## Moskva za selitev ZN v "svobodni" Berlin!

Sovjetska zveza je predložila, naj bi se Združeni narodi preselili v Zah. Berlin, če bi zahodne sile umaknile iz njega svoje vojsko.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Sovjetska zveza se je že lani izjavila za selitev Združenih narodov iz New Yorka. Tedaj so omenjali kot možni novi središči Dunaj in Ženevo v Švici. Sedaj je Sovjetska zveza predložila, naj bi se ti preselili v Zahodni Berlin, če zahodne sile umaknijo iz njega svoje vojaške zasedbene čete in pristanejo na to, da postane "svobodno mesto."

Združene države selitv Združenih narodov v Zahodni Berlin niso posebno naklonjene, ker smatrajo, da bi bilo za nje neugodno, če bi imeli svoj sedež 110 milij globoko v po komunistih vladanem ozemlju. Zahodno-nemški kancler dr. K. Adenauer je še pretekli teden označil predlog za selitev ZN v Zah. Berlin in "pogumen," ni pa sicer izrazil svojega stališča do tega vprašanja.

Selitv bi stala Združene narode tudi velike vsote denarja, ki ga nimajo. Ne smemo pozabiti, da imajo ti v New Yorku urejene prostore, med tem ko bi jih morali v Berlinu še iskati in urejati. Sama selitev bi stala desetine milijonov. Združeni narodi so sedaj v hudi finančni stiski. Iz te so jih v zadnjih mesecih reševalne Združene države, ki tudi sicer nosijo večji del celotnega proračuna ZN.

V Havani prišlo do novih demonstracij proti režimu.

HAVANA, Kuba. — Zadnjih ponedeljek je prišlo v Havani do novih demonstracij proti Castroviemu režimu. Povod zanje je dala zopet cerkvena procesija. Demonstrante so želeli v glavnem dati duška svoji nezadovoljnici, ker je Castro začel tako brez obzirno preganjati škofe in duhovnike.

Pri demonstracijah je bilo aretiranih 176 udeležencev, večinoma po tajni policiji, ki se je posmela med demonstrante. Pri tej demonstraciji so se prvič slišali krki: "Dol s Castrom!" Demonstracij se niso udeležili politični nasprotniki sedanjega Castrovega režima.

Vzhodna Nemčija izseljuje mejno področje v Berlinu

BERLIN, Nem. — Vzhodno nemške oblasti so začele seliti prebivalstvo iz poslopij, velikih in malih, v oddaljenosti 500 yardov od meje, oziroma ograje, ki loči zahodni del mesta od vzhodnega.

S tem bo Berlin tudi v tem pogledu izenačen z ostalo Vzhod. Nemčijo, kjer so izpraznili ob meji pol kilometra širok pas čisto, do štiri kilometre pa delno.

Predlog je naletel na težave že od vsega začetka, ker je predvideval samo podpiranje takozvanih javnih šol, ne pa tudi podpiranje privatnih šol, namenjenih široki javnosti. Vodniki Katoliške cerkve so se zakonu očitno postavili po robu češ, da je kričen, ker bo nalagal katoličnom nova bremena, od katerih pa ne bodo imeli nobene koristi.

## NOBENEGA ZNAMENJA ZA POPUŠCANJE SOVJETIJE!

Včeraj sta se ameriški državni tajnik Rusk in sovjetski zunanjji minister Gromiko pogovarjala štiri in pol ure ter sklenila, da se bosta prihodnji teden sestala ponovno. Po vseh iz ameriških uradnih krogov niso sovjetski zastopniki pokazali nobene volje do popuščanja. — Ostra debata v Združenih narodih.

NEW YORK, N. Y. — Včeraj popoldne sta se v hotelu Waldorf-Astoria sestala ameriški državni tajnik Dean Rusk in sovjetski zunanjji minister Andrej Gromiko s svojimi ožjimi sodelavci na razgovor, ki naj bi pokazal, če obstoje kaki izgledi za mirno rešitev berlinske krize in za kompromis v Združenih narodih, kjer je treba rešiti imenovanje novega glavnega tajnika. Sestanek je trajal širi ura in 25 minut. Nobena stran ni uradno dala o njem kakega komentarja, vendar so prišle iz ameriških uradnih krogov vesti, ki trdijo, da Gromiko ni kazal nobenega znamenja za kako sovjetsko pripravljenost k popuščanju, podobno je tudi državni tajnik Rusk vstrajal na dosedanje znamenstvi ZDA tako v vprašanju Berlina in Nemčije kot v vprašanju ZN.

