- PREGLED NAJVAŽNEJŠIH DOGODKOV -

Predstavniški dom Kongresa zavrnil pomoč »contras« — Reagan ni pripravljen sprejeti poraza — Ponovno glasovanje v aprilu

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Včeraj je predstavniški dom zavrnil pobudo predsednika Reagana, da bi ZDA poslale 100 milijonov dolarjev pomoči nikaragveškim »contras«. Glasovanje je bil 210 za predsednika, 222 proti. V glavnem so bili proti demokrati, ki razpolagajo z zanesljivo večino v spodnjem domu, za pobudo pa so bili republikanci. Proti so bili na primer vsi ohijski demokrati, vključivši Dennis Eckart, Reagana so pa podprli vsi republikanci iz izjemo Chalmersa Wylie-ja. Predsednik je izjavil, da je bilo včerajšnje glasovanje črn dan za svobodo. Mora priti do ponovnega glasovanja in drugačnega izida, je nadaljeval Reagan. Sovjetska zveza ne sme biti prepričana o tem, da ko pride katera država pod komunistično oblast, je zadeva za vedno rešena, je pripomnil.

Vodja republikanske večine v senatu, sen. Robert Dole, je rekel, da bodo senatorji glasovali o predsednikovi pobudi prihodnji teden. Poznavalci razpoloženja v senatu menijo, da ima Reagan možnost zmage, čeprav je nekaj senatorjev še neopredeljenih. Kljub taki morebitni zmagi, bi moral Reagan premagati nasprotovanje v spodnjem domu Kongresa. Demokratski strategi pravijo, da so šli Reagan in njegovi privrženci predaleč, ko so izražali dvome o patriotizmu tistih kongresnikov, ki pobude niso podpirali. Daleje, demokratsko vodstvo je obljudilo, da včerajšnje glasovanje ni bilo zadnja beseda o zadevi ter da bo privolilo v ponovno glasovanje sredi aprila.

V Nikaragvi je predsednik države Daniel Ortega pohvalil izid včerajšnje glasovanje in izrazil upanje, da predstavlja spremembu v ameriški politiki do sandinističnega režima. Nikaragveška sredstva obveščanja zoper poudarjajo nevarnost skorajšnje ameriške vojaške invazije.

V zadnjih dneh nikaragveške vojaške enote napadajo »contras« gverilce v bližini meje s Hondurasom. Ker je honduraška vladna v skrbi, da bi nikaragveške enote prekorčile mejo, je poslala v obmejne kraje okrog 5000 svojih vojakov.

Panama noče dati Ferdinandu Marcosu politično zatočišče — Na Filipinih predlagajo spremembu političnega sistema

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Sinoči je panamski predsednik Eric Arturo Delvalle zavrnil prošnjo bivšega filipinskega predsednika Ferdinanda Marcosa, da bi Marcos skupaj s svojo družino in nekaterimi drugimi osebami prišli v Panamo in tam živel. Kot kaže, je bila panamska vlada pripravljena privoliti v Marcosov prihod, precej prahu pa je dvignila opozicija. ZDA so se v imenu Marcosa pogajale s Panamci o tem, vendar se je poskus izjavil. Jasno je namreč, da bi se tudi Reaganova vlada rada znebila Marcosa, vendar Marcos ne more najti države, ki ga je pripravljena dati politično zatočišče.

Na Filipinih so pa objavili besedilo »začasne« nove ustave, po kateri bi bil parlament razpuščen, predsednica Corazon Aquino pa bi imela obsežne politične pravice v prav tako »začasnici« revolucionarni vladi. Tako bi mogla Aquinova kontrolirati ne le osrednji vladni aparat, ampak tudi lokalne politične oblasti. Te izjemne pravice naj bi bile v veljavi, dokler ne bi filipinsko ljudstvo

izglasovalo novo, demokratično ustavo. Aquinova bo izjavila prihodnji teden, ako res namerava proglašiti revolucionarno vlado.

