V Pakistanu prijeli vodilja opozicije

V sredo so prijeli v Lahoru kivšega zunanjega ministra Bhutto, vodnika levica, kar je 'ščuval množice'.

KARACHI, Pak. — Policia je prijela v sredo ob zori vodnika "Ljudske stranke" Zulfarija Alija Bhutto, ker "je ščuval množice" proti vladi, kot trdi poročilo. Poleg njega je bilo zaprtih še 14 drugih znanih politikov, nasprotnikov vlade. Bhutto, 41 let stari odvetnik, vodi levičarsko Ljudsko stranko, ki nasprotuje vladi. Do leta 1966 je bil zunanjji minister in sodelavec predsednika Ayub Khan. Ko je Pakistan hotel le čisto odtrgati od Združenih držav in ga povesti v zvezo in sodelovanje z rdečo Kitajsko, ga je Ayub Khan odpustil. Objavili so pa le, da je šel iz vlade zaradi bolezni.

Z. A. Bhutto je študiral v Kaliforniji na državni univerzi in v Oxfordu v Veliki Britaniji. Je zagovornik in pristaš "islamskega socializma", ki je hladen do Zahoda in išče naslonitve na "socialistični blok". Bhutto je v tem smislu usmerjal kot zunanjji minister Pakistan stran od Združenih držav proti rdeči Kini. Predsednik je v tem konzervativec, zato je Bhutta odslovil in krenil s Pakistanom nazaj proti Zahodu.

V svojih govorih po Zahodnem Pakistanu v zadnjih tednih je Bhutto ostro napadal vladu. Ko je koncem tedna prišel v Lahore, je prišlo tam do nemirov študentov, ki so trajali tri dni. Oblasti so mu svetovale, naj pozove študente k končanju izgredov in demonstracij, kar pa je Bhutto odklonil, češ, "kako naj to storim, ko se bore proti tiraniji". Njegovi pristaši sodijo, da mu bo zapor, kjer se mu sicer ne bo godilo posebno slabo, ker bo kot politični jetnik užival razne ugodnosti, politično samo koristil. Napravil ga bo za političnega "mučenika" in tako njegov ugled v očeh volivev dvignil. Trdijo, da utegne leta 1970 kandidirati za predsednika republike.

Ruska nevarnost vzrok dogovora Nixon-Johnson?

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Iz Nixoneve okolice je prišla vest, da je huda zaskrbljenost vodilnih posavalev sovjetske politike, da utegne Moskva napraviti kako novo potezo v vzhodni Evropi v neposredni bodočnosti, pripravljala izvoljenega predsednika k izjavi, da govor L. B. Johnson tuje v njegovem imenu.

Vladni strokovnjaki so svarili Johnsona in Nixon, da utegne biti sovjetski nastop v ČSR uvod k podobnemu nastopom proti Romuniji, Jugoslaviji in Albaniji.

Veliki štirje prigajajo Jarringa k posredovanju

KAIRO, ZAR. — Ko se polaganj na Srednjem vzhodu zapleta in obe strani govorita odprto o možnosti obnove vojskovanja, prihajajo v javnost vesti, da štiri velike sile, Amerika, Rusija, Anglia in Francija, pritisajo na posredovalca ZN Gunnarja V. Jarringa, naj postane živahnejši in podjetnejši v svojih naporih za iskanje poti k pomirivosti Srednjega vzhoda. G. V. Gunnar je švedski poslanik v Moskvi, ki je prevzel lansko jesen nalogo iskri v okviru Združenih narodov pomiritev med Izraelom in Arabci.

Doslej so vsi Jarringovi poskusili obtičali in tudi zadnji ne obetajo nič boljšega. Razgovori v New Yorku tekom zasedanja gl. skupščine ZN so se pretekli teden zaključili, ko sta egiptovski in jordanijski zunanjji minister odšla domov. Napovedano je sicer nadaljevanje razgovorov v Ženevi, toda to je bolj nočnost, kot resen načrt.