Združeni narodi so objavili, da pilotirata katanški jet-letalni belgijski letalca. Ti dve letali sta v bojih zadnjih dni ponovno napadli čete in oporišča ZN v Katangi in preprečili vse letalske zveze med njihovimi posameznimi postojankami. Tudi Dag Hammarskjöld se je iz strahu pred napadom teh letal, podal iz Leopoldvillu v Ndolo na razgore v Šombejovi ponoči.

Belgia je odločno zanikala, da bi Šombejova letala vodili njeni letali, izjavila je, da je vse svoje vojaške svetovalce umaknila z Konga, ne odgovarja pa za to, če je Šombejovi službi kak belgijski privatnik.

Včeraj je nastopilo v Katangi premijer med domačimi četami in četami ZN. V koliko bo to premijer obstalo, še ni gotovo, ker je del vodstva ZN še vedno mnenja, da je Katango treba pokriti vladu v Leopoldvillu.

Gromiko je po vseh iz uradnih virov trdil, da smatra Sovjetsko zvezo podpis mirovne pogodbe z Vzhod. Nemčijo za najboljšo rešitev nemškega vprašanja. Rusk je skušal Gromika pripraviti k razpravi o celotnem nemškem vprašanju ne samo o bodočnosti Zah. Berlina. V vprašanju Združenih narodov je Sovjetska stran vztrajala na stališču treh glavnih tajnikov, medtem ko je ameriška prav tako odločno tako rešitev zavračala in branila sedanjo ureditev z enim glavnim tajnikom.

Stevenson je sovjetsko stališče obsodil, ko je vprašal, če misli Sovjeti tako dolgo zastrupljati ozračje po vsem

Po podatkih Združenih narodov je na svetu še okoli 150 milijonov malarčnih bolnikov.

V obširnem poročilu oddelka za socialne zadeve ZN je reče- no, da naraste število svetovnega prebivalstva, ki se bo letos povzelo na tri milijarde, po- vprečno za 45–55 milijonov na leto in da dosegajo letni pri- rastek 1.6 do 1.9 odstotka, medtem ko se je gibal pred drugo svetovno vojno okoli enega odstotka.

Poročilo sicer ne vsebuje podatkov o zemljepisni razpore- ditvi svetovnega prebivalstva in tudi ne o demografskih prob- lemih dežel ali celin, zato pa nakazuje poglavitev razvojne smeri na raznih področjih po le- tu 1935. Gleda prehrane je na primer Daljni vzhod še vedno na zadnjem mestu, ker je pro- izvodnja na prebivalca močno pod tisto med obema vojnoma. Prebivalstvo tega področja je manj mesa, potrošnja drugih proizvodov pa se ohranja pred- vsem po zaslugi uvoza, medtem ko so daljnovezne dežele na- stopale nekoč kot velike izvo- nlice potrošnega blaga. Zbiranje vojaštva in obmejne policije ima za komuniste tudi negativne posledice. Število vo- jaških in policijskih prebežnikov raste od tedra do teuma. Niti najstrožji predpisi jih ne ustrešajo, zmeraj najdejo luknje, ki jim odpirajo pot v svo- bodo.

## Število brezposelnih v Kanadi vidno padlo

OTTAWA, Can. — Prvi v poldržem letu je število brez- poselnih v vsej deželi padlo pod- ono pred enim letom. Sredi av- gusta je bilo v vsej deželi skupno 323,000 brezposelnih ali 4.8 odstotkov celotne delovne sile v primeri s 5.3 odstotka lani v istem času.

Število brezposelnih je v ome- njenem mesecu padlo za 31.000. V prejšnjih letih je v tem času število brezposelnih prej rastlo, kot padlo. K padcu je pripomo- gla deloma avtomobilска industrija, ki je letos preje poklicala na posel delavstvo kot običajno v drugih letih, na drugi strani pa se čuti tudi splošno poživitev gospodarstva.

V preteklem februarju je bilo brez posla 719,000 oseb ali 11.9 odstotkov celotne delovne sile, največ v vseh letih po drugi svetovni vojni.

