Začen o mehiških delavcih bo podaljšan za dve leti

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Na pritisk veleposilstnikov v južnih državah je poljedelski odbor Predstavnika doma odobril predlog administracije, naj se veljavnost sedanjega zakona podaljša še za dve leti. V smislu zakona ima 200,000 sezonskih poljedelskih delavcev iz Mehiki možnost, da dobijo delo na farmah, ki pridelujejo pavo-lo, sadje in sočivje.

Unije in socijalne ter verske organizacije so sicer stalno proti zakonu, ker hočejo varovati interese naših brezposelnih, toda njihovi protesti ne zaledajo proti združeni volji naših kongresnih konservativcev. Zakon seveda zagovarja farmske organizacije. Razume se, da so delavci izredno slabo plačani. Kdo zasluži dolar na uro, je lahko srečen.

Angleški vladi se mudi z Portugalci bombardirali atomskimi podmornicami senegalsko naselje v Afriki

LONDON, Ang. — Akoravno nima angleška vlada še končna načrta, kako naj bodo zgrajene angleške atomske podmornice, akoravno tudi ne ve, kako bo sestavila atomske glave Polaris rakete, je vendarle že sklenila pogodbo z našo administracijo za dobavo Polaris raket A-3, ki naj letijo kakih 3,000 milj daleč. Seveda tudi naša administracija ne ve, kdaj bo ta tip raket res goden za proizvodnjo.

Ta zelo tvegana hitrica ima svoje politično ozadje. Angleška delavska stranka je namreč proti načrtu, da Anglija zgradi štiri atomske podmornice z ameriško pomočjo. Prihodnje leto bodo v Angliji parlamentarne volitve. Ako bodo zmagali socialisti, bo novi ministrski predsednik načelnik stranek Wilson, ki je odločen protivnik vladnega načrta. Skupščina ga bom čim hitreje likvidirati, ker pomeni zanj razmetavanje denarja. Konservativci mu hočejo prekrižati račun s tem, da bodo že do volitev skušali toliko investirati v atomske podmornice, da ne bo Anglija imela več računa, da vse skupaj ustavi in odpise kot zgubo.

Pospesitev gradnje avtovelecesti Rt. 71

COLUMBUS, O. — V torek se bo sestala Ohio Turnpike Commission k razpravi o pospešitvi gradnje avtovelecesti Rt. 71 od Clevelandu na Columbus in dalje na Cincinnati.

Gradnja te ceste se je zavlekla in guv. Rhodes je imenoval načelnika komisije Shocknessya, da odstrani zastoje in zaprskni v poskrbi, da bo cesta čim preje dobila zvezodo od Medine skozi okraj Cuyahoga in Innerbeltom in Lakeland velecesto.

Senat izglasoval načrt za zaposlitev mladine

Predsednik predlog za mladinski zbor, ki naj bi se brigal za ohranitev naravnih parkov in njihovo izboljšanje, je bil v Senatu sprejet s 50:34 glasovom.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Zvezna vlada je izdelala načrt, ki naj bi na eni strani zaposlil mladino, na drugi pa koristil dejali pri njenih naporih za ohranitev njenih naravnih zakladov, zlasti prirodnih lepot v predelih primernih za razvedrično množiče. Kongres je bil predložen v obliki mladinskega zborna za konzervacijo. Senat je v sredo predlog odobril kljub precejšnjemu odporu republikanske opozicije. Za predlog je glasovalo 50 senatorjev, proti njemu pa 34.

Republikanci so bili proti predlogu ne toliko zaradi trošenja zveznih sredstev v nenujne namene, ampak največ zaradi tega, ker daje mladini sicer zaposlitev ne bo pa ji je preskrbel nobenega strokovnega znanja, ki ji naj bi kasneje pomagalo do stalne zaposlitve.

Predlog bo prišel v maju v razpravo v Predstavnškem domu, če bo tudi tam odobren, bo v sedanjem okviru nudil v prvem letu ob stroških, okoli 100 milijonov dolarjev zaposlitev okoli 75,000 mladini. Leta, kasneje pa celo do 100,000. Obstoječi mladinski zborni je sedaj doloden na pet let.

