Zavezniki se jezijo na politiko ZD v Vietnamu

Ameriški zavezniki v NATO so zaskrbljeni zaradi razvoja v jugovzhodni Aziji in se jezijo na Washington, ker jih pušča v tem pogledu v temi.

PARIZ, Fr. — Razvoj vojne v Vietnamu je začel skrbeti zaveznike Združenih držav v NATO. Boje se, da bi se utegnila vojna raztegniti v taki meri, da bi bili potegnjeni vanjo tudi oni. Jezijo se na Združene države, da jih puščajo v pogledu vojne v Vietnamu v temi, da delajo vse na svojo roko.

De Gaulle in njegova vlada sta javno izrazila svojo skrb zavaroči razvoja v Vietnamu in izjavila, da sta prepričana, da bo vojna zajela "velik kos Azije", če ne bo prišlo do ureditve potom pogajanja. Za te se De Gaulle zavzema že od lanskega poletja in je francoska vlada pred par dnevi izjavila, da bo sodelovala s Sovjetsko zvezo pri naporu na sklicanje nove ženevske konference prizadetih držav, ki so leta 1954 sklenile dogovor o ureditvi Indokine. Nekateri glasovi iz vladnih krogov namigajo, da Francija v slučaju razširitve vojne ne bo pomagala Združenim državam, če bodo te francoske predloge za razgovore zavračale.

Od vseh zaveznikov NATO so ameriški strani odločno le v Londonu, kjer imajo sami težave v jugovzhodni Aziji, obvezani so namreč braniti Malezijo pred Sukarnom v Indoneziji. Ta se kar očitno postavlja na stran drdeč Kitajske in bi brez dvoma postal še bolj nasilen in bojevit, če bi Amerika v Južnem Vietnamu popustila rdečemu prijatelju.

Napad na ameriško poslaništvo v Moskvi

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Včeraj popoldne okoli treh je skušno kakih 3,000 študentov z moskovsko in "Luminbove" univerze prikorakala pred ameriško poslaništvo, ki ga je policija preje zastražila in zavarovala z laško ograjo in tovornimi avtomobili s snežnimi plugi. Za to obrambno linijo je bilo kakih 600 policijev in več sto detektivov. Demonstranti so navalili na policijski kordon in ga predvsem začeli metati kamenje in črnimke proti poslopju poslaništva.

Turška vladna kriza končana samo na pol

ANKARA, Tur. — Zadnja turška vladna kriza, ki se je začela 13. februarja z demisijo Inoencijevje republikanske vlade, je bila posledica političnih potekov treh turških politikov. Predsednik republike general Gursel je prišel do prepričanja, da republikanska stranka sili preveč na levo: v domači politiki zagovarja socialne reforme, v zunanjosti politički se hoče nasloniti na Moskovo. To turški armadi ne gre v račun, zato je treba republikance spraviti v vlade. Ministrski predsednik Inoenu je vedel, kaj mislijo generali in se ni hotel boriti z njimi. Pripravil je se že dolgo na vladno krizo in opozicijo. V tem namen je že lani dal izglasovati volivni zakon, ki bo verjetno najbolj škodoval stranki pravice (bivši demokrati). Obenem je hotel spraviti svojo stranko pravočasno v opozicijo, da se lahko pripravi na parlamentarne volitve, ki so predvidene za 10. oktober. Voditelj največje opozicijske stranke Demirel bi pa bil rad imel krizo, gočasna, to lahko pričakujemo, da ugotovi, kaj mislijo generali Republikanska stranka je po le-

Avstrija je torej pripravljena, da svoje gospodarstvo vstopi v EGS. Seveda bo pa morala pretrgati svoje zveze z EFTA, to je gospodarsko skupnostjo, ki jo je svoj čas Anglija ustanovila kot protutez proti EGS. Za Jugoslavijo bo to hud udarec.

