Poraba raket v vojne svrhe ne pozna meja

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Pris je v navado naziranje, da rakete lahko vporabljamo samo z sporišč na suhem. To je zmotno, pravijo vojaki. Sedaj sestavljajo posebne vlake, ki bodo na njih prevažali, montirani in streljali z raketami, ne morda samo z malimi, tudi s takimi, ki lahko letijo na 6,000 milij. Ako se strokovnjakom res posreči, da sestavijo tak vlak, potem bodo stalna oporišča izgubila precej na svojem pomenu.

Naša armada je dala napraviti tudi posebne vrste helikopter, ki bo mala trdnjava. V svojo obrambo bo nosil strojne puške, poleg njih bo pa lahko streljal z raketami na kratke daljave. Novi helikopter bo izrazito takčno orodje. Lahko se bo pokazal hipoma v prvi bojni liniji, cestreljal v par trenutkih svoje rakete in zopet izgnil, tako, da ga sovražnik ne bo vtegnil preganjati.

Nov dokaz, da smo v gospodarski konjunkturi

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Tajanstvo za delavske zadave je obljivo, da je bilo v deželi tekom prvih treh mesecev 675 malih štrajkov, torej 20% več kot lani. Izgubljeno je bilo 4.5 milijona delovnih dni, še enkrat toliko kot lani.

Ameriške in kanadske ladje dobe prednosti?

Težave v prometu skozi zatvornice globokovodne poti po reki sv. Lovrenca so sprožile zahtevo po prednosti kanadskim in ameriškim ladjam.

OTTAWA, Can. — Zvezna vlada in vodstvo vodne poti reke sv. Lovrenca razmišljata o potrebi uvedbe prednosti za domače, kanadske in ameriške, ladje skozi zatvornice, kjer je prislo v času od otvoritve vodne poti ponovno do dolgega čakanja in hude gneče. Domača brodarica podjetja so začela pritisati na vlado, naj zaščiti njihove koristi s tem, da prizna njihovim ladjam pri prehodu prednost. Ko se je sredi preteklega tedna položaj malo izboljšal, je sicer trenutno pritisk na vlado popustil, toda le samo do nastopa novih težav.

V prvih dneh otvoritve prometa je čakalo v Ontario jezeru enkrat preko 50 tujih in domačih ladij za prehod v Erie jezero. Sredi tega tedna je to število padlo na okoli 30. Težave povzroča na eni strani pomanjkanje skušenih pilotov, ki naj bi vodili tuje ladje skozi zatvornice in prekope, na drugi pa tudi nepripravljenost in nevajenost tujih ladij in njihovega moštva na plovbo skozi rečne kanale in zatvornice.

Umor Rudolfa Kordiša pred okrajnim sodiščem

CLEVELAND, O. — Vredo se je začela pred okrajnim sodniki Josephom H. Silbertom razprava proti Robertu Lowtheru, ki je obdolžen, da je pobil do smrti Rudolfa Kordiša na njegovem domu na 15112 Ridpath Ave. znamen, da ga oropa. Državo je zavzel okrajni pomožni tožilec Thomas L. Osborne, obtoženca pa odvetnik Morris H. Wolf.

Zaposlencstv v aprilu v znamenju novega gospodarskega poleta

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Tajanstvo za delavske zadave in zatvornino so pred par dnevi objavila podatke o zaposlenosti v aprili. Številke same po sebi niso slabe.

Stevilo zaposlenih je naraslo od marca do aprila za 1,184,000 na 65,012,000. To je kar lep napredok, toda mu še manjka veliko, da bi dosegel rekord iz junija 1957, ki je znašal 67,221,000.

Povečanje zaposlenosti so ugotovili največ na gospodarskih področjih izven industrije, največ v kmetijstvu. Industrija sama je zaposila samo 369,000 novih delavcev.

Temu primerno je padlo število brezposelnih za 735,000 na 3,627,000. Tako malo brezposelnih že nismo imeli od decembra 1957. Je pa tudi v tej številki nekaj grenkob: odstotek tistih, ki so že dolgo časa brez posla, je še zmeraj visok; od marca na april je število takih brezposelnih padlo za 150,000, toda znaša še zmeraj 1,400,000. Toliko je selenih.

