Kaj je z koreninami našega življenjskega drevesa?

"Ljubljanski dnevnik" je pretekli mesec objavil članek, ki na temelju zadnjih uradnih podatkov prikazuje slike rasti, oziroma propadanje slovenskega naroda v Socialistični ljudski republiki Sloveniji. O tem vprašanje smo v našem listu že nekajkrati razpravljali. Zdi se nam, da je ta članek poučen in važen za vse, ki se za slovenske narodne stvari zanimajo, zato ga objavljamo v celoti. Glaši se:

II.

Najpoprej se vsak zasuče okoli osebnega dohodka. Upravičena slava po denarju je izražena v ukažljnosti mladih ljudi. Predlanskim je položilo izpite za kvalifikacijo 10,000 delavcev, lani 17,600, a leta 1958 komaj 7000. Spremenjanje kvalifikacijske strukture delavcev in uslužbenec seveda vpliva na formiranje povprečnega mesečnega osebnega dohodka, ki se je lani v Sloveniji približal okroglim 30,000 dinarjem, kar je dokaj nad povprečjem v drugih republikah.

Višji osebni dohodek — več ustvarljivih želja! Še predlanskim je na račun raznih kreditov dolgovalo bankam in trgovini 120,000 dolžnikov (najemnikov kredita!) 3 milijarde in 300 milijonov dinarjev, lani beleži statistika 188,000 dolžnikov, ki dolgujejo 16 milijard in 600 milijonov dinarjev. Primerjava dolžnikov in dolgov govorji v prid dražjim nakupom in nič čudnega ni potemtakem v dejstvu, da je bilo v Sloveniji predlanskim 24,000 motorjev in 23,700 avtomobilov, lani pa je drvelo po naših cestah 29,000 motornih koles in že 30,874 avtomobilov.

Skladno z osebnimi dohodki se cene raznih proizvodov — predvsem motorjev, avtomobilov, da ne podčrtamo razne gospodinjske mehanizme, radijske aparate, ki jih je bilo lani v decembri v Jugoslaviji že nad 2 milijona, in televizijske sprejemnike, ki so že presegli število 130,000 — v tolikšni meri dostopne, da vsakogar opogumljajo pri iskanju kredita, pri nakupu, mu dajejo impuls pri štendni.

Mimogrede: leta 1961 je bilo na hranilnih knjižicah v Jugoslaviji nekaj nad 24 milijard dinarjev, lani 30 milijard, letos še za nekaj milijard več!

Vse tole je seveda povezano v številom rojstev, s pristopom prirastkom, z oblikovanjem odnosa do otrok; v vseh teh številkah tiči odgovor na vprašanje, ki si ga bomo bržkone zastavili čez deset ali dvajset let, ko bomo ugotovili, da imamo preveč šol, preveč postelj v porodnišnicah, preveč denarja za mlečne kuhinje in za otroške jasli, preveč vsega za otroke in za njihovo rast, mnogo več kot smo imeli kdajkoli, recimo tam nekje v letu 1963.

"NAROD, ENKRAT BLAGOSLOVLJEN, DEVEK RAT OBSOJEN, KAKO SI ŽIVEL, KAJ SI DOŽIVEL?"

Ivan Cankar je bil neusmiljen s svojimi vprašanji. Večjala so njegovemu času, odmevajo dandanes.

Res, kako živi današnja štiričlanska družina pri nas? Statistika pravi: ob povprečnem dohodku 610,000 din letno porabi družina v Sloveniji približno 230,000 din za prehrano, 25,000 din za tobak in piča, 87,000 din za oblačenje, 34,000 za stanovanje, 35,000 za opremo stanovanja in 23,000 za razsvetljavo in ogrevanje, 42,000 za kulturno izživljvanje ter za ostalo 32,000 din. Pri tem daje slovenska družina približno 68,000 din letno na račun raznih kreditov in so v končni vsoti izdatkov njeni dohodki manjši od izdatkov, kar seveda prekriva z najemanjem novih kreditov.

