Razne najnovejše svetovne vesti

LONDON. — V Angliji so že tri tedne na stavki premogarji; več kot 60,000 jih je doma. Vsled pomanjkanja premoga bodo morale tovarne zapreti, če ne bodo šli premogarji nazaj na delo.

NEW DELHI, INDIJA. — Manj kot en mesec je, odkar je zadobila Anglija svojo neodvisnost. V tem času je bilo ubitih že 116,500 oseb v pobojih med posameznimi strujami.

WASHINGTON. — Italija je naprosila ameriško vlado, naj ji priskoči naglo na pomoč z denarjem, da bo mogla nakušiti nekaj hrane in kuriva.

Kaj je rekel predsednik Wilson?

Ko je šel predsednik Wilson dne 2. aprila 1917, da vpraša kongres za vojno napoved Nemčiji, je hotel osrčiti ameriški narod za veliko nalogo, ki je bila pred njim, s tem, da je pokazal na Rusijo, kjer je revolucija dne 15. marca vrgla carski režim.

"Ali ne čuti vsak Amerikanec, da je naše upanje za bodočnost sveta ojačeno po čudovitih razvojih zadnjih tednov v Rusiji?" je rekel predsednik Wilson. "Rusija je bila od nekdaj znana kot demokratična po srcu in po svojih nazorih do življenja. Večko in velikoučno rusko ljudstvo je bilo zdaj prideljeno v vsem svojem naivnem veličastju onim silam, ki se borijo za svobodo sveta, za pravico in mir. V Rusiji imamo vrednega partnerja za Ligo časti."

S temi besedami je predsednik Wilson izrazil misli ogromnega števila Amerikancev v tedanji krizi ameriških zadev. Amerika je bila namreč na tem, da tvega svoj nausodnješki narak izza svoje vojne za neodvisnost. Za nas bi bilo namreč mnočo teže spraviti na noge naše ljudstvo, če bi se morali boriti proti Nemčiji ob strani avtokratične Rusije.

Predsednik Wilson je polagal veliko važnost na dejstvo, da je rusko ljudstvo po svojem srcu demokratično.

Dne leti in pol pozneje, ko je predsednik Wilson potoval po deželi ter govoril za Ligo narodov in mirovno pogodbo, je ponovno omenjal usodo, ki je zadevala rusko ljudstvo po boljševiški revoluciji v novembra leta 1917.

"Možje, ki izvajajo danes kontrolu nad zadevami v Rusiji," je rekel predsednik Wilson dne 6. septembra 1919 v Kansas Cityju, "ne reprezentirajo nikogar, razen sami sebe. Ponovno in ponovno so bili pozvani, naj dokazejo, da imajo ta ali one vrste mandat izza enega samega sloja svojih reakcij, toda oni si ne upojo poskušati takega dokazovanja. Danes je v Petrogradu in Moskvi večji monopol sile in oblasti, kot je bil kdaj v Berlinu, in skupina mož, bolj krutih kot je bil sam car, kontrolira danes usodo velikega ruskega naroda."

Primerjajte velika upanja predsednika Wilsona, ki jih je izgovoril v marcu 1917, z besedami, ki jih je bil prisiljen izgovoriti v Kansas Cityju. Bil je razcoran do dna srca, kakov smo razočarani nad Rusijo oziroma njenimi diktatorji zdaj, po drugi svetovni vojni. Danes sploh ni več vprašanja, ali bo Rusija postala demokratična država. Možje, ki so se leta 1917 polastili v Rusiji moči, so danes v popolni kontroli ruske policijske države ter države v svojih rokah usodo 190 milijonov ljudi. . .

Toda tekom druge svetovne vojne je bilo mnogo upanja, da bo Rusija sodelovala z ostalim svetom pri obnovi ogromnega razdejanja, pri pisanju pravičnih pogodb ter pri organiziranju novega sveta, ki naj bo svet miru. Toda vsa ta upanja so bila do kaj omajana po korakih, ki jih je pričela Rusija ubirati izza konca druge svetovne vojne.

