Njegovo vstajenje

Gledano s posvetnimi očmi je Njegovo vstajenje nekaj pošastno skrivnostnega. Samo par besed govori o tem: "Ni ga več, vstal je!" in dodano je še naročilo, kdo vse naj to zve. In vendar je to čudež nad čudeži.

Naš Zveličar ni skrival svojih čudežev. Saj je napravil prvega kar v veseli svatovski družbi, spremenil je vodo v vino, čeprav svatje niso ravno umirali od žeje. Od takrat pa do večerje v Emavsu je potekala Njegova poč po ulicah, hišah, v templju, na jezerskih obalah in povsod so čudeži oznanjali Njegovo vsemogočnost. Na Veliko noč je pa vstal sam z lastno močjo brez vseh prič, še priroda je Njegovo vstajenje kar skromno zabeležila z malim potresom. Kako vse drugače je to bilo na Kalvariji v trenutku Njegove smrti!

Njegovo vstajenje je pa zavito v skrivnost, ki jo je na zunaj dokazoval samo prazen grob.

Dokazoval ga je celo tistim, ki bi morali verovati v Njegovo besedo. Saj je celo Simon šel nazaj h grobu in pogledal vanj ter ugotovil le praznoto in oboje kot edini spomin na mrtvo Zveličarjevo telo. Podoben nevernik je bil Tomaž, pa ne sam, o vstajenju so dvomili tudi nekateri njegovci učenci, kot pravijo evangeliji. Kaj jih je tako zbezgal, da so zgubili vero v dano besedo? Prazen grob seveda ni prepričal tudi pismarjev in farizejev, čeprav so dobili o vstajenju poročilo iz prve roke iz ust stražnikov Božjega groba.

Skrivnost vstajenja je rodila zbegano med Njegovimi učenci in verniki. Človek bi misil, da bo vstali Zveličar pojasnil, kar se je godilo na Veliko noč, in opisal potek. Pa se ni zgodilo ničesar od tega. Do Svojega vnebovhoda ni obešal vstajenja na veliki zvon, čeprav je bilo jasno, da bodo judovski voditelji to novico zmališili, da sejejo nezaupanje v Njegove napovedi. Kako bi bila vsaka javna Njegova izjava odmevala med judovskim ljudstvom! Pa vendar je govoril o vstajenju samo Svojim in samo takrat, kadar je videl dvom v njihovih srečih. Zakaj vse to? Čemu vse to?

Tako je pustil za seboj samo en viden dokaz: prazen grob. In vendar je tudi ta dokaz šel hitro v pozabno. Nikjer več ni zanesljivo omenjeno, kakšna je bila usoda praznega groba. Ali je Njegovo vstajenje tako zasezenčilo vse spomine na grob, da nihče ni več pomislil na kraj, kjer je bilo izmučeno mrtvo telo položeno k zadnjemu, pa ne večnemu počitku?

Saj je bil prazen grob obenem tudi dokaz za Njegovo zmago nad smrtno. Zmago, ki je pred njim ni nihče mogel praznovati in je po njem tudi nihče ne bo mogel. Koliko bilijonov trupel je že našlo v grobovih svoj počitek, pa niti eno ni vstalo z lastno močjo. Sicer pa, kaj je smrt? Ali naj bo samo konec telesnega življenja ali naj bo to tudi začetek novega? Kdo ve? Samo vera more dači odgovor, ki človeka zadovoljil.

Ta pošastna skrivnost z vsemi svojimi odtenki preuzeže človeka, ko stoji na Veliko noč sam ob praznem grobu. Ljudje smo res otroci Božji, vsaj na velikonočno jutro. Komaj spremimo vstalega Zveličarja od groba v Njegovo slavo, se začnemo veseliti Njegove zmage nad smrtno. Grob pa ostane sam in tišina zavlada okoli njega, kakor hitro potihne velikonočno petje.

Pošastna skrivnost Njegovega vstajenja pa še ni konča na velikonočno jutro. Spremlja nas vse leto, celo življenje. Občutimo jo pa najbolj ob praznem, tihem grobu ravno na dan Njegovega vstajenja. Občutka skrivnosti ne more zatreći tudi vsa posvetna šara, ki jo je verska tradicija tekmo stoljetij nagrmadiła okoli groba. Je le priča, kako dobro se počutimo kot otroci Božji, ne vede in ne hote, kot se za otroke spodbidi.

