Pogajanja Francije z alžirskimi uporniki so dosegla prvi uspeh

Pod vplivom tunizijskega nastopa sta se delegaciji sporazumeli za način razgovorov in se lotili vprašanja bodočnosti — Sahare.

PARIZ, Fr. — Iz Lugrina, kjer se pogaja delegacija De Gaulle z uporniškimi delegati, je prišla prva vesela vest. Obe delegaciji sta se sporazumeli o načinu debatiranja. Navidez je to malenkost, ki je pa vendar celo tedne držala razgovore na mrtvi točki, alžiriska delegacija je namreč obravnavala samo splošne zadeve, v podrobnosti se ni hotela spuščati. Francoska delegacija je bila ves čas za pogajanja o konkretnih spornih točkah.

Kaj je alžirsko delegacijo nagnilo, da je opustila svoje sedanje stališče, ni jasno. Verjetno je pa to povzročil tunizijski predsednik Burgiba s svojo nepremisljeno akcijo o Bizerti. Zahteval je namreč od Francije ne samo takojšnjo izročitev francoske vojne postojanke v Bizerti, ampak tudi del Sahare. Zadeva s Saharo je za Alžirje izredno važna, pa tudi neprijetna, kadar Tunisija zahteva del Sahare. Zato je zelo verjetno, da bo dosegel pogajanja s Francijo, da se ne bi mogla vanje vmešavati še Tunizija.

Alžiriska delegacija je takoj po dosegzenem sporazumu o načinu debatiranja postavila na dnevni red: Sahar! Predsednika obeh delegacij sta o Sahari govorila že pred sporazumom o načinu debatiranja.

Tako je tunizijski predsednik Burgiba doživel še novo razočaranje, ki ga je rodila njegova nepremisljena akcija o Bizerti: možnost, da se Francija pogodi z Alžirijo o Sahari v odsotnosti Tunizije.

Adenauer ne verjame v vojno zaradi Berlina!

BONN, Nem. — Ministrski predsednik Adenauer je odšel na kratke oddih v Italijo, da zbere moč za volivni boj, ki gačka, kajti nemške parlamentarne volitve so pred vrat. Pred odrhodom je na tiskovni konferenci povedal, da misli, da Hruščev ne bo zaradi Berlina izvabil.

Po njegovem ima Hruščev polne roke dela s pripravami na oktobrske slavnosti in na takratne konference s komunističnimi voditelji vsega sveta. Hruščev mora do oktobra tudi izdelati svoj "20-letni gospodarski plan", kar ni šala, kajti ve, da se v tem delu ne sme prehitovati. Ponovno blamažo na tem področju bi namreč njegov osebni ugled le težko prenesel.

Predsednikov kabinet je zopet ob veljavo

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Po novih ustavi in naših zakonih imenuje predsednik federalne tehnike, Senat jih pa potrdi. So samo njegovi uradniki in sodelavci v prvi liniji. Ker imajo sami le toliko pristojnosti, kolikor jim jo odredil predsednik, zato tudi njihove seje ne pomenujo dosti. Na njih obvelja samo to, na kar pristane predsednik.

CLEVELAND, O. — Okrajni komisarji so dobili v odobritev načrt proračuna na leto 1962 v skupini višini \$78,469,068. Od celotnih vstopov je določenih \$47,565,382 ali 60.6 odstotka za socialno skrbstvo, oziroma neposredno pomoč potrebnim.

Vsek predsednik je uredil vprašanje sej kabineta po svoji. Predsednik Wilson se s kabinetom sploh ni posvetoval o nobeni važni zadevi, je vse odločal kar tam. Predsednik Roosevelt je bil rad na sejih kabineta, toda porabil jih je kot priliko za pogovore in razgovore o vseh nogočnih problemih. Pod njegovim vodstvom ni bilo na sejah nobenega pravega dnevnega reda. Predsednik Eisenhower je imel seje zares. Pod njim se je kabinet sestajal redno, vsaka edenska seja je imela svoj dnevni red, v zapisnik je prišel teden potek debat in predlogov.