Vse kaže, da bo prihodnje meseca brezposelnost še padala; kako nizko bo padla, tega ne upa nihko prorokati. Pravijo pa da bi bilo idealno, ako bi padla na približno dva milijona. Skušnja namreč govori, da smo imeli tudi za časa največjih konjunkturnih padlo za 150,000, toda znaša še zmeraj 1,400,000. Toliko je selenih.

Delavski voditelji vidijo vzrok za povečanje brezposelnosti nekeje druge. Pravijo, da se podjetja bojijo štrajka v jeklarski industriji in da radi tega hitijo z proizvodnjo in delajo kar "na skladisče."

Se bolj zanesljiv znak za oživo konjunkturo je povprečni tedenski delavni čas. Pred letom je bil komaj 39 ur na teden,

sedaj je 40.3 ure. To je znamejne, da nekateri delavci delajo že zopet več kot 40 ur na teden in da je število tistih, ki delajo povprečno manj kot 40 ur, zelo padlo.

Pri vsem tem popolne zaposlenosti ni v nobeni gospodarski panogi. Še celo tem, kjer vlada sezona in konjunktura, je precej nezaposlenosti. V avtomobilski industriji je na primer še zmeraj 8.6% delavcev brez posla.

Vsi računajo s tem, da se bo tekom letosnjega poletja pokazalo, ali je sedanja gospodarska konjunktura res tako močna, da bo vrska vse brezposelne v proizvodni proces. Ako se bo res zgodilo, se bo odvalil več kamen s srca ne samo brez-

poselnim delavcem, ampak tudi diplomatske zvezde z Bolgarijo, je politikom, kajti tudi njim grozi cbenem prepovedala potovanja brezposelnost jeseni l. 1960, ako to v satelitsko deželo. Sedaj bo ne bodo ponovno izvoljeni. Ste-

mo v kratkem obnovili stike na predlog iz Sofije in bo zaposlenosti pomeni tudi krizo naše poslanstvo začelo tam z pet poslovnati.

Hruščev hoče na vsak način priti v Ameriko

Predsednik sovjetske vlade Nikita Hruščev že dolgo želi priti v Ameriko, letos izgleda, da se mu bo to posrečilo.

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Zvezne oblasti so se že nekako spriznile z mislio, da bo prišel sovjetski oblastnik Nikita Hruščev v Združene države na obisk še letos. Poslaniku Thompsonu v Moskvi je to naravnost namignil v zvezi z otvoritvijo sovjetske razstave koncem junija v New Yorku. Podobno ameriško razstavo v Moskvi pojde odprt podpredsednik Richard Nixon.

Hruščev je že ponovno v preteklih letih namignil, da bi si rad prišel ogledati Združene države, kjer naj bi ga predstavniki svobodne Amerike slovesno sprejemali in pozdravljali kot sta

ga pred nekaj leti angleška vladna v angleški dvor. Eisenhower in Dulles sta vse poskuse

Hruščeva v preteklosti znašal spretno zavrniti, sedaj pa bo kaj podobnega le težko storiti.

Predsednik sovjetske vlade sudi, da bo prišel v Združene države na sestank na vrhu, ki naj bi bil po njegovih željah, če le mogče v avgustu v San Franciscu. Če bi se mu to ne posrečilo, je odločen izkoristiti priložnost in priti osebno odpretni sovjetskega zunanjega ministra Gromika, o obstoju dveh Nemčij v dveh nemških vlad. Dejal je, da zahodne sile pozna samo eno svobodno izvoljeno nemško vladno, ki ima pravico govoriti v imenu Nemčev. Herterjev stanje pa podpira tudi predsednik ministra Anglije in Francije.

Zahod zahteva postopno zdržitev Nemčije na temelju svobodni volitev in sklenitev mirovne pogodbe z vladno zdržitev Nemčije, ki bo svobodno izvoljena. Sovjetska zveza trdi,

da na zdržitev Nemčije je dolgo misliti in da je potrebno skleniti mirovno pogodbo z obe

ma nemškima vladama.

Kam se bo nagnila Afrika?

I.

Borba med komunizmom in demokratičnim redom ni omejena na Evropo in Azijo, zajela je vse kontinente, prav posebno pa se razvija v zadnjih letih na črnem kontinentu — v Afriki.