PRINCETON, N.J. — Gallupov zavod je spraševal ljudi, kaj misijo o politiki. Nič dobrega, kajti 54% ne bi rado videlo, da bi se njihovi otroci začeli poklicno početi s politiko. Samo 36% jih ne bi imelo ničesar proti temu. Politika ni torej kreditna med ljudmi. Vendar pa se njen ugled popravlja.

Pred 20 leti je bilo 68% Amerikancev "proti politiki", kar je razumljivo. Dežela je prezivela vojno, sicer je zmagala, toda žalostnih spominov nanjo pa zmagala ni mogla zatrepi. Pred 10 leti jih je pa bilo 60% proti politiki. Zanimivo je, zakaj ljudje ne marajo politike: 17% jih pravi, da je politika preveč povezana s korupcijo, 11% ne vidi v političnem poklicu nobene dobročinstvi. Dobro bi bilo, da bi še kdjo ugotovil, koliko volivev voli kandidate po kravatah in oblekah in koliko po sposobnostih in življenski skupnosti. To bi bila najbolj značilna statistika, toda ob enem verjetno tudi najbolj obupna.

MIAMI BEACH, Fla. — Leta 1949 so tiste unije, ki niso hoteli prenašati komunistične diktature v mednarodni uniji zvezki, ustanovile svojo pod imenom: Mednarodna konfederacija svobodnih unij (ICFTU). Pobudo za to so dale naše AFL-CIO in so tudi novo zvezo denarno močno podpirale s povprečnim letnim prispevkom \$15 milijonov. V konfederaciji so včlanjene unije iz 70 držav, ki imajo skupaj nad 60 milijonov članov.

Ameriška AFL-CIO je hotela v novi konfederaciji igrati prvo vijolino, s čemer pa evropski sindikati niso bili zadovoljni, posebno angleški in francoski se so upirali ameriškemu vplivu.

Prišlo je pa tudi do ostrih trenj glede politike konfederacije v Aziji in Afriki. Trenja so se zadnja leta hudo zaostriila. Toda ni sedanja izjava AFL-CIO, da hčete iz konfederacije, presenetila tistih, ki poznajo notranje razmere v konfederaciji. Vendar pa vsi upajo, da bo ostalo le pri grožnji.

"Mi sodimo, da obstoji kriza v smislu, da je Kanada prišla do trenutka, ko se je treba odločiti, ki je razvoj pripeljal do tega, kar nas bo vodilo k razpadu ali pa ustvarilo nove pogoje za bodoči obstoj... Vseh 10 nas je prepričanih, da je v sedanjem položaju težka nevarnost za bodočnost Kanade v vseh Kanadčanov. Spopad med angleškim vodstvom, ampak preračunano delo raznih gangsterjev. Gangsterji niso revni ljudje, imajo denar in se dobro razumejo na gospodarjenje in pri tem ne poznaajo meje, kaj je dovoljeno in kaj ni. Tako so že nekajkrat najeli denar, z najetim denarjem pa kupili večinske pakete malih bank. Ko so po tej poti dobili banko v roke, so dajali proti visokim nagradam tvegana posojila in tako zavod upropastili."

Francoska Kanada obsegata poleg Quebec in dele sosednjih obmorskih pokrajin. Francosko govoreči Kanadčani predstavljajo pičo tretjino prebivalstva delo.

Poleg francosko in angleško govorečega prebivalstva je v Kanadi tudi več drugih narodnostnih skupin, Ukrainer, Italijan, Nemecv, pa tudi nekaj deset tisoč Slovencev. Prebivalstvo angleškega izvora predstavlja le okoli 43% celotnega prebivalstva Kanade, okoli 30% Kanadčanov je francoskega izvora.

HOME AND FLOWER SHOW OPENS TOMORROW

For the first time, too, more exciting gardens and Green Thumb court will be located in the Main Exhibit Hall directly below the beloved traditional Main Arena fairlyland spectacle.

Applying the magical formula of long hours, dogged hard work, planning and planting know-how that creates the inspirational beauty of thousands of fresh blossoms that may normally never see the same season of the sun or geographical area, grower members of the Florists Association of Greater Cleveland are preparing their plants for an masse debut.