Kubanski begunci imajo velike želje in načrte

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik Kennedy je naročil obalnim stražam, da morajo preprečiti vse oborožene izlete kubanskih beguncov na Kubo. Odredil je tak postopek ne samo radi tega, ker velja pravilo, da se politični begunci ne smejo pečati s politiko, ki škode državi, kjer so dobili prizadevanje, ampak tudi radi tega, ker se državno tajništvo bojni, da bi Hruščev vtegnil porabiti akcije kubanskih emigrantov kot razlog, da ne umakne ostanka ruskih čet s Kube.

S tem niso seveda zadovoljni kubanski begunci. Predsednik glavnega begunskega odbora v Miami dr. Miro Cardona je celo odstopil v znak protesta proti Kennedyjevemu stališču. Z njegovim protestom pa tiči tudi neko vojašnico. Podobni napadi naj bi se izvršili tudi v preteklem januarju. Portugalci naj bi pri njihovi zavrnitvi prekorčili mejo in zasedovali napadalo v Senegalijo.

Senegalija je bila do leta 1960 francoska kolonija, od tedaj pa je neodvisna država z okoli 2,5 milijoni prebivalcev.

KENNEDY JE POPUSTIL V VPRAŠANJU CEN JEKLA

Predsednik Kennedy je včeraj pred svojim odhodom na velikonočni oddih v Palm Beach v Floridi izjavil, da je še vedno proti splošnemu zvišanju cen jekla, kot je bil lani, da pa razume povisanje cen posameznih vrst, v kolikor je opravičljivo.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Od kar je Wheeling Steel Corp. objavila zvišanje cen nekaterih svojih produktov, je vladala v glavnem mestu napetost. Vodniki gospodarstva so čakali, kako bo na to odgovorila vlada, ki se je lani tako odločno postavila po robu splošnemu zvišanju cen produktov jeklske industrije. Ozračje se je umirilo, ko je predsednik Kennedy tik pred svojim odhodom na kratek velikonočni oddih, ki ga je odložil za en dan, izjavil, da nima nič proti zvišanju cen nekaterih produktov jeklske industrije, da pa je še prav tako nasproten splošnemu zvišanju cen produktov v jeklski industriji kot je bil.

Zastopnik U.S. Steel Corp., največje jeklske družbe v delži in na svetu, je dejal, da ta skrbno proučuje cene, da pa ne bo o svojih načrtih dala nobene izjave pred koncem praznikov.

Unija jeklskih delavcev ima pravico s koncem meseca obnoviti razgovore o plačah. Brez dvoma bo to storila, če bodo jeklarne povisile cene svojih produktov kar čez.

Predsednik Kennedy je dejal, da njegova vlada ni zainteresirana v dolgotanju cen, je pa zainteresirana v splešni javni porasti in splošna javnost bi trebala škodo od kar splošnega zvišanja cen jeklskih produktov, ker bi to sprožilo nov val inflacije. Jeklarne in unija jeklskega delavstva je pozval, naj "ne store ničesar, kar bi privelo k splošnemu povisanju cen".

Srebreni dollar opuščen

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predstavnški dom je sprejel zakonski predlog, ki ukinja srebreni dollar, to se pravi kritje v srebru za endolarske bankovce. Po zakonu, ki je bil sprejet skoraj pred sto leti z namenom, da podpre srebreni rudnike, je bila vlada obvezana kupovati srebro po 90,5 centa za unčo za kritje vseh endolarskih bankovcev. Bankovci preko te vrednosti imajo zlato kritje.

Ker je srebro zaradi večje uporabe v industriji doseglo redno ceno 1,27 dolarja za unčo, je starci zakon postal brezpredmeten, obvezuje pa zvezno vlado, da drži za blizu dve bilijona dolarjev vrednosti srebra v svoji zakladnici. Ko bo predlog odobren tudi v Senatu in ga bo predsednik podpisal v zakon, bo zvezna vlada lahko srebro prodala in s tem zmanjšala pričakovanje v proračunu.

Nemiri v Britski Gvajani

GEORGETOWN, Brit. Gvajana. — Koncem tedna je priskočilo zaradi prepričev med delavskimi unijami do demonstracij in izgredov, tekom katerih je bila najmanj ena oseba mrtva, 24 pa ranjenih. Policija je prijela okoli 150 oseb.

