

## ZDA bodo razširile trgovino s Sovjetijo

### Jugoslavija sodeluje pri pomoči Zahoda Zambiji

PARIZ, Fr. — Zambija je pomembna država osrednje, črne Afrike z zmerno vlado, katere predsednik Kenneth Kaunda sodeluje pri iskanju mirne rešitve rodezijskih krize, pa tudi prihajajoče krize v Namibiji in v sami Južni Afriki. Ta afriška država se je znašla v finančnih težavah, ko so padle cene bakra in kositra, ki predstavljata glavno izvozno blago in ji prinašata devize.

Da bi Zambijo rešile pred finančnim polomom in njemu sledili zmedami in nemiri, so se zahodne države odločile, da ji pomagajo. Njim se je pridružila tudi Jugoslavija, četudi sama ni brez finančnih težav, ker hoče ohraniti vpliv med neuvrščenimi državami Afrike.

Načrt za rešitev zambijske finančne stiske so obravnavali teden na posebni konferenci v Parizu, ki se jo je udeležilo 10 zahodnih držav in SFR Jugoslavija.

### Somalijci so izvršili smrtno kazeno nad Kubanci

MOGADISCHU, Som. — Zastopnik Zahodnosomalijске osvobodilne fronte S. Husein Haile je dejal, da so vse ujetje Kubancev postavili pred ljudsko sodišče, ki jih je obsodilo, in so nato nad njimi izrečeno sodbo izvršili.

"Ko je ljudstvo videlo Kubance klati nedolžne žene in otroke, je bilo tako jezno, da ni bilo nobene izbire," je izjavil Haile. Dejal je, da je bilo ujetih Kubancev "manj kot 100".

### Castro spet predložil sestanek s Carterjem

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Fidel Castro je v teku dveh tednov dvakrat predložil sestanek s predsednikom ZDA J. Carterjem. Na tak sestanek naj bi Castro povabil Carter.

Ta je na prvi tak poziv Castro odgovoril, da bi bil sestanek s Castrom zanj "neprimeren" v sedanjem času. Na ponovni poziv Castro za sestanek je odgovoril Carterjev tiskovni tajnik, da se ni nič dogodilo, kar bi moglo Carterjevo zadnevno izjavo od preteklega tedna spreminiti.

V bojih v Angoli padlo večje število Kubancev obtožbo Izraela

LONDON, Vel. Brit. — Zastopnik Narodne zveze za popolno osvoboditev Angole tu izjavil, da so protivladne gverilske sile uničile pretekli teden v bojih 50 kubanskih vojakov in ujeli štiri kubanske častnike. Skupno naj bi bili gverilci, kot je trdil Tony Fernandes, ujeli okoli 600 sovražnih vojakov, ostale pa prisili k umiku.

Gverilci Narodne zveze so baje porušili štiri mostove, da bi zadržali vladno ofenzivo in prekinili železniško progo, ki vodi iz Rodezije do morja. Glavni boji se bi naj vršili v južnih pokrajinal Cunene in Cuando Cubango.

## Crawford zanika krivo "PRAVDA" že obsodila AMERIŠKA Poročevalca

Zastopnik International Harvester v Moskvi, ki so ga prijeli in nato pustili v varstvo poslanika ZDA, zanika vsako krivo.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Francis J. Crawford, 37 let stari upravnik zastopstva International Harvester Company v Moskvi, je bil prijet in obožen nezakonitega ravnana z devizarni. Koso ga sovjetske oblasti v sporazumu z vlado ZDA izpustile iz zapora in ga prepustile v varstvo poslanika ZDA v Moskvi, je izjavil, da ni zakril tega kar ga sovjetske oblasti dolže.

Prijeli so ga sredi dneva, ko se je peljal v avtu s svojo zarokenko in ga s silo odpeljali v zapor. Obtožili so ga menjavanju deviz na črni borzi.

Po izpustitvi iz zapora je na tiskovni konferenci v poslaništvu ZDA F. J. Crawford dejal, da "ne razume in morda ne bo nikdar razumel, zakaj so ga držali v zaporu tekom preiskave". Dodal je, da so z njim postopali "zadovoljivo".

