Proračun ZN za 1976 in 1977 višji 21.6%

Glavni tajnik ZN Kurt Waldheim je predložil povisitev proračuna Združenih narodov za prihodnji dve leti za 21.6%.

ZDRAŽENI NARODI, N.Y.— Ko se pripravlja glavna skupščina Združenih narodov na svoje redno jesensko zasedanje, je glavni tajnik ZN Kurt Waldheim objavil predlog proračuna za prihodnji dve leti delovanja mednarodne ustanove. Predvideva 737 milijonov dolarjev izdatkov, 21.6% več kot v preteklih dveh letih.

Glavni tajnik ZN trdi, da je potreba po večjih sredstvih za redno delovanje potrebna zaradi inflacije, pa tudi zaradi novih nalog in uvedbe arabščine kot dodatnega rednega službenega jezika. Preje so v ZN prevajali vse govorje v angleščino, francosčino, ruščino, španščino in kitajščino, leta 1973 se jim bo pridružila še arabščina.

Arabske države so ob uvedbi arabščine izjavile, da bodo krije vse posebne stroške za to do leta 1976, za leto 1977 je Waldheim dal v ta namen v proračun ZN 3.6 milijonov dolarjev. Nekateri dokumenti bodo ZN objavljivali tudi v nemščini, za kar so obvezale nositi stroške obe Nemčiji in Avstriji.

Večji del drugih dodatnih sredstev pojde za najem novih uslužencev. ZN jih imajo sedaj 11,000 v New Yorku in v Zenevi v Švici, najeli pa bi jih radi še 826. Posvetovalni odbor glavne skupščine ZN za proračun je predložil omejitev izdatkov na 721.2 milijona dolarjev in priznala, da komunizem na Portugalskem ne bo prevladal.

V Fatimi so molili za Portugalsko in Angolo

FATIMA, Port. — Na 13. se je zbral v Fatimi, na kraju prikazovanja Marije, pol milijona vernih Portugalcev, ki so pod vodstvom duhovščine molili za Portugalsko in Angolo, afriško portugalsko ozemlje, ki bo 11. novembra postaleno neodvisna država. Tam je še okoli 300.000 Portugalcev, ki so se odločeni vrniti domov, v kolikor ne bodo šli iskat zatočišča v Južno Afriko.

Maria je pastirčkom v Fatimi leta 1917, ko je Rusija preživljala boljševiško revolucijo, obljubila spreobrnitev Rusije, če bodo ljudje dovolj molili v ta namen. Maria je rekla, da bo na Portugalskem "dogma vere vedno ohranjena". Portugalci to tolmačijo kot oblubo in zagotovilo, da komunizem na Portugalskem ne bo prevladal.

Cena umetnih smaragdov bi naj bila za več kot polovico nižja od naravnih. Ti stanejo v sorazmerni s kakovostjo od \$1,300 do \$2,300 karat.

Zadnje vesti

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik Ford je danes objavil, da bo vetril zakonski predlog o podaljšanju nadzora nad cennimi olji za 6 mesecev. Če bo njegov veto obstal, bo nato ukinil carino \$2 na sod uvoznega olja, četudi bi Vrhovno sodišče odločilo, da je zakonita.

LUANDA, Ang. — Portugalski vrhovni komisar je izjavil, da je skupna črnska vlada razpadla in da zato prevzema samodgovornost za javno upravo Angole, ki bi naj 11. novembra letos postala neodvisna država.

DAKA, Bang. — Vojaki so odstavili Rahmana z vodstva republike in izgleda uvedli levčarski režim. Državo so preimenovali v Ljudsko republiko Bangladeš. Rahman je bil pri prevratu ubit, baje tudi del njegove družine.

BUENOS AIRES, Arg. — Deset vrhovnih vojaških voditeljev je včeraj po 7 ur trajajočem posvetu izjavilo, da oborožene sile ne bodo posegle v politične razmere.

Cena arabskega olja bo ostala pri starem!

Savdski oljni minister šejk Yamani je dejal, da utegne Organizacija izvoznic olja ohraniti sedanjo ceno olja do srede prihodnjega leta.

MILAN, It. — Savdski oljni minister šejk Zaki Yamani je dejal tod v sredo, da utegne države izvoznice olja sedano ceno ohraniti preko prihodnjih 9 mesecev, namesto da bi jo s koncem letosnjega septembra povišale, kot se je govorilo v zadnjih mesecih.

Vzrok ohranitve sedanjih cen je izboljšanje tečaja dolarja in popustitev inflacije na Zahodu. Cene industrijskih izdelkov, ki jih države izvoznice olja kupujejo, so delno padle in zato nivzrcka za povišanje cen olja. Yamani je pripomnil, da zmanjšanje porabe olja ni noben zdržek za povišanje cen tega, če bi se pokazala potreba in dovoljen vzrok za to. Počasnejše črpanje je samo koristno, ker bo podaljšalo življeno sedanjih oljnih polj in zmanjšalo kopice in denarnih sredstev, ki jih nekatere izvoznice olja ne morejo pametno porabiti.