Predsednik Kennedy ne da dobiti na seje, jih poredkoma sklicuje in ne dovoli, da bi bil dnevni red preobložen s predmeti in debatami. Zato so člani kabineta sklenili, da se bodo sestajali kar sami brez Kennedyja. Taki sestanki niso prave seje, so samo prilike, da si tajniki izmenjavajo informacije in skušanje in da skupaj poslušajo nekatera važna poročila kot na primer poročila o stanju proračuna, o gospodarskem stanju države, o zunanjih politiki itd.

Drugače ti sestanki nimajo nobenega upravnega značaja in tudi nobenega političnega pomena.

Keng. Michael Feighan za odločnejšo izjavo!

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Keng. Michael Feighan iz Clevelandu v Ohio je kot edini vstal proti rezoluciji predloženi v Predstavniškem domu, ki odpira stališče predsednika Kennedyja v vprašanju Berlina. Zahteval je, da je spomenica odločnejša in da se vanjo vnesne zahteva po svobodnih in splošnih volitvah za obe Nemčiji kot prvi korak k pripravi za podpis mirovne pogodbe z združeno Nemčijo.

Prvotno besedilo je bilo ustavljeno v soglasju z Belo hišo in vodnikom Doma so sklenili, da ne bo o njem nobene debate. Feighanov nastop je sprejem rešoljice začasno zavrl.

Do kubanske begunske vlade je še dolga pot

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Kubanski begunci so bili že davno opozorjeni, da bi bilo pametno, ako bi imeli neke vrste begunske vlado vsaj "na zalogi," tako je že nočelo formalno ustvariti. Begunci so napravili v tej smeri nekaj poskusov, toda vsi so se ponovili, ker je med njimi preveč političnih struj.

Ponovljena invazija jih je še bolj sprla med seboj. Se zmeraj iščejo krivca za polom ne samo v ameriški CIA, ampak tudi v lastnih vrstah. To jih ovira, da bi sestavili začasno begunske skupščino, ki naj bi imenovala begunske vlado.

Razume se, da prijatelji kubanskih beguncov niso prav nič zadovoljni s takim položajem in zmeraj bolj pritisajo na vodilne begunce, naj napravijo konec notranjim preprirom.

Skoraj dve tretjini za podporo — potrebnim!

CLEVELAND, O. — Okrajni komisarji so dobili v odobritev načrt proračuna na leto 1962 v skupini višini \$78,469,068. Od celotnih vstopov je določenih \$47,565,382 ali 60.6 odstotka za socialno skrbstvo, oziroma neposredno pomoč potrebnim.

Predlog bo prišel v javno razpravo 7. avgusta. Od tekočega proračuna je novi višji za 8.3 odstotka, vendar ne bo potrebno izvišanje davkov.

Načrt proračuna kaže jasno, koliko mora davkoplakevalec prispevati za socialno skrbstvo. Mislimo, da je skrajni čas, da cela država pretreče temeljito to vprašanje in ga skuša rešiti na pameten način. Tako bo vsakdo prispeval in breme bo pravljene razdeljeno kot je zdaj, ko je vse na "prostovoljni osnovi."

ZN v Zah. Berlin!

LONDON, Vel. Brit. — Pri

iskanju poti za rešitev berlinske krize je skupina angleških labo-

rističnih članov parlementa predložila temu resolucijo, v kateri se zavzema za to, naj bi poslat Zah. Berlin mednarodno mestu pod upravo Združenih narodov.

Zah. Berlin naj bi bil nevtraliziran, priznan kot mednarodno ozemlje, katerega upravo naj bi prevzel Združeni narodi. Ti naj bi svoj sedež prenesli iz New Yorka v Zah. Berlin. Laboristična skupina bi na ta način rada ustregla sovjetski zahtevi po prenosu sedeža ZN iz New Yorka.

