LEWIS PODPIRA REPUBLIKANCA

Washington, D. C., 25. okt. — John L. Lewis, predsednik delavske organizacije CIO je nocoj apeliral na vse organizirano delavstvo in na vse druge sloje po Zed. državah, da izvolijo "galantnega Amerikanca" za predsednika, Wendell L. Willkie-a.

Ta delavski vodja, ki je leta 1936 vodil 4,000,000 organiziranih delavcev k Rooseveltu, je imenoval predsednika "mednarodnega meštarja," katerega izvolitev bi pomenila diktaturo v svobodni Ameriki.

Svojo bodočo usodo je združil z ono kandidata Willkie-a ter se izjavil, da se bo odpovedal kot predsednik CIO, če bo Roosevelt izvoljen. Rekel je tudi, da Roosevelt ne bo mogel biti izvoljen brez zadostne podpore delavskih mož in žena in da bo ponovna izvolitev Roosevelta pomnila, da CIO ni poslušala njegovega priporočila ter bo to smatral, da mu (Lewisu) delavstvo ne zupa več.

Lewis je govoril po radiu, kateri govor je oddajalo 362 postaj. Stroški za govor so bili \$45,000. Sodijo, da je govor poslušalo 30,000,000 oseb.

Akron, O., 25. okt. — Unija United Rubber Workers of America, ena najmočnejših podružnic CIO, bo šla 100% za Roosevelta. Tako se je danes izjavil predsednik unije, Sherman Dalrymple.

V jutranjih urah, ko so hiteli ljudje za svojim in dnevni opriki, so začele iz oblakov padati bombe, ki so razbijale vozove ulične železnice, buse in morebitne ljudi na levo in desno po načrtnih ulicah in trgih.

15 letnica Ilirije

Cerkveni pevski zbor Ilirija, edini pevski zbor te vrste v pari Marije Vnebovzetje, obhaja te dni 15 letnico obstoja, kar bo zbor proslavlil s pevskim koncertom. Ta koncert se bo vršil jutri večer v Slovenskem domu na Holmes Ave.

Petnajst let petja cerkvene in narodne pesmi je že do kaj lepa doba, da se lahko pri tem nekoliko pomudimo in pregledamo delo zobra zadnjih petnajst let. In če ima kdo vse važne podatke o tem na razpolago, jih ima gotovo pevovodja, zato smo se obrnili do prijaznega in uslužnega pevca, organista in pevovodja Ilirije, g. Martina Rakarja, ki je tako ponosen na ta svoj zbor in povedal nam je mnogo o teh svojih "fantih in dekletih," kako so delali, peli in vprizarjali igre ter sploh veliko storili za korist collinwoodskih slovenskih fare.

Prva večja prireditev Ilirije je bila spevoigra "Darinka," katero je zbor podal leta 1931. V istem letu je zbor podal tudi prvi cerkveni koncert, ki je bil lep uspeh. V zboru je bilo takrat 36 pevcev in pevk.

Leta 1932 je Ilirija sodelovala pri programu društva sv. Jožefa št. 169 KSKJ, sodelovala pri koncertu v Newburgu in v Lorainu, obenem pa je zbor i sam priredil koncert ter igro "Pri belem konjičku."

Leta 1933 je zbor sodeloval pri igri "Rodoljub iz Amerike," par tednov pozneje je zbor priredil svoj koncert ter imel v svoji sredi kot goste tudi pevce iz Loraina.

Na 23. maja istega leta je zbor podal igro "Rodoljub iz Amerike" v počast delegaciji Slovenske ženske zveze. V novembra istega leta je zopet podal zbor opereto "Silvia," zelo lepo delo, katero je prestavil iz angleščine Rev. Milan Slaje. Kot posebnost se mora takrat začnamovati izredno veliko udeležbo.

Na 25. februarja 1934 je zbor podal cerkveni koncert, ki je bil nekaj posebnega namreč, mašni strežniki so peli pred oltarjem, a zbor na koru, kar je bilo res nekaj impozantnega.

Dne 18. marca je priredil zbor koncert v Barbertonu. Pevci in pevke še danes niso pozabili slovenske gostoljubnosti barbertonskih rojakov.

Nepozabna slovesnost pa je bila istega leta na 3. junija, ko so bile blagoslovljene cerkvene orgle, katere je zbor Ilirija kupil popolnoma iz svoje blagajne.