Yamani je dejal, da se za povišanje cene olja zenejo predvsem države Venezuela, Ekvador, Alžirija, Irak, Gabon in Libija.

Amerški kongresniki obiskali Jalto na Krimu

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Skupina 18 ameriških kongresnikov, ki je pod vodstvom Carla Alberta na uradnem obisku v Sovjetski zvezzi, je po razgovorih v Moskvi odletela za dva dni na obisk v Jalto in sosednja letovišča ob Crnem morju.

Včeraj je ameriško kongresno delegacijo, ki je v Sovjetski zvezzi d. 7. avgusta, sprejel Brežnev in jo zagotovil, da bo vladna ZSSR izvajala sklep o človečanskih pravicah in svobodnih stikih preko meja, podpisane v Helsinkih. Danes je delegacija odpotovala domov.

Pomilostiveni odbor podal pregled dela

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Pomilostiveni odbor, ki ga je imenoval predsednik Ford Lani, da bi pregledal in odločil o pomilostivitvah vojaških beguncov iz dobre vietnameske vojne, je blizu konca svojega poslovanja. Njegova doba poteka 5. septembra 1975.

Načelnik odbora Charles E. Goodell je dejal, da je odbor dobil 15,000 prijav za pomilostivitev in da je 12,000 prošen pregledal. Od tega je za polovico priporočil polno pomilostitev brez pogojev, mil postopek in upoštevanje okoliščin pa tudi pri večini vseh ostalih.

Odbor priznava, da je bilo število prijavljenih soražmerno majhno, ko računa, da utegne biti skupno število vojaških učenikov pred obvezno vojno službo iz onih let preko 100,000.

Muslimanski uporniki na Filipinih še vedno povzročajo težave vlad

MANILA, Filip. — Vlado predsednika Ferdinandu Marcosu je večkrat objavila, da je muslimanski upor na jugu republike konec, pa se je vedno znova izkazalo, da to ni res.

Upor traja že nad tri leta in vladne si glede ga ne morejo niti resno nimejiti, kaj da bi ga šele zatrele.

Tako so uporniki zadnje dni znova napadli v dveh južnih pokrajih in je bilo v bojih po končanih vsaj 108 oseb, med njimi 31 civilistov.

KISSINGER SOVJETIJI: ROKE PROC OD PORTUGALSKIE!

Državni tajnik Henry Kissinger je včeraj v Birminghamu v Alabama govoril o politiki ZDA v Evropi in na Srednjem vzhodu. V svojem govoru je pozval Sovjetsko zvezo, naj umakne roke od Portugalske in obljubil v imenu ZDA "pomoč demokratični Portugalski".

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Državno tajništvo je bilo v pogledu Portugalske do včeraj sorazmerno molčeče in zelo previndno, kadar je dalo kako izjavilo. Včeraj je državni tajnik Henry Kissinger prvič spregovoril jasno in odločno. Sovjetsko zvezo je posvaril, naj se ne meša v notranje zadeve Portugalske, istočasno pa je izjavil, da bodo ZDA "pomagale demokratični Portugalski". ZDA so se s tem pridružile odprtvo svojim zaveznikom v Evropi in državam s socialističnimi vladami, ki so se povezale za skupno podporo demokratičnemu socializmu na Portugalskem v njegovem sedanjem boju proti poskusu uvedbe komunistične diktature.

Kissingerjeva izjava je prišla v času, ko so se portugalske ljudske množice dvignile odkrito proti komunističnim načrtom in pokazale, da se jim bodo uprle s silo, če ne pojde drugače. Val odpora, ki se je začel v severnem delu Portugalske je pljuskal že preko glavnega mestna oblasti vsaj 45 dni.

Mario Soares je Gomesov predlog odklonil in izjavil, da bo boj nadaljeval v vso odločnostjo. Pri tem uživa polno podporo in sodelovanje ljudske demokratične stranke, ki je poleg socialistične dobila pri volitvah največ glasov. Skupno sta dve dobili nad dve tretjini glasov pri volitvah 25. aprila letos, komunisti pa le 12.5%.

Včeraj je tisoč nasprotnikov komunizma demonstriralo pred predsedniško palačo Belem v Lizboni in zahtevalo: "Proč z Goncalvesom!" Slične demonstracije so bile v Portu, drugem največjem mestu Portugalske, in Cascais pri Lizboni, kjer so zborovali ljudski demokrati.

