V Sovjetski zvezi njenih sprememb

Kongres Komunistične partije se je končal, ne da bi pokrenil kakšne spremembe v Sovjetski zvezi, s tem pa so komunisti ali njeni nem podstavljeni.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Vsake večje, resnične spremembe v Sovjetski zvezi bodo morale čakati novo vodstvo, sedanje je na 25. kongresu Komunistične partije pretekli mesec pokazalo jasno, da hoče hoditi naslednja leta po starih potih "detente" z Zahodom, pospeševanja v razvoju težke industrije in v manjši meri potrošniške in poljedelstva doma.

Glavno partitsko glasilo moskovska "Pravda" piše samozvestno in samozavestno o "mogočnem programu za nadaljnjo gradnjo komunizma", pa ne navaja pri tem nikakih novih načrtov, misli ali predlogov, ki naj bi odstranili neučinkovitost v Sovjetskem gospodarstvu, zlasti še v poljedelstvu in življenu.

Iz celotnega pisanja časopisa je razvidno, da Sovjetsko ljudstvo ne more pričakovati nobene sprostitev, oziroma kakšega olajšanja pritiska doma in ne zmanjšanja podpiranja komunističnih revolucion in osvobodilnih gibanj na tujem. Na samem kongresu partije so poudarjali, da Sovjetska zveza ne misli po puščati v podpiranju "razrednega boja" in "progresivnih sil" po vseh delih sveta.

Leonid I. Brežnev je svoj vodilni položaj očitno utrdil, med tem ko je Kosygina še bolj omejil na izključno upravljanje rednih vladnih poslov. Kongres je bil poln hvalje za Brežnjeva, ni pa kazal posebne pozornosti Kosyginu. Ko je ta podajal svoje obsežno gospodarsko poročilo, Brežnev sploh ni bil navzrok, ker je precej očiten znak nepozornosti če že ne omalovaževanja.

Zakladni tajnik Simon obljubil pomoč Italiji

Ko je ameriški zakladni tajnik obljubil Italiji gospodarsko pomoč, je povedal, da bo ta prestala, če bodo v vlado sprejeti komunisti.

RIM, It. — Ameriški zakladni tajnik William E. Simon se je mudil ta teden tri dni v Italiji in se razgovarjal s člani vlade o gospodarskem položaju. Obljubil je Italiji "v uru potrebe" ameriško gospodarsko pomoč, pa pri tem pripomnil, da bo ta verjetno izstala, če bi bili v italijansko vlado sprejeti predstavniki italijanske Komunistične partije.

Iz Italije je Simon odletel v Zvezno republiko Nemčijo, kjer je v Mainzu na tiskovni konferenci napovedoval, da bo ameriško gospodarstvo v letošnjem letu rastlo na ravni okoli 7% in ne na 6.2%, kot so preje napovedali. Porast v februarju naj bi utemeljevala nova napoved.

Italija je v gospodarskih težavah, iz katerih pa ne more, ker ji manjka trdne vlade, ki bi bila sposobna sprejeti odločne reforme in jih tudi izvesti. Lira je v zadnjih tednih izgubila okoli 15% svoje vrednosti in jih je bilo včeraj preko 800 za en dollar. To bo posnelo italijansko blago in, kot upajo, povečalo izvoz italijanskih izdelkov.

Kabel žrtev se je pretrgal: 42 mrtvih

TRENTO, It. — Kabel žrtev, po kateri je tekel voz poln smučarjev, se je nenadno odtrgal in voz je zletel 200 čevljev globoko na zemljo. Pri tem je bilo 42 oseb mrtvih, živa je ostala samo neka ženska, pa še je bila težko ranjena.

Vlada je objavila, da je vključila v voj proti gverilcem večje število varnostnih sil, da je težko januarja povečala za nad polovico v spoklicem večjega števila rezervistov v aktivno službo.

Sodijo, da razpolaga Rodezija z nekako 12,000 možmi v vojski, vojaški policiji in letalstvu, ki jih podpira še kakih 25,000 mož v rezervi.

Minister je dejal, da doslej še niso opazili kubanske ali sovjetske prisotnosti v nastopih proti Rodeziji v Mozambiku, pač pa so gverilci, ki jih Rodezija vlada smatra za "teroriste", oboroženi večji del s sovjetskim oružjem, saj sedaj samo s pehotnim.

Po poročilu policije je bilo samo nekaj Italijanov, vsi ostali so bili Nemci in Avstrije.

Nesreča se je dogodila pri Cavalesu v dolini Fiemme v Dolomitih, kakih 45 milj južno od avstrijske meje. Potniki žrtev so se vračali iz izleta na goro Cerinis.

Po poročilu očividcev se je kabel odtrgal pri spodnji postaji in voz žrtev je začel nihat, dokler ni trešil na zemljo, ko se je kabel pretrgal.

Predsednik republike Franjeh je obljubil izvesti sporazum, ko bodo čete Palestinske osvobodilne vojske, ki imajo sedaj zaseden večji del Libanona, tega zapustile in se vrnilo v Sirijo.

Slovenčina in italijanske stranke

Zahteva po uveljavitvi pravice do uporabe slovenčine v izvoljenih organih, ki jo je z vso odločnostjo sprožila Slovenska skupnost preko svojih izvoljenih predstavnikov v tržaškem občinskem in pokrajinskem svetu, je živo razburkala mirujoče vode glede iskrenih namenov italijanskih vsedržavnih strank za konkretno reševanje problemov slovenske narodne manjšine v Italiji.