Brežnjev brani vdor v ČSR z novo teorijo

Glavni tajnik Komunistične partije ZSSR trdi, da je Zahod upal, da bodo komunisti mirno gledali, ko bo prevladovala v ČSR socialna demokracija in se nato raztegnila še na Poljsko in v Vzhodno Nemčijo.

VARŠAVA, Polj. — Leonid Brežnjev je priletel iz Moskve v Varšavo, da se udeleži kot odšen gost kongresa poljske Komunistične partije. Kot tak je tudi govoril na nekem delavnem shodu v največji varšavski jeklarni in tam razvijal novo teorijo, ki naj opraviči vdor četvaršavske petorce na Češkoslovaško. Teorijo je skoval na podlagi nekega "uglednega ameriškega časopisa", ki ga pa ne imenuje. Casopisni članek razlagatačno tisto, — tako trdi Brežnjev —, kar so v Kremelu predvideli že ob začetku.

"Imperialistični volkovi v ovčjih oblekah" so že davno napravili načrt, kako bi spiskovali kar z enim mahom tri socijalistične države: Vzhodno Nemčijo, Poljsko in Češkoslovaško. Najprvo bi Zahodna Nemčija obnovila diplomatske stike s Prago in pritegnila Čehe in Slovake s krediti in gospodarskimi koncesijami na sebe. Prihodnji korak naj bi spiskopal vidilno "idejno-politično vlogo" češkoslovaškega komunizma in prepeljal Češkoslovaško v "socijalno demokracijo", toda že zelo pomembno s kapitalističnimi idejam. Zadnji korak naj bi bil sprejemba režimov v Varšavi in Vzhodnem Berlinu, kjer naj bi bune vlade sledile češkoslovaškemu zgledu.

Varšavska petorica se ni dala ukončiti, je pravočasno spoznala hudo kapitalistični načrt in ga s svojimi divizijami preprečila. Brežnjev je verjetno mislil ameriški časopis "Fortune", ki res razlagata tako možen razvoj v ČSR, toda v očeh Moskve, ne v očeh Zahoda.

Ker imajo Poljaki na splošno vendarle možnost in priliko, da poslušajo tudi "kapitalistične" radio postaje, so lahko hitro spoznali, kam cilja govor tovariša Brežnjeva, ki mu je varšavská ulica hitro dala pravo ceno.

Okrajni načelnik GOP Stillman sodi po svoje o republikanski zmagi

CLEVELAND, O. — Mr. Stillman, načelnik republikanske stranke v okraju Cuyahoga, spada med vodilne ohajске republikance. Mož je toliko neodvisen in staren, da ne najde na republikanskih uspehih le svetih, ampak tudi temne plati. Tako je na nekem shodu v Clevelandu trdil, da ga republikanski uspehi ne presenečajo, da pa jih ni treba precenjevati.

Opozoril je svoje poslušalce na dejstvo, da je v voliniborbi obiskala cel vlandske republikance celo vrsta odličnih republikanskih politikov, učinek teh obiskov pa je bil majhen: stranka je dobila v okraju Cuyahoga komaj 18,000 glasov nad povprečjem. Tako so enote južno od Demilitarizirane cone odgovorile s topovskim ognjem na rdeče obstreljevanje iz Demilitarizirane cone. Pri tem so jih podprele še vojne ladje, ki so s svojimi topovi obdelovali rdeče položaje v Demilitarizirani coni.

V JUŽNEM VIETNAMU JE PRIŠLO DO NOVIH BOJEV

Zatišje prvih dni po ustanovitvi ameriških napadov na Severni Vietnam je končano, včeraj je prišlo do obsežnega rdečega napada na vladno postojanko blizu meje Kambodže. Po večurnem boju so bili rdeči pregnani. Na bojišču so pustili 287 mrtvih. — Število padlih in ranjenih Amerikancev pretekli teden najviše v enem mesecu.