Zdravila brez vsake vrednosti niso pri nas pre-povedana

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Pred Kefauverjevim senatnim podoborom se je ravnatelj federalne agencije za prehrano in zdravila brido pritoževal nad našo zakonodajo, ki mu ne daje možnosti, da bi preganjal taka zdravila, ki sicer niso zdravju škodljiva, toda mu tudi nič ne koristi.

Njegova agencija stoji na stališču, da so zdravila, ki zdravju direktno ne škodujejo, vendarle škodljiva v drugih ozirih. Agencija se mora zapletati v pravde, ki trajajo včasih celo leta, da prepreči sodejstvo o pravilnosti njenega stališča. Federalno tajništvo za zdravje bi moralno na vsak način dobiti oblast, da lahko preskuša tudi učinkovitost posameznih zdravil.

Zdravniško društvo in farmacevtske tovarne seveda ostro nasprotujejo, da bi ta predmet prišel v Kefauverjev načrt o kontroli zdravil.

Kontrola vseh atomskih eksplozij še ni mogoča

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Kongresni odbor za atomske silo je tri dni zasiščaval razne strokovnjake, da bi dosegel, kako je s kontrolo atomskih eksplozij. Strokovnjaki so dali take odgovore, ki se da iz njih sklepati, da majhnih eksplozij atomskoga strilja podzemljo in vseh eksplozij v visolju še zmeraj ni mogoče z gotovostjo dogmati. Menijo, da za potrebnih instrumentov. Strokovnjaki misijo, da bi se taki instrumenti da se dobiti, tako da se tudi instrumenti, ki naj bi pomagale preskušati, ako bi jih bilo mogoče preskušati. To pa sedaj ni mogoče, ker naša administracija sprejme svoja prestovoljno obvezno, da atomskih eksplozij ne bo prestreljala.

Naša administracija je že se stavila nečet za 13 atomskih eksplozij, ki naj bi pomagale preskušati tudi instrumente, da predsednik Kennedy eksplozij še ni dovolil.

V kongresnem odboru so prisli do zaključka, da sistem kontrole preskušanja atomskih eksplozij, ki je sedaj predmet debata na znani ženevski konferenci, sploh ni praktično vporabljiv, kajti dveh vrst eksplozij (malih podzemlju in vseh v visolju) sploh ni mogoče s sedanjimi instrumenti kontrolirati.

Strokovnjaki so opozorili, da na drugo važno okoljšino: ne napreduje samo učinkovitost v tehniki kontroliranja atomskih eksplozij, napreduje tudi način skrivanja eksplozij pred kontrolami. S tem problemom se v ženevi sploh že niso pečali.

Castro ima nov načrt za širjenje komunizma v južni Ameriki

HAVANA, Kuba. — Načrt je napravil Castro, ampak moskovski komunisti, ki sedaj že neovirano vedrijo in oblačijo v Havani. Načrt je vzel na piko vsa podjetja v Južni Ameriki, ki so last Združenih držav. V teh podjetjih je treba takoj ustaviti komunistične trojke in okoli njih nabrali čim večjo mrežo sopotnikov. Ta podjetja naj bi bila stalno pod opazovanjem komunistov. Vsako priliko je treba vporabiti, da pridejo podjetja iz normalnega poslovanja. V ta namen je treba organizirati štrajke, ako je treba, tudi poulične nemire, ki naj uničujejo ameriško imovino.

Dalje je treba ob priliki vsakega sestanka ali konference, ki jo priprejajo države Latinske Amerike in so tam zastopane tudi ZDA, organizirati demonstracije, nemire in štrajke vsaj v posameznih prestolih, ako ne po celih deželah.

Ker bo letos par takih konferenc, bomo lahko kmalu videli, kako se bo Castro in njegov tovarišem ta načrt posrečil.

Anglija išče posojilo

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Semajna je prišla delegacija angleških finančnih strokovnjakov in začela pogajjanja za pol bilijona dolalarjev kratkoročnega posojila. Posojilo naj bi dal Mednarodni denarni fond.

Posojilo ne bi bilo samo v dolgoročnem, ampak v vseh drugih valutah, ki jih ima fond na razpolago in ki jih Anglija rabi v svojih denarnih transakcijah s tujino.