In vendar je od praznega groba do našega življenja samo korak. Bližina praznega groba bi nas moralatakoj napeljati na misel, da je tudi naše življenje podobno grobu. Dokler je Bog v njem, je grob poln, kot je bil od trenutka Njegovega pokopa pa do trenutka Njegovega vstajenja. Kot okoli Božjega groba, se tudi okoli našega življenja nabere vse polno posvetne navlake, ki se je veselimo kot otroci igrač.

Misel ob praznem grobu gre pa še naprej. Ves svet mu je podoben, ako ni Boga v njem. Prazna je družina, prazna je soseska, prazna je domovina, prazna je prsteklost, prazna je prihodnjost. Kdo pa se na vse to še spomni, ko stoji ob praznem grobu? Zakaj?

Vsa ta strašna skrivnost obdaja prazen Božji grob. In ne moremo prodreti vanjo, akoravno je znana človeškemu rodu že skoraj par tisočletij. Nad 60 rodom je že šlo mimo nje in odkrila se ni niti enemu med njimi. In se tudi ne bo. In vendar se nihče radi tega ne vznemirja. Zakaj?

Ta strašna skrivnost tlači k tlom, kdor ne veruje v Njegovo vstajenje, ga potaplja v obup, ga zasipa s temo, ga goni iz krize v krizo.

Kdor pa veruje v Njegovo vstajenje, ve, da tudi njega čaka grob, kajti vsa poto na zemlji vodijo tja. Ve pa, da ne bo tam za večno, da tudi zanj pride ura vstajenja, ker je otrok Božji.

Ko pa pride tisti dan, bomo stopili pred sodni stol. Takrat pa, o Gospod, bodi nam milostljiv, prizanesi nam, kajti premalo smo Ti služili, preveč smo pa grešili.

Kardinal Šeper bo
blagoslovil cerkev v
St. Augustinu v Floridi

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. — Tu bo na belo nedeljo, 17. aprila, ob treh popoldne kardinal Šeper, zagrebški nadškof in naslednik kardinala Stepinca, blagoslovil cerkev za "Pravi mir", ki so se jo zaobljubili postaviti duhovniki in verniki škofije St. Augustine leta 1954. Nova cerkev bo stala na prostorih Mission of Nombre de Dios, kjer je na to nedeljo vsako leto znani romarski shod.

Kardinal Šeper je bil rojen 1905 v Osijeku na Hrvaškem kot sin krojaškega pomočnika in šivilje. Po študijah v domovini je dopolnil svojo duhovniško izobrazbo na Gregorijanski univerzi v Rimu. V letih 1934 do 1941 je bil tajnik pokojnemu kardinalu Stepincu, leta 1954 pa je postal zagrebški pomočni nadškof. Po Stepinčevi smrti 10. februarja 1960 je bil imenovan za zagrebškega nadškofa, kasneje pa tudi za kardinala.

Dosegla ga je roka pravice

Horst Fischer, 53-letni zdravnik v zloglasnem taborišču Auschwitu na Poljskem je po dvajsetih letih končno padel v roke pravice. Ni se sicer skrival, ker bi se lahko zatekel v zahodni Berlin, in je, kakor je povedal njegov branilec, vedno čakal, da ga bodo končno prijeli. Sodišče v vzhodnem Berlinu je Fischerja spoznalo za krivega smrti 75.000 Judov v plinskih celicah in ga je obsodilo na smrt pod giljotino. Žalostno dejstvo je zopetna pojava giljotine v dvajsetem stoletju, a še bolj žalostna je ugotovitev, da so še na svetu počasti, ki tako smrt zasluzijo. Seveda se je Fischer kakor vsi njegovi dosedanji tovariši v krvnem skliceval na to, da je izvrševal večja povelja.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Federalno tajni

Kongres je odobril Indiji pomoč v hrani

Kongres je odobril predsednikov načrt o pomoči Indiji, ker je občutno pomanjkanje hrane. Amerika ji bo poslala hrane v skupni vrednosti 500 milijonov dolarjev.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predstavniški dom je izglasoval predsednikov predlog pomoči Indiji že v ponedeljek, v sredo je storil to tudi Senat. Protipredlogu, čeprav naklada Združenim državam 500 milijonov dolarjev izdatkov, ni bilo nobenega pravega odpora. Za Indijo je kazal Kongres že v vseh zadnjih letih izredno veliko razumevanja in naklonjenosti. Obisk predsednice vlade Indire Gandhi pretekli mesec je dobro voljo za Indijo še povečal.

