

Officials of the companies estimated their 7014 donors would contribute \$43,163. This figure was included in the \$5,307,556 total audited goal figure.

Little Business and Big Government

Nation's Business recently ran an article by Henry C. Link of the Psychological Corporation dealing with a survey made among "little business" to find out what this section of our industrial economy thinks of "big business."

One of the questions was: "Would you rather compete with a private company (large or small) or with a government corporation?" Ninety-two percent replied that they would rather compete with a private company, as against a mere four percent favoring a government owned business. The remaining four percent didn't know.

Another question asked: "Which, if any, of the following has produced the most difficult problems for your business: large companies, labor unions, government bureaus, other small companies?" When the answers were tabulated, it was found that 58 percent said the government bureaus had produced the toughest problems. Large companies and labor unions followed, with but 20 percent each.

It is clear from this that the smaller businesses of the country now realize that super-government is the worst menace they face — and that, though competition with other business may be difficult, to compete with government is virtually impossible. Government has every advantage, it is free from taxes, regulation and legislation that applies to other business. It makes laws to suit itself.


The people can control big business or little business. They can't control big government. It can hamstring and dominate all business, regardless of size.

Maintaining Macaroni Quality



Leading manufacturers go to great lengths and expense to insure a uniformly fine finished product, as well as to discover new and better methods of processing. Pictured here are scenes from the quality control laboratory of the Creamette Company, Minneapolis, said to be most complete and modern in the macaroni industry. Under the constant supervision of a graduate

chemist, raw materials are continually sampled and checked with operating departments to insure purity and uniformity as well as to determine new combinations for possible product improvements. Here also, the finished macaroni, spaghetti and noodles are constantly tested and checked against high standards of quality to assure consumers of a consistently fine product.