Mnogo vode že preteklo po Volgi, odkar je predsednik Wilson obsodil mož, ki so se polastili leta 1917 oblasti v Rusiji. Ti možje niso še nikoli v tridesetih letih sprejeli poziva, da bodo dobili svobodne volitve in da bi dokazali, da imajo kak mandat od tega ali onega sloja ruskega ljudstva. Že predsednik Wilson je moral ugotoviti, da je "neznosno," da peščica teh mož kontrolira usodo ruskega naroda. Predsednik Truman in njegovi svetovalci pa so ugotovili, da je "neznosno," da bi se ta grupa mož nasilno polastila kontrole nad svojimi zapadnimi sosedmi. Zato smatramo lahko ta leta kot leta poraza za demokratične države.

Toda pri tem ne smemo pozabiti, da diktatorske države kakor Rusija lahko izpremeni in so že tudi nenadoma spremeni v preteklosti svoje smernice, kadar uvidijo, da jadrajo nevarnostim nasproti. Dalje moramo vedeti, da diktatorji, pa naj bodo še tako silni in močni, niso neumrljivi ljudje. Ob smrti diktatorja je navadno perioda konfuzije in često preobrat politike. Zato vemo, da je čas — ako ga znamo pravilno izrabljati — na strani demokratičnih sil.

"Glas Amerike"

Kakor znano, oddaja naša vlada v Rusijo potom radia razna poročila kakor tudi razne programe, ki jih v Rusiji silno radi poslušajo. Da so sovjetski vladi te ameriške radio oddaje silno neljube, je dokaz to, ker so predmet silnih napadov od strani sovjetskega komunističnega časopisa, ki označuje ta poročila kot "kapitalistične laži."

Nobeno čudo, če komunistični voditelji ne marajo "Glasu Amerike." Oni prav tako ne marajo "Amerike," v ruskem jeziku tiskane mesečnika našega državnega departmента. Slike v tem mesečniku proglaša rusko komunistično časopisje kot "propagando idiličnega življenja ameriškega ljudstva gornjih plasti." Rusko ljudstvo pa je drugačnih misli, kajti naglo pokupljene iztise "Amerike" ljudje raztrgajo ter prodajajo posamezne strani, da tako zadoste ljudskim zahtevam. Sovjetski vladi je vse to "vmešavanje tujih kapitalistov" in notranje zadeve Sovjetske Rusije." Zato ne dovolje svojim državljanom občevanja z Amerikaniki, ker smatrajo to za sumljivo in izdajalsko početje. — Kako pa Jugoslaviji? Popolnoma enako!

Employment News

Starting Sept. 8th, continued claims under both the federal readjustment act and state law will again be filed in the Cleveland Office of the Bureau of Unemployment Compensation weekly instead of every two weeks. The resumption of weekly reporting discontinued in February as the result of a drastic cut in administrative funds, is now possible because of decline of the claims load in Ohio from a weekly average of 77,000 in January to a July average of 57,000.

The resumption of weekly reporting also means that claimants will receive their benefit checks weekly after September 8 instead of bi-weekly as they did during the emergency period since February, said B. C. Sipple, manager of the Cleveland office of the B.U.C. The local office will commence rescheduling all claimants as they report next week, so that by the second week in September all claimants will be reporting weekly.

Claimants who file for state or federal unemployment benefits must register for employment with the Ohio State Employment Service, a division of the Bureau of Unemployment Compensation. The Cleveland Office of the B.U.C. is located at 1242 West Third St. Ohio State Employment Service offices are at 1242 West Third St. and 747 Euclid Ave.

WAC Enlistments

Former WAC's desiring to reenlist in the Women's Army Corps must do so before September 30, 1947. Major G. D. Mauck of the U. S. Army and Air Force Recruiting Station said today.

The date is set in anticipation of the termination of the Women's Army Corps and its integration in the Regular Army as provided in legislation now pending before Congress.