SAIGON, J. Viet. — V preteklem tednu je padlo v bojih v so imeli 4 mrtvih in 23 ranjenih. Južnem Vietnamu 166 ameriški vojakov, največ v zadnjih takoj velike, ker se je posrečilo 4 tednih. Ta teden je bil prvi po ameriškemu oponištvu udariti ustanovitvi ameriških napadov na nanj, ko je preko cistine v valovem Vietnam. Rdeče izgube vih drž proti utrjeni vladni poso med tem znižale in so največ stojanki. V boju so posegla tudi manjše v zadnjih petih tednih.

Saragat v Tridentu in Trstu

Za 50-letnico italijanske "zmage na Piavi" je obiskal predsednik italijanske republike Trident in Trst, ki ju je Italija po tej zmagi zasedla in do danes obdržala. V Gorici izhajajoči slovenski tednik "Katoliški glas" je o tem obisku prinesel 7. novembra 1968 članek, ki ga tu prinašamo v prepričanju, da zanimo večino naših čitalcev, posebno pa one iz Primorske.

Italija praznuje vsako leto 4. novembra "Dan zmage". Po 42 mesecih krvave vojne, v kateri je padlo 600,000 njenih mladih sinov ter zrelih mož in ki je imela svoj zmagovalci zaključek ob reki Piavi, je prišlo konec oktobra 1918 do splošnega razsula avstrijske fronte, posledica notranjega razpada avstro-ogrsko monarhije. Dober teden pred 4. novembrom, 28. oktobra 1918 so Čehi in Slovaki proglašili svojo državno neodvisnost, naslednji dan pa je bila ustavljena v Ljubljani prva slovenska vlada.

Dnevi po 4. novembra 1918 so bili za Italijo dnevi velikega zmagošlavja. Italijanski rodoljubi so mogli slaviti svoj stoletni sen: Trident (Trento) in Trst sta se vključila v italijansko državo. Italijanske čete pa so tedaj zasedle tudi ozemlje, kjer so živeli nemško govoreči Južnotirolici in Slovenci ter Hrvati na Goriškem, Notranjskem, Tržaškem in Istri. V iskanju "naravnih" in "varnih" mej je nastala sedanja meja na Brennerju, na slovenskem ozemlju pa je do leta 1943 obstala na črti Reka-Postojna-Idrija-Trieglav, Vršič in Jalovec.

Vsa ta dejstva so našla določen odmev tudi v govorih, ki jih je imel predsednik italijanske države Saragat v mestu Tridentu in Trstu, ki jih je 3. in 4. novembra obiskal v zvezi s proslavami 50-letnice njih priključitve Italiji.

"Vojna kot taka — je dejal Saragat v Tridentu — je bila strahotno brezno, v katerega so se zagnali evropski narodi v svojem bratomornem klanju. Povzročila je neštete žrte, bolečine in razvaline. Toda prav v takih trenutkih, ko pride nad narod bodisi po naključju ali zaradi napak ljudi vojni bes, se pokaže pogum in moralna moč ljudstva, ki se mora z vojno soočiti. Italijanski narod je dal dokaz za tak pogum, saj ni klonil niti tedaj, ko so mu bili vojni dogodki nasprotni in si je zato znal zasluziti zmago. Prav tega duha žrtvovanja proslavljamo v teh dneh."

Saragat je našel tudi trezne besede za južnotiroško vprašanje, ki še vedno kali sožitje dveh različno govorečih narodov v bocenski pokrajini na Južnem Tirolskem. "Rad bi poudaril — je reklo Saragat — da mi priznavamo in spomnimo pogum naših nasprotnikov od tedaj; želim izrabiti povrh to priložnost, da pozdravim avstrijski narod. Mi poznamo posebne okoliščine, ki so značilne za tridentinsko deželo. Sedanje meje so sicer za nas nedotakljive, toda znotraj teh meja je naša moralna dolžnost, da absolutno spomnimo pravice tako posameznikov kot skupin, kateri so naši državljanji. Zato je v proslavljanju obletnice zmage vključen tudi poudarek na idealih miru, ne pa vojne, povezanosti in ne razprtij, z eno besedo: idealov napredka in civilizacije."