Konservativec Jacques Chirac novi predsednik francoske vlade — Bombni napad v Parizu ubil dve osebi

PARIZ, Fra. — Včeraj je socialistični predsednik Francije Francois Mitterand imenoval vodjo konservativev, pariškega župana Jacquesa Chiraca, za novega predsednika francoske vlade. Konservativci so namreč zmagali na nedavnih parlamentarnih volitvah. To je prvič v najnovejši francoski zgodovini, da ima država socialističnega predsednika in konservativnega predsednika vlade. Opazovalci francoskih političnih razmer pričakujejo velike težave med Mitterandom in Chiracom, ker traja Mitterandova mandatna doba še dve leti.

Člani Chiracove vlade so tudi vodilni konservativci. Novi zunanjji minister je 60-letni Bernard Raimond, ki je sedaj francoski veleposlanik v ZSSR, obrambni minister pa 60-letni Andre Giraud.

Včeraj je eksplodirala bomba v trgovini na Champs Elysees v Parizu. Gre za šesti tovrstni napad v zadnjih dveh mesecih. Bomba je ubila dve osebi, 28 jih je bilo ranjenih. Policia je našla drugo bombo in jo odstranila. Neka skupina je obvestila francosko tiskovno agencijo, da želijo atentatorji izpuštitev treh arabskih teroristov, ki so v francoskih zaporih.

Naftni ministri OPEC držav neenotni glede pošiljanja nafte na svetovni trg — Nekateri pričakujejo nov padec cene nafte

ŽENEVA, Švi. — Včeraj so končali peti dan svojega zasedanja naftni ministri OPEC držav. Kot kaže, še vedno niso našli kompromisne rešitve za problem v zvezi s padanjem cene nafte na svetovnem trgu. Dejstvo je, da OPEC države pošiljajo na ta trg veliko več nafte, kot trg potrebuje. To pritska na ceno, ki je v zadnjih mesecih padla kar za 60 odstotkov. OPEC države bi rade dosegli sporazum, po katerem bi omejili količino nafte, ki prihaja na svetovni trg, pri tem pa dvignili ceno na sod nafte od sedanjih 12 ali 13 dolarjev vsaj na 20 dolarjev. Ker pa imajo razne OPEC članice različne potrebe in politična stališča, enotnosti ne dosežejo.

Ako ne bo pri OPEC državah kmalu soglasja, napovedujejo nekateri opazovalci naftne industrije, utegne pasti cena za sod nafte celo na 8 dolarjev. Pripominjajo pa, da takšna nizka cena ne bi dolgo ostala v veljavi.

Po nekaterih sicer nepotrjenih vesteh, bi bila Reagonova vlada vesela, ako bi ameriške enote napadli Libijci.

Clovekovo dostojanstvo: Vest in odgovornost

Oroke so nas učili, da imamo v duši poseben zvonček; ta se oglaša in svari, če delamo slabo; vabi nas in spodbuja, če delamo dobro. Prispodoba vesti z zvončkom ni slaba in je dostopna otroškemu dojemanju, ki hoče konkretnih stvarnih dejstev in abstraktnih splošnih pojmov.

V zgodovini filozofije srečamo starega Sokrata. Someščani so mu očitali, da kvari njihovo mladino. Sokrat se je pa zagonjavjal, da mu njegovo ravnanje in učenje narekuje glas bogov, ki ga čuti v sebi. Da zato ne more učiti in ravnati drugače. To je že više pojmovanje vesti: notranji glas, ki ga človek v sebi čuti, oz. sliši in ga ne more preslišati, četudi bi hotel.

Pesniki in pisatelji so v literarni govorici in simboliki izpovedovali isto resnico in spoznanje, tako A. Gradnik v sonetu »Večerna senca«, ki ga je za uvod v predavanje prebral nadškof A. Šuštar, ali Ivan Cankar v »Zaklenjeni kamnici«, ali F. Dostoevski v romanu »Zločin in kazen«. Saj človek, ki misli, ne more mimo svoje vesti. Tudi današnji človek ne, kakor je raztrgan v svoji duševnosti in raztresen v svoji dejavnosti.

Mimo vprašanja človekove vesti ni šlo tudi božje razodete. Nasprotno, že prav na začetku, kmalu po izvirnem grehu, se zastavlja vprašanje vesti ob zgodbi o Kajnu in Abelu. S to zgodbo je hotel Bog osvetiliti ravno problem vesti, kakor se javlja v človeku pred dejanjem, med dejanjem in po dejanju.