Združene države bodo v okviru novega zakona poslane Indiji 3,5 milijona ton pšenice, pa tudi večje količine koruze, olja, mleka v prahu, bombaža in tobaka. Tobak naj bi Indija prodala v tujino in z izkupičkom kupila umetna gnojila.

Predsednik je pozval, ko je predložil Kongresu svoj načrt pomoči, tudi vse ostale države, ki imajo viške dejelnih pridelkov, da priskočijo Indiji na pomoč. V Indiji so imeli pretekelo leto hudo sušo in pridelek žita je bil za okoli 10 milijonov ton manjši kot običajno. Ker je bila dežela že vedno v težavah s prehrano preko 500 milijonov svojih prebivalcev, je postala stiska letos izredna. Pomoč za v "Indiji gladuječe" zbirajo po vsem svobodnem svetu. Prav to zbiranje je spravilo odgovorne v Indiji do tega, da so se zganili v položaj podrobno preučili.

V New Delhiju je bilo nato objavljeno, da je stiska prehrane res huda, da pa ni nobene nevarnosti, da bi ljudje naravnost od lakote umirali. Občutno je zlasti pomanjkanje riže, ki je v nekaterih delih Indije običajno vsakdanja hrana. Ko so ljudem, ki so vajeni, ponudili moko, je prišlo do izgredov in demonstracij, ki so jih komunisti znali posebno v državi Kerali in v Bengali dobro izkoristiti.

O ugrabljenemu fanu v Floridi še ni sledu

MIAMI, Fla. — Aaron Goldman, 47 let stari bogati lastnik gradbenega podjetja, čaka zastonj že od 28. marca na kako vest o svojem 18 let staremu sinu Danielu. Tega je na omenjeni dan ponovno odpeljal s seboj neki neznani čokati moški z močnimi obrvimi, ko ni dobil na domu, v katerega je vlomlil, zahtevane vsote denarja.

Očet je ugrabitelj pred odhodom dejal, naj pripravi \$25,000, če hoče videti in dobiti domov svojega sina nepoškodovanega. Oče je pripravil denar, pa od ugrabitelja ni dobil še nobenega sporočila. Začel se je resno batiti za njegovo življenje, zato je pripravil oblasti do tega, da bodo stale čisto ob strani in s tem dale ugrabitelju pogum, da se bo oglašil zaradi odkupnine in vrnih sina. Včeraj so to razglasili vseporos, da bi prišlo tudi do ušes ugrabitelja.

Libanonska vladna kriza se je proti pričakovanju zavlekla

BEIRUT, Lib. — Kot smo poročali, je libanonski ministrski predsednik Karami dal ostavko, ker parlament ni bil zadovoljen z njegovo uradniško vlogo. Zahvalil je, naj vanjo pridejo člani kongresa. Vsi so mislili, da bo Karamu zopet sestavil novo vladu iz parlamentarcev. Pa se je oglašil proti njemu njegov tekmelec Saeb Saalam in zahteval od predsednika Helouja, naj njemu zaupa mandat.

Helou se je izvlekel iz zadre-

ge s tem, da je sestavo vlade povrnil advokatu dr. Yaffiju. Dr. Yaffi je znan pristaš zmerne politike, dočim je Karamu na glasovanju kot levicar, Saeb Saalam pa kot desnicar.

Da vlada v Beirutu za sedanjeno vladno krizo toliko zanimanja, velja poseben razlog. Prejšnja vlada je na pritisk parlamenta poslala v pokoj vse polno starih uradnikov. Na njihova mesta je treba postaviti nove in člani parlamenta bi seveda radi spravili na prazna mesta svoje velenje.

Ameriški bombniki napadajo okolico Hanoia

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik Johnson kontrolira osebno, ali naše vojno letalstvo res izvršuje njegova naročila, zato je vsaka spremembva v taktiki bombardiranja v Sev. Vietnamu odvisna od njegovega prisanka. Zadnje čase niso naši bombniki napadali vojaških objektov blizu Hanoia. Sedaj so pa napade obnovili.

V enem dnevu so napadli znano železniško progo Kunming-Hanoi-Nanming, ki veže Vietnam s Kitajsko, kar na dveh mestih. Pri tem so bombe uničile važen železniški most.

V Saigonu mislijo, da so sedanja bombardiranja odgovor na terorističen akt v Saigonu, kjer je par sto funtov močnega streliva porušilo sredi Saigona hišo, ki so v njej stanovali ameriški vojaki. Pri napadu je bilo ubitih nekaj naših vojakov in nekaj domaćinov.