Je pa doživel državni predsednik v Tridentu tudi nekaj nevšečnega. Skupina nezadovoljnih študentov sociologije, ki jim v Italiji pravijo "i contestatori" (tisti, ki oporekajo), je hotel protestirati proti obstoječim razmeram takoj, da se je pet ali šest deklek obleceni v hlače in s škorjenji na nogah, vrglo pred avtomobil, v katerem se je vozil Saragat. Seveda jih je je policia hitro odstranila. Kasneje je po mestnih ulicah še večkrat prišlo do spopadov med temi študenti in veterani iz prve svetovne vojne, ki so korakali po mestu z godbo in s praporji.

Predsednik Saragat je nato odpotoval v Trst, kamor je prišel s posebnim vlakom v nedeljo, 3. novembra, na večer. Spotoma se je ustavil še v mestecu Vittorio Veneto, kjer je podelil odlikovanje skupini borcev iz prve svetovne vojne ter se zahvalil vsem, ki so pripomogli k tedanji zmagi.

V Trstu je v ponedeljek dopoldne najprej obiskal županstvo, kjer mu je župan izročil spominsko kolajno "Trst '68", nato pa je imel slavnostni govor v gledališču Verdi. Medtem se je razvijala zunaj vojaška parada, v kateri je sodelovalo 7206 mož, 70 letal in 15 vojaških godb.

Misli, ki jih je Saragat razvijal v Trstu, so bile podobne tistim, ki jih je izrekel v Tridentu. Zmago od 4. novembra 1918 in priključitev Trsta Italiji je povezel z vojno, ki je tem dogodkom odprla pot. Zavrnil je trditve, da je vojna osnovni in večni zakon sveta. Če bi sledili v naši dobi — ki je doba atomskega orožja — tej trditvi, bi človeštvo obsovali na uničenje. Vojna nikakor ni neka neizogibna nujnost, temveč je rezultat pomot in zmot ljudi. Zato z grozo odklanjamo vsako kršitev mednarodnih zakonov. Pri tem

je Saragat omenil "plemenito državo, v katero so nedaleč od naših meja vdrlje tuje armade", se dotaknil Blížnjega vzhoda, ki je prepoln klic novih spopadov, ter izrazil svoje veselje nad odločitvijo predsednika ZDA Johnsona, da se preneha bombardiranje Severnega Vietnama. Izrekel je že, da bi Italija živila v miru z vsemi narodi zemlje ter pri tem poslat prisrčen pozdrav prijateljski jugoslovanski državi. Na koncu svojega govorja je Saragat pozval Tržačane, naj bodo na vzhodnih mejah Italije izraz in svedoki italijanske kulture in civilizacije.

Popolne se je Saragat udeležil slovesnega "Te Deuma" v stolnici sv. Justa, se ob 16.40 na trgu Oberdan poslovil od predstavnika Trsta, nato pa še obiskal vojaško kopališče v Ridelugli, kjer je položil lovorcev venec na skupni grob stotisočnih padlih na fronti na doberdobski planoti. Še isti večer se je potem vrnil v Rim.

Čeprav sta slovesnostim v Trstu botrovola na splošno čut za realnost in strpnost, pa ni mogoče iti mimo naslednjega dejstva: v obilju besed ni bilo niti enkrat omenjeno, da tod živita skupaj da naroda, italijanski in slovenski in da je to dejstvo z vsemi svojimi nerešenimi problemi eno temeljnih značilnosti v deželi Furlanija-Julijška Krajina ter v tržaškem mestu.

Tasty Trick: Potato Cookies



Eminently practical, instantly whipped potatoes and Danish-flavored margarine help the teen-age cook turn this good trick—Potato Drop Cookies. Here's how the Borden Kitchen does it!

Potato Drop Cookies
(Makes 4-dozen 2-inch diameter cookies.)