Afrika spada k "starem," znanemu svetu. Na afriških tleh je zrasla egiptanska kultura, ena najstarejših, če ne sploh najstarejša na vsem svetu. Egiptski vladarji, faraoni, so že v tretjem tisočletju prodrli globoko v notranjost kontinenta navzgor ob reki Nilu. V starem veku se je posrečilo objadati ves kontinent od Nilovega ustja skozi Gibraltarska vrata, mimo Zelenega rtiča in rta Dobre nade skozi Adenski preliv in Rdeče morje. Perzijski kralj Darij je obnovil prekop, ki je povezel Sredozemlje po Nilu z Rdečim morjem.

Na afriški obali Sredozemlja je zrastla mogoča Kartagina, ki je grozila uničiti stari Rim, še predno je prišel prav do svoje moči. Njen vojskovodja Hanibal se je pojavil pred samimi vrti Rima.

V Afriki je bila v Aleksandriji v antiki največja knjižnica, tam se je rodila in zrastla vrsta velikih mož zgodnjega krščanstva. V starem veku je bila severna Afrika del enotnega kulturnega sveta, ki je nastal ob Sredozemskem morju.

Islam je v sedmem in osmtem stoletju osvojil ves Sredenjih vzhod in se preko severne obale Afrike pognal prav tja v Španijo in Južno Francijo. S težavo so Franki ustavili arabski naval pri Poitiersu 732 l. po Kr. r.

Od onih din se je islam v severni Afriki turtil in segel daleč v Saharo in še preko nje v Sudan. Tako je danes Afrika v svojem severnem delu islamska in poseljena po arabsko-berberski mešanici, med tem ko je v srednjem in južnem delu po ogromni večini poganska in naseljena s črnimi. Le na skrajnem jugu je naseljenih kakrš tri milijone belcev, ki skušajo v Južnoafriški uniji ohraniti oblast nad črnsko velenino.

Afrika meri po površini okoli 11.5 milijona kv. milj, skoraj štirikrat toliko kot kontinentalne Združene države, pa ima komaj kaj več prebivalstva od njih. Od vseh kontinentov je najbolj zaprta. Nima večjega števila ugodnih naravnih pristanišč, večina velikih rek, ki se izlivajo v more, ima že blizu izliva hude brzice, ki otežujejo plovbo v notranjost. Tako ni čudno, da je ostala ta še do druge polovice preteklega stoletja zahodnemu človeku prava skrivenost.

Zahodni svet se za Afriko do moderne dobe ni posebno zanimal. Na severu so mu zapirali pod vanjo bojeviti muslimani, ob obalah pa so si pomorski narodi postavili le malo oporišča, potrebna za oskrbo, Angleži pa tudi oporišča za lov na črnce, ki so jih vozili od tam v Ameriko prodajat za sužnje. Pri tem poslu so jim pomagali tudi islamski domaćini, ki so hodili po črni sužnji daleč v notranjost dežele. Angleži so suženjstvo prepovedali l. 1837 in skušali nato sramotno trgovino ustaviti in preprečiti.

V notranjost črnega kontinenta sta v drugi polovici preteklega stoletja prodrla angleški misijonar Livingstone in ameriški časnik Stanley, ki je prvega šel iskat. Ta je kot prvi belec prepotoval Afriko od Zanzibarja v Indijskem oceanu do Kongovega ustja ob Atlantiku. Globoko v notranjost Afrike je prodrl tudi slovenski rojak, misijonar Ignacij Knoblehar.

Proti koncu preteklega in v začetku sedanjega stoletja je prišlo do hude tekme med evropskimi silami za afriško zemljo. Angleži so se utrdili v Egiptu, kjer jim je bil posebno važen Sueški prekop, prodrl navzgor po Nilu v Sudan, Ugando, se utrdili v Keniji in dejansko osvojili v boju z Burirji vso vzhodno Afriko razen portugalskega Mozambiqua in Nemške vzhodne Afrike. Imeli so v načrtu graditev železnice in ceste od Aleksandrije in Kaira v Egiptu pa do Capetowna v Južni Afriki.

Francozi so se utrdili v severni Afriki, kjer so dobili pod svoje nadzorstvo najprej Alžirijo (1830), nato pa še Tunizijo (1881) in Maroko (1906). Preko Sahare so prodrl v Sudan in tropsko Afriko in dosegli tudi reko Nil. Tedaj je postalne nevarno, da se bodo popadli z Angleži, ki so hoteli za vsako ceno očuvati porečje Nila za sebe.

