno odklonil in oponoril na to, da je v nasprotju z določili ustavnove listine Združenih narodov. Tudi tekom svojih razgovorov s sovjetskim zunanjim ministrom A. Gromikom je opozoril na to svoje stališče.

Zastopstvo ČSR v Moskvi

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Po sklepnu Prezidija Komunistične partije ČSR je prišla sem delegacij ČSR, da se sporazume z ZSSR o začasni namestitvi dela sovjetskih čet v ČSR in umiku

V Saigonu nova zaroča?

SAIGON, J. Viet. — Sluhi o zaroči proti vladu Van Thieu spadajo med dnevne čenče. Kdor sliši take govorice, jim ne zaupa. Do sedaj je imel prav. Zadnje dni so sluhi dobili realnejšo podlagu.

Ne da se tajiti, da je sedanji režim dal zapreti precej vidnih vojaških in civilnih oseb. Režim trdi, da jih je zaprl, ker jih hčete postaviti pred sodišče radi korupcije. Van Thieu je namreč res začel preganjati tudi korupcijo na vrhovih. V zvezi z aretacijami so se začele širiti govorice, da tisti, ki jim grozi preganjanje radi korupcije, sestavljajo načrt za zaročo. Policija je na podlagi podatkov o tem načrtu že zaprla nekatere oficirje, ki jih pa uradno dolži le korupcije in ne zarote.

Gоворice spravljajo aretacije tudi v zvezi s podpredsednikom Kyjem, ki se baje ne more pomiriti s tem, da ga je politika pahnila v kot. Dokazi za utemeljenost te domneve pa manjkajo. Res pa je, da nihče ne verjam, da bi Ky mogel dolgo časa prenašati sedanje prezdele.

Vse to je seveda odlično građivo za čenče in politične špekulacije. To tem bolj, ker je v "zaročo" vmešanih tudi nekaj vidnih članov sedanjega parlamenta, ki so pa tudi znani po svoji korupnosti. Vlada drži zaenkrat vse oborožene sile v stanju pripravljenosti.

Francoski pravnik dobil Noblovo nagrado za mir

OSLO, Nor. — Po 4 letih je bila letos zopet podeljena Noblova nagrada za mir. Dobil jo je 81 let star francoski pravnik Rene Cassin, ki je bil glavni stavljač izjave ZN o človečanskih pravicah. Zadnjič je bila ta nagrada podeljena leta 1964 dr. M. L. Kingu, leta kasneje pa Ostroskemu skladu ZN, ker odbor ni mogel najti nobenega posameznika, ki bi bil nagrada zaslужen.

Nagrada bo izročena Cassinu 10. decembra 1968 v Stockholmu. Znaša \$67,500. Z njim bo počasna 20-letnica proglašitve človečanskih pravic v ZN.

JOHNSON SE JE ODLOČNO POGNAL ZA HUMPHREYJA

Predsednik L. B. Johnson se je včeraj odločno zavzel za demokratskega predsedniškega kandidata H. H. Humphreyja in trdo prijemale republikanca R. M. Nixonja in "neodvisne" G. Wallacea. Tega je označil za "krivega preroka" strahu.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Ko je predsednik L. B. Johnson 31. marca letos izjavil, da ne bo več kandidiral, je povedal tudi, da se ne bo vtipkal v volivno borbo, ker da bo ves svoj razpoložljiv čas posvetil svojim uradnim poslovom v korist vseh dežel. Včeraj se je kljub temu oglasil jasno in odločno, volivce je pozval, naj podpro demokratskega predsedniškega kandidata podpredsednika ZDA H. H. Humphreyja. Republikanca Richarda M. Nixonja si je hudo privoščil, ker je v preteklosti nasprotoval zvezni pomoči šolstvu, se upiral vsej bistveni, napredni zakonodaji in je sedaj proti glasovanju o dogovoru za omejitve atomskega oboroževanja. Še ostrejši je bil predsednik v svojih besedah o G. Wallaceu, ki se hoče ameriškemu ljudstvu predstaviti kot "apostol reda", pa je le "krivi prerok" strahu.