Resolucija dolži in obsoja Izrael zapostavljanja Arabcev v zaseđenih področjih in rasizma. Odklonitev resolucije kaže, da so v ILO začeli zavedati, da jim mešanje v mednarodno politiko več škoduje kot koristi.

Poraz resolucije pomeni močan udarec arabskim državam,

ki so v preteklosti vselej skušale uporabiti mednarodne organizacije in ustanove za napade in obsojanja Izraela.

ZDA so prav zaradi prevelikega mešanja v politiko ILO lažni zapustile. Izjavile so, da se bodo vrnil, kadar se bo ta mednarodna ustanova vrnila k svojim glavnim nalogam in tem posvetila ves svoj napor, opustila pa mešanje v izrazito politično vprašanja.

## "PRAVDA" že obsodila AMERIŠKA Poročevalca

Glavno glasilo Komunistične partije Pravda je včeraj v obsežnem članku proglašeno obtožena ameriška poročevalca kriva obrekovanja, pet dni pred začetkom sodne razprave proti njima.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Komunistični svet ima res svoje lastno pravosodstvo, močno različno od onega v zahodnem demokratičnem svetu. Kljub vsemu je običaj, da javna občina počaka na uradno sodbo sodišča, četudi v času razprave redno podpirajo obtožbo. Moskovska Pravda, glavno glasilo Komunistične partije Sovjetske zveze, je tokrat ubrala doslej neobičajno pot, da je ameriška časopisna poročevalca razglasila za kriva kar proti njima.

Predteklo sredo sta bila poročevalca Craig R. Whitney od New York Times-a in Harold D. Piper od Baltimore Sun uradno obtožena obrekovanja sestavljene televizijske razgovorje po zatrjevanju njegovih prijateljev ponarejeno. Obtožba zahteva 15% višje plače in še povišanje plač na temelju porasta cen. Bečka hiša bi rada omejila povišanje cen na 5.5% kot sredstvo za zadrževanje inflacije.

Razlika med zahtevo unije in stališčem vlade je tolkina, da lahko privede do štrajka. Za ta slučaj bo verjetno kot pred leti prevzela začasno odgovornost za dostavo pošte armada.

Povprečni poštni uslužbenec ima sedaj okoli \$15,500 letne plače, \$3,018 več kot pred tremi leti. Poleg povišanja plač bo poštna unija tudi jamstvo za stalnost služb in varnost pred odpustom v zvezi z uvažjanjem avtomatizacije.

Umetni satelit raziskuje svetovne oceane

VANDENBERG AIR FORCE BASE, Calif. — Od tod je bil pognan v vesolje umetni satelit ZDA, ki uporablja kratke valove za preiskovanje svetovnih oceanov, vse od njihovih valov in ribjega bogastva pa do vremenskega.

Satelit Seasat-A je preskusil značaja, vsakih 36 ur pregleda 95% celotne površine oceana, ko obkroži Zemljo vsak dan 14-krat.

JERUZALEM, Izr. — Bomba je včeraj eksplodirala na živilskem trgu v Jeruzalem in ubila dve, ranila pa okoli 35 oseb. Nekaj ur po eksploziji je v Bejrutu objavila Palestinska osvobodilna organizacija, da je to bilo njen delo.

BEIRUT, Lib. — Predsednik republike Elias Sarkis je včeraj imel sestanek z vodniki varnostnih sil in vlado o tem, kako ustaviti prelivanje krvi med Falangisti in pripadniki hivšega predsednika republike Franjieha. Pritaši zadnjega so v sredo pobili 36 oseb v Bekaa dolini v odgovor na umor sina, žene in vnuka vprašanja.

V Washingtonu slučaju skrbno sledijo z "veliko resnostjo" in svarijo sovjetske oblasti, da "utegne vplivati na širša vprašanja" v odnosih med obema deželama.