Tudi na to je opozoril v četrtek 6. marca predavatelj nadškof A. Šuštar. Vendar vprašanja vesti ni zagrabil s strani razodetja ali filozofije, temveč v »luči zadnjega vesoljnega cerkvenega zpora in zadnje smode škofov«.

Drugi vatikanski koncil je namreč vprašanju vesti posvetil veliko pozornost zlasti v konstituciji Gaudium et spes ali Cerkev v svetu, pa tudi v drugih dokumentih. Nastal je tako neki celosten nauk o vesti in s tem tudi odgovornosti, saj iz vesti izhaja tudi odgovornost za dejanja.

»V notranjosti svoje vesti odkriva človek postavo, ki si je ne daje sam, temveč se ji mora pokoravati,« pravi zadnji koncil (GS 16). Pri tem gre za moralno postavo, za postavo, ki naj ureja človeška dejanja. Človeška dejanja pa imenujemo tista dejanja, ki jih človek premisli in se zanje svobodno odloči. Gre za neki notranji proces, ko človek s svojim umom presoja dejanje pred začetkom na podlagi osnovne moralne zahteve: Delaj dobro in ogibaj se slabega! Po dejanju pa spet presoja samega sebe, ali je ravnal v soglasju z vestjo, to je s svojim spoznanjem o moralno dobrem in moralno slabem; če je dobro opustil ali slabo storil. Pravimo, da človeka peče vest.

Vest je torej naša osebna sodba o naših dejanjih glede na nihovo soglasje z naravnim moralnim zakonom. »Človek ima v srcu od Boga zapisano postavo,« uči koncil. Vemo, da so grški filozofi prvi razmišljali o tej postavi, ki ji pravimo naravni moralni zakon. Grške tragedije so vse zasnovane na konfliktu med človekom in naravnim moralnim zakonom. Zato so tudi tako občeločeve in veljavne za vse čase.

»Vest je človekovo najbolj skrito jedro in svetišče, kjer je človek čisto sam z Bogom,« nadaljuje koncil. Iz teh spoznanj

CLEVELAND, O. - Približujemo se prazniku Zveličarjevega Vstajenja, katero naš vsako leto napolni z gotovostjo, da pride za Velikim petkom tudi Vstajenje. Naj vas vse, ki berete te vrstice, osreči ta lepi vzikklik: Aleluja, ki je zapeta na Velikonočno jutro, vstali Zveličar pa prinese velikonočni mir, katerega nihče drugi ne more dati.

Od usmiljenke sestre Terezije Pavlič, ki dela na Madagaskarju v gobavskem naselju, smo prejeli pismo. Piše:

»Iskren Bog plačaj za poslanini dar, ki je vedno dobradošel, saj vse naše materialno delovanje zavisi od vas dobrotnikov v zaledju.«

Imeli smo v programu, da sami odpremo kirurško šolo za amputacije naših gobavih bolnikov, ker dosedaj smo jih vozili v Tananarive — pa se je nabava potrebne opreme med potjo v Pariz izgubila. Torej vse je treba na novo začeti. Radi bi nabavili stroj za stopanje riža, to ker je delo pretežko za bolnike, pa nam je elektrika odpovedala. Zato bo treba najprvo elektriko popraviti, kar ni šala tu pri nas. Pretekli teden so se zamašile vse vodovodne cevi, ki oskrbujejo šolo, ambulanto, celo gobavsko naselje in polovico sestrskega stanovanja. Vzrok? Vse je staro, napravljeno 1968. leta. Edini izhod je zamenjava vseh cevi.

Velike težave imamo s prehranjevanjem bolnikov. Včasih smo potrebeni riž kupovali pri državi po umirjeni ceni, sedaj pa ga že pet ali šest mesecev ne dobimo. Bila sem primorana kupiti na trgu po trojno zvišani ceni. Sicer nekaj pridelamo doma, ker imamo zemljo, vendar to še daleč ne zadostuje, saj je treba dnevno nahraniti 60 do 80 oseb.

Naše obdelovanje zemlje je še v razvoju, ker včasih niso bile potrebe, da se zemlja obdeluje. Zato imamo sedaj dokaj težav, da naučimo ljudi ali jih prepričamo, da je to edini izhod iz lakote.