Odmev na te pobude je bil nadvse pozitiven v slovenski javnosti. Podobno kot za nedavni primer samostojnega šolskega okraja, tako se tudi sedaj oglašajo kulturne in prosvetne organizacije manjšine ter glasujejo resolucije v podporo uveljavitvi slovenčine v javnih ustanovah in izvoljenih svetih.

Pa pojdim kar po vrsti! Začelo se je pred mesecem dni v tržaškem občinskem svetu, ko so bile na dnevnem redu volitve župana in novega odbora, da bi se rešila kriza, ki so jo bili sprožili socialisti s svojim izstopom novembra meseca.

Svetovalec Slovenske skupnosti dr. Dolhar je začel brati glasovalno izjavo v slovenčini, sklicujoč se na Posebeni statut Londonskega sporazuma. Župan ga je prekinil, češ da italijanska zakonodaja ne predvideva uporabe slovenčine v izvoljenih organih. V znak protesta, ker mu ni bilo dovoljeno nadaljevati v slovenčini, je zapustil sejno dvorano ob splošni pozornosti drugih svetovalcev in prisotnega občinstva.

Pričakovati je bilo, da se bodo nato prijavili k besedi drugi slovenski svetovalci, izvoljeni na listah PCI in PSI ter začeli govoriti v svojem materinem jeziku ali pa v znak solidarnosti s svetovalcem Slovenske skupnosti takoj zapustili sejno dvorano. Toda zgodilo se ni eno ne drugo.

Tako Hreščak (PSI) kot Spetič, Cancini (Kocjančič) in Guglielmi (Vilhelm), vsi PCI, so morali lepo molčati in disciplinirano ostati na svojih sedežih. Ne komunisti in ne socialisti niso smatrali za potrebno, da vsaj njihovi slovenski tovariši izrazijo svoje zgrajanje nad ravnanjem večinske stranke DC, proti katerej znajo ob drugih priložnostih trdo nastopiti.

Tako se je izkazalo, da italijanskim strankam, pa naj bodo to socialisti ali komunisti ali DC, so pravice Slovencev toliko pri srcu, kolikor to prija njihovim strankarskim koristim. Razlika je samo ta, da je DC na oblasti, PCI v opoziciji, PSI pa sama ne ve več, kje je in se zato prepriča strankarskemu oportunizmu, kot se je zgodilo tudi glede šolskih okrajev.

Sledila je razprava o rabi slovenčine v dejelnom svetu na osnovi popravka k notranjemu pravilniku, ki ga je predložil dr. Štoka in za njim komunisti. Ker so socialisti v dejelnom svetu trenutno v opoziciji, so sicer po sili razmer morali glasovati proti stališču odbora (da dežela ni kompetentna za uvedbo slovenčine). Toda kje je svetovalec Štoka zaključil svoj govor v slovenčini, ga je predsednik Pittoni (PSI) prekinjal z zvončkljanjem... in s tem potrjeval stališče dejelnega odbora.

Tudi zadržanje komunističnih svetovalcev ni zavoljilo, čeprav je načelnik skupine Colli zagovarjal pravico do uporabe slovenčine. Vendar zadeve niso gnali dlje od umirjenega besediščenja, vsekakor še da leč od tega, da bi uprizorili kako protestno potezo kot to dobro, znajo ob drugih priložnostih. Javnost je pričakovala, da bo o tej pravici spregovoril tudi slovenski svetovalec Lovriha, toda partija je drugače odločila, kajti njo očitno bolj zanima "zgodovinski kompromis" z DC kot pa pravice Slovencev.

12. februarja je o uporabi slovenčine razpravljal tržaški pokrajinski svet. Tudi tu je razpravo o tem prvi sprožil svetovalec Slovenske skupnosti Brezigar, ki je začel svoj poseg v slovenčini. Ker ga je predsednik dr. Zanetti prekinil, je nato v italijansčini podal zgodovinski pregled boja za uveljavitev slovenskega jezika v izvoljenih svetih v Trstu od Nabergoja do danes. Ob zaključku svojih izvajanj je s posebno resolucijo zahteval odstop pokrajinskega odbora, ki nima več podpore niti polovice članov pokrajinskega sveta.

Slovenska skupnost je namreč mesece julija lani zagotovila samo izvilitve sedanjega odbora in nikakor ne, da ga bo vseskozi podpirala. Zaradi tako odločnega nasprotnega stališča pokrajinskega odbora proti dvojezičnosti v izvoljenih organih je namreč svet Slovenske skupnosti sklenil odreči mu glas in podpomo.

Svet Slovenske skupnosti je negativno ocenil tudi osnutek programskih obveznosti tržaške občinske uprave, ki ga je posredoval v proučitev župan Spaccini.

Ugotovil je, da predloženi program ne zadošča sedanju kritičnemu gospodarskemu stanju, obenem pa ne vsebuje nobenih novih izgledov za konkretno reševanje vprašanj manjšinske problematike.

Slovenska skupnost — kot politična stranka manjšine — bije v tem trenutku težak boj za uveljavitev jekika manjšine v javnosti. Študentje in delovni ljudje pozorno spremljajo njene napore v prepričanju, da bo začeti boj uspešno izpeljala do kraja.


