Indija bo podvojila izdalke za oborožitev

Za slučaj novega kitajskega napada se hoče boljše pripraviti. Pri tem upa na večo pomoč od strani Zadoda.

NEW DELHI, Ind. — Predsednik vlade Nehru in njegov obrambni minister sta se odločila, da mora Indija skoraj povojiti sredstva z svoje oborožene sile, če hoče to usposobiti za upečato obrambo pred novim kitajskim napadom. V novem proračunskem letu, ki se začne 1. aprila, bo predvidoma porabila Indija za oborožene sile okoli dva biliiona dolarjev. Poleg tega bo skušala dobiti še obesnašnjo pomoč v oroožju in drugih vojaških potrebsčinah v Združenih državah, Veliki Britaniji, Avstraliji in Kanadi.

Indija je sorazmerno revna na finančnih sredstvih. Doselej je pri izdatkih za narodno obrambo skrajno varčevala in, kar je le mogla, vložila v kapitalne dobrine za gospodarski razvoj dežele. Po novem proračunu bodo izdatki za narodno obrambo podvojeni in bodo predstavljeni okoli 5 odstotkov celotnega narodnega dohodka. Predsednik vlade Nehru upa, da mu ne bo treba omejiti obstoječih gospodarskih načrtov. Veliko oporo v tem upanju mu daja posojilo Združenih držav 240 milijonov dolarjev za 40 let in skoraj brez vsakih obresti.

V New Delhiju še vedno ne smatrajo kitajsko nevarnost za toliko, da bi popustili v kašmirskem sporu s Pakistanom.

Od božiča so imeli o tem vprašanju že tri sestanke, ne da bi se rešitvi približali. Nov sestanek je napovedan za prihodnji mesec v Kalkuti. Indijci so na Pakistan te dni posebno nejedoljni, ker je podpisal z rdečo Kitajsko sporazum o skupni meji.

Boeing Co. dobila naročilo za \$418,000,000

WASHINGTON, D.C. — NASA je dala znani letalski tovarni Boeing Co. do sedaj največje naročilo v vrednosti nad \$418,000,000. Naročila je pogonske motorje za raketo Saturn V. Raketa Saturn V. bo pognala v vesolje gondolo, ki bo pristala na Luni.

Ves načrt je znan pod imenom Projekt Apollo. Pogonski motor bo 33 čevljev širok in 138 čevljev dolg. Raketa sama bo imela pet vrst takih motorjev.

Zivljenjski stroški so se zoper dvignili

Dosegli so 106 povprečja iz let 1957-1959, kjer so bili lanji v novembra.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Po podatkih zvezne vlade so se življenjski stroški tekmo januarja dvignili za dve desetinki odstotka na 106 povprečja cen v letih 1957-59. V preteklem decembru so se za prav enako mero znižali, tako da smo dejansko dosegli znova višino cen iz preteklega novembra.

Glavni razlog za zvišanje življenjskih stroškov so porasle cene sadja in zelenjave. Hud mraz v decembru in januarju je uničil veliko sadja, sočivja in zelenjave. Ker ta v januarju in v februarju ni popustil, ni pričakovati, da bi cene te vrste živil skoro popustile. Treba je računati s tem, da bo indeks cen življenjskih stroškov v februarju zoper porastel.

Severna meja Tajske je postala sumljivo nemirna

BANGKOK, Taj. — Tajska vlada se že od nekdaj boji, da bi ji kitajski komunisti utegnili delati sitnosti na njeni severni meji. Njen strah se je sedaj uresničil. KENNEDYJEV PREDLOG ZA ČUVANJE DRŽAVLJANSKIH PRAVIC BREZ IZGLEDOV

Predsednik je včeraj predložil Kongresu svoj načrt za utrditev in čuvanje državljanovih pravic črnicev. Zakonodajavce je pozval, naj se vzamejo za volivno pravico črnih državljanov, za skupne sile in za podaljšanje življenja komisije za civilne pravice. — Liberalni del Kongresa je označil predlog za "skromen", južnjački pa so izjavili, da je nova zakonodaja v tem pogledu nepotrebna.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik Kennedy je včeraj prvi, od kar je v Beli hiši, v posebni poslanici pozval Kongres, naj sklene zakone za čuvanje državljanovih pravic črnicev, ki da so skoraj v vsej deželi vsaj do neke mere zapostavljeni. V uvodu poslanice je poudarjal, kaj vse je bilo v pogledu varovanja pravic črnih državljanov storjeno, nato pa je zatrjeval, da so ti kljub temu, da je poteklo že sto let, od kar so bili osvobojeni, še vedno v velikem delu dežele pri svojih pravicah prikrajševani. Opozoril je posebno na čuvanje njihove volive pravice, na potrebo po končanju šolske segregacije, ki jo zakon prepoveduje, pa vendar obstaja, ter se zavzel za podaljšanje obstoja komisije za civilne pravice.