"Malo tega, malo onega" je bil naslov koncertu, ki ga je Ilirija podala 4. novembra. Udeležba je bila zelo lepa in občinstvo je bilo zelo zadovoljno. Isto je zbor ponovil potem v decembri tudi v Lorainu. Na 25. novembra pa je zbor sodeloval pri Jugoslovenskem dnevu.

Na 6. januarja 1935 je zbor ponovil "Malo tega, malo onega," v Slovenskem delavskem domu na Waterloo Rd., na 31. marca je zopet podal "Rodoljuba iz Amerike" in na 20. oktobra je zbor proslavljal svojo desetletnico v Slovenskem domu na Holmes Ave.

Na 23. februarja in 22. marca je Ilirija podala ljudsko igro "Revček Andrejček." Prebitek od obih predstav je šel za prenovitev cerkvene dvorane.

Zbor je sodeloval na 9. avgusta pri Slovenskem dnevu, na 30. avgusta pri Baragovem dnevu, na 10. septembra pri programu v počast delegaciji JSKJ. Na 15. novembra je zbor podal dve opereti: Srce in denar ter Povodnji mož. Na 26. novembra je pa Ilirija sodelovala pri proslavi Gregorčiča in Cankarja v Jugoslovenskem kulturnem vrtu.

Na 7. februarja 1937 je imel zbor domačo zabavo s plesom, na 26. septembra je pel pri romanju v Providence Heights, na 6. oktobra je sodeloval pri razstavi v Slovenskem domu na Holmes Ave., na 10. oktobra je podal cerkveni koncert v novo pobravani cerkvi, kjer je bil slavnostni govornik misijonar Vital Vodušek. Na 7. novembra je Ilirija sodelovala pri odkritju uspominskih plošč Rev. Viranta in Rev. Kužnika, na 21. novembra pa je podal koncert v Slovenskem domu na Holmes Ave.

Na 23. januarja je moški zbor Ilirije sodeloval pri prireditvi godbe društva sv. Jožefa. Na 27. februarja je Ilirija podala mično igro "Micki je treba moža," katero je na zahtevo občinstva ponovila 21. aprila v Newburgu. Na 26. junija je bila prireditev v korist članov zobra za potovanje v Joliet, Ill., in na 3. in 4. julija je zbor napravil izlet v Joliet in v Lemont. To je bilo ob prilikl slavnosti polaganja vogelnega kamna novega lastnega doma KSKJ. Na 25. septembra je zbor pel ob prilikl romanja Slovencev v Providence Heights, na 30. oktobra je Ilirija pa sodelovala pri proslavi 25 letnice Slovenske zadružne zveze. Na 4. decembra je zbor podal cerkveni koncert, slavnostni govornik je bil lorrainežki župnik Rev. Milan Slaje.

V januarju 1939 je moški zbor Ilirije sodeloval pri prireditvi godbe društva sv. Jožefa št. 169 KSKJ, v februarju je podal zbor opereto "Čevljari in vrag," 12. avgusta je pel na prireditvi v počast Rev. Joška Ovna, ki je bil na obisku iz stare domvine, na 20. avgusta je sodeloval pri prireditvi Slovenske zveze društva Najs. Imena, na 24. septembra sodeloval na proslavi 20 letnice Slovenskega doma na Holmes Ave., na 17. decembra je pa podal oratorij "Slovenski božič," ki je bil prvič podan v Ameriki. Isto je zbor ponovil 24. decembra v Newburgu.

Na 7. januarja je pa zbor podal cerkveni koncert, pri katerem je pel same božične pesmi, kar je občinstvu nenačadno dobro ugajalo.

To je kratek pregled tega žilavega zobra zadnjih deset let. Kot nam je povedal g. Rakar, nima zbor zapisnika o delovanju prvih petih let, zato se tudi ne more podati popolne slike delovanja tega zobra za vseh 15. let.

Ljudje nimamo pojma, koliko en tak zbor dela in žrtvuje v teku let, dokler ne nanizamo vsega skupaj. Potem si šele lahko predstavljamo vso agilnost in delo, ki ga napravi zbor v teku let in tedaj se čudimo in tudi hvalimo, ker delo res ni majhno. Če se računa, da žrtvuje pevec takega cerkvenega zobra za svojo faro okrog 6 ur na teden, to je za vse in potem za petje v cerkvi, znese to v 15. letih 4,680 ur. Neukognomega, ali ne?