Priprave za pogajjanja so bile dolgo časa v teku, zato računa je, da bodo pregovori zelo hitro uspešno zaključeni.

KLJUB OBOROŽEVANJU IŠČE ZAHOD MIRNO REŠITEV!

Združene države so začele krepiti svoje oborožene sile in prigajajo k temu tudi zavezničke v NATO, vendar še vedno vstrajno iščejo poti za mirno rešitev berlinske krize. — Predsednikove predloge obravnava Kongres po pospešenem postopku.

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Vodstvo oboroženih sil je napovedalo za prihodnji mesec povečanje števila vojaških vpoklicancev, Kongres obravnava predsednikov predlog za okrepitev oboroženih sil dežele po pospešenem postopku. Senatovi odbori so doleželi že skoraj končali in pride predlog, da se danes pred celotno zbornico. Pri tem iščejo vodniki zadržanja oboroženih sil za razgovore s Sovjetsko zvezo. Zatrjeval je, da bodo Združene države in njihovi zaveznički mirno rešitev berlinske krize. Razgovor o raznih možnostih je odklonil češ, da se bo o tem posvetoval prihodnji teden z zunanjimi ministri Vel. Britanije, Francije in Nemčije v Parizu.

Dean Rusk je dejal, da bodo na sestanku v Parizu prihodnji teden skušali vzoprediti ne samo diplomatske napore, ampak tudi vojaške v okviru NATO. Dosedanji zadevni razgovori z zaveznički kažejo na uspeh.

Senatov odbor odobril predloge

Senatov odbor za oborožene sile je večerjog soglasno odobril bližnj bilijon dodatnih denarnih sredstev za neatomsko oružje in strelično ter polnomočje predsedniku za vpoklic četrt milijona rezervistov. Obrambni tajnik McNamara je obljubil, da predsednik uporabljal polnomočje le v slučaju resnične potrebe. Oborožene sile bodo skušale kriti svoje potrebe s prostovoljci, če ne bo teh dovolj, z vpoklici novincev. Vpoklic rezervistov bo še na zadnjem mestu.

Dijaki visokih šol, pripadniki onih poklicev, kjer je pomankanje delovne sile, poljedelski delavci in člani njihovih družin bodo v pogledu vojaških vpoklicev deležni sedanjih ugodnosti, dokler ne bo vpoklic povečan v velikem obsegu.

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Ko je neki kokošnjec v državi Texas hotel, da bi mu kokoš znesle poleti več jajec, je oskrbel kokošnjake s klimatskimi napravami, ki so vzdrževale v nihj znosno temperaturo. Kokoski so znesle v najkrajšem času 60 odstotkov več jajec.

Skušnja je pokazala, da se tudi piščanci, govedo in prašiči rede hitrejše v hladu kot v vročini. Krave v hlajenih hlevih dajo dobiti več mleka kot one v vročih.

Tovarna ur v državi Illinois je uvedla klimatske naprave, da bi preprečila rjavjenje in zapra-

šitev malih preciznih delov mehanizma.

Klimatska naprava ali airconditioning, kot pravimo temu angleško, ima svoj začetek v npravi Willisa Carrierja iz leta 1902, ki je urejala temperaturo, vlago, kroženje in čistočo zraka v njegovi tiskarni v Brooklynu. Te naprave so že dolgo prenehale biti lukus, postale so v vseh vročih predelih sveta prava potreba, ki ne olajšuje samo življenja, ampak povečuje tudi delovne sposobnosti in delovno vmeno.

Angleški pacifisti objavili zemljevid o ameriških vojaških postojankah

LONDON, Ang. — Angleškim pacifistom so ameriške vojaške postojanke tri v peti. Napadajo jih ob vsaki priliki. Sedaj so si celo dovolili prednost, da so izdali poseben zemljevid Anglije, kjer so označena vsa ameriška vojna letališča, oporišča za rakete in vojne luke. Tako je na zemljevidu zaznamovanih 19 oporišč za našo raketo Thor, 16 letališč za naše bombnike, mesta treh skladisč vodikovih bomb itd.