Predsednik je napovedal, da bodo v naslednjih 10 dneh predloženi posebni zakonski osnutki v smislu včeraj predloženega načrta za civilne pravice. "Program, predložen v spomenici neznamenu vojaku položili k poslednjemu počitku 11 članov posadke "leteče trdnjave" B-25, ki se je 1. februarja 1944 zadevala neizpolnjena. Liberalno krije se mnenje, da je načrt začetek za čuvanje državljanovih pravic v spomenici, čeprav je v tem delu delovali v bližini vzdoljščev. — Skupno sv. obhajilo—

Jemen izgnal britiske diplomatske zastopnike

ADEN, Arab. — Velika Britanija, katere kolonija Aden je sosed Jemena, je edina od velenih, ki nove republikanske vlade Jemena noče priznati. Tako se je ta razjezila in britanske diplomatske zastopnike pognala iz dežele. Ves položaj v tem delu Arabeje se je znova zapletel in postaja nevarno vroč.

Kraljevi pristaši obvladujejo dober del Jemena kljub vsej vojaški pomoči, ki jo nudi Naser republikanski vlad Abdulla Salala. Uspehi nasprotnikov ki uživajo pomoč Saudske Arabeje in Jordanije in delno nemara tudi Angležev, so republikansko vlado napravili nervozno. Njene čete so udarile preko meje na področje Adena, pričemer pa so jih Angleži prestregli in pognali nazaj. Jemenska vlada je Angleža obdolžila kršenja njenega ozemlja in zahvala pri Združenih narodih, da napravijo konec tej "agresiji".

Namestnik glavnega tajnika ZN Tanta dr. R. Bunche je sedaj na Srednjem vzhodu, da ugotovi dejansko stanje in skuša preprečiti nov večji vojni spopad.

Kako so ga dobili?

PARIZ, Fr. — Francoska polica je pustekl torek prijela bivšega polkovnika A. Argouda, ki je bil pred časom obsojen v odsotnosti na smrt zaradi kovanja upora v Alžiriji. Policia trdi, da je nekdo poklical in dejal, da je Argoud za cerkvijo Notre Dame zvezan v tovornem avtomobilu. Dodal je še, da ga izdajajo policiji, ker ni izvrnil lani v avgustu atentata na De Gaulle, kot bi bilo treba. Na De Gaulle so tedaj streljali s strojnic, ko se je vozil mimo v avtomobilu. K sreči ni bil zadet.

Pred sodiščem je sedaj razprava proti organizatorjem tega atentata. Zagovornik obtožencev je zahteval, da tožitelj povede pred sodiščo Argouda, da bo lahko pričal, kako vlogo je igral pri omenjenem atentatu on. Zagovornik je dejal, da bo zavrnitev njegove zahteve dokaz, da je Francija "kriva mednarodnega tolovajstva". S tem je namignil na vesti, da naj bi A. Argouda prijela v Muenchenu na Nemškem francosku tajno policijo in ga odvedla skrivaj domov, podobno kot so storili Izraelci z Eichmannom v Argentini.

Med Francijo in Brazilijo se je začela "rakova" vojna

PARIZ, Fr. — Pet francoskih ribiških čolnov je začelo loviti rake na visokem morju, 100 milj daleč od brazilskih obala. S tem ni zadovoljna Brazilija, ki trdi, da so raki prišli na visoko morje od brazilskih obala in da jih torej ne sme nihče loviti brez brazilskega dovoljenja.

Ker se francoski ribiški čolni niso zmenili za stališče brazilski vlade jih je hotela pregnati s silo. Francoska vlada je sklenila, da bo poslala ribiškim čolnom varstvo v obliki male, toda moderne in zelo hitre vojne ladje Tartu. Ladja je že na potu proti brazilskim obalama.