Jack Andress of Hi-Way Nursery, Westlake, will show a two-level contemporary garden featuring roses with petunias and coleus for additional color.

Frank Spear of Stoney Acre Gardens, Warrensville Heights, will show a large patio garden with a lily-filled fountain pool and red geranium Penelope for color.

Robert Perkins of Westlake will present an old-fashioned herb garden complete with an herb house and split-rail fence.

Jack Ellacott, Warrensville Hts., will feature a formal garden patio with hyacinths and azaleas.

Louis Schlegel of Parma will display hyacinths and forsythia with white pines as background.

William Jensen of Avon has imported an eight foot high Dutch Windmill for his scene of radiant tulips and a canal bridge.

Steve Gall of Shaker Heights will create a trilevel brook with oriental effect using Fuji mums, Queens Lace and Yellow lace.

Larry Lieux of Avon will spotlight a semi-formal garden featuring pink floribunda roses and geraniums Irene.

Arthur Hirt of Strongsville will

show a Kentucky blue grass backyard garden as viewed from a house, using white azaleas and red fibrous begonias.

James Beam of Sunbeam Gardens, Westlake, will create a rock garden with tulips, dwarf narcissus, primrose, trillium and ferns.

Kurt Laubinger of Northfield will unveil a tropical setting with a bamboo hut set in the midst of foliage plants.

Here the City of Cleveland will show three more gardens, one of them being a preview of the Talking Garden for the Blind soon to be planted at Cleveland's Garden Center.

Here, also, the Holden Arboretum will show the four oldest tree species known to man: the Ginko, the Sequoia, the Bristlecone Pine, and the Dawn Redwood.

And the Cleveland Board of Education will present a Talking Vegetable Garden with animated vegetable caricatures of Tomato Tomato, Carla Carrot, and Oscar Onion along with vegetables grown by the Garden Division of the Educational System. They will have their own "Rainbow" ending in a basket of health-nutritious vegetables.

Reporting from Washington

ARMS CONTROL AND DISARMAMENT ACT. On February 17, 1965, the House of Representatives amended the Arms Control and Disarmament Act, authorizing the sum of \$40 million for a 3-year period. The Administration originally requested \$55 million over the next 4 fiscal years.

We are all interested in effective arms control and continued efforts to develop a common understanding among the nuclear powers. Since the inception of the Arms Control Agency in 1961, I have been quite agreeable to a two-year authorization program. But I could not support a further extension, for the long history of legislative review has established the authorization process as an integral part of Congressional control over the Nation's purse strings and policy determinations. Therefore, we in the Congress should not abdicate this traditional responsibility at the mere request of the Administration.

Many of us, including some prominent Democrats, felt there had been no solid reasons put forth to justify a diminution of Congressional control by a 4-year authorization. It seems particularly significant at a time when chaos and instability has reached almost every corner of this globe. Surely, under such circumstances more rather than less congressional scrutiny seems reasonable. Moreover, in the past we have found that under the weight of legislative business, programs are not examined with sufficient care except when authorization requests are made. It has often happened, as in the case of the Foreign Assistance Act, that legislation is greatly improved and inefficiency and waste uncovered through Committee investigations. Therefore I believe that the two-year authorization procedure should have been maintained as in the best interests of our country.

$\frac{1}{2}$ cup consomme or dry white wine
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup cider vinegar
1 small white onion, minced
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup butter or margarine
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup flour
2 cups milk


$\frac{1}{4}$ cup heavy cream
1 teaspoon minced chives
salt and pepper to taste
3 cans (4 oz. each) Maine Sardines
1 package frozen peas cooked
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup grated Parmesan cheese

Combine consomme or wine, vinegar and onion. Simmer until reduced to about $\frac{1}{2}$ cup liquid. Make a cream sauce by melting butter or margarine, stirring in flour and cooking until mixture bubbles. Add milk and stir until mixture thickens. Stir hot cream sauce into hot wine mixture. Simmer gently for about 4-5 minutes. Whip heavy cream very slightly to give it body and stir into sauce. Add chives. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Drain sardines and place in casserole. Pour sauce over sardines. Garnish with peas and grated cheese. Place in hot oven (450 F.) for 10 minutes until cheese is bubbly. — Yield: 4 servings.