Vlada predsednika Cheddy Jagana je zagrozila, da bo oklicala obsedno stanje in pozvala na pomoč britanske čete, če ne bo nemirov konec. Jagana je po svojem političnem preprčanju bud Levičar, če ne naravnost komunist, rad bi se znebil britskega varušstva, na drugi strani pa spožnavata, da bi bil brez njega v sreči. Ima jih skupno okoli 40; vsakega je pobarvala drugače.

Glavni odbor ruske KP se bo sestal 28. maja

MOSKVA, Rus. — Hruščev je sklical za 28. maj sejo glavnega odbora ruske Komunistične partije. Seje se bo udeležilo 175 pravih odbornikov, 125 njihovih namestnikov, povrhu pa še zastopniki kulturnega sveta. Glavna točka na dnevnem redu je debata o "ideoloških" napakah, ki jih delajo russki kulturniki vseh vrst, posebno pa umetniki, pisatelji in skladatelji.

Debata o tem vprašanju se je začela 1. decembra, ko se je Hruščev zelo kritično izrazil o sodobnih russkih slikah in kipih, ko je obiskal neko umetniško razstavo. Stranka je že večkrat obsojila počenjanje russkih kulturnikov, zdi se pa, da glavni odbor ne bo samo obsojal, ampak tudi sklepil. Napovedujejo, da bo naročil komunistom, naj nategnjevo vajeti v vseh poklicnih organizacijah russkih kulturnikov, naj "zdržujejo" društva in klube, ki niso zanesljivi, naj postavijo časopise vseh vrst pod strožjo kontrolo in naj pravilno "umerjajo" radijo, televizijo itd.

Russki kulturniki torej vedo, kaj jih čaka. O tem bodo govorili tudi na Russkem umetniškem kongresu, ki se vrši v dnevi v Veliki kremeljski dvorani. Mislijo, da bo na Kongresu izbrano novo tajništvo, da se potolači okolica tovariša Hruščeva. Zadnji umetniški kongres se je vršil l. 1957.

Za delavci in kmeti so torej prišli tudi kulturniki pod strožji partijski režim. Značilno je, da ima Tito na las podobne težave v svojih "kulturnih" vrstah.

Dom izglasoval zakon za nadaljevanje javnih del

WASHINGTON, D.C.—Predsednik Kennedy je dosegel v Kongresu še eno zmago, ko je Predstavniški dom izglasoval 450 milijonov dolarjev za nadaljevanje javnih del, ki naj posmagajo predelom v veliko brezposelnostjo. Finančni odbor Doma je pretekli teden predlog zavrnil.

Republikanci so se trudili, da bi dobili večino proti predlogu tudi v splošni zbornici, to jim vendar ni uspelo. Za odobritev novih finančnih sredstev je glasovalo 288 članov Predstavniškega doma, proti pa 184. Bela hiša je Kongresu čestitala za ta korak v boju "proti brezposelnosti", demokratsko vodstvo v Predstavniškem domu pa je glasovanje označilo za veliko demokratsko zmago. Če bi bil predlog v Domu poražen, bi imelo to skrajno neugodno posledico za napore dobiti zaposlitv pol milijonu ljudi v raznih delih dežele, kjer je brezposelnost posebno občutna.

Težko verujem v mrtvi Hersonov brod, toda prav tako težko v kraljevanje človeka, ki sem ga obsojil na smrt. In vendar se mi zdi, da vsak dan bolj stopam proti meji nečesa, ki bi utegnilo biti njegova lastnina. Plinija me vabi. Slišim njen glas, celo tapkanje njenih nog, ki vsak večer prihajajo proti moji spalnici. Slišim jo na vrtu, slišim jo v šumenu vode — od povsod prihaja njen glas. In ob tem glasu se drobi sila mojega starega srca, ki se počasi ustavlja. Ko obrnem uro, vem, da je nekoč ne bom več mogel. Negibno bo obstal pesek na dnu in ko bom zatisnil oči, tudi ure več ne bom videl.

Kaj bom videl potem?