Francija je prvi hip hotela poslati kar velik rušilec, pa si je pozneje premisnila in poslala le Tartu.

Kje naj bo gornja mej za federalne zadolžitve?

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Sedaj se je gornja mej za federalne zadolžitve zaustavila na višini \$308 bilijonov. Bo pa 1. aprila padla na 305 bilijonov, ako je Kongres ne bo podaljšal do 30. junija, kot to predлага Kennedyeva administracija. Na Kapitolu pravijo, da bo Kennedy predlagal za prihodnje davčno leto novo višino v znesku \$320 bilijonov.

V Kongresu nimajo dosti ve-

selja, da bi dvigali mejo za zadolževanje. Kennedju bodo verjetno podaljšali mejo do 30. junija tako, kot želi administracija. Proti povisanju na \$320 bilijonov se pa misljivo upreti posebno republikanci.

Bodočnost atomske tovorne ladje Savannah negotova

HOUSTON, Tex. — Prva atomska tovorna ladja Savannah je opravila poskusno vožnjo po svetu, pa se vožnja ni menda prav posebno obnesla. Velike pomorske luke niso bile nič veselje njenega obiska. Nekatere države sploh niso hotele dati dovoljenja, da se pri njih ustavi.

Sedaj se je vrnila v Galveston in čaka, kaj bo naša Atomska komisija z njo naredila. Mislijo, da bodo najprvo na novo kontrolirali ves atomske mehanizem in skušali dogmati, kje se da kaj popraviti. Šele potem bo komisija rekla svojo besedo, kaj naj se z ladjo zgoditi.

Bivši predsednik Mednarodne banke naj rešuje ZN finance?

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Generalni tajnik ZN Tant je naprosil bivšega glavnega ravnatelja Mednarodne banke Eugena Blacka, naj skuša iztrjati pričlanicah ZN nad \$100 milijonov zapadnih prispevkov.

Black je dobro poznan v krogih delegacij ZN, saj je skoraj vsaki pomagal na ta ali oni način do posojil. To seveda še ne pomeni, da bo tudi sedaj dosegel uspeh. De Gaulle in Hruščev ne bosta gotovo prišla tako pod njegov vpliv, da bi plačala prispevke, ki zavlačujeta njihovo plačilo iz političnih in ne gospodarskih razlogov.

Ten Bomber Players Attend College During Off Season: The image of the modern ball player is changing.

No fewer than ten young players on the Yankee roster are college students. Those attending school in the off season are Tom Tresh, Central Michigan University; Roland Sheldon, University of Connecticut; Jim Bouton, Western Michigan; Al Downing, Muhlenberg; Curt Blefari, Wagner; Mike Hegan, John Carroll; Howard Kitt, Hofstra; Bob Meyer, Toledo; Ron Solomini, Long Island University, and Hal Stowe, Clemson.

Spanh Signs Record 19th Pact w/ Braves' Twirler: Warren Spanh broke a record just by signing his contract with the Braves, February 15. He set a new high of 19 seasons for a pitcher with one N. L. club, eclipsing the former mark shared by Babe Adams of the Pirates and Jesse Haines of the Cardinals.

Although terms were not announced, Spanh also probably broke his own league record for the highest salary by a pitcher. He is presumed to have received a slight raise to about \$78,000, a figure topped only by Bob Feller of the Indians in the American League.

Spanh broke in with the Braves in September, 1942. After 3 years in the Army, he returned to stay in June, 1946. He has won 327 games, more than any other left-hander in major league history.

Wynn to Try for No. 300; Joins White Sox in Sarasota: Early Wynn has decided to make a try for that 300th victory.

The 43-year-old righthander showed up at the White Sox camp here, February 21, and announced he will make a stab at the goal he missed last year. He will be reinstated on the roster if he impresses Manager Al Lopez during the training period.

Wynn, a major leaguer since 1941, ended the 1962 season with 299 career victories.

Lane Supports Saperstein Bid for Three-Point Goal: Though Zephyr General Manager Frank Lane had a running feud with Abe Saperstein last summer, he freely admits that Saperstein is one of the nation's best basketball men and says he'd like to see the National Basketball Association adopt Saperstein's three-point basket.

The three-point basket was among the features of the now defunct American Basketball League, which was started last season by Saperstein. The ABL according to Saperstein's original plans, was to have been a genuine rival to the NBA, but the league was a failure from the start and only recently folded.

