SOCIJALIZEM IN ČLOVEK

Tehniko, gospodarstvo, državo gledata vedno v razmerju do človeka. Z isto neumornostjo in skrbnostjo, s katero zasledujeta razvoj kapitalizma, zbirata dokaze o bedi delavcev, o prokletstvu otroškega in ženskega dela, o moreči monotoni mehaničnega dela, skozi slavospev gigantskemu tehničnemu napredku prodira vedno krik človeškega upora. Marx je v tistih časih, ko se je kapitalizem še bohotno razvijal, napovedal njegov konec: "Buržauzija je nesposobna trajno vladati, ker je nesposobna, da bi svojim sužnjem zagotovila eksistenco v samem okviru njenega suženjstva, ker je prisiljena, da jih poniža v položaju, ko jih bo morala sama rediti, namesto da se ona redi o njih."

Nasproti vsem tistim, ki so v svoji kratkovidnosti dolžili stroj in tehniko kot kriveca človeške bede, sta branila stroj in povedala, da je od človeka odvisno, ali se kaka stvar obrne njemu v korist ali škodo. Stroj je blagoslov za človeka, če se pravilno uporablja. Toda v kapitalističnem sistemu se vsaka najboljša stvar obrne v slabo. V kapitalističnem sistemu se nalaga kapital samo tam, kjer se bolj množi, ves pogon kapitalističnega gospodarskega življenja je samo v pohlepnu po dobičku; radi dobička se grade tovarne, radi dobička se racionalizira produkcija, radi dobička se odpuščajo delavci; na potrebo človeških množic se ne ozira. Gospodarsko življenje "pride do zastoja ne tam, kjer zapoveduje zastoj zadovoljitev človeških potreb, temveč tam, kjer ga zapoveduje realizacija dobička." In tako sam stroj ni krv ničemur, ker "stroj sam po sebi krajša delovni čas, toda kapitalistično uporabljen stroj ga pa podaljšuje; stroj sam lajsa delo, kapitalistično uporabljen pa veča napor; stroj sam pomeni zmago človeka nad naravo, kapitalistično uporabljen pa človeka zasušnjuje naravi; stroj sam veča blagostanje producentov, kapitalistično uporabljen jih pa spravlja na beraško palico." Zato naj ljudje spremene sistem, da bo človeku postal delo blagoslov in osvobajenje. Tega končnega cilja pa nista zasanjala kot neki pesniški ideal, temveč sta znanstveno dokazala, da je mogoč, potreben in nujen nov gospodarski in družabni red, ki ne bo razrušil ustvarjenih pridobitev, temveč jih bo samo postavil v službo celoti. Njuna teorija ni filozofska špekulacija, temveč nauk, sloče na spoznanju stvarnega, materialnega stanja. Iz te realne, stvarne, razumske osnove so pa potem mnogi napravili zmoto s tem, da so sprejeli in pojmovali marksizem le enostransko.

Iz tega dialektičnega nauka, ki vidi povsod glavni pogon napredka v večnem boju nasprotij med gospodarskimi razmerami in živimi potrebami, človeštva, so napravili fatalistično potvaro, češ: gospodarstvo samo se razvija v socializem. Povsod po svetu pa vidimo nazorne primeyre, kako lahko vprav v časih najhujše križe kapitalizma zmagujejo najreakcionarnje struje in koliko je torej odvisno tudi od akcije živih ljudi.





These pages have proved of interest to our juvenile membership as letters from them have designated. A number of them are not only writing for pages devoted to them in particular, but we find articles written by more aggressive members of Vrtec lodges on our Forum Page. Through this medium we will find better relationship between them and ourselves. They will begin taking interest in material forwarded by more experienced members and lodges. Likewise they will feel as one of us instead as a group restricted from advancement.

Often we have heard words to the effect that our juveniles are our future leaders, as we have also heard emphasis placed upon English speaking members that they must be ready to take the realm of our fraternities and guide its future successfully. Well spoken and written phrases were made to encourage activity and interest into minds and actions of younger element. Today we find life among younger sections that have surpassed the activity of their elders.

Our Vrtec units is not an original idea. SSPZ was the first Slovene society to accept it as an important act in its progress and growth. We also urge the same process be accepted by other Slovene fraternal societies.

