Sukarno veže rdeče
s poskusom prevrača

Predsednik Indonezije je v razgovoru z japonskimi časnikarji končno le poveval komuniste z nedavnim poskusom prevrata.

SINGAPORE. — V sredo se dogodilo prvič, da je predsednik Sukarno javno priznal, da so bili s poskusom prevrata v Indoneziji 30. septembra povezani komunisti, domači in tudi. Doslej je vedno izjavljal, da je bil to notranji preprič v armadi in pozival javnost ter oborožene sile, naj "opuste maščevanje" nad uporniki. Oborožene sile in javnost se za te predsednikove pozive niso menile.

Oborožene sile so prijele vodnike vojaškega upora podpolk. Untunga, ki jim je razkril, kot trdijo vesti, vse podrobnosti o zadaju upora. Prav tako so ujeli večji del predsednikove straže, ki se je podpolk. Untungu pridružila v uporu. V srednji Javi, kjer so se upornikom tudi pridružile nekatere vojaške enote, je prišlo v prvih dneh do obsežnejših bojev, sedaj pa vlad stveto vojaštvo čisti še zadnje ostanke upornikov, v glavnem rdeče civiliste.

Armada je prepovedala Komunistično partijo v Džakarti, v severnem delu otoka Sumatre in še v nekaterih drugih vojaških okrožjih obširne dežele. Samo na področju glavnega mesta so prijeli okoli 1,500 rdečih. Med njimi ni glavnega tajnika Komunistične partije Aidita, ki se po nekaterih vesteh še vedno skriva na Javi, po drugih pa naj bi v kitajski podmornici pobegnil iz dežele.

Predsednik Sukarno je v razgovoru z japonskimi časnikarji, s prvimi tujimi časnikarji po poskusu prevrata, dejal, da z uporom niso bile povezane samo nekatere enote armade in letalstva, ampak tudi komunistična partija. Napovedal je, da bodo vsi strogo kaznovani, ko bodo "zbrana vsa dejstva".

Predsednik Johnson

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik L. B. Johnson je včeraj zapustil bolnišnico v Bethesda in se vrnil v Belo hišo, kjer bo ostal nekaj dni, nato pa bo odletel na svojo farmo v Tekses. Zdravniksi so mu naročili, da mora počivati od 4 do 6 tednov, karob bo pač okreval po operaciji.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Glavni demokratski odbor je sklical te dni vse predsednike državnih in okrajnih demokratskih organizacij na posvet, kako bo treba organizirati volivno kampanjo za prihodnje kongresne volitve, ki bodo l. 1966. Da je vsaj Johnson smatral sestanek za važen, se vidi po tem, da je kot predavatelje poslal nanj ne samo podpredsednika Humphreyja in večino članov svojega kabineta, ampak tudi celo vrsto svojih osebnih sodelavcev.

Ker ni bil sestanek namenjen za javnost, so časniki ostali brez novic. Pač pa so dobili na vpogled najnovejši demokratski politični priročnik za kandidate. Priročnik obravnava razne vrste propagando, posebno pa opozarja kandidate na nevarnosti, skušnjave in napake, ki se jih morajo izgibati, akoravno se jim na prvi pogled ne zdijo velike. Priročnike so seveda porazdelili med prisotne predsednike demokratskih organizacij "za notranjo rabo". Notranja raba seveda ne bo ostala tajna, vsaj za republikance ne.

V kraljevini Burundi so
se šli poskus revolucije

BUJUMBURA, Burundi. — Kraljevina Burundi spada med najmanjše države v Afriki. Manjši sta samo še Gambija in Rwanda. Burundski kralj Mwambutsa IV. nima srče s svojim režimom. V oktobru 1961 so mu ubili prestolonaslednika.

Vse sledi za morilci so kazale na kitajske komuniste, zato je kralj pretrgal diplomatske stike s Peipingom. Letošnjega januarja so mu ubili ministarskega predsednika Biho, sedaj bi bil pa kmalu sam zgubil prestol, doživel je namreč nov upor. Uprla se je dvorna straža, pomagala ji je dvorna policija.

Ob dveh zjutraj so uporniki smrtno ranili s streli ministarskega predsednika, kralj jim je pa komaj ušel in zbežal v 11 milj oddaljeno kongoško območje mesta Kiliba. Od tam se je lahko kmalu vrnil, kajti njemu zveste čete so pod vodstvom belgijskih oficirjev hitro ukrotile in pregnale upornike.