Obdelujemo pa tako: en del rizievih polj obdelujejo bolniki, ki lahko delajo, en del delavci, ki jih imamo pri hiši,

končila je dr. Šuštar razvil nekatere teze in resnice o vesti, npr.: ni človeka brez vesti. Če kdaj pravimo, da je kdo brez vesti, menimo, da vesti ne posluša. Potem da je vest nekaj osebnega, saj gre za osebno prepričanje in sodbo o svojih dejanjih. V poslušnosti vesti je človekovo dostojanstvo in po njej bo človek sojen. Zato nobena človeška oblast, tudi cerkvena ne, ne sme človeka siliti, da bi ravnal proti svoji vesti.

Iz nauka o vesti izvira nauk o človekovi odgovornosti in svobodi. V vesti, to je v samem sebi se človek svobodno odloča za dobro ali slabo. Zato pravi vesoljni cerkveni zbor, da bo človek sojen po svoji vesti. Pri tem koncil odločno zagovarja človekovo svobodo in svobodno voljo. »Le svobodno se more človek obrniti k dobremu« (GS 17), ali k slabemu. To načelo o svobodnem odločanju zagovarja koncil posebno, ko govorí o verski svobodi. »Ta vatikanski cerkveni zbor izjavlja, da ima človeška oseba pravico do verske svobode. Ta svoboda je v tem, da morajo biti vsi ljudje prosti od siljenja tako s strani posameznikov kakor tudi s strani družbenih skupnosti in katekoli človeške oblasti.« S tem je enkrat za vselej konec nasilnemu krščevanju, kot se je godilo v srednjem veku, in nasilnemu prekrščevanju, kot so ga uganjali ustaši nad pravoslavnimi v zadnji vojni.

Argentinski Slovenci žalujejo za svojim dušnim pastirjem

V majskih dneh leta 1945 je 25.000 Slovencev zapustilo svojo domovino, saj je vse zgledalo, da bo tudi Slovenija postala sovjetska provinca, ki ji bo stalinizem krojil nadaljnjo usodo. K sreči so se kasnejši dogodki tako razvijali, da do tega ni prišlo.

S tistimi, ki so tedaj odšli na bridko pot begunstva, je bil tudi profesor verouka in stolni vikar v Ljubljani Anton Orehar. Njegova sošolca v bogoslovem študiju sta bila med drugimi beograjski nadškof Alojzij Turk in koprski škof Janez Jenko.

Pok. msgr. Orehar (umrl je 7. marca 1986 v Argentini) se je rodil 13. junija 1910 v Preddoljah pri Kranju. Izšel je iz vzorne krščanske družine z 9 otroki. Po gimnaziji v Kranju je nadaljeval študije v ljubljanskem semenišču in bil 8. julija 1934 posvečen v duhovnika.

Že prve tedne po odhodu iz domovine je v maju leta 1945 prevzel na svoja ramena dušnopaštirsko službo v taborišču Monigo pri Trevisu in spremljal nato svoje rojake v Servigliano in Senigallio pri Anconi. Dostikrat je tedaj doživel težke ure bodisi s strani angleških oblasti, ki njegove poslanstva niso hotele razumeti bodisi s strani nekaterih del pa tisti, ki pridejo prosit, ker so revni in nimajo kaj jesti. Vsak, ki lahko dela, pride delat, za plačilo dobi kar prosi — ali obleko ali denar —, da si lahko kupi hrano. Tako ni sedaj nikogar več, ki prosjači. Če oseba sama ni zmožna za delo, pride kdo od družine na mesto njega. Vsem damo razumeti, da življenje ni igrača in da mi nismo bogati, da bi samo dajali.

Tako sem vam podala nekaj drobtinic. Oprostite, če morda preveč črno gledam, a razumebam boste, da skušamo storiti vse, kar je v naši moči, da jim pomagamo, da si sami začnejo pomagati. Končno želim vam vsem, še posebej g. Wolbangu: Veselo Alelujo!«

terih rojakov, ki so njegovo avtoriteto zlonamereno rušili.

Leta 1948 je prišel v Argentino pod tujim imenom, kajti jugoslovanski režim mu je na vsak način skušal preprečiti odhod iz Italije in zahteval od zasedbenih oblasti, da mu ga izročijo. Najprej se je nastanil kot hišni kaplan v župniji sv. Julije v Buenos Airesu, odker je začel z versko organizacijo novodošlih rojakov, kakih sedem tisoč po številu.