Predsednik je govoril na programu, ki ga je v podporo demokratom pripravila Mednarodna unija delavcev za žensko obleko. Program je prenašala radijska mreža NBC. Johnson je dejal, da čaka dan, ko bo podpredsednik H. H. Humphrey prevzel "bleščoči stisko" — bremena in sijajne priložnosti predsednika ZDA". Dejal je, da bo Humphrey dal deželi "progresivno vodstvo" in je zato pozval volivce in volivke, naj glasujejo zanj.

G. Wallace je označil L. B. Johnsona za človeka, ki bo "razdelil našo deželo in naše ljudstvo". Odločno je zavračal trditve Wallacea, da "ni niti za eno desetic razlike med Nixonom in Humphreyjem". Trdil je, da Nixon tisti, ki je glasoval proti podpori šolstvu, da sedaj nasprotuje odobritvi dogovora o omejitvi atomskega oboroževanja in da je on tudi proti vsem "bistvenim, naprednim zakonskim predlogom".

Johnson je razlagal, da napredek zadnjih let ni delo republikanske stranke. Ta je obljudila odpraviti veliko tega, kar je bilo pridobljenega. Oni ne predlagajo veliko več kot potisnute naše dežele in naroda v nov krog reakcije in neakcije. Wallace je v Johnsonovih očeh "krivi prerok", ki gradi na strahu, pa se predstavlja volivcem kot varuh in "apostol reda". Ameriškega ljudstva ne bo presleplil s svojo držo in praznimi besedami je dejal L. B. Johnson. O demokratskem podpredsedniškem kandidatu Musku je pripomnil, da je

"v vsakem pogledu sposoben biti le za en utrip srca od predsedstva ZDA".

Zadnje vesti

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Demokratsko vodstvo v Senatu se je pred republikansko grožnjo z neomejeno razpravo odločilo opustiti glasovanje o zakonskem predlogu o omejitvi dolžila o enakem času za kandidate za letosne predsedniške volitve, ki ga je v sredo izglasoval Predstavniški dom.

CAPE KENNEDY, Fla. — Za polet vesoljske ladje Apollo 7 je vse pripravljeno. Če le ne bo vreme preveč nagajalo, bo Apollo 7 poletel v vesolje in krožil okoli Zemlje 11 dni, predno se bo vrnil nanjo. Vzlet je določen za danes dopolne ob 11.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predstavniški dom je včeraj izglasoval nakazilni zakon za pomoci tujini. To je omejil na 1.75 bilijona. Predsednik L. B. Johnson je prvotno predložil v ta namen 2.9 bilijona.

EVANSVILLE, Ind. — G. Wallace je objavil, da bo verjetno že v ponedeljek odletel podpredsedniški kandidat gen. LeMay v Vietnam, da si na lastne oči ogleda položaj. Ko se bo vrnil, bo poročal o vsem Wallaceuta, ta pa nato javnosti.

ZDRUŽENI NARODI, N.Y. — Po tukajšnjih vestih je Sovjetska zveza obljubila ČSR umakniti do 28. oktobra za 50-letnico obstoja ČSR 90% vseh zasedbenih čet z njenih tal. V ČSR bi naj torej po tem dnevu ostalo "začasno" le okoli 50,000 do 60,000 tujih vojakov.

BALTIMORE, Md. — Porota je spoznala "9 katoličanov", ki so bili obtoženi zasega in uničenja nabornih seznamov v Catonsvillu in v Baltimorju, za krive. Sodnik je poroti naročal, naj pri svojem razpravljanju nič ne gleda "na višje verske razlage" in ne na to da bi utegnili obtoženci "v očeh zgodovine" imeti prav. Na to so se namreč obtoženci in njihovi odvetniki tekmovali na razprave sklicevali.

GIBRALTAR. — Razgovori med predsednikom britanske vlade H. Wilsonom ter predsednikom rodežijske vlade I. Smithom so težavi in dolžen še niso priveli do nobene odločitve.