Upor je zadušen, toda miru ne bo. V deželi ima namreč vladovo v rokah pleme Tutsi, ki predstavlja manjšino prebivalstva, s čimer pleme Hutu, ki tvori večino, ni zadovoljno. Sedanja re-

PARIZ, Fr. — Francoski zunanjji minister Maurice Couve de Murville je v narodni skupščini obdolžil izvršno komisijo Skupnega trga, da je šla preko svoje avtoritete in s tem povzročila krizo v Skupnem trgu. Do te krize je prišlo pred štirimi meseci, ko se članice niso mogle zediniti o skupnih cenah za delzeline pridelke in je zato Francija začela delo Skupnega trga delno bojkotirati.

Izvršni odbor seveda zanika vsako krivo. Sklicuje se na Rimski sporazum, s katerim je bil Skupni trg ustanovljen in v katerem je bila predvidena tudi politična povezava držav članic. S prihodnjim letom naj bi pri odločitvah odločala večina in, takški sklepi naj bi bili obvezni za vse članice. To je trd spotike DeGaullovi Franciji in ta isče možnosti razveljavitev tega dogovora.

Ostale članice Skupnega trga, Nemčija, Italija, Belgija, Holandija in Luksemburg bi radi Francijo pridobile zopet za polno sodelovanje. V ta namen se bodo njihovi zastopniki zbrali prihodnji teden v Bruxellesu na posvet.

Zunanjji minister Murville je obdelal tudi vsa ostala mednarodna vprašanja, ki zadevajo Francijo, med njimi NATO in odnose Pariza z Bonnom. Priznal je, da francoski napor za povezavo Zahodne Evrope niso bili posebno uspešni. Obiski vodnikov Poljske, Sovjetske zveze in Romunije pa so odprli možnost k normalizaciji odnosov z državami vzhodne Evrope.

RDEČI OBLEGATO VLADNO
POSTOJANKO V VIETNAMU

V torek so močne rdeče enote obkolile in začele napadati vladno postojanko Plei Me v osrednjem višavju. Brani jo okoli 300 "Gorjancev" pod vodstvom kakega ducata Amerikancev. To je taborišče takozvanih "posebnih sil". Včeraj so poslali v taborišče vojaško okrepitev in strelivo. Kazalo je, da so rdeči napad opustili. Danes so udarili z novo silo.

SAIGON, J. Viet. — Rdeči v zadnjih tednih v svojih bojih proti vladnim četam niso bili posebno uspešni, še slabše so se odrezali v spopadih z ameriškimi četami, ki domače vladne oborožene sile podpirajo v njihovem boju proti rdečim "osvoboditeljem". Med tem ko je v južnem delu dežele monzumsko deževje prenhalo, se je v osrednjem višavju Južnega Vietnamu šele dobro začelo. To je torek ugoden čas za nastope rdečih gverilcev. Ti so v torek obkolili s kakimi 500 borci taborišče "posebnih sil" pri Plei Me v osrednjem višavju kakih 210 milj severovzhodno od tu. V taborišču je okoli 300 domačih borcev, takozvanih Gorjancev (Montagnards) in 10 do 12 Amerikancev. V dosedanjih bojih so imeli rdeči najmanj sto mrtvih in še več ranjenih. Najmanj 90 trupel padlih napadalcev so našeli v neposredni bližini taborišča. Napadalce so pomagala zavratiti letala. Včeraj so poslali z letali v taborišče oddelek vietnamskih "rangerjev" in strelivo. Rdeči so napad prekinili, pa ga danes začeli z novo silo. Poročila trdijo, da so zbrali rdeči v neposredni okolici tega taborišča močne sile in da ga hočejo, zavzeti za vsako ceno.

Zanimivo je to, da so rdeči napad na Plei Me začeli v torek napadajo podnevi, ko običajno vedno napadejo ponoči, ko se čutijo bolj varne pred letalskimi napadi. Tekom bojev so rdeči sestrelili ameriški helikopter v sredu, nato pa še enega včeraj. Posadki oben sta bili mrtvi. S helikopterji so pripeljali včeraj več vietnamskih čet z opremo in strelivom. Koliko moštva je sedaj dejansko v taborišču poročila ne povedo, trdijo pa, da so rdeči zbrali v okoli močne enote in da so nemara odločeni to taborišče uničiti za vsako ceno.

Dalje proti severu so rdeči napadli vladni bataljon pri Quang Tri nedaleč od meje Severnega Vietnamu. Tudi tamniso dosegli nobenega uspeha. Težki bombniki B-52 z otoka Guama so bombardirali odee področje v Binh Ding pokrajini, ameriška letala z letalonosilk pa so bombardirala več vojaških ciljev v Severnem Vietnamu.