Leta 1953 je na podlagi papeške enciklike »Exult familia« prejel iz Rima imenovanje za ravnatelja slovenskih dušnih pastirjev. Pri tem si je pridobil nemirljivih zaslug za versko oskrbo svojih rojakov in za ustvarjanje struktur za njihovo narodno in prosvetno-kulturno rast.

Organiziral je 17 dušnopaštirskih središč (9 v Vel. Easter Baked Ham and a Festive Cake

When the Easter meal is planned, many families opt for a baked ham with a shiny glaze to season both ham and vegetables. . . others have the traditional roast lamb. But for all occasions a festive cake is popular as dessert or in the afternoon with coffee and ice cream.

Two very popular vegetables are Louisiana yams, either canned or fresh and small white onions both glazed to a rich lustre with a corn syrup based glaze. Canned peaches or pears may be glazed with the same glaze. The glaze may be flavored with orange or pineapple or marachino cherry juice and usually has a hint of dry mustard.

In making glazes for meat, they can be as simple as dark corn syrup poured from the bottle the last 30 minutes of roasting or flavored to suit the family taste.

For the Easter Bonnet Cake which can serve as a centerpiece as well as dessert, bake your favorite cake mix or our yellow cake recipe in two layers, one an 8-inch and one a 9-inch layer. Frost with a fluffy white frosting and top with a small nosegay of fresh flowers.

Glazed Ham with Yams and Onions

1 ready-to-eat ham (about 13 pounds)
2 cups dark corn syrup
2 teaspoons grated orange rind
1 tablespoon dry mustard
Whole cloves
8 cooked or canned Louisiana yams
1 1/2 dozen small white onions, cooked

1/4-inches apart across fat surface of ham. Brush ham with 1 cup of the syrup mixture. Bake in oven about 45 minutes, basting frequently, until ham is well glazed and heated thoroughly. Remove from oven and insert one clove in center of each square marked on ham. Baste once more and heat in oven 10 minutes.

Arrange 8 servings each of cooked yams and small white onions in shallow baking pans. Baste frequently with remaining syrup mixture about 30 minutes or until heated and well glazed. A 13-pound ham will make about 25 generous servings.

Pineapple Glazed Ham: Prepare as directed for Glazed Ham. Add 1 (1-pound, 4-ounce) can crushed pineapple to syrup mixture, making cuts in ham 3/4-inch apart instead of 1 1/4 inches.

Easter Bonnet Cake

3/4 cup margarine
1 1/3 cups sugar
3 eggs
1 teaspoon vanilla
1/2 teaspoon almond extract
3 cups sifted cake flour
2 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
1 teaspoon salt
1 cup milk
1 recipe White Frosting

Grease and lightly flour 1 (9-inch) and 1 (8-inch) round cake pan. Mix margarine and sugar. Add eggs, 1 at a time, blending until smooth. Stir in flavorings. Sift together flour, baking powder and salt. Add flour mixture in 4 additions alternately with milk, beginning and ending with flour and mixing just until smooth. Pour into prepared cake pans. Bake in 350° F. (moderate) oven 30 to 35 minutes or until cake springs back when touched lightly. The 8-inch layer may require slightly longer baking. Layers may be split and filled if desired before frosting.

Note: This cake may be baked in 1 (13 x 9 x 2-inch) cake pan 35 to 40 minutes or in 30 medium cupcake cups 25 to 30 minutes.

White Frosting

Beat 2 egg whites and 1/8 teaspoon salt until soft peaks form when beater is raised. Mix 1 cup light corn syrup and 1/4 cup sugar in small saucepan. Cook over low heat, stirring constantly, until sugar is completely dissolved and mixture just reaches full boil. Beat hot syrup into egg whites, a little at a time. Beat in 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla. Continue beating until mixture holds stiff peaks. Makes 4 1/3 cups or enough to frost tops and sides of 2 (8 or 9-inch) layers.

Chris, the grandson of Gene Drobnić of Cleveland, then took one of the covers with him when he, his mother and Jonathan went shopping. Chris slipped the plastic over the cart handle and Jonathan started nibbling almost immediately.