Odnosi med Moskvo in Peipingom so se spet nekaj bolj zategnili

Predsednik vlade Ljudske republike Kitajske Ču-En-laj je na proslavi 19-letnice zmage komunistične revolucije in ustanovitve Kitajske ljudske republike 1. oktobra letos govoril o zbiranju ruskih čet na mejah Kitajske in o stalnem preletavanju ruskih letal v kitajski zračni prostor. "Rdeča zvezda", glasilo ruske "Rdeče" armade, je zapisala, da bi Kitajska rada zapletla Rusijo v vojno. Zanesljiva, podrobna poročila o položaju na meji Kitajske in Rusije so redka in prihajajo vsa iz tajnih, največ vojaško-vohunskih virov.

Poročila iz britanskih virov trdijo, da so Rusi res povčeli ševidniških poletov v velikih višinah nad Sini-kiongom, kjer imajo Kitajci svoje atmosko središče in prekuševali atomskega orožja in raket. V Moskvi naj bi bili prepričani, da Kitajci vse to pripravljajo proti Združenim državam, ampak sumijo, da se Kitajci pripravljajo za obračun z Rusi.

Japonski viri pravijo, da krepita svoje sile na mejah obe strani, Rusi in Kitajci. Vzdolž 4,000 milij dolge meje s Sovjetsko zvezo imajo Kitajci zbranih kakih 50 divizij, Rusi pa okoli 42, med njimi oklopne, letalsko pehoto in posebne raketne oddelke. V zadnjih treh letih naj bi se število teh sil na meji povečalo za nekako polovico.

Zunanjina Mongolija je vojaško, politično in gospodarsko povezana z Sovjetsko zvezo, čeprav so jo kitajski komunisti vneto snubili in jo smatrajo za nekako svoje ozemlje, ker je bila več stoletij povezana s Kitajsko. Kitajci naj bi bili v zadnjem času okreplili svoje sile na meji Mongolije z dvema divizijama na skupno 8. Sovjetska zveza je prav tako okreplila svoje sile v Mongoliji z dvema divizijama in jih ima sedaj tam skupno 6. Poleg tega so na mongolsko-kitajski meji tudi domače mongolske vojaške sile.

Vse to zbiranje vojaštva na kitajsko-sovjetski meji še dolgo ne pomeni, da obstoji nevarnost vojaškega sponda med obema. S čim takim ne računa resno za enkrat nihče, toda tako Peiping kot Moskva sta previdna, da ne bi bila presenečena. Dolga skušnja v medsebojnih odnosih ju je namreč marsikaj naučila.

Spor med Sovjetsko zvezo in Kitajsko poteka na dveh ravneh. V sporu sta obe državi, v sporu pa sta tudi obe Komunistični partiji kot vodnici obeh držav. Državi se prerekata zaradi meje, vodstvi Komunističnih partij se borita za to, katero od njih naj ima glavno besedo v vodstvu komunističnega gibanja na svetu.

Rusi in Kitajci so se prvič srečali že v 16. stoletju, ko se je "veliki kan" v Mongoliji sprl s Kitajci in je ponudil svojo podreditve ruskemu carju. Kasneje, ko se je s Kitajci pomiril, je to ponudbo zopet umaknil in Mongolija je postala vse od tedaj sporno ozemlje med Rusijo in Kitajsko. Danes je Zunanjina Mongolija pod vplivom Rusije, s katero ima prijateljsko in vojaško obrambno pogodbo. Notranja Mongolija pa je kitajska pokrajina.

Rusi so v začetku novega veka, ko so se osvobodili mongolskega jarma in uničili ostanke mongolske oblasti v Rusiji, začeli prodrijeti preko Urala v Azijo in že sredi 17. stoletja prodrijeti preko nje do Tihega morja. Tam so se obrnili na sever in na jug. Na poti na jug so trčili na Kitajce, ki so gospodarili Mandžuriji in sedanjemu ruskemu Pomorju z Vladivostokom vred. V Nercinsku je bil leta 1689 sklenjen med Rusi in Kitajci prvi mejni dogovor. Z njim je bilo ugotovljeno in potrjeno v glavnem obstoječe stanje. Do novih trenj na meji Rusije in Kitajske je prišlo v naslednjem stoletju, vendar v Moskvi vso reč niso smatrati za posebno pomembno in se niso marali spuščati s Kitajci v noben resen spor.