1/3 cup Danish flavor margarine	1-1/4 cups Borden Instant Whipped Potato Flakes, dry form
2 eggs, separated	1/2 cup chopped walnuts
2 (1-oz.) squares unsweetened chocolate, melted	1 cup sifted all-purpose flour
	1-1/2 teaspoons baking powder
	1/2 teaspoon salt

In a large-size electric mixer bowl, beat margarine until light and fluffy. Gradually add sugar; mix well. Add egg yolks. Stir in melted chocolate, potato flakes and nuts; mix well. Sift together flour, baking powder and salt. Stir into creamed mixture. (NOTE: Mixture will be dry and crumbly.) In a small-size bowl, beat egg whites until stiff but not dry. Fold beaten whites into chocolate mixture until well blended. Drop by teaspoons onto greased baking sheet. Bake in a moderate (350°F.) oven, 15 to 20 minutes or until cookies are set. Cool slightly before removing from baking sheet. Frost cookies with chocolate icing.

★ Woodmere, O.—Magazine subscriptions, memberships in book clubs, record albums and bills for them have flooded into the Donald Lasch home. The curious thing about the avalanche of mail and parcel post deliveries is that a source unknown to the Lasch family had ordered all of it. They have had exterminators come, claiming that the Lasch family called them and an awning firm came. Postal inspectors are investigating.

★ Washington, D.C.—The Post Office Department has issued the 1968 Christmas postage stamp, a detail of the 15th century masterpiece, "The Annunciation." The stamp reproduces in five colors Angel Gabriel with wings of peacock feathers, a detail of the painting by Flemish artist Jan van Eyck and currently part of the Mellon Collection in the National Gallery of Art. He works for the Cincinnati waste collection department.

First Immigration History Newsletter Published

The first issue of an Immigration History Newsletter—the only one of its kind in the world—will be out by Thanksgiving, says editor Victor Greene of Cleveland State University's history department.

The newsletter, with a beginning circulation of 100, will be sent all over the globe to scholars interested in ethnic history and to various national historical associations.

Headline stories in the first semi-annual issue, according to Greene, will be "Ethnic America's Response to the Civil Rights Movement," plus coverage of a meeting in Slovakia on the history of Slovak migration to America, and one at State University of New York College at Oswego on the use of computers in immigration history research. Among research noted is the "Contribution of Italians to the American Diet," and "The Japanese and Their Descendents in Brazil."

There is very little knowledge of how different nationalities have adjusted to life in America and other countries, says Greene—one of the country's few ethnic historians. It is a very neglected area.

Because of this, and because scholars don't know the exact individual research that has been done, Greene originated the newsletter—a central clearing house with information on meetings, research and pertinent activities in ethnic studies.

The editor-historian became interested in ethnic history while researching his recently published book on the anthracite labor unrest in Eastern Pennsylvania between 1880 and 1903, entitled "The Slovak Community on Strike."

Greene also teaches a course in immigration at the University, mainly to children of recent immigrants.

The Immigration History Newsletter is sponsored by the Immigration History Group, a national organization of historians, sociologists and anthropologists who wish to encourage ethnic history. It will be printed at CSU.

Four Hot Flag Races

The best thing the football pros have done in the last 35 years, in the way of scheduling, is the four-division format—which, in a 14-week season, brings each club against all but four of the 16 NFL members and provides four separate pennant races.

It can be predicted with confidence today that there will be a general rise in baseball interest next summer when the older national pastime likewise offers four pennant races instead of two. Some sports writers, on very solid ground will object, but there will be no protests in the cities where public interest rises in a pennant race that would not have been possible with 1967 scheduling.

Olympic Payola Probe Planned

Apparently, there will be a full-scale investigation of payola practices for Olympic athletes before the 1972 Games will around—and the rules will be tightened up.

Speaking in Washington on Sept. 17, Avery Brundage, president of the International Olympic Committee, admitted there had been some hanky-panky in the Winter Games.

It is odd that Brundage, who zealously polices amateurism, was on the 1912 Olympic team. That was when the great Jim Thorpe was stripped of his medals because he had played semi-pro baseball.

Brundage is not always the curmudgeon. Talking about the Thorpe incident, he said: "It was regrettable that Jim lost his medals. He was a great athlete, but there was nothing else that could be done."

The irony is that the breach of amateurism for which Thorpe was nailed would hardly be classed as professionalism in these changing times.