Angleška vlada se je zaenkrat zadovoljila s tem, da ni časnikarjem hotela ne potrditi ne zanikit, da je zemljevid pravilen. Kaj takega si zanesenjak lahko dovoljuje samo v svobodnih demokracijah. Za želesno zavoso je gotovo že sama misel o takem zemljevidu hud zločin. Kdor ne čuti razlike med svobo- do in diktaturom, jo lahko vidi nazorno v tem slučaju.

KAIRO, ZAR. — Arabska liga je na posebni seji sklenila poslati dobrovoljce v Tunizijo, da pomagajo izgnati Francoze s pomorskega oporišča v Bizerti.

Število dobrovoljskega zobra in čas odhoda sta vojaški tajni. Prijave za dobrovoljce sprejemajo konzulat Libije.

OTTAWA, Can. — Za novega guvernerja Bank of Canada je bil imenovan Louis J. Rasmussen, eden izmed podguvernerjev. Nasledil je Jamesa Coyne, ki je po sporu z vladom Diefenbakerja odstopil.

Ameriška in evropska označba mre

Tako bi na primer št. 38 bila ameriške mere 6 1/2, št. 5 in 36 pa 4.

Pri ženskih oblekah pa je razlika v označbi mere vedno za 1 točko. Na primer, če vam sorodnik piše, da nosi obleko št. 40, je to ameriške mere 32, št. 42 je 34, ameriške mere 34, 44 je 36, 46 je 38, 48 je 40, 50 je 42 in 52 je 54.

Isto je pri meri za deklice. Evropska št. 38 je ameriška 12, 40 je 14, 42 je 16, 44 je 18, in 46 je 20.

Pri moških oblekah pa začenja mere v Evropi s št. 42, kar je enako ameriški meri 38, št. 44 je ameriška 34, 46 je 36, 48 je 38, 50 je 39, 52 je 41, 54 je 42 in 56 je 44.

Pri moških stajah pa je razlika v označbi sledenca: št. 35 pomeni ameriško mero 13 1/4, 36 je 14, 37 je 14 1/2, 38 je 15, 39 je 15 1/2, 40 je 15 3/4, 41 je 16, 42 je 16 1/2, 43 je 17.







"Going sleeve-less — going hoseless, going hat-less — glove-less? Fashion has endorsed one or all at various times but what woman could or would, or should, face the world with a shiny nose and without kit or pocketbooks for keys, credit cards, cosmetics and other kaboodle?

"Are, then, handbags and cosmetics 'luxuries'? For the woman in business, these items are beyond any doubt practical necessities and the 10 per cent Federal excise tax works a special hardship professionally, economically and esthetically.

"Legislators who have ignored or vetoed bills introduced to correct the situation are, we feel sure, the very same husbands and beaux who refuse to carry our lipsticks, combs and compacts in their own tax-free pockets.

"So let's rise and shine—not face-wise—but to effect the long overdue repeal of this highly discriminatory tax. When fig leaves were worn, there were no taxes to pay—why tax our necessary accessories today?"

Division of Wildlife

Columbus, O. — It costs \$2 to fish with a license; it costs much more to fish without one. Yet, 761 persons have been apprehended already this year for attempting to fish without a license.

This information came from J. L. Copeland, Ohio Division of Wildlife, law enforcement chief, who commended that "it is much less expensive to abide by the law and buy a \$2 license. We spend a lot of time and effort every year to warn Ohio anglers to get licenses before they go fishing. In spite of this warning, about 1,500 persons are apprehended each year for this violation."

A person can fish an entire year with a \$2 license. It costs that much or more for one evening of most other types of recreation, Copeland pointed out.

"Why jeopardize a vacation or a week end outing by not buying a fishing license?" the enforcement chief asks. "It is the cheapest recreation you can find — as long as you are legal."