V drugi polovici preteklega stoletja, ko je bilo očitno, da je Kitajska onemogla, so Rusi zasedli ves severni breg reke Amurja in morsko obalo vzhodno od reke Ussuri ter to svojo novo posest zavarovali s pogodbo v Peipingu leta 1860. V istem času so začeli Rusi siliti tudi v Kitajski Turkestan in tudi tam razširili svojo oblast. Kitajcem so tam s časom vzeli skupno okoli 350,000 kvadratnih milij ozemlja.

Ko je na Kitajskem zavladal Mao in vzpostavil notranjo enotnost države, je Moskvi predložil ureditev meje. Komunistična Kitajska načelno ni hotela priznati pogodb, ki jih je sklenila Kitajska s carsko Rusijo v preteklem stoletju, češ da je moral Peiping na nje pristati, ker je bil prešibek, da želi se moći upirati. Moskva se ni marala spustiti v nobene razgovore, posebno še, ker je prišlo po Stalinovi smrti tudi do spora s Peipingu o vodstvu komunističnega sveta.

V Peipingu so toliko stvarni, da vedo, da nimajo izgledov na "osvoboditev" ozemlja, ki ga je morala Kitajska skozi leta odstopiti Rusiji. Verjetno bi se zadovoljili z ma-

limi "popravki" in določitvijo meje na temelju "enakopravnosti". Na tak način so se namreč Kitajci sporazumeli o mejah doslej z Afganistanom, Pakistanom in Burmo, med tem ko je spor z Indijo še vedno odprt in si stoje na meji nasproti močne vojaške enote.

Kitajska ima obsežno ozemlje, ki sega daleč v notranjno Azijo in daleč na sever. Vse to ozemlje z izjemo Mandžurije je skrajno redko naseljeno, ker je za naselitev tudi malo primerno, saj je v dobrem delu na pol delno pa celo prava puščava. Kitajci do moderne dobe niso nikdar silili v te predele, ker jim tudi podnebje ni všeč, silili so veliko bolj v smeri proti jugu in jugovzhodu. Rusi imajo za potrebo tudi dovolj obširno ozemlje in nimajo nobene potrebe po njegovem širjenju ne v Evropi ne v Aziji. V tem pogledu je spor s Kitajci torej ni vzrokov.

Spor med vodstvom Kitajske in Ruske Komunistične partije za vodstvo komunističnega sveta bo postopno izgubljal na svojem pomenu, ko se bo komunistični blok bolj in bolj notranje razkraljal, se drobil in bo vsak del ubiral svojo pot.



* CHICAGO! KJE SI SE VZEL? KDO TE JE KRSTIL?

Zgodovina po svojih virih pripoveduje, da njegovo ime izvira iz tretih nekdanjih besed, ki so jih rabil indijanski rodovi, ki so z njimi označevali moč ali mogočnost. Te tri besede so bile: CHICA-GU. To ime je nosil tudi eden izmed njihovih glavarjev.

Možno je, da so Indijanci, ki so imeli v notranosti od jezera svoja naselja, imenovali ta krajnjemu v spomin. Drugi viri pa vodo povedati, da je neki indijanski rod izražal z besedo CHICA-GU slab (smrdljiv) duh, ki je vladal po tej okolici vsled divje čebule, ki je rastla vse naokrog po prerijah tega kraja. Vse to so mogoče ugibanja — pa lahko je v njih tudi nekaj resnike.

GREASED SKIDS TO BANKRUPTCY

What is the answer to rising welfare costs? This is a question that may soon be foremost in the minds of voters, as well as officials at every level of government. In spite of statistics that indicate prosperity, the relief rolls continue to grow.