Belgia je dobila Kongo čisto po sreči — podvedovala ga je po kralju Leopoldu, ki je bil kot predsednik Družbe za odkritje in proučevanje Konga skrbel za njegovo ureditev potem, ko ga je Stanley odkril. Portugalcii so obdržali, kar jim niso tekom let pobrali močnejši. Nemci so prišli pozno, pa se moralni po prvi svetovni vojni umakniti popolnoma. Tedaj je začel snovati svoj afriški imperij italijanski Mussolini. Tega je vzelala druga svetovna vojna.

Ta je močno omajala tudi francoski položaj v Tuniziji, Alžiriji in Maroku. Prebivalci teh treh dežel so dosegli že prejšnjo stopnjo civilizacije in videč francosko slabost se odločili otresti nadoblasti Pariza. Maroku in Tuniziji je uspelo, Alžirija se za to še boriti.

Anglija se je morala umakniti iz Egipta in Sueza, njen vpliv je oslabljen v Južno-afrški uniji, ki je za enkrat še ostala v britski Skupnosti narodov, paže več let govori o izstopu iz nje. Dala je svobodo Sudanu, sosedu Egipta na jugu, nato Gani v zahodni Afriki. Tema bodo v prihodnjih letih sledile druge kolonije in ozemlja.

Pred dvemi desetletji je bila dejansko v vsej Afriki edina čisto svobodna država republika Liberija, kajti Abesinijo so imeli zasedeno Italijani, Egipt in Južna Afrika pa sta bila povezana z Britskim imperijem. Danes je vsa severna Afrika razen Alžirije svobodna, svobodna je tudi Abesinija, svobodna bo skoraj njena sosedna Somalija, med tem ko sta nastali na zahodni obali poleg Liberije še neodvisni republiki Gana in Gvineja.

Ti dve sta sklenili federacijo, ki naj postane jedro nove Zvezze zahodno-afrških držav.





THOSE HORRIBLE ADS AGAIN!

The following editorial is reprinted from Editor & Publisher:

"Why is it that the word 'advertising' is getting to be a dirty word? More and more the people who benefit by the high level of advertising in our economy, which keeps our industrial wheels turning at a high rate, are taking a stand against it. This obviously reflects wide-spread ignorance of advertising's role in our day-to-day life which unless corrected may lead to national economic disaster. Our standard of living and our high rate of production of consumer goods would never be maintained without advertising."

"There seems to be something inherently wrong with advertising, according to many who attack it or scorn it today. The federal government declares that patent attorneys who advertise their services may not practice before U. S. agencies. The Federal Power Commission says utilities cannot consider the expense of certain advertising as a cost of doing business for rate-making purposes. The Internal Revenue Service says advertising concerning legislation is lobbying and cannot be used as a business expense for income tax purposes. The Supreme Court says you cannot oppose pending legislation through paid advertising (and consider it a business expense) even though the legislation may threaten the existence of your business and your livelihood. Some service business such as funeral directors and optometrists in their search for 'professional status' would have their advertising controlled, restricted and even prohibited in the mistaken belief that this will help them become a profession. Now comes George Meany, AFL-CIO president, who believes that labor papers should not carry advertising because 'the labor movement, as a matter of pride, should pay its own way.'

"Where is there any lack of pride in producing a publication that is so good and has such wide and proven leadership that people are anxious to buy space in it? Mr. Meany implies, obviously, that publications which carry advertising are beholden to their advertisers for their news and editorial policies. Even if such a situation existed, which it doesn't what possibly would a union-controlled publication have to fear from an advertiser?

"Statements such as Mr. Meany's . . . are bound to have an eroding effect on the public's belief in advertising. Meanwhile, though advertising people and the media which depend upon them discuss the situation among themselves, little if anything is being done to bolster advertising's position with the public which also lives by it without realizing.

"An advertising industry-wide propaganda or educational effort is needed and the need becomes more and more urgent every day."



From the Indian Teepee



The uphill road to distinction as one of the American League's premier pitchers has been almost as long as his name for Calvin Coolidge Julius Caesar Tuskaoma McLish of the Cleveland Indians.

After 16 seasons in organized baseball dating back to 1944 when he started pitching for the Brooklyn Dodgers at a \$150 monthly salary, McLish now is ready to admit that he's glad baseball is his chosen profession.