Saperstein has long contended that fans want to see the old-style of play and initiated the rule that three points were to be awarded for each basket scored from 25 feet out or further.

This, Saperstein said, would encourage long shooting and also give the smaller and average-size player a better chance to compete with the skyscraping stars.

"I think the three-point basket is a good idea and that the NBA should copy it," Lane said.

United States Air Force officials announced this week that the Officer Training School has been expanded. With the termination of the old Officer Candidate School, the Air Force looks to the relatively new 90 day orientation course as one of the main sources for Officers.

THOSE WARTIME EXCISE TAXES

One of the constructive acts of this Congress was to repeal the wartime excise tax of 10 per cent on railroad and bus tickets and to reduce the rate on airline tickets to five per cent.


But this should not be the end of the line so far as those taxes are concerned. Numbers of them are left — imposed as World War II emergency measures, with the tacit understanding that they would be removed soon after the war's end.

A spokesman for the American Retail Federation made the point in a letter to President Kennedy: "May I respectfully point out that removal of wartime excise taxes is not only justified, but would result in placing disposable personal income immediately in the hands of the consumer... Women who spend the biggest portion of the consumer dollar, find it quite difficult to understand why a wartime excise tax is still imposed upon cosmetics, furs, perfume, handbags, luggage, jewelry, and other items... If you really want to help the consumer, ask for the removal of these objectionable wartime excise taxes."

This argument is a compelling one. Aside from the manifest injustice of continuing an emergency tax for many years after the emergency's end, one of the principal problems of the moment is to find ways and means to increase consumer spending in order to stimulate the economy and provide more employment. Repeal of the excise taxes would be an equitable, simple and substantial move in that important direction.

Reporting from Washington

A BRAHAM LINCOLN AND A FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY
No business was scheduled in the House this past week to give Members an opportunity to participate in traditional observances commemorating the birthday of Abraham Lincoln.

It was this first Republican President who enunciated a philosophy of government which is in keeping with the constitutional objectives of our Republic. Lincoln wrote: "The legitimate object of Government is to do for a community of people whatever they need to have done, but cannot do at all, or cannot so well do for themselves, in their separate and individual capacities. In all that the people can individually do as well for themselves, Government ought not to interfere."

How far we have strayed from this objective! Today we see an ever-expanding Federal government. Spending has increased nearly 20 per cent since 1960 and next year's budget of \$98.8 billion is the highest in history. New domestic programs have required the Federal government to spend money it does not have. In fiscal 1964, the U.S. must commit \$1 out of every \$9 in tax revenue just to pay the interest on the national debt. Indications are that the Administration will have to ask Congress to increase the debt limit from its present "temporary" \$308 billion to approximately \$320 billion. This will mean even greater interest payments.

As the Congress resumes its work on the record spending proposals of the Administration, and requests for tax cuts and tax reform, it is essential that the people express themselves to their representatives on the economic road they desire to travel. It also was Lincoln who said: "The people know their rights, and they are never slow to assert and maintain them, when they are invaded."

FOREIGN AID AMENDMENTS IMPLEMENTED

Last year the Congress adopted an amendment to the Foreign Aid



Assistance Act which dealt with the question of expropriation of American property by foreign countries without proper compensation under international law. This provision simply stipulated that a country which seized property of an American firm without taking "appropriate steps" towards compensation shall be denied foreign aid. There have been two incidents in which this provision has proved useful.

The first concerned the confiscation of the telephone facilities of the International Telephone and Telegraph Company. Since the passage of this amendment a satisfactory settlement has been arranged between the officials of the government of Brazil and representatives of the company.

Many of you no doubt have heard of the termination of American aid to Ceylon. This has come about as a direct result of the confiscation of various oil concerns in that nation. Since the Ceylonese government has failed to take any appropriate steps to make proper restitution, our aid has been terminated.

SALUTE TO BOY SCOUTS

With Boy Scout Week arriving in February, it gives me an excellent opportunity to salute the Boy Scouts of America as this fine organization celebrates its 55th birthday. I know that each of you shares my pride in the fine job that Scouting does for the youth of America. Over 30 million boys have been proud members of Scout units and have earned their steps up the ladder of achievement within the organization since it was founded in our Nation's Capital on February 8, 1910. Today there are about 5.5 million boys and volunteer leaders active in the organization. The Boy Scout program gives thousands and thousands of lads not only the chance to build physically but also characterize. This we need for America's leaders of tomorrow.

tions of the current New York season and will be sung by the Met's greatest voices.