Two states, California and New York are approaching a crisis — 2.4 million people in these two states live on relief. This amounts to 25 per cent of all the welfare recipients in the nation. These two states are expected to spend \$4.5 billion on welfare during the next fiscal year. Welfare roles in New York State rose 40 per cent in 1966 and 1967. California's welfare tally has doubled in the last five years. Medicaid has become a major part of the welfare picture — \$946 million of California's \$2.3 billion welfare budget for next year is allocated to medical aid for the needy.

A New York official in commenting on what has become a national problem says, "Welfare is now almost beyond the power of any city to handle. It is getting too big for a State." All of which brings up the question of how much longer candidates for public office can ask for voter support on the strength of bigger spending programs.

CHAMBER MUSIC FROM VIENNA SLATED FOR CLEVELAND OCTOBER 15



The Concentus Musicus from Vienna will present a concert sponsored by the Cleveland Chamber Music Society in Cleveland on Tuesday, October 15.

The ensemble will perform at Strosacker Auditorium on the Case-Western Reserve University campus at 8:30 p.m.

The Concentus Musicus was founded in 1954 and has met with continuous success since its first public appearance in 1958. At that time two concerts in the Vienna Schwarzenberg Palace were cited as providing "a rare world of tone."

The Concentus Musicus first came to the United States in 1966 for 27 concerts at leading music centers. It consistently won high praise while on that tour.

The ensemble is, perhaps, unique in the world today because its concerts often include compositions

written as far back as the 13th century. The original instruments for which the composition was written are used and the music is interpreted as it was originally intended to be played.

The repertoire of the Concentus Musicus is the broadest that such a group is able to offer. One of the outstanding accomplishments of the group has been the performance of all of Bach's Brandenburg Concertos on the original instruments.

Members of the Concentus Musicus also hold chairs in the Vienna Symphony.

Individual tickets for the performance by the Concentus Musicus at Strosacker Auditorium are \$3.50 and can be obtained at the Auditorium the night of the performance or from Burrows prior to the concert. Student tickets are \$1.25.

PUBLIC DEBT. In the latest review of the Federal Government budget, issued a short time ago, one little noticed item estimated the interest on the public debt at \$15.3 billion for the current 1969 fiscal year (which began July 1). This was an increase of some \$900 million over the estimate made in the budget submitted to Congress last January.

The latest estimate means that there is now in effect an interest charge of about \$76 a year against every man, woman and child in the United States, and of about \$304 a year against every family of four persons. This, of course, is a charge against American taxpayers. This heavy interest obligation is one measure of the impact of the extravagant spending policies of the present National Administration. Two major factors in the interest obligation are the increase in the public debt due to deficit financing, and the rise in interest rates to the highest level in nearly a century. A basic cause of the rise in interest rates has been the heavy borrowing by the Federal Government.

Deficit financing has boosted the public debt \$70 billion since the 1961 fiscal year, and the interest on the public debt has increased nearly 90 percent. To gain an idea of how much the Federal Government is now spending in interest on the public debt, consider these examples of what an interest charge of \$15.3 billion a year would do if applied to other uses. It would pay a salary of more than \$100 a week to all of the 2.8 million persons reported to be unemployed in August. It would build every two years a \$25,000 house for 1.2 million families. It would provide more than \$125 a month to all of the 10 million persons who, according to some reports, are said to be undernourished in the United States. It would buy \$40 worth of food at the grocery each week for 7,335,000 families. It would buy two \$75 suits a year for half the population of the country.

Is there any wonder why there is now a groundswell of demand for a change?

CUTBACK IN FEDERAL HIGHWAY FUNDS. Once again the Administration is attempting to hold back highway funds for the Federal aid highway program under the guise of cutting the budget. The Highway Trust Fund, established for the sole purpose of constructing, improving and maintaining the Interstate and AEC Federal-aid system, is sustained by highway user taxes. It is not part of the general revenue fund of the Treasury and, for this reason, should not be diverted, suspended, or cut back to serve any other needs of the Government.