The 33-year-old Oklahoman readily admits that there were many times in the past when he said to himself, "Maybe I ought to get into something else. I wonder if I'll ever earn enough in baseball to support my family."

Mrs. Ruth Irish McLish and the five little McLishes starting with eight - year-old Calvin Coolidge, Jr. down to Thomas Jefferson, now almost two, are happy that papa stuck with baseball since today Cal is earning the money necessary to raise such a large, healthy brood.

Manager Joe Gordon will tell you that in his opinion McLish is the best pitcher in the American League and who can very well argue with him on the basis of Cal's performances for Gordon since the latter was appointed Cleveland's pilot last June 26.

When Gordon came to Cleveland, McLish, who had been used sparingly by Gordon's predecessor, Bob Bragan, owned the unimpressive mark of three victories and five defeats. Gordon immediately installed McLish as one of his regular starters and in the final half of the 1958 season, McLish won 18 and lost but three games. One of his setbacks was a 12-inning 4 to 2 loss to Washington and another was a 2 to 1 setback to Kansas City.

This season he has been the outstanding pitcher in the league in the first month of the 1959 season as he has won four straight games without a loss. He has given up but seven earned runs in 45 innings for the remarkable ERA of 1.40.



CLEVELAND AND HARBOR HEARINGS

Last week I was happy to join my Cleveland colleagues in submitting a statement to the House and Senate Appropriations Committees in support of the request for an appropriation of \$200,000 for construction plans for the replacement of the Erie Railroad Bridge on the Cuyahoga River. As you know, the Cleveland Harbor Improvement Project has been underway for more than 20 years to improve navigation and permit larger vessels to use the Cuyahoga River. To date six of the seven railroad bridges which hindered navigation have been replaced. The Erie Railroad Bridge is the last remaining restriction to navigation. Once it is replaced the larger vessels coming with the opening of the St. Lawrence Seaway will be able to navigate the Cuyahoga freely. In my statement I reminded the Members of the Committee that the House Committee on Public Works in their report on the Omnibus Rivers and Harbor Bill last year had noted that the Cleveland Harbor Project had an unusually high benefit-to-cost ratio. We are hoping that the planning money will be provided this year so that actual construction can get underway as soon as possible.

RAILROAD RETIREMENT BENEFITS INCREASED

An adjustment in pensions for retired railroad employees was approved by the House and Senate last week. Under this legislation, pensions will be increased an average of 10 per cent and unemployment compensation will be upped an average of 20 per cent. To pay for this increase the retirement tax on both employee and the railroad will be increased from 6.25 per cent to 6.75 per cent.

Gensus Bureau to Survey Newspaper Buying Habits

Questions on the daily and Sunday newspaper buying habits of the American people will be asked in the May Current Population Survey, it was announced today by Field Director John E. Tharaldson of the Census Bureau's regional office at Detroit.

The questions will cover home delivery and purchases of daily and Sunday newspapers at newsstands and other retail outlets. The survey will provide the first comprehensive national statistics on this subject.

The special questions on home delivery and purchase of newspapers will be in addition to the regular inquiries on employment and unemployment which are asked in the Current Population Survey which is conducted every month by the Census Bureau in 330 sample areas throughout the country.

Current Population Survey information will be collected from a cross-section of local families during the week of May 18 by certified enumerators.

Rarest Caruso Record To Be Played

The rarest Caruso record in existence is going to be played on Station WERE FM, Monday, May 25, 1959, at 8:45 p.m." says S/SGT Thomas R. Villella, local air force recruiter. The record is famous because the great tenor sings in bass voice. Here's the story.

Enrico Caruso, the great Italian tenor, went to Philadelphia to sing a performance of La Bohème, in 1916. During the last act, the basso of the performance, Andres de Segurola, lost his voice and could not continue, just as he was to have sung the famous coat song "Vecchia Zimara". He turned to Caruso in panic. Caruso told him to move his lips and that he would sing the aria for him, which he did, with his back turned to the audience. The audience was unaware that Caruso was singing in BASS VOICE. Later, the beloved tenor made a record of the aria, had six copies struck, and the master record destroyed before his very eyes. "He didn't want to spoil the bass business", comments Sgt. Villella. Fortunately, one copy has survived. It is from the private collection of Sgt. Villella, and it will be fea-

tured in the new series "Great Vocal Rarities", sponsored by the United States Air Force, and broadcast over the facilities of local station WERE FM.