Ugotovitve statistike (ki so predvsem povprečne!) vsekakor kažejo na minimalna razpoložljiva sredstva za zadovoljitev tistih želja, ki so v prenekateri mladi družini vsakdanji imperativ: televizija, avto, hladilnik, pralni stroj in potovanja. Še leta 1958 smo imeli v prometu komaj 322 avtobusov, zdaj jih imamo nad 600, takrat smo prevozili okroglo poldrugi milijon potnikov, zdaj se približujemo petemu milijonu.

Kaj potlej ostaja za otroke?

Ob ljubezni — otroški dodatek! Ta je že dolga leta neizpremenjen in ostajamo pri desetih milijardah, ki jih izplačujemo na račun 300,000 otrok, kolikor jih je.

In če bi otroški dodatek uporabili kot spodbudo za skrbnejši odnos do rasti mladega rodu, kdo ve, če bi s tem ne spodbudili sle za avtomobili in sploh za udobnejšim življienjem!

Francija je imela pred leti podobne probleme, danes jih nima. Italija je znala uskladiti število rojstev z umrljivostjo in se njen diagram prirodnega prirastka rahlo vzpenja. Avstrija dohitela zamujeno v prvih povojnih letih.

Vrata tega problema pri nas so na široko odprta. V Jugoslaviji in še posebej v Sloveniji.

STRELA PRETRGALA TELEFONSKO ZVEZO MED BELO HIŠO IN KREMLJEM



Human Rights

A century after slavery was abolished in the United States, human beings are still bought and sold in some parts of the world.

And more than 150 years after the Bill of Rights became a bulwark for Americans, countries exist where inhuman punishment, forced labor, stern censorship and political oppression are commonplace.

To spread the benefits of democratic guarantees worldwide, the United Nations adopted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights just 15 years ago this month.

It evolved from earlier pro-

nouncements—from the Magna Charta to the American Declaration of Independence. Many of its provisions parallel those of the U.S. Constitution: freedom of worship and expression and the right of peaceful assembly. It also calls for equal opportunity in the economic and social fields; the right to a job, a fair standard of living and universal education.

The declaration is neither a treaty nor a law. But as a statement of principle, it already has guided the framing of new constitutions and legislation in countries with gaps in their human-rights guarantees.



Reporting from Washington

THE PRESIDENT'S BUDGET MESSAGE. Highlighting last week's activities was the presentation of the President's Budget Message for fiscal year 1965, which begins July 1. We were told this is a budget of "economy and progress". The \$97.9 billion requested purports to be \$500 million less than the amount recommended by President Kennedy a year ago. However, it is about \$5.5 billion higher than was actually appropriated by the Congress for the present fiscal year. President Johnson's first budget tops the last one submitted by President Eisenhower by some \$16.4 billion.

Deficit financing continues to have heavy impact upon your tax dollar. Interest costs on the national debt next year will rise \$400 million above 1964's requirements to \$11 billion. In other words, even before the government starts spending, over 11 cents of the budget dollar must come off the top for interest charges. Next to defense, this is our largest single Federal expenditure. Our debt charges cost us nearly seven times more of the taxpayers' dollars than will total Federal payments to educational facilities; and more than ten times as much will be spent on debt interest than for our entire Federal health research program.

However, it is encouraging to hear the President include in the Budget Message and in public statements such language as "economy, frugality, and elimination of waste and mismanagement". We must wait to see if those words will be translated into action by the Executive and the Congress. This sudden emphasis upon economy by the Administration represents a whole-hearted affirmation of the fiscal position taken by Republicans last year relative to the proposed tax reduction program. No one has questioned the need for cutting taxes all down the line. However, many Members of Congress, including myself, believe that tax reduction should be geared to a reduction in federal spending.