NO MEAT IN MOSCOW

"No Meat in Moscow." That was a title of a recent editorial in the Muncie, Indiana, Star — and it has so significant a bearing on developments in this country that Congressman Halleck read it into the Congressional Record.

The editorial began by pointing out that the proposed new farm law would make it possible to put hogs or cattle, and perhaps other livestock, under government marketing orders — and if that should happen, free agriculture would be just about through in this country. Then the Star said: "An acute meat shortage has hit Moscow . . . The Government in Russia, operating in accordance with the Communist theory of national planning, sets the amount of meat which Soviet citizens need to consume and which Red farmers are to produce. An AP correspondent who toured the state-run butcher shops in Moscow failed to find a single scrap of fresh meat, not even sausages. Canned meat from Bulgaria and dried fish were available."

"Meat could be bought in the central market where the peasants bring produce grown on their private plots of land. But the peasants set their own prices in that market, and chunks of beef including the bone were being sold for 4.75 rubles per kilogram, or more than \$2 per pound. The peasants were selling eggs for 16 cents each . . ."

"If an American farmer, or any American Congressman wants to know how a controlled agriculture operates, all he has to do is look to Russia. Government control of supply, which the Communists have in Russia, will bring meatless days to Washington."

"The United States doesn't need to adopt any plan of this kind."

Festival of Nations

Cleveland — The International City with a colorful "Festival of Nations" theme will be the keynote of the third gala Downtown Festival August 24, 25 and 26, it is announced by Benjamin S. Hubbell, Jr., President of the Downtown Cleveland Council, sponsors of the continuing heart-of-the-city enlivement activities.

REGULAR COMMISSIONS FOR MEN NURSES. A bill I recently introduced in the House (H.R. 8135) would authorize the Army and Navy to appoint men nurses as regular commissioned officers in the Nurse Corps. Present statutes give permissive authority to the Air Force to commission men nurses as regular officers, but an amendment to the law is necessary to give the same authority to the Army and Navy. Since 1955 (as a result of Public Law 294, 84th Congress which I sponsored) men nurses have been appointed as reserve officers. Prior to that time they could serve only as wardmen or corpsmen in an enlisted status although many had the same training and qualifications as women nurse officers. There has now been a sufficient time to evaluate the usefulness, the potential and the limitations of men as commissioned officers in the Nurse Corps. Experience has shown that men are particularly useful and effective as general duty nurses, anesthetists, psychiatric nurses, and operating room nurses. While women have never been assigned to airborne divisions, the authority to commission men nurses has permitted the assignment of Army Nurse Corps Officers to these units. Here, the man nurse makes a much needed contribution to the medical units of these special divisions.

The number of professional nurses in the United States is not keeping pace with the national requirements for this profession, and this is reflected in efforts to keep the Nurse Corps of the Services at required strength. It is believed that authorization of regular commissions for men nurses will assist in retention of motivated individuals in military service as a career. In addition, the added recognition of men nurses by the Services will be an incentive for others to enter the nursing profession, thereby helping to relieve the overall shortage of nurses in the civilian as well as military fields.

USS LONG BEACH, OUR FIRST NUCLEAR POWERED SURFACE SHIP

It was a thrill to receive a letter from Admiral Hyman Rickover written aboard the USS LONG BEACH, our first nuclear powered surface ship, just after she had completed her trial tests. Admiral Rickover said the ship made her

designed full power; in fact she exceeded it. During the trials she demonstrated capability to meet all maneuvering requirements including emergency stops and fast reversals.

This 14,000 ton ship has two pressurized water nuclear power plants. She is 721 feet in length and has a beam of 70 feet. She is commanded by Captain Eugene P. Wilkinson, USN, who was also the first captain of the USS NAUTILUS. The advent of the USS LONG BEACH marks an historic step in the development of our nuclear powered surface fleet. Her operation will make possible the first realistic evaluation of nuclear powered naval surface ships with their practically unlimited high speed endurance and operation flexibility. Once her potentialities are understood the LONG BEACH may well have the significance for surface naval warfare that the NAUTILUS had for undersea warfare.