Položaj se naglo bliža odločitvi, ko imajo, kot trdijo, nasprotniki vlade Goncalvesa večno tudi v oboroženih silah. Do 80% enot oboroženih sil naj bi se izjavilo za podporo spomenici, ki jo je sestavilo 9 članov Visokega sveta revolucije pretekel teden. Vladajoča trojka Gomes, Goncalves, Carvalho je to devetorico izključila iz Visokega sveta revolucije, pa to pustila na njenih vojaških položajih, kjer ta odločno nadaljuje svoj boj.

Značilno je, da je načelnik armadnega glavnega stana gen. Carlos Fabiao odstavil podpolk. Varelo Gomesa, simpatizerja komunistov, kot namestnika povojnega 5. oddelka v glavnem štabu. Ta se ukvarja s političnimi in propagandnimi zadavami. Pod vodstvom kap. R. Correie, zastopnika vojne mornarice, in podpolk. Gomesa je ta oddelek zastopal čisto komunistično lino.

Sovjetska zveza v redni zvezi z otoško afriško republiko

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Tu je bilo objavljeno, da je Kanada prodala Sovjetski zvezi novih 825,000 ton žita, s čimer je skupna količina narastla na skoraj 4 milijone ton.

THE MONGOLS AND THE ORTHODOX CHURCH

By STANLEY J. KUHAR

The "Tatar Yoke" descended upon Russia during its Apponage Period (1200-1400).

Besides the Tatars, Russia was being constantly invaded by the German Teutons.

Moreover, the Eastern Slavs divided into three groups of Russians: the Great, the Little, and the White.

In 1236, Genghis Kahn's grandson, Batu, made a direct attack across the Urals. With the exception of Novgorod, Batu and the Tatars destroyed and rampaged entire cities and villages.

The main reason why the Tatars were so successful in this endeavor was due to the fact they were exceptionally organized in military warfare. The combined use of swift attack and a disciplined cavalry made the Tatars an effective offensive army. Moreover, the Tatars, unlike the Russians, had a capable and well-trained general staff.

For the next two hundred years, the Mongols virtually dominated and controlled the Russians in their domestic and foreign affairs. And the Tatar Yoke had a long-lasting effect upon the Russian way of life.

Primarily, the Mongols, formally and informally, instituted a sense of absolutism in Russia. A despotic tradition evolved while the Mongols preoccupied Russia. The use of a secret police was also brought about by these Asian conquerors.

A detrimental factor arising from this situation was that the Russians were deprived of fertile land in southern Russia. This caused a migration to northern cities such as Novgorod. Albeit, the full impact of the Mongols domination in Russia was felt in one area: a cut-off from the Byzantine Empire and Western Europe.

In general, trading and cultural exchange between Europe ceased to flourish. A xenophobic fear of foreigners was the psychological impact on Russians which has not subsided even till the present time.

However, there was at least one positive aspect from this: a strengthening of the Orthodox Church. Churches were left intact and the Church, as an in-

We attended Mass in this small community, Sunday, July 13th, Church of the Good Shepherd. Celebrant of the Mass was Rev. Emil Sages. During the course of the Mass, Father played the guitar, and led the congregation in song.

Known as the flying priest, he ministers to six small towns, covering a 160 mile area. He commutes with his home made plane, and car.

While making his rounds, he was caught in a storm, his plane crashed in a bush, on Sept. 12, 1969.

He stayed with the plane for 13 days, slept in a burrow, scooped out of mud, then walked 9 days thru the wilderness to a point where he was picked up by some hunters in a boat. His plane, a 85 horsepower model, was found on Black Stuart Mountain, about 10 miles from where he was picked up. The hunters found him in the Cariboo region, 350 miles north of Vancouver.

Suffering from frostbitten feet, exhaustion, and exposure, he received treatment at Prince George Hospital.

The 22 day ordeal was quite an experience for this modest Roman Catholic Priest. On the 40th day after his crash he celebrated Mass at Good Shepherd Church.

We made a return trip to Jasper, and boarded the Sky Tram. The 30 passenger cars travel one and one quarter mile to Whistlers Mountain. Altitude 7500 ft. On the mountain top lies a vast area of Alpine Tundra carpeted with unusual grasses and flowering plants.

At the Sky deck balcony, a breath taking view, as you observe the Athabasca, and Miette River Valleys.

In the distance to the west, we saw the snow capped peak of Mt. Robson (12792 ft), monarch of the Canadian Rockies.

On our way to the Columbia Icefield with its adjoining glaciers, which blanket nearly 150 square miles in the southern portion of Jasper National Park. The icefields melting waters empty into three oceans, Atlantic, Pacific and Arctic.

Along the icefield one could take a ride via snowmobile, a 3 mile trip. Another highlight on this trip, we visited Lake Louise.

The temperatures were around 90 degrees, but thousands of visitors were viewing the beautiful scenery. The lake was discovered in 1882. With its icy, blue green water, the famous