Brazilski maršal Branco praznoval obletnico svojega režima

RIO DE JANEIRO, Braz. — Te dni je brazilski diktator maršal Branco praznoval drugo obletnico svojega režima. Prijatelji so mu pripredili nekaj slovesnosti, toda maršal je gledal, da niso postale spotika političnim krogom.

Zato ni dal tudi nobene politične izjave. Pač pa je podčrtal, koliko tujega kapitala je bilo zadnji dve leti investiranega v brazilsko gospodarstvo. Branco ni tudi spremenil svojega stališča, da misli ostati na oblasti samo še do prihodnjega marca. Do takrat mora Kongres izbrati naslednika na podlagi dekretov, ki jih je Branco že objavil.

Create A Family Of Eggheads For Easter Fun



NEW LOOK IN EASTER EGGS—Add new dimension to your Easter egg decorations by creating a family of egghead bunnies. Q-tips or cotton swabs make easy-to-use paint brushes; double for arms and legs. Cut ears from construction paper; glue on paper or cotton fabric for bunny clothes. Dip swabs in vegetable dye or water colors to paint on cute bunny faces.

A family of eggheads will add new dimension to your Easter eggs this year. All it takes is a little imagination and a few inexpensive supplies, reports the National Cotton Council.

For a starter, join your young-

sters in creating a family of Easter bunnies. Use large hard-boiled eggs for the parents, small eggs for their offspring.

Q-tips or cotton swabs make easy-to-use brushes for painting on faces. You'll have a fresh brush for each color, and you'll also find them handy for making bunny arms and legs.

A few drops of vegetable dye in a quarter cup of water gives a good, deep color. Color goes on better if you scrub the eggs with a little scouring powder and rinse well before painting.

Since it's easier to paint faces on

eggs when they're standing up, attach the feet first. Snap a cotton swab in half, and glue the halves to wide end of egg for paws. Use white liquid glue. When the glue has dried, stand the egg up and paint on a cute bunny face.

Ears are easy, too. Draw outlines on white construction paper. Make ears about three inches long for larger bunnies, and one and one-half inches for smaller ones. Paint ears pink. Then cut out and glue to egg head.

For clothes, circle the lower half of the egg with a small piece of brightly colored construction paper or cotton fabric. Glue ends together in back. Add buttons and bows as desired.

Final step is gluing on arms. Wrap stems of cotton swabs with colored plastic tape and glue in place.

Rev. Bonaventure Bandi Transferred To Boulder

Canon City, Colo. — One of Canon City's outstanding citizens, the Rev. Bonaventure Bandi, O.S.B., left his pastorate at St. Michael's Church March 1 to take up his new appointment as pastor of Sacred Heart Church in Boulder.

Father Bonaventure replaced Coadjutor Abbot Edward Vollmer, former pastor of the Boulder church, who was elected abbot of the Holy Cross Abbey on Feb. 16.

In August of 1964, Fr. Bonaventure was appointed pastor of St. Michael's.

The Rev. Bonaventure Bandi was born in Brooklyn, N.Y., on April 26 in 1914, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Bandi, who now reside at 692 N. Raynolds, Canon City.

As a boy he attended St. Vitus parochial school in Cleveland, Ohio. He graduated from Cathedral Latin High School, Cleveland, in 1932 and for the next two years was a student at John Carroll University in Cleveland. He was awarded his bachelor of arts degree from Holy Cross College, Canon City, in 1939 and his master of arts from Seton Hall University in So. Orange, N.J.

Fr. Bonaventure did further graduate work at the Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C.; Columbia University, N.Y.; in the extension division of the University of Colorado in 1958 and at Colorado College during the summers of 1960 and 1961.

Father Bonaventure arrived at the Holy Cross Abbey as a postulant on June 10, 1936 and was first garbed as a Benedictine in September of that year.

Two years later, including a year of novitiate, he pronounced his first religious vows.

He was ordained a priest by Bishop Joseph Clement Willging on May 16, 1942, at Sacred Heart Cathedral in Pueblo.

In the years 1938 to 1940 and 1942 to 1946, Fr. Bonaventure was prefect of the students at the Abbey School. He served as instructor in horsemanship on the staff of Camp Holy Cross in 1938 and for a number of years was director of the summer camp.

He was assistant headmaster of the Abbey School in 1945 and in the next year became its headmaster, a post he held to 1949 and from 1949 to 1956 and from 1960 to 1963. Fr. Bonaventure was also chaplain for Abbey School students in 1943-44 at St. Scholastica Academy in 1945.

