KRVAVI IZGREDI, POŽIGI IN POBOJI SE RAZŠIR-JAJO PO VSEJ FRANCII

VICHY, 15. avgusta. — Kravavi izgredi, pokolji, požiganje, bombardiranje in nasilje, ki je izbruhnilo včeraj v Parizu, se je pričelo danes širiti po vsej zasedeni in nezasedeni Franciji. — Nemške oblasti v Franciji javno grozijo, da bo trpelo prebivalstvo zasedene Francije, ako ne prenehajo "komunistični" izgredi.

Nemški general v Parizu je izjavil, da bodo vse osebe, ki so odgovorne za izgrede, ustreljeni.

"Podtalne celice" komunistov Oblasti izjavljajo, da so francoski komunisti stvorili "podzemne celice", ki izvajajo opozicijo proti vladi v Vichyju, ki se je odločila kooperirati z Nemčijo.

Danes zjutraj je v Nici predčasno eksplozirala bomba, ki je ubila troje oseb, katero so jo nosile v zavodu, in sicer dva moška in eno žensko. — Reuterjeva brzjavka v Londonu naznana da je bilo samo v Parizu aretiranih nad 2,000 oseb.

Po vsej Franciji, zasedeni in nezasedeni, se je pričelo požiganje tovarn in raznih naprav, pred vsem onih, kjer se izdeluje pod nemško kontrolo vojni material.

Samo z resnicu naprej — in resnica bo zmagała ter nas osvoboda!

Tako se glasi točen in dobeseden prevod Firisovega pisma, kateremu prilaga ček desetih dolarjev za fond "nezavisne hrvatske države," to je tiste države, proti kateri so protestirali Hrvati s svojimi podpisi na shodu, na katerem je tudi on govoril! Kaj je govoril, je brez pomena! Pomembno je to, da je bil govornik na shodu, na katerega sploh ni spadal, če je bil shod res to, za kakršnega je bil razglašen!

Toda poglejmo malo, kakšna je vendar tista novina, katere urednikom ta vriji duhovnik čestita na njemem "modrem urejevanju."

Ta poglavnik Pavelič je tisti Pavelič, ki je zasneval v Italiji umor jugoslovenskega kralja Aleksandra, pri katerem atentatu je bil ubit tudi francoski minister Barthou, radi česar je bil Pavelič v svoji odsotnosti po francoskem in po jugoslovanskem sodišču obsojen na smrt, toda ga roka pravice ni mogla doseči, ker se je nahajal v posebnih zaščiti Mussolinija, ki ga ni hotel izročiti Franciji ali Jugoslaviji. Nemčiji prepevajo: "Danes smo gospodarji Evrope, jutri bomo gospodarji sveta!"

Možno je, da bo Amerika čakala, dokler bodo nacisti gotovi z zavojevanjem Evrope, nakar se bodo usmerili proti Južni Ameriki; toda ob tem času bi mi ostali še edin močan narod proti nacistom. Mnogim se zdi ta ideja fantastična, toda tudi padec Francije se je zdel fantastičen pred dvema letoma.

Nacisti bodo vodili gledajo z mržnjo na Ameriko. Oni so namreč vedno mislili, da je mogoče milijone Amerikancev zabitati v sanje o varnosti, dočim je nadaljnje mogoče kupiti, kar pa jih še ostane, jih bo lahko načuvati na medsebojno borbbo. Zato nacisti z veseljem bodo sovražno razpoloženje proti židom, republikancem in demokratom, proti visokim uradnikom in raznim religioznim skupinam, samo da se zaseje med ameriško ljudstvo seme medsebojne mržnje.

Nacisti bi nas radi prepričali, da nimajo nobenih zlahka namenov napram Ameriki, prav takor je Hitler v Monakovem svečano izjavil, da nima poslej več nobenih zahtev in ambicij na evropskem kontinentu. Oni nas hočejo dalje prepričati, da bomo lahko delali "biznes" s Hitlerjem novim redom v Evropi. Nemčija se je vedno posluževala trgovine kot orožja. Njena metoda je, da si to ali ono deželo najprej podvrže trgovsko, nato pa ji noče plačati nakupov, jazven če se država izjaví, da bo sledila "nasvetom" Nemčije.

Doslej se Amerikanci še niso dali ukaniti, kajti mnogi Amerikanci so sami čitali Hitlerjevo knjigo "Mein Kampf." Že zdaj je mnogo parnikov s potrebičnimi odpeljalo od naših obali, dočim bodo nadaljnji odpelji v najbližji bodočnosti.

Dolga in težka pot do zmage

Treba bo izvajati predredek dolgega roka, kajti treba bo prehoditi še dolgo in težko pot, preden bo izvojevana ona populna zmaga, brez katere bi bila vsa naša prizadevanja in žrtve zamršene.

Vojna se vrši na več frontah in preden bo končana, se bodo morda razvile še nadaljnje fronte. Nujne potrebe vaših in naših oboroženih sil se morejo ugotoviti samo z natancenim poznanjem mnogih činiteljev, ki jih je treba vzeti v poštev pri naših zaključkih. Iz razloga, da se bomo vsi skupaj lahko naložili skupinov za najboljšo izrabo naših skupnih pridobitvenih virov, predlagamo v Moskvi tozadovno sejo, na katero bomo poslali naše visoke reprezentante, ki bodo opolnomočeni, razpravljati z Vami o teh zadevah. Ako se strinjate s tako konferenco, Vas obvezamo, da dokler se ne odločite glede nje, bomo ves ta čas nadaljevali s pošiljanjem naših vojnih potrebičnin Rusiji, in to z največjo mogočo naglico.