Among those coming to Cleveland for the festival are Renata Tebaldi, Eileen Farrell, Dorothy Kirsten, Licia Albanese, Lauri Hurley, Lucine Amara, Gabriella Tucci, Franco Corelli, Robert Merrill, Giorgio Tozzi and Richard Tucker.

There will be no increase in prices, with seats again ranging from \$2 to \$12, it was announced. There is no tax.

The colorful opening night performance on Monday, April 22, will be a special double bill which won the acclaim and sincere applause of recent New York audiences.

The festival's curtain will rise at 8 p.m. on Pietro Mascagni's loveable "Cavalleria Rusticana" with the talented soprano, Eileen Farrell as Santuzza, dark-eyed Rosalind Elias as Lola, Lili Chookasian as Lucia, stocky Morrell as Turiddu and Walter Cassel as Alfio. Following the opening night's intermission promenade Ruggiero Leoncavallo's familiar, two act, "Pagliacci", with its oft hummed arias, will be heard. Attractive Teresita Streitas will sing the lead of Nedda, with James McCracken, Anselmo Colzani and Charles Anthony. Fausto Cleva is the conductor.

"We believe this is one of the most exciting opera festivals offered by the MET in Cleveland," Herman L. Vail, Chairman of the Board, Northern Ohio Opera Association, sponsors of the festival, said in commenting on the 1963 repertoire.

"The MET's greatest voices, which have won the praises of New York critics and audiences alike during the current season, will again make our festival week an outstanding musical success."

All evening performance will be at 8 p.m. sharp. Saturday and Sunday and Sunday matinees will be at 1:30 p.m. but due to the change over to daylight saving time, the Sunday matinee on April 23 will be on daylight saving time.

Prices for single performance tickets will be \$2, \$3, \$4, \$5, \$6, \$7, \$8, \$10 and \$12. Season tickets will be \$16, \$24, \$32, \$40, \$48, \$56, \$64, \$80 and \$84. There is no tax.

Although the box office will not be open to the public until Monday, February 25th, literature and order blanks will be available beginning this week.

Origin Of County Names

"I wonder how that county got its name" is a statement echoed frequently by both visitor and resident of Ohio. Although many Ohioans possess some knowledge of their home counties, they often "draw a blank" when it comes to the derivations of their neighboring counties.

A look at the origin of Ohio's 88 counties sheds some interesting light on the heritage of our state, said Secretary of State Ted W. Brown, who issues such information in the "Ohio Population Report," and other publications.

The publication recalls that Carroll County was named after Charles Carroll, last survivor of the signers of the Declaration of Independence, while Hancock County chose as its namesake, John Hancock, first signer of the historical document.

Columbiana County got its appellation from the combined names of Christopher Columbus and Arma.

Early American inventors Benjamin Franklin and Robert Fulton were remembered, name-wise, by Franklin and Fulton Counties.

General Zebulon M. Pike, discoverer of Pike's Peak in 1806, was honored by having his name chosen to represent Pike County.

Licking County received its title because of the great number of salt licks that occupied the area.

Counties that paid homage to Presidents of the United States (some of whom were serving in office at the time the counties were organized) included Washington, Monroe, Adams, Harrison, Jackson, Jefferson and Madison.

Three Ohio counties adopted the names of distinguished cabinet members of the federal government. They were General Henry Knox, Secretary of War under Washington; Alexander Hamilton, Secretary of the Treasury; and Jonathon Meigs, Postmaster General.

Ohio which is the Iroquois word for "great river," has some 19 counties within its borders whose names refer to the state's first inhabitants, the Indian. They are: Miami—Ottawa word for "mother"; Wyandot—named after the Wyandot tribe meaning "around the plains"; Ashtabula—Indian name meaning "fish river;" Coshocton—Delaware Indian word for "union of waters;" Cuyahoga—Indian name meaning "crooked river" (referring to Cuyahoga River); Huron—named after the Huron Indians; Ottawa—Indian word for "trader;" Auglaize—Indian meaning for "fallen timbers;" Pickaway—variant of the Indian word, "Piqua;" Sandusky—Indian word for "cold water;" Tuscarawas—Indian meaning for "open mouth" (referring to the Tuscarawas River); Mahoning—Indian meaning for "at the licks;" Delaware—named after the Governor of

Governors and unsuccessful gubernatorial candidates also come in for their share of recognition from various counties. Several counties selected their names from such far-away lands as Athens (Greece), Medina (Arabia) and Guernsey (Isle of Guernsey, Great Britain).