**INVESTIGATION OF ADMINISTRATION OF EXPORT CONTROL ACT.** Last week the House passed H. Res. 403, to create a select committee to conduct an investigation and study of the administration, operation, and enforcement of the United States Export Control Program. Increased attention has been drawn to the problem of trading with the Soviet bloc, and this has been brought to a head this session of Congress because of a series of export licensing actions which have come under severe criticism by Congress and the public. The concern has of course been heightened by the Berlin situation. According to a compilation recently made, during the three week period after President Kennedy's Berlin speech, the dollar value of exports authorized to the Soviet bloc increased 800% over the previous three weeks—involved were such items as precision machine tools to build truck and automobile engines, ballbearing manufacturing machines used in the manufacture of missile guidance systems, subsidized surplus agriculture products, electronic products and other strategic items. The investigation of this matter is long overdue. It is felt that an investigation of this subject as authorized by H. Res. 403 will produce a change in policy and also bring forth recommendations for tightening our export control laws. It seems preposterous that our government should continue to permit the shipment of strategic goods into Communist countries which cannot help but strengthen the Communist economy and be of material aid to their military might.

**"CONTINENTAL CLASSROOM" PRESENTS AMERICAN GOVERNMENT COURSE VIA TV**

"Continental Classroom," the first nationwide educational TV project, will continue for its fourth year on the NBC television network, offering a course in American Government. The course will be carried by approximately 170 TV stations in every part of the country Monday through Friday from

**Frosty Salute Set for Lerner, Loewe**

Among the highlights of the forthcoming "Ice Capades," at the Arena, Oct. 2-15 will be a colorful and tuneful "Salute to Lerner and Loewe," whose "My Fair Lady" just recently nudged out "Oklahoma!" as the champion musical show of all time.

"Wagon" is the least known of the team's works, but it's good. I recall some years ago attending the Broadway debut of this rousing musical with a Western locale, lusty characters and catchy music. The star was Burl Ives. It lasted a few months, and now there's talk of making a movie of it.

**Gets New Partner.** — In the "Wagon" excerpt veteran Bobby Specht gets a new and dazzling partner in Sandy Culbertson. World champion Cathy Machado will headline "Brigadoon"; the spectacular team of Romayne & Steele will lead the skater-dancers in "Lady" and all hands will appear in gorgeous "Camelot."

On Broadway it was rated the most beautiful spectacle in history — and you can depend on Johnny Harris to duplicate those visual splendors in the frosted version — settings, lightings, costumes et al. In addition to the popular Lerner & Loewe concoctions "Ice Capades" will make its usual bow to the classics with one of the 10 big production numbers being devoted to Liszt's "Hungarian Rhapsody," and another to Tchaikovsky's "Fifth Symphony."

In the "Rhapsody" the main performer will be Ronnie Robertson, world champion speedster, so fast in his glides and whirls that he's known as "The Blur." Aided by the Ice Capets and Ice Capets, Romayne & Steele will demonstrate their artistry in the Tchaikovsky creation.

Less classical, perhaps, but always a top audience-pleaser are the Old Smoothies, otherwise known as Orrin Markhus and Irma Thomas skate-waltzing to the old time tunes. They were a great hit with the Moscovites in the recent peaceful breach of the Iron Curtain by Mr. Harris' valiant troupe. So was Eric Waite, the clown prince of the ice in his impersonations of dizzy dames. "Frozen Frenzy" they call Eric's hilarious antics.

Currently the show is getting its final polishing and grooming in the gargantuan convention hall at Atlantic City, prior to its bow in Madison Square Garden as the 22nd edition of "Ice Capades."

"Ice Capades" lends itself ideally to production numbers based on musicals, such as "Wish You Were Here," or on fanciful plots such as "Snow White," designed and executed with the aid and blessings of Walt Disney. Years ago a condensed version of "Brigadoon" was a thing of beauty for both the eyes and the ears.

**The Big Finale.** — At this formative stage of the show, Mr. Harris is tentatively planning a super-

per finale, "Circus on Ice," where in his pretty Ice Capets and hand-some Ice Cadets will impersonate acrobats and tumblers — the girls and boys climbing ropes and dangling on trapezes, others attired as animals in cages, clowns, lion tamers, ring-masters, etc. — all to slam-bang Big Top music.

This could be a rousing overture to the real thing — the visit to the arena of Ringling Bros., Barnum & Bailey Circus. The Ringling show is to play the Arena, November 15-19.