Tougher Schedule for Western Hockey League Expansion Clubs

Boston, Mass.—The National Hockey League's Western Division teams pushed through legislation for an increase in games against the older Eastern Division clubs this season. As a result, the expansion teams are winning more at the box office—and losing more on the ice.

Last year, in 144 interlocking games, the Western Division teams won 49 games and tied for 18 for a respectable 34 percent of the points. They will have trouble reaching that percentage this time around, if early-season results are any yardstick.

The new owners decided that Eastern Division players like Chicago's Bobby Hull, Detroit's Gordie Howe, Montreal's Jean Beliveau and Boston's Bobby Orr would put more people into their buildings. They have, but they are also leading their respective teams to more victories.

Pro Football Looking At New Artificial Turf

San Francisco, Calif.—Pro football will try to improve the playing surfaces, said Lou Spadia, boss of the San Francisco 49ers.

"One of football's big problems," he noted, "is the large number of knee injuries, usually caused when a player's cleats stick in the turf."

"There have been some experiments with Astro-Turf and Tartan surfaces and the statistics (on knee injuries) have been remarkable."

AGAINST THE GRAIN

The people of the United States have always believed in the idea that a day's work was a fair exchange for a day's pay. Apparently, this is one basic thought that is still with us.

Recent Gallup Polls have shown that 78 per cent of the American public favors a guaranteed job program so that everyone capable of working might have the opportunity to do so. In contrast to this strong support for guaranteed jobs, only 36 per cent of the people interviewed favored a guaranteed annual income. To the average person, the great drawbacks to government paying everybody a certain minimum income still seem two-fold. The cost, added to present welfare programs growing bigger every day, would be the last thing the nation's finances could stand, and politically it would be highly unlikely that the hundreds of local, state and federal welfare programs would be dropped or cut back. Secondly, something for nothing has never encouraged anybody yet to work harder to help himself, and so far that is the only way anybody has ever gotten out of poverty.

We are told that the millennium is coming when all the work in the country will be done by machines and most of us will have the burden of finding uses for our leisure time. So far, most of us haven't been troubled with this situation and find the idea of guaranteeing everybody an income as a matter of right, whether they work or not, thoroughly nonsensical.

THE NAME OF THE GAME IS "FRAMES"

New York (NAPS) — On Twigs they're a trademark. On the Princess of Monaco they're regal. When Sophia Loren wears them, she looks like an adorable owl. But what about you?

Will your glasses add "spec's appeal" to your appearance? Of course they will if you'll take a tip from the beautiful people who now spend almost as much time choosing eyewear frames as are flattering — as well as far out, fun or just high-fashion — as they do selecting clothes, cosmetics and hair styles.

In fact, if Dorothy Parker were writing today she'd undoubtedly have to revise her famous lines to read: "Most men make passes at girls who wear glasses." Because most men are attracted to girls who know what the score is, they get with it. And these days, as you may have noticed, specs are making the scene from L.A. to London Town, from cover girls to campus queens, from discotheques to drawing rooms.

How do chic tricks and mod moms manage to look so spectacular in spectacles?

The secret lies in the word "frame." When you choose the right type of frame, your glasses will actually work for you, emphasizing your best features and minimizing your deficiencies. They can also highlight your outfit, your image or your moods, helping you to make that quick switch from desk decorum to date devastation, from outdoor sport to candlelight coquette, from friendly pal to frame fatale.

How to choose an in-fashion frame which flatters?

This year, the designers are con-

centrating on "geometrics", following the big trend in clothes, costume jewelry, fabrics and furniture with the result that frames in the shape of squares, diamonds, oblongs, hexagons and oversized circles are very much in vogue.

Pictured above are a few suggestions on high fashion framework as conceived by a group of leading beauty stylists working with frame designers of the American Optical Company, one of the world's largest and best known makers of eyewear.

If you're lucky enough to have an oval face to start with, your frame should be gently rounded, almost understated, so that its shape does nothing to detract from that of your face. A triangular face, as shown, looks best with a big, round-eyed frame; a diamond-shaped face will be most flattered by the new "hexagonal" eyewear; the length of an oblong face can be reduced by a square frame while the round or heartshaped type should choose frames with a longish, slightly narrow look to minimize the width of forehead and cheekbone.