NEW NATIONAL MUSEUM

One of Washington's newest monuments honors man's technological achievement and cultural progress. Situated on the Mall, between the Capitol and the Wash-

ington Monument, is the Smithsonian's newest addition, the Museum of History and Technology. I was privileged to be present when President Johnson dedicated this magnificent new building on January 22. In the center hall of the museum a golden pendulum swings, demonstrating one of the most basic scientific proofs for the rotation of the earth. It is attached to the ceiling of the second floor and hangs down through the spherical opening in the ceiling of the first floor. A golden indicator arm on the floor indicates how fast the building turns independent of the pendulum. Looking up through the opening, the visitor can see the original Star Spangled Banner that flew over Fort McHenry.

Although some of the exhibits are still incomplete, early visitors will see the Halls of Everyday Life and American Costume, including the gowns of the First Ladies, on the second floor, and farm machinery, railroads, vehicles, tools, clocks and watches, phonographs and typewriters on the first floor. One of the largest exhibits is a 180-ton steam locomotive and tender. It was necessary to install the locomotive before the building was completed and then build the room around it.

The second floor is devoted to civil and political history and the third floor to the history of the armed forces. Also featured on the third floor will be exhibits of ceramics, glass, musical instruments, printing presses, the history of money, the National postage stamp collection and the history of the mails. Those planning trips to Washington should put this building on their "must" list. It is a truly wonderful Museum!

DID YOU KNOW?

My colleague in the 23rd District, Honorable William E. Minshall, recently called attention to the fact that four of the "favorite son" statues selected by the States for the Capitol's famed Statuary Hall are "favorite daughters" — Frances E. Willard, Illinois temperance leader and college president; Dr. Florence Rena Sabin, Colorado, first woman member of the National Academy of Sciences; Maria Sanford, Minnesota educator; and Esther Hobart Morris, Wyoming, first woman justice of the peace.

Sports Resort

Development of Ohio's first all seasons, all sports resort in the heart of Mohican State Forest was announced by Natural Resources Director Fred E. Morr.

The development is under way on scenic Mohican Mountain in Ashland County, off State Route 97, near Perrysville. The lodge itself will initially offer 60 rooms for overnight guests, Morr said.

"What pleases me most," Morr added, "is the complete versatility of the development. It offers a complete selection of recreational activities for spring, summer, fall, and winter."

The scenic facility is under development by Chiefs, Inc., under the direction of Buck Wertz, president, and Karl Sturtz, vice president, who originated Ohio's first commercial winter sports area.

The development, Morr said, is in line with the avowed administration policy of working closely with private enterprise to beef up Ohio's tourist attraction potential, and to capture a larger share of the nation's tourist dollars.

"It also represents a part of the state's economic development drive," Morr said. "The facility will not only create new jobs itself, but represents the kind of recreational area which industry places high on its site-selection list."

In addition to a rustic lodge and good cuisine, Morr said, the facility will offer golfing, hiking, horseback riding, archery, swimming, canoeing, tennis, fishing, skiing, water skiing, skeet and trap shooting, rifle and pistol ranges, ice skating, badminton, shuffleboard, tobogganing, snow shoeing, ski-joring, sleigh riding, hay rides, and horse shows.

"The Mohican Mountain scenery is unsurpassed," Morr declared. "The development lends itself to every kind of recreation and hobby for every age and every season."

The lodge will include three dining areas, many fireplaces, convention facilities, a nursery, country store, craft and apparel shop, ski rental shop, sauna baths, a heated swimming pool, recreation & game room, reading lounge, and private club room.

All sports facilities, Morr said, will be built to top specifications for the sport. Experts are to be hired as pros.

"Hikers will be able to obtain a box lunch at the lodge and follow many trails along scenic natural trails through all 5,000 acres of Mohican State Forest. Golfers will find an 18-hole championship course."

"Horsemen will find miles of country roads and trails, and an annual horse show will provide a test of skills. Swimmers will find a natural pool nestled in the hillside near the lodge plus a sandy beach minutes away at Pleasant Hill Reservoir."