Maine sardines were a familiar sight of their silvery scales is best sighted in the moonlight. Search planes hover along the coastline watching for the "silver streak" in the water. Below there are powerful radar-guided fishing vessels with modern equipment which go after the schools of fish, but nothing has ever replaced the skill and strength of the salty fishermen who STILL haul in the huge nets of Maine sardines by hand as they did fish on the Sea of Galilee. Where the tides are strong and the water shallow, a modification of the old Indian weir is used.

The carrier ship arrives at the scene of the catch — which may run as high as 30,000 bushels — and a huge pump sucks the fish through a scaling machine into tanks for the ride back to the cannery. On the way, the fish are constantly washed with salt showers to keep them firm and in prime condition.

To catch a sardine sometimes takes all of man's ingenuity. The

Drain Main Sardines. Combine soft butter, Worcestershire sauce, chili sauce, and spread on toast fingers. Top with a sardine. Makes about 12 hors d'oeuvres. For a fancy holiday party arrangement that looks every bit like a Christmas tree, here's what you do: Place half of a gouda cheese at one end of an oval platter to form the tree base. Then on a large skewer the length of the platter, alternate Spanish olives, cheddar cheese, gherkins and radishes to form a decorative tree trunk. Top the skewer with a Christmas star made of cheese. Then spread the Maine sardine canapes around the edge of the platter to make the tree branches, and fill in with thin lemon wedges. Surround the platter with the traditional egg nog, and your holiday buffet will be complete.

National Plane & Space Model Show

America's top aviation historian is general chairman of the 18th Annual National Plane & Space Model Show scheduled for Higbee's Auditorium April 1-3.

He is Dr. Paul E. Garber, chief curator of the Smithsonian Institution's National Air Museum in Washington, D. C.

During its 18-year-history the show has become the major event of its kind in the U. S. Many prize-winning models first seen in the show have become permanent property of the government-financed National Air Museum and are now displayed at the Smithsonian Institution to illustrate the development of aviation.

Co-sponsors of the show are Air Foundation Inc., Cleveland Chamber of Commerce and The Cleveland Press.

Ben T. Franklin, executive director of Air Foundation, said Dr. Garber has accepted the general chairmanship. He will be in Cleveland the week of the show to supervise judging of entries and presentation of 126 prizes to builders of best models.

All boys and girls interested in space flight or aviation are invited to enter projects for judging. They will be grouped into six age divisions, including one for those 18 and older or out of school.

Special Census Of The City Of Cleveland April 1, 1965

April 1, 1965 will be Census Day for the City of Cleveland. Everyone living within the corporate boundaries of the city as of April 1 will be counted. The suburban areas outside the city limits will not be included.

It's Official

It will be a Federal Census conducted by the Federal Government's Bureau of the Census, and final population figures tabulated by the Bureau will be certified by the Director of the Bureau to the Mayor of Cleveland.

It is a Special Census planned to test methods that may be used in taking the 19th Decennial Census of the Nation in 1970. The methods to be tested are (1) use of mail to distribute census forms to all households and to return them to census headquarters; (2) use of specially designed census forms that can be "read" by the Census Bureau's high speed electronic devices; and (3) the filling out of the forms by respondents themselves rather than by enumerators.

At Federal Expense

This Special Census will be taken at no cost to the City. Because it is part of preparations for the 1970 Census of Population and Housing, Congress has authorized the Census Bureau to bear the cost.

Since the 1960 Census, four communities have taken part in censuses testing these new methods, each community more populous than the previous one. The test areas were: Fort Smith, Arkansas; Skokie, Ill.; Huntington Town, Long Island, New York; and Metropolitan Louisville, which covers one county in Kentucky and two in Indiana.