Plinijo, ki sem jo ljubil in je odšla? Juda Jezusa, ki sem mu vsaj v napisu priznal ime kralja in tega nisem hotel preklicati?

Prepuščaš me milosti tega kralja, si mi dejal, ko si odhalil. Njegovi milosti in Plinijemu klicu. Ko bom umirajoč gledal zadnja zrnca peska v uri, bosta oba prišla k meni. Tako si rekel.

Zdi se mi, da že živim v tem pričakovanju in da si s svojim prihodom to pričakovanje še povečal. Želim se srečati z njo in z njim, zakaj nisem več sodnik, ampak samo človek, ki je obvisel nad preteklostjo kakor nad breznom in roke so pretrudne, da bi se mogle dolgo oklepati robu. Moral se bom spustiti.

Hvala ti, predragi, za twojobje. In če mi na skrivaj pošlješ tistega, ki je prepričal tebe, ga bom sprejel in poslušal.





SPECIAL REPUBLICAN TASK FORCE ON EXPENDITURES soon after the President presented his staggering budget request for \$108 billion in new spending authority and \$99 billion in actual expenditures for next year, the Republican Members of the Appropriations Committee formed a Special Task Force to see where savings could be made. Representative Frank Bow of Canton, Ohio, was made Chairman. To assist in analyzing the voluminous budget document, expert assistance was obtained from Mr. Maurice H. Stans who served as Director of the Budget Bureau under President Eisenhower from 1958 to 1961. In addition, dozens of other persons who are familiar with various aspects of government spending were consulted.

After a careful study the Task Force concluded that it is not only feasible, but urgent in the national interest, to reduce substantially the President's budget request. The study revealed that new spending authority could be reduced by a magnitude of from 10 to 15 billion dollars by applying the following basic principles: (1) Limitation of personnel additions in 1964 to requirements of non-deferrable workload increases such as may be caused by recent new legislation, or for law enforcement or protection of property, or high priority objectives. (2) Absorption by all agencies of the half year payroll increases effective January 1, 1964. (3) Postponement of a considerable portion of new non-emergency construction, both civil and military; and some stretch out of previously authorized capital outlays. (4) A moratorium on initiation of new programs not essential for the national welfare or security. (5) Conscious reappraisal of continuing programs and services, with a view to reducing those of low priority and leveling out temporarily those (like research) which have enlarged substantially in recent years.

This week the first appropriation bill—H.R. 5279, for the Department of Interior—was brought before the House. Following the suggestions proposed by the Republican Task Force, this measure was cut by 9 per cent below the Administration's request. This is a constructive beginning and a good

omen. If most of the other appropriation bills reflect a similar reduction and if the Senate cooperates, the goal of achieving a realistic level of Federal expenditures in fiscal year 1964 can be realized.

'87 MILLION JOBS' — BY CONGRESSMAN TOM CURTIS

With unemployment at the very high rate of 6.1 per cent of the civilian labor force, the Kennedy Administration would be well advised to study a short, but penetrating analysis of the unemployment problem by Congressman Tom Curtis of Missouri. Congressman Curtis, who is one of the ablest and hardest-working Members of the House, is the senior Republican on the Joint Economic Committee and a high-ranking member of the House Ways and Means Committee.

His book, entitled "87 Million Jobs—A Dynamic Program to End Unemployment" (published by Duell, Sloan and Pearce), offers a fresh and stimulating program that is in sharp contrast to the Administration's tired-out approach of trying to create jobs through larger and larger Federal budget deficits.

Congressman Curtis' main point is that advancing technology and other changes taking place in our economy are eliminating many obsolete jobs, but at the same time, creating many new ones. The problem is that the people whose jobs are being eliminated are either not qualified to take on the new jobs, which generally call for a higher degree of skill, or they live in an area other than where the new jobs are located. According to Congressman Curtis, the easing of these dislocations in the labor market requires a massive effort to upgrade workers skills through training and retraining, more effective efforts to increase worker mobility, greater success in identifying job vacancies and in matching the manless job with the jobless man, and in a greater stimulation of savings and investment, upon which job creation depends.

The ideas in Tom Curtis' book are exciting and challenging and deserve the attention of everyone who is concerned about finding a genuine and lasting solution to the problems of mounting and persistent unemployment.