★ Salt Lake City, Utah — The lives of many people depend on the skillful hand of a middleaged Salt Lake City woman, Mary Eleanor McKay. Miss McKay operates the only federally certified parachute loft in Utah, and is the only master parachute rigger in the state. She learned parachute packing at Hill air base during World War II. Since then she has rigged chutes for state flying schools, the Civil Air patrol, sky divers, and, most recently, for drag racers who have installed parachutes on their vehicles to assist braking.

★ Chattanooga, Tenn. — Doctors told Terry Crawley seven years ago that he never again would participate regularly in sports. The boy, then 9 years old, had just recovered from an infection which nearly cost him his life, gave him a heart murmur, and left him deaf in one ear. Now he ranks as one of the city's top young baseball

and football players. His mother says he got the infection almost overnight. He had a temperature of 106. Doctors at the University of Michigan confirmed that he had a rare green strep infection, which is one of the deadliest infections the human body can take. The heart murmur left, as doctors said it would if Terry took care of himself. But he never regained the hearing in his ear. He occasionally is totally deaf when he comes down with a cold. His father bought a set of weights and Terry gradually conditioned himself to stand up under athletic competition.

★ New York, N.Y. — A program to conserve water, and some long overdue rain, have combined to start refilling New York's reservoirs. Heavy rains over the past three weeks have poured 22 billion gallons of water in them. The Water Commissioner said it was cause for "encouragement." But we will still have to continue our intensive conservation program.

Many more billions of gallons of water are needed to fill the reservoirs, now at 37.7% of capacity.

★ Portland, Maine — The Roman Catholic practice of lighting vigil candles in churches has been ordered discontinued in the Maine diocese. Bishop Daniel J. Feeney said it is too hazardous. Over the last decade, he said, fires attributed to the candles have caused \$119,000 loss to church property.

★ Dallas, Texas — Some homeowners near Love Field at Dallas have notified major airlines they will charge rent for use of the airspace over their homes by low-altitude flights. James Donovan, their attorney, told the airlines the fee would be \$50 per flight to each property owner whose land is overflown at an altitude of less than 1,000 feet. As precedent, he cited a 1962 Supreme Court ruling in Griggs vs. Allegheny County, Pa., which said that in certain instances, persons are entitled to receive payment for trespassing over their air rights.

★ Chattanooga, Tenn. — Mary (Gramma) Walker has learned to read at the age of 99 because, she said, she "wanted to learn more about God." The woman first went to school a year ago when she joined a class conducted by the Chattanooga Area Literacy movement. She now reads fluently from the Bible. She also has learned to write and copies passages from the Bible.

★ Port Arthur, Tex. — The city fathers were all set to dedicate a new \$14,000 traffic light. They hoped the light, which is controlled by the volume of traffic, would change a dangerous intersection into a safe one. The light was turned on — and an ambulance and a car crashed together right

under it. After a 30-minute wait to clear away the wreckage, dedication ceremonies proceeded.

There have been five Series homers by National League pitchers. They were by Rosy Ryan and John Bentley, both of the Giants, in 1924; Jess Haines, St. Louis, 1926; Buckley Walters, Cincinnati, 1940, and Lou Burdette, Milwaukee 1958.

ADDING TO UNEMPLOYMENT

A bill now proposed in Congress would bring some seven million additional workers — a substantial part of them farm workers — under the federal minimum wage law. But the irony is that, if it becomes law, it will do serious harm to the very groups it is supposed to help.

As the Portland Oregonian succinctly puts it, the bill "... would add to unemployment by limiting job opportunities for the young, the unskilled and minorities." And the reason it would do that is that it would force the payment of an arbitrary wage without taking into consideration the productive abilities of the workers involved.

When that happens, two unfortunate results are certain to follow. First, prices go up — and the low-income groups are hit the hardest. Second, employers reduce the employment of marginal workers to the greatest extent possible. And that means that these workers are denied the opportunity to gain the experience and learn the skills that would qualify them for better paying jobs.

Many enterprises — retailing and agriculture and its related businesses among them — can provide a place and a training ground for the unskilled. But they can do that to the desirable degree only if the wages paid bear a fair relationship to the workers' productive value. The currently proposed bill would give a new shove to inflation — and at the same time swell the rolls of the unemployed.

Quick Tricks For Halloween Treats



TRICK OR TREAT — Here's a new way to go about it — with costume a la sandwich-board sign. Which clown has the cuter face?