Father Bonaventure also has served as prior, second in command, at Holy Cross Abbey.

Father Bonaventure is a member of St. Vitus Society No. 25 KSKJ.



Reporting from Washington

INFLATIONARY TREND AND GOVERNMENT SPENDING. In recent weeks a combination of alarming factors have created grave concern over our Nation's economic condition. In February the wholesale price index showed the sharpest rise since the Korean War. The cost of living continues to mount. A recent Gallup Poll reported that according to the American public's own appraisal of living costs, it takes a family of 4 about \$18.00 more a week to get along this year.


In spite of this serious inflationary situation and the spiraling costs of an escalated war in Vietnam, the Administration has continued to insist upon a large number of new programs. For example, in the Second Supplemental Appropriation bill passed by the House this week there is money for rent supplements and for the Federal Teachers Corps. This is money that was requested, considered and then rejected during the first session of this Congress. Once an appropriation is made for rent supplements (opposed by 71% of those replying to my recent opinion poll), the Federal Government will be on its way to a 40 year, \$6 billion program. Also, even though the proposed regulations governing allowable income limits and assets have been tightened since last year; if funds are appropriated, Congress will have little or no control over future regulations.

The Federal Teachers Corps has had an even more checkered career. In the House only one witness testified on this proposal. It then was added to the Higher Education Act by the Senate. House Republicans refused to sign the conference report and moved to recommit the report with instructions to delete the Teachers Corps. Thereafter the \$13.2 million that would have been used to finance the Teachers Corps was removed from an appropriation measure. Objections to the Teachers Corps Center on the fact that it will be a federally-financed project in which the U.S. Commissioner of Education has the authority to recruit, select, train and pay most of the salary of teachers and then choose the district, from among those that apply, in which such teachers would be assigned — a dangerous extension of federal power into local school districts.

The Record now reflects that the Administration underestimated the Vietnam needs last year by \$15 billion. This undoubtedly will be repeated this year. Until such time as a realistic appraisal of Vietnam costs is forwarded to Congress, all new and non-essential spending should be curtailed, especially when the Administration, under the guise of economy, proposes slashing such tried and true programs as the school milk and lunch program, aid to Federally-impacted school areas, and vocational education.

"WAR ON POVERTY". Two Republican members of the House Committee on Education and Labor, Representatives Albert Quile of Minnesota and Charles E. Goodell of New York, have introduced a 100-page bill which would revamp and redirect the "poverty war." Their bill is a complete substitute for the present program (which has proven to be woefully lacking), dealing with every facet and detail of present problems in the war on poverty and proposing a variety of new approaches. It will guarantee true involvement of the poor, bringing the states in as partners in the Opportunity Crusade and giving realistic incentives for employers to develop productive, permanent jobs in private enterprise for unskilled and the uneducated.

Unfortunately it appears that this committee proposal will not be given any consideration by the Committee on Education and Labor. None of the 54 witnesses requested by the Republican members has been called to testify and it is re-



One of the most intensive campaigns ever organized here to reach the city's 50,000 functional illiterates and enroll them in adult basic education classes was launched by the Cleveland Board of Education. The schools' new "I Can Read" program is being conducted as part of a nationwide drive to combat illiteracy under the Economic Opportunity Act.

"Because they have not learned to read, our functionally illiterates are being denied many opportunities, both on the employment level and on the social level," School Superintendent Paul W. Briggs said in announcing the new campaign.

"We are going to make a more concerted effort to reach these people and to get them into the free classes by making it easier for them to enroll and by having classes in more locations."


At present nearly 2500 adults are enrolled in basic education classes.

"We hope to at least double this," Briggs said, "by trying to make those who cannot read aware that the opportunity to learn is here and that there is no shame in trying to learn."

He reported the system plans to conduct a door-to-door recruitment campaign in areas where large numbers of the functionally illiterate live and to utilize newspapers, radio and television to reach them and their friends and relatives. Printed material will be distributed to all school children so they may take it home and explain it to their parents, where necessary, without creating any embarrassment.

For the convenience of those who wish to attend a class near their homes, classes beginning in April will be conducted in 53 locations in schools, churches, libraries, recreation and community centers. They can enroll for morning, afternoon, evening or weekend classes.

The free classes are open to any adult — there is no age limit. Those interested in learning to read, or their relatives and friends, are being asked to telephone the special "I Can Read" number: 391-0970.