Patriots, Indian fighters, statesmen and engineers also received their share of recognition from such counties as Henry—Patrick (Give Me Liberty Or Give Me Death) Henry; Clinton—George Clinton, Vice President of the United States (1805-1812); Noble—James Noble, early settler, and Warren Noble, New Counties Chairman. Wood—Eleazer Wood, engineer and builder of Fort Meigs; Logan—General Benjamin Logan, known for his expeditions against the Indians; Crawford—Colonel William Crawford, burned at the stake by Indians; Defiance—Fort Defiance, built by General Arthur Wayne in 1794; Ashland—named after "Ashland" the estate of Henry Clay near Lexington, Kentucky; and Union—so named because it was formed from parts of four counties.

Local characteristics of the area were distinguishing factors in the naming of certain counties. These counties included: Summit—reputed to have the highest elevation along the Ohio Canal; Lake—named so because of its frontage on Lake Erie; Fairfield—known for its picturesque fields; Highland—recognized for its hilly terrain; Portage—noted for its Indian trails connecting head waters; and Richland County descriptive of the character of its soil.

The valiant men who fought in the Revolutionary War and the War of 1812 influenced the largest number of counties in choosing their namesakes. Included among these combatants were: Adventurers—Ethan Allen (captured Fort Ticonderoga), John Paulding, David Williams, and Isaac Van Wert (carters of British spy Major Andre); Revolutionary War Generals—Richard Montgomery, Nathaniel Greene, George Rogers Clark, Daniel Morgan, Joseph Warren, John Stark, "Mad Anthony" Wayne, Richard Butler, William Darke, Francis Marion, John Hardin, Hugh Mercer, Isaac Shelby and General Andrew H. Holmes.

France played a powerful role in the state's early history, as evidenced by the names of numerous Ohio counties: Fayette—named after Marquis de La Fayette; Gallia—Gaul (Latin name meaning France), a county settled by the French; Clermont—named after the Province of Clermont, France; Lorain—named after the Province of Lorraine, France; Champaign—French word meaning "a plain;" and Belmont—French word for "beautiful mountain."







Fare Plan For Golden Agers

The reduced fare plan for Golden Agers will become effective on April 1, 1963, Donald C. Hyde, Cleveland Transit System General Manager, has announced.

Twenty-seven registration centers have been set up throughout the community through the cooperation of the Cleveland Welfare Federation. Any person wishing to make application for the Senior Citizen Reduced Fare Identification Card should stop in at one of the registration centers between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. starting Monday, March 4th. These centers will be open Monday through Friday for two weeks.

The reduced rate of fare for senior citizens is a privilege extended by the Cleveland Transit System to residents of the area who are 65 years of age or over and whose annual income from all sources does not exceed \$1200.00 — excluding up to \$1200.00 per year in social security, federal, state or municipal retirement benefits. In the case of a married couple, the joint annual income from all sources should not exceed \$2400.00, excluding the \$1200 retirement benefit mentioned above.

Senior citizens will be asked to fill out an application form at one registration centers when they apply for their identification card. They should bring with them some document which will authenticate the date of their birth, a full-faced recent photograph 1½" x 2", a self-addressed stamped envelope, and 25¢ in coin to cover the charge of processing the identification card.

After the application has been approved, the ID card will be mailed to the home of the applicant.

This ID card will allow the senior citizens to use special four-for-five local tickets within the specified hours with the same privilege of regular adult local tickets. Rides on express lines or the Rapid Transit will be 5¢ extra. There will also be a 5¢ charge for each extra fare zone. The Identification Card must be shown to the CTS operator to take advantage of these half-fare tickets. Transfers will be 1¢ during the specified hours.

The specified hours for the reduced rate of fare will be from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. and from 7 p.m. until midnight on weekdays and Saturdays, and from 5 a.m. until midnight on Sundays and holidays.

Pamphlets explaining the procedure to follow in making application for the reduced fare are available on CTS vehicles, or by writing to CTS Public Relations Department at 1404 East 9th Street, Cleveland 14, Ohio.