There is no reason why we could not have a magazine published by all our fraternals that would be the pride of our populace and an educational feature for our juveniles. We must approach them in a sense of publicity, a method of acquainting them with our problems, our purpose and necessity for organization and value of fraternal societies. This is something we all needed and still are open for the knowledge they should not be withheld. Our failure to take earlier action in bringing understanding to our youth about fraternal insurance and other vital questions has cost us thousands of members. It made many of our youth socially incapable. Their vision upon surroundings, their attitude upon nationalistic background, their ignorance of social and economic problems was a sad state of misunderstanding in their minds and no procedure to bring light was attempted by the best medium, our fraternal groups. In fact even today there are individuals and groups who have little consideration for the new generation and care little as to the outcome of our organizations future. They are people who live only for themselves.

Nevertheless today we find majority inclined towards bettering our conditions as members of fraternal organizations and thus are giving aid to better conditions in general.

For Vrtec Christmas edition, which will be published December 19, it would be to our organizations advantage that every member takes interest by helping contribute material of value and to induce new contributors and encourage continuation of contributors to date. We are calling upon every administrator, every lodge official, every member of Vrtec and adult lodges to give their best in making our coming Christmas edition the best in a modern view and an enjoyable feature. Pictures of Vrtec groups and officials, who have not yet sent in pictures, are welcome and we urge that you will do this immediately. All contributions should be in the Forum office not later than December 15th.

ELECT CAPABLE LODGE OFFICERS

Month of December is here again which means the addition of elections on the agenda. This is a regular yearly procedure in fraternal organizations. Every member has a right to vote for lodge executives that will best serve the interest of the lodge and Society. You have a right to replace any member of the executive board who has become "inefficient, discourteous" or become "negligent" etc.

Live activity is a vital point of any lodge. If your lodge, through its committees and lodge executives, have failed to live up to its reputation or has failed to gain prestige, it is time that change or changes are made. In order to activize a lodge it may need new leaders who will show aggressiveness and a livelier spirit in lodge work.

In selecting lodge officers have in mind his devotion to the lodge, his effort in giving enough time to duties by planning and encouraging others into activity. He should be a student of fraternalism, a respectable member, earnest and able so that members could be proud of having him in position he may hold. Choose wisely and cautiously.

USE DISCRETION IN CHOOSING NEW LODGE OFFICERS

(EDITORIAL from the Fraternal Monitor)

That season of the year is upon us when up-and-doing lodges are looking around for the right material to fill the various chairs. Only "live" lodges will be particularly concerned about the qualifications of the incoming officers—that's why they are LIVE. Competition has long been recognized as "the life of trade." Good natured rivalry and keen competition helps a long way to keep a lodge up on its toes. The things in life we have to fight for are the things we appreciate and value most.

In some lodges it is the custom to reelect officers year after year. With the possible exception of the secretary, this is not considered good practice. There are, of course, in some lodges officers, who by their lively interest in the work of the lodge and by their devotion to its success, have justly earned the honor of reelection.... There is just one criticism of this procedure. If the officer going up the line shows lack of interest or preparation for his work he should be dropped and another elected to succeed him.

After all, it isn't the plan of selecting officers that counts, but rather the fitness of the man designated for the office. A man may be popular in his lodge, a first-rate good fellow from a social standpoint, but a perfect flop when he is confronted with the necessity of learning his part in the ritual or exercising any executive ability. Another, of the quiet, self-effacing type, may turn out to be a veritable wizard when it comes to hard work and realistic performance. These things should be considered before election.

Selection of the proper officers is important to the success of any lodge. It invariably means the difference between a live lodge and a dead one....

Younger men should be placed in offices where their alertness and quick action can keep the proceedings, be it transaction of lodge business or the ritual, at a quick tempo. No member cares to spend an evening bored stiff by a droning business session or listening to officers stumble and mumble their way through the ritual. Once is usually quite sufficient.

We have spoken in these columns many times of the imperative need today of fraternal societies giving recognition to the younger members, those just graduated into the adult class, in their lodge proceedings. They should have a place among the lesser offices in the lodge where there is an opportunity for them to show their mettle and work up to more responsible positions. They should have their place on the social and other committees where new ideas and enthusiastic cooperation are essential.

Now is the time for every lodge to take stock of this new blood. Don't treat these "new members" as though they were something that had to be tolerated. Show them that their membership is highly valued and give them an opportunity to have a real, active part in the affairs of the lodge. When you give official recognition to one of these young people you are performing an act of far-reaching results. You are appealing to the pride of youth and arousing in that young person's heart a desire to give his best, but you are likewise arousing interest in lodge activities among his young friends and associates....

Societies are devoting much time and money to the enrollment of younger members. Those fraternals with vision are exerting equal effort to holding them after they get them.

That even now they are revamping their rates and dividend policies because of the lower rates on their investments... That they are being openly criticised for purposely suppressing the truth about their security rates... That a congressional investigating committee might be given an opportunity to sharpen your wits on matters concerning commercial life insurance companies.