### Derwinski Hosts Yugoslav Human Rights Spokesman

At a special breakfast meeting held in Washington June 21, Congressman Ed Derwinski (R., 4th, Ill.) presented author Mihailo Mihailov, the leading human rights dissident in Yugoslavia, to Members of Congress so that he could report to them on the internal conditions within that country.

Mr. Mihailov has spent 12 years in Yugoslav jails, serving three different terms imposed by the Tito Government.

"Mr. Mihailov is the leading spokesman for the application or fundamental human rights in Yugoslavia and has been especially prominent in calling for freedom of speech, freedom of the press, and the establishment of a multi-party political system," Derwinski said. "For his views he has been repeatedly harassed by Yugoslav authorities and subjected to jail sentences."

"The human rights issue is of special concern to many Members of Congress, and the President's attention to it has created interest and controversy."

Mr. Mihailov has charged that the Yugoslav government has not abided by the intent and spirit of the Helsinki Accords despite being the host for a recent conference on the subject that dealt with furtherance of the Helsinki Agreement," Derwinski pointed out.

Mihailov is on a tour of the United States. The Yugoslav government hoped that he would remain in exile, but he insists that he will return to his homeland to continue his battle for human rights.

## SLOVENIAN STUDIES AWARD AT KENT

Mark Sfiligoj, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Marko Sfiligoj of South Euclid, was the recipient of the Slovenian Studies Award 1978 at the May 14th Honors Day Program at Kent State University.

The award, which was established several years ago by KSU Foundation and The Slovenian Research Center of America, Inc., was presented to Mark by KSU President, Dr. Brage Golding, in a magnificent public ceremony, attended by thousands of students, relatives, professors, journalists, and friends.

An article about Mark and his photo appeared in The Cleveland Press and in several other newspapers which highlighted Mark's accomplishments, as well as the unique opportunities for Slovenian Studies at Kent State University — the only university in America which offers a series of six Slovenian language and literature courses, as well as opportunities for the study of several other Slovenian subjects, including theses and doctoral dissertations on Slovenian topics in several fields of specialization.

Kent is also the first university in America to offer an annual Slovenian Studies Award, designed to stimulate serious interest and conscientious work in the field of Slovenian Studies.

Although Mark was born in America, he has an outstanding mastery of the Slovenian language and has for two years taught beginning and more advanced Slovenian language courses as tutor in KSU Critical Languages Program. He has also completed, with excellent success, a 5-credit Honors Course in Slovenian American history, culture, and contributions.

"We are very proud of Mark's accomplishments, not only in Slovenian Studies, but also in other areas," said Prof. Edward Gobetz, who had been instrumental in starting Slovenian Studies at Kent and at several other universities and schools. Born in Cleveland, Mark attended the Saturday Slovenian Language School at St. Vitus, and was an active member of the Slovenian Dramatic Society "Lilija" which — let us underscore — continues to present excellent dramas and comedies up to the present day.

A very talented actor, Mark also appeared in the role of Bossanio, together with America's famous Shakespearean star Morris Carnovsky, at the JCC Theater in 1973. Mark, who is graduating this year from KSU School of Journalism, has already developed an impressive journalistic career which includes a stint as general assignment writer and editor of Soap Bubble Magazine and writer for SCENE Magazine. Like many other talented and heritage-conscious Slovenian Americans, Mark is also an associate of the Slovenski Ameriški Inštitut — The Slovenian Research Center of America, Inc., to which he donates his time and talents as translator and writer.

(Continued from page 5) that unless the notes to the editor take another approach, we shall forever discuss a problem, and solve nothing. The issue is not the first, nor the subsequent meeting, but the underlying principle of the editorials, namely, the 100% reciprocity of cultural exchange.

Hardly anybody will deny that all our concerts, plays and commemorations, amateurish as they may be, are very much a part of our cultural endeavor. The value of these performances is in the results and not in the ideological affiliation of the sponsors. The latter is used, nevertheless, by the Yugoslav government to determine whether or not a cultural performance is worthy of mention in their papers. This kind of discrimination leaves no room for communication.

If we strive to preserve Slovenian heritage in America then let us first look for it in America. It would be of interest to hear which of the two it is better to subsidize and preserve;