Once you have determined your own frame fashion group, you still have a wide variety of styles, colors, materials and trimmings to choose from. TEACH YOUR CHILD FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

New York (NAPS)—Your daughter's record player blares down records all day long. Your son makes constant requests for more "date" money. These "minor" annoyances can indicate serious financial irresponsibility on the part of your children! By placing them on a budget based on a weekly allowance (rather than haphazard handouts), you will be helping yourself in the short run — and teaching the youngsters a valuable long-term lesson.

The first step, say experts at the National Consumer Finance Association, is to establish the allowance. Explain to your child why he needs a budget, and let him get into the act. Ask him to draw up a list of his weekly expenditures. A youngster likes being treated as an adult, and if you handle the budgeting as a lesson in life, rather than punishment, he won't resent it.

It might be a good idea to discuss each item with him to see if all his expenses are necessary. By limiting his "incidental expenses" to just enough for a weekend show or a new record or magazine — and holding the line firmly — you will be forcing him to keep a careful watch on his cash while allowing him some latitude and choice. But be sure to allow adequate money for lunches, carfare, school supplies, and church donations.

A firm policy on allowances benefits your youngster and saves wear-and-tear on your wallet! When your child has a "crisis" — he'll need more money than you give him. Try not to succumb to his "doo-eyed" pleas for more than he's due — but suggest in advance several ways for him to build up emergency funds.

Make sure he knows some sure-fire methods of earning "extra income". It doesn't have to be a 9 to 5 job — maybe just little chores.

Babysitting, lawnmowing, or dishwashing, for you or a neighbor, are some good examples of work he can easily do.

Encourage him to save. Give him a short-winded but farsighted lesson in banks and interest, and open a savings account in his name. Eventually, the account can be used for college or as a "nest egg". Parents can deduct certain deposits made in a child's savings account from their taxes under the Uniform Gifts to Minors Act. Don't insist that your child save all his money; financial experts say he should have practice in spending as well!

A third way in which your child can conquer a "crisis" will teach him about credit. Give him a small loan — as he pays it back, deduct token interest from his allowance. This will teach him that to establish credit he must also establish his reliability. Fatherly credit given to a child will show him he can have what he wants now by paying for it as he uses it.

Loans, savings accounts, and "moonlighting" won't teach your child much if he doesn't learn how to use his money. The limits you place on his allowance may help, but you should provide him with additional guidelines on shopping. Warn him against making foolish expenditures just because he's earned or saved some extra money. Be tactful in what you tell him. Limiting his financial freedom will eliminate the important lesson mistakes can give him. If the house fills up with feathers, fragrances, goldfish and posters — and your child chronically complains of "insufficient funds" even AFTER you've budgeted him — you'll know it's time for a little talk about excess.

Remember that part of teaching him how to use money depends upon how you use it! Repay all your debts on time. Don't be excessive.

Both right-handers, Romo is 24 years-old and Pina 21. The 1968 season was their first taste of major league competition. Romo spent time on major league rosters (Indians and Dodgers) before blossoming into one of the top relief hurlers in baseball mid-way through the campaign. He posted the lowest earned run average among the league's relief pitchers.

SECOND STATISTICAL ROUND-UP — 90TH CONGRESS

UP — 90th CONGRESS. The second session of the 90th Congress convened on January 15, 1968 and adjourned on October 14, 1968. The Senate was in session on 158 days, the House on 139 days.

During 1968, 8,746 bills and resolutions were introduced. Of these, 391 became public laws and 158 became private laws (private laws deal mostly with immigration matters or private claims affecting individual persons rather than the general public). The Senate in 1968 had 280 roll call votes, the House 233. Five bills were vetoed and there was no attempt to override the vetoes.

All measures still pending at the time of adjournment are dead. The 91st Congress will begin with a clean slate — new bills must be introduced (old ones can be put back in but they will have a new number). Committees must be reorganized and places found for new Members, etc...