When the Robbens returned home, Chris brought the plastic cover with him, and his mom washed it off and put it away until the next trip. Chris' teacher submitted his invention to the "Weekly Reader" folks who liked it enough to award him \$250 and special recognition in a contest that drew entries from more than 700 fifth graders around the country.

Since inventing the cart guard, which drew mention in the "Wall Street Journal" and was displayed last month at the National Inventor's Expo in Washington, D.C., Chris, Jonathan, their two sisters and mom and dad — Norman and Genie (Drobnić) Robben — have moved to Cape Coral, Fla., where dad just started a new position as administrator of a nursing home.

There's no word yet whether or not Chris has begun working on a way to send some of the Florida sunshine up to grandma's Cleveland home.



RECIPES

ROAST SADDLE OF LAMB

1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon fresh ground pepper
2 garlic cloves, minced
1/3 cup chopped fresh mint
1/3 cup chopped fresh basil
1 boneless saddle of lamb (about 5 lbs.), trimmed and tied, or — 1 boneless leg of lamb (about 7 lbs.), butterflied and tied.

Red currant jelly

In small bowl combine salt, pepper, garlic and herbs. With fingers and handle of wooden spoon, stuff into openings in lamb. (Can be prepared ahead. Let stand at room temperature up to 3 hours.)

Preheat oven to 500°F. Place lamb fat side up on rack in roasting pan. Roast 15 minutes. Reduce temperature to 375°F. Roast 40 minutes more for rare, 45 minutes more for medium-rare. (For leg of lamb, roast 1 hour more for rare, 70 minutes more for medium-rare).

Let stand 10 minutes before slicing. Serve with jelly. Makes 10 servings, about 480 calories each for saddle of lamb, 590 calories each for leg of lamb.

CARROT CHEDDAR CHEESE CASSEROLE

1 lb. carrots, cooked and mashed
2 eggs, beaten
1 1/2 C. milk
1C. cheddar cheese, shredded
1 C. cracker crumbs or 1/2 C. Peppridge stuffing
2 T. butter
1 tsp. salt

Preheat oven to 350. Combine all ingredients and mix well. Bake 30 minutes in a 8 inch square pan. Serves 6.

BARLEY CASSEROLE

4 T. butter
3/4 C. barley
1/2 C. diced onion
1 - 4 oz. can mushrooms, undrained
1 - 13 3/4 oz. can chicken broth
1/2 C. slivered almonds

Preheat oven to 350. Sauté butter with barley and onion until barely brown. Add mushrooms and chicken broth. Bake in covered casserole for 1 1/4 hours, add almonds, bake 15 minutes more. Serves 6 to 8.

Easy Shrimp

- Cover the bottom of a large skillet with two tablespoons of olive oil, the juice of one lime and a tablespoon of white vinegar.
- Add chopped garlic (two cloves) and bring to a boil.
- Add shrimp in the shells and stir until the shrimp turn pink.
- Serve with melted butter and lime juice.

Suster backs strong anti-drug laws

The Ohio House of Representatives has unanimously passed a bill which seeks to stiffen penalties for drug offenses committed on school premises or within one thousand feet of school property. The legislation is modeled after recent changes in federal law designed to help educators and law enforcement agencies fight drug abuse.

"Teenagers are increasing drug use at an alarming rate in Ohio," said Ohio Representative Suster, co-sponsor of the bill. "The Ohio Department of Mental Health found that seven percent of the high school students surveyed use hard drugs almost every day. Fifteen percent said they used drugs several times each month. And 29 percent used hard drugs occasionally. These figures do not include alcohol and marijuana users."

While House Bill 844 would increase penalties for all drug offenses, law enforcement officials have demonstrated particular interest in strengthening sentences for Trafficking in Drugs and Corrupting Another with Drugs.

Trafficking in Drugs, currently a fourth degree felony, will become a third degree felony under House Bill 844. Sentences will be increased from a minimum of eighteen months actual incarceration to two years, and from a maximum of five years actual incarceration to ten years.

In cases where the teenager involved is under 18 years of age and at least four years the junior of the offender, individuals charged with Corrupting Another with Drugs will face a sentence of 12 years actual incarceration, compared with seven years under current law.

"House Bill 844 responds to a need for stronger penalties to deter drug sales near school property," said Representative Suster. "Drugs have no place in our children's lives. This legislation complements all schools' efforts to combat drug usage and trafficking."