Already the completion date of the Interstate Highway System has been extended beyond its target date of 1972 because of numerous delays in the construction program. Additional postponements and delays will aggravate further the accident rate and traffic congestion on the Nation's highways, increase the cost of highway construction for mileage postponed, and disrupt planned construction projects en-

tailing the loss of many jobs. The Administration has ordered cutbacks on highway funds too many times already, then restored them, then cut them back again. Use of the Highway Trust Fund for other than specific highway purposes is not the intent of the Congress. The completion of our highway program is too vital to the safety and well being of our Nation to be toyed with and continually interrupted.

STUDY ABROAD. Time is short for students who want Government grants for study at research abroad in 1969-70. Because of cutbacks in funds, the number of grants may be only one-third of the usual 900. A student now in college can get information and forms from his campus Fulbright-program adviser. Those not in college can write to Information Division, Institute of International Education, 809 United Nations Plaza, New York, N.Y. 10017. Applications should be filed to reach the Institute of International Education by November.

Nature Will Provide Says Health Dept.

The American food supply is the best in the world. Yet, the most widespread and expensive type of quackery in the U.S. is the promotion of vitamins, special dietary foods, and food supplements. It is estimated that nutritional quackery takes \$500,000,000 from Americans each year.

Education is our best weapon against quackery. If everyone learned the basis of a good diet, nutritional quackery and food faddism would be eliminated. The public must learn the food facts instead of the fallacies.

FOOD FACTS ARE:

1. There is NO substitute for good food as a basic for good health.
2. No ONE food is essential to your health.

3. It is not true that the average healthy person needs additional vitamins if he is getting a well balanced diet.

4. Vitamin deficiency is a rare condition in this country.

5. Vitamins can be harmful if too many are taken for too long.

6. "Special dietary foods" and vitamins are valuable for people with certain diseases — but only if prescribed by a physician.

7. Reliance on any one unusual food may be harmful.

8. There is only one medically approved way to reduce — eat fewer calories, exercise more, or both. Nothing can just "Melt the ugly fat away."

9. An adequate daily menu should include selections from the four basic food groups:

Milk and dairy products
Vegetables and fruits
Meat, fowl, fish, or eggs
Bread and cereals

10. Most important is that all food be clean, unspoiled and properly refrigerated.

Named Chairman of St. Paul Fed. Savings

Chicago, Ill. — Frank P. Kosmach looked tan and fit as he reminisced just a week before he became chairman of St. Paul Federal Savings and Loan association — his home for 55 years.

He has seen the savings and loan business expand from the days when it was operated out of a vest pocket in the back of a store or saloon to a multimillion-dollar industry financing the major portion of the nation's homes.

The institutions were called building and loans when he began and many like St. Paul, which was founded in 1889, performed a service for parishioners of a particular church. They promoted savings and made loans for homes, a goal which hasn't changed in the intervening years.

Kosmach was an immigrant boy from Yugoslavia who quit school early to work in a factory for \$15 a week. When he found that men 50 years old working the same 12-hour shifts were making the same wages, he decided to return to school.

Always a saver, Kosmach earned extra money bringing beer to workers at lunchtime. While the beer cans were being filled, he indulged in the free fare saloons once offered. Then back to the factory he would go with as many as 10 cans strung over poles on his shoulders.

Saves for School

He put away part of each paycheck and finally had enough to return to school for a two-year business course.

Down the street was the "ma and pa" real estate office of Emil A. Besener. When Mrs. Besener left to have a child, Kosmach was hired as a bookkeeper.

That was in 1913 and Kosmach soon found that a minor part of the business was the building and loan association of St. Paul's Church, 21st Place and Hoyne Avenue.

He can look back to the days of quarterly dividend periods and 6 and 7 per cent mortgage interest rates — conditions which have just returned to the market.

And he remembers the 7 and 12-year savings plans, in which

every quarter an account was credited with earnings. But if a saver pulled out before the maturation of the account, he got only 3 per cent interest on his money and the rest was divided among other shareholders.

"People were encouraged to save," he said. "We wouldn't make a loan with less than one-third down."

Overhead of the operation was almost nil. The secretary made \$100 a month; there was no office rent because business was carried on in the rear of the real estate office at 2116 W. Cermak Rd.; and the auditors charged \$36 a year.

began in 1936 when it received a charter as a federal savings and loan.