Zato je pa prav in pošteno, da pokažemo priznanje in zahvalo Iliriji za njeno 15 letno delo za slovensko faro Marije Vnebovzetje. Predvsem pa je na mestu javno priznanje neumornemu pevovodji, našemu vrlemu rodoljubu, g. Martinu Rakarju. Nihče ne ve, koliko skrbim ima pevovodja zobra, koliko dela in načrtov za bodoče delovanje, za nove pesmi, za programe in za vse, da ostane zbor živahno na delu, pa da vedno kaj novega poda. Vsa fara mora biti hvaležna g. Rakarju in njegovemu zboru za vse, kar so storili za cerkev in faro, odnosno za kulturo slovenskega naroda.

BESEDA IZ NARODA

Ob 15 letnici "Ilirije"

V podstavku zvonika cerkve Marije Vnebovzetje v Collinwoodu je vzdana plošča z letnico 1906, kar znači, da so si Collinwoodčani postavili svojo cerkev že pred 34 leti. Nepoznani opazovalci razmer bi sodili, da v tej cerkvi ni bilo petja celih 19 let, ker cerkveni pevski zbor še sedaj praznuje svojo 15-letnico. Tedanji organist je moral imeti omenjeni in zelo slab okus, ker je določil, da bomo prihodnjo nedeljo peli nam povsem neznano Marijino pesem, ki jo je bil iztaknil v Holmarnjevi pesmarici Slava Bogu. Marijine pesmi so vse lepe, da so pa nekateri bolj melodijoči ne od drugih, je pa tudi resna.

Nam pevcom dotedna pesem ni ugajala. Svetovali smo organistu, da naj izbere kaj lepšega. Organist: "Ta pesem je lepa in v nedeljo jo bomo peli za god naše farne patron." Mi pevci pa smo rekel: "Mi hočemo lepo pesem, ali pa se moramo te boljše naučiti. Pesem prav peti se ne more naučiti samo z eno pevsko vajo." Organist je postal pri svoji trditvi, a mi pevci pri svoji.

Naslednjo nedeljo, takoj po darovanju, pri 10. maši je organist razdelil pesmarice ter nam povedal, da bomo peli tisto pesem, ki jo je on določil. Dekleta so brez godnjanja pričele peti in tudi srečno prišle skozi, mi moški pa smo položili knjige na harmonij in se vseledi v klopi. Nekateri trdijo, da so sedeči štrajki dobili začetek v delavski organizaciji CIO, drugi zopet trdijo, da so francoskega izvora. Jaz pa še vedno trdim, da so prvi sedeči štrajki v prizorišči cerkveni pevci v Collinwoodu leta 1925.

Po maši pa smo se z organizmom pred cerkvijo precej glasno pogovorili in nagovarjali dekleta, da naj se še one pridružijo nam upornikom. Dekleta pa so nam odgovorile: "Me pojemo v čast božjo in se ne oziramo na vaše kaprice in ne na trmglavost organista. Doživeli smo prvo pogoreto pri naših sopevkah."

Kdor je pevec, pa ne poje, je ali bolan, ali pa čemer. Petje in čmernost si nasprotujeta kot ogenj in voda. Nam, takratnim, cerkvenim pevcom ni bilo treba biti čemer radi tega, ko smo

pevci poigravali s pevovodjem kakor veter z listjem, ampak včasih bi se moralno upoštevati tudi težnje pevcev. Da je pa že tudi, kateri izmed pevovodov kratko potegnil, mi je pa prav dobro in živo v spominu to, kar sem sedaj opisal.

Zanimiva anekdota. Pri generalni vaji neke opere, v priozoru, ki je predstavljal zimsko kočo z ognjiščem, je prišel pevec na oder ter z mogočnim glasom pričel peti, a je takoj utihnil rekoč: "Pod temi okoliščinami ne morem peti, ognjišče bi moralno biti na vsak način bolj na strani, ker preveč kadi." Režiser pa se je temu odločno uprl. Pevec pa mirno reče: "Torej naj ognjišče pojde, jaz bom pa kadi!"

Ta anekdota nam priča, da so poklicnimi pevci prav take težkoče kakor z nami, ki komaj razumemo kaj je petje.

Zato pa le pojte še v bodoče Bogu v čast, sebi in ljudem v veselje."

Farani to velja vsem štirim faram v Clevelandu. Dajte svojim cerkvenim pevcem priznanje. Posetejte njih prireditve, kadar vas vabi; zelo malo prosijo pevci od vas, a če storite to malo, bodo pevci zadovoljni, ker se boste izkazali, da ceneite njih trud.