New York, N.Y. (ED) — When it's time to transform youngsters into little "ghosts" and "goblins" for October 31st merry-making, turn costume-making into fun and games for everyone. With a little imagination, a pillowcase for each child, scissors, bits of felt and other fabric scraps, you can outfit a most sartorial spook for trick or treating and Halloween parties.

The custom of "dressing up" wasn't always fun and games. Ancient Druids put on terrifying costumes to fool the demons and witches they feared. The belief was that if you dressed in a horrible enough fashion and went trooping around with the spirits all night, they would think you were one of them and do you no harm.

Nowadays, costumes are strictly for play — and much easier to make. With a pillowcase as the basic element, there's nothing to sew. Just snip out armholes and neckline, adjust shoulder sizes with cafe-curtain rings, and decorate as you wish.



A WINNING WITCH — You'd smile too, if you were a witch and looked as cute as this. Costume is made with pillowcase, felt and fabric scraps and a skein of black wool.

If you have them, use pinking shears to cut a 12-inch slit in the center top of the pillowcase for the neck. Next measure five inches down each side of the pillowcase and mark. With pinking shears, cut eight-inch openings from each mark for the armholes.

Then make a big witch's face on the front of the pillowcase. Patterns for the face are available from makers of Lady Pepperell sheets and pillowcases. Pin the pattern pieces on felt, cut and paste on the pillowcase. Outline all the felt pieces with black dri-mark, then outline the shape of the face. Be sure to insert paper in the pillowcase to prevent the ink from coming through.

Naturally you'll want to frame the face with a witchlike hairdo.

Cut a skein of black wool into 30-inch lengths. Arrange evenly across the top of the pillowcase and stitch across, catching each strand of wool. Then give it a real witch's trim with bangs and all.

Slip the spooky creation on your youngster and pull the corners at each shoulder through cafe-curtain rings to adjust the fit... for a cute effect. The perfect accessories? A pair of black leotards, a pumpkin in one hand, a broom in the other, top it off with a pointed hat, and what a witch!

For a new twist to trick-or-treat costumes, make a sandwich-board sign that says "trick or treat" and pictures a funny clown face on the front. Thumbtack pillowcases to two large pieces of cardboard. Then make the clown face by cutting pieces of felt from patterns in the Pepperell kit. Give him a funny hat, big popping eyes, rouge patches, a little round nose, a big smiling mouth and a fat cigar. After you paste the pieces on, outline the cigar, mouth and nose with the dri-marker.

Paste the words "Trick or Treat" below the clown's face, string the boards together, tie on some balloons and send a happy hobgoblin off to ring doorbells.

For Halloween partying, make an adorable little bunny out of your party-goer, complete with whiskers and bunny ears. For this costume, use a colorful pillowcase like Lady Pepperell's Sweet Heart pattern (red hearts on white). With pinking shears, cut a 12-inch slit in the center top of the pillowcase for the neck, the same as for the witch's costume.

Then measure nine inches down each side of the pillowcase and mark. Cut eight-inch openings down from each mark for armholes. Paste on felt pieces from

ADJOURNMENT NEAR? There is a growing consensus within the Congress that it is time to take a breath and reflect on some of the far-ranging decisions made during the last nine months. This session already has established a new record for quorum calls and roll call votes. It has produced many new programs which will have an effect on the lives of every one of us. There are many who feel it has been longer on quantity than on quality.

To review some of the actions taken, here is a list of the major legislative enactments: Excise taxes have been reduced or eliminated in the amount of nearly \$5 billion. Federal spending for the so-called war on poverty has been doubled, and a huge separate Appalachian Development Act was passed. In the field of education, federal programs have been renewed and expanded to assist higher education, elementary and secondary education, and vocational education. A \$7 billion housing and urban development act, including a new rent supplement program, was approved. A new Cabinet-level Department of Housing and Urban Affairs also became a reality.

There was an increase in social security benefits as well as a new program of medical care for the elderly requiring considerable increases in social security taxes. Military pay has been increased. A voting rights bill became law and a major revision of our immi-

For Air Mail parcels the period is December 1st to 10th. Greeting cards for the Armed Forces overseas should be mailed within the period designated for parcels if they are to have a reasonable expectation of delivery delivery prior to Christmas.

All articles should be packed in boxes of wood, metal, solid fiberboard or strong double faced corrugated fiberboard.

Each box should be well tied with strong cord. Sufficient cushioning material should be used to prevent any rattling or loosening of articles within the packages.