Kosmach became president in 1945 when assets were 3 million dollars. In 1953, when the association moved to 6700 W. North Ave., assets were 22 millions.

Today the institution has 275 millions in assets.

Your philosophy? "Service," he replied. "You've got to keep your customers before you can bring new ones in." He makes it a personal job to greet employees each day and see to it that they smile at customers.

Rules Are Welcome

Government regulations? "When your children don't behave properly, you have to set up standards," he said. "Some went out of line and the federal home loan bank board had to set up regulations to live by. They (regulations) are welcome if they help the industry and prevent further problems."

Kosmach moved up to board chairman July 1. His right hand man, Percy Wagner, a savings and loan executive, real estate appraiser, and educator of international reputation, moved onto the board, too.

Taking Kosmach's place will be Faustin Pipal, an affable, articulate executive who was hand-picked for the presidency when he came from Talman Federal Savings and Loan association six years ago.

Kosmach will be spending winters in Fort Lauderdale, Fla., and summers at St. Paul Federal. "Well, maybe not every day, unless it is necessary," he added.

Society Corporation Files Stock Offering with SEC

Society Corporation, a registered bank holding company headquartered in Cleveland, Ohio, filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission a registration statement covering 116,279 shares of common stock, Mervin B. France, President, announced.

Holders of Society Corporation common stock and voting trust certificates will be offered the right to purchase one new share for each five shares held on a record date, and at a price to be set at the time the registration becomes effective. These rights will have an expiration date which will also be announced when the final terms are set. Rights not exercised on or before this date will be void and have no value thereafter.

"When the offer becomes effective all holders of Society Corporation Common Shares and Voting Trust Certificates will be notified by mail as to the procedure to follow to exercise their rights," Mr. France said.

Any shares not subscribed to by the shareholders and voting trust certificate holders will be offered to the public through a nationwide group of underwriters headed by M. A. Schapiro & Co., Inc., and Prescott, Merrill, Turben & Co.

This will be the first public offering of Society Corporation Common Shares. More than 560,000 of the corporation's 581,393 outstanding Common Shares were distributed in 1962 to former depositors of Society for Savings. This distribution, in the form of Voting Trust Certificates, was made as part of a plan for the conversion of Society for Savings, a mutual savings bank, to a shareholder owned commercial bank.

The remaining 19,737 outstanding Common Shares of Society Corporation were issued in the acquisition of two of the holding company's four banking affiliates and for directors' qualifying shares.

Society Corporation is the 17th largest registered bank holding company in the United States. The corporation is the controlling shareholder in the four Ohio banks: Society National Bank of Cleveland; The Fremont Savings Bank Company; The Western Reserve Bank of Lake County, Painesville; and The Springfield Bank. The four affiliated banks have total assets in excess of \$800 million.

Maria Temco made this comment to a counselor at Family Service Association during the final interview she and her husband had at the agency. The couple is among the almost 20,000 families served by the agency each year. Their case is typical of the complex problems brought to F.S.A.

Maria and John Temco had been married 25 years. Their only son married and moved to another city. Mrs. Temco worked, part or full-time, whenever she could. When she was not working, she found other ways to keep herself busy. Actually, she was fleeing her marriage. Finally her husband left her.

The next day she had two accidents at work, the first hurt only materials, the second caused her an injury as well. The personnel manager at the factory guessed at the cause of the accidents and suggested she go to Family Service. Three months of interviews, at first with her and later with her husband, or both of them, helped the Temcos build a new life.

Family Service Association is one of 155 Red Feather agencies supported by the United Appeal. Since F.S.A. receives over 65% of its financial support from UA, it has a large stake in the success of the United Appeal's drive for \$17.2 million, this Oct. 14-24. When the US drive failed to reach its goal last year, F.S.A. was one of 16 agencies which bore the brunt of the lack of funds. It was forced to cut back personnel and consequently served 60 to 70 fewer families than usual each month. An over-the-top win in the 1968 UA drive is therefore imperative if Family Service Association and other UA-supported agencies are to meet the community's needs.
